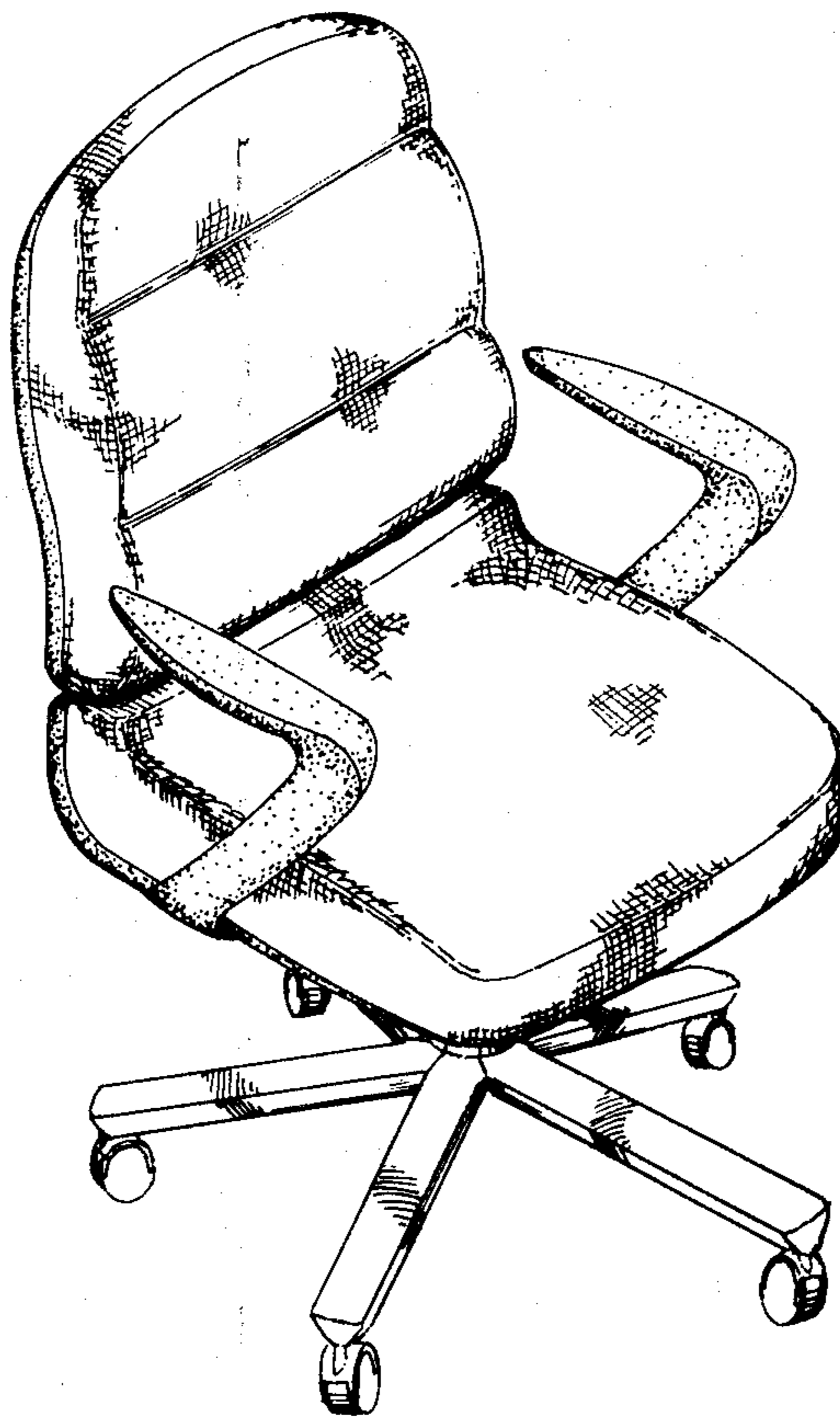

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a chair embodying our new design;
FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a front elevation view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a rear elevation view thereof.



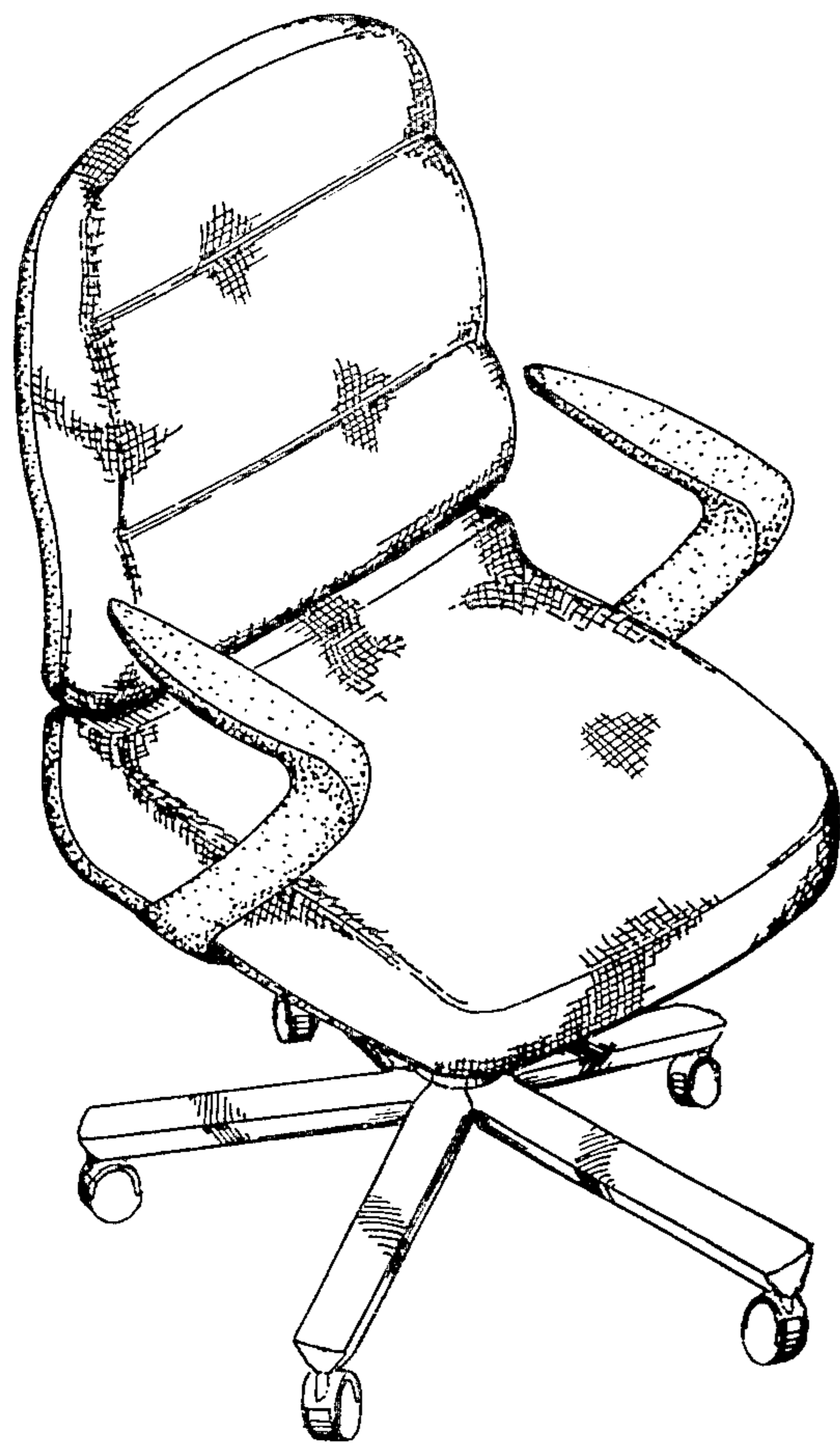

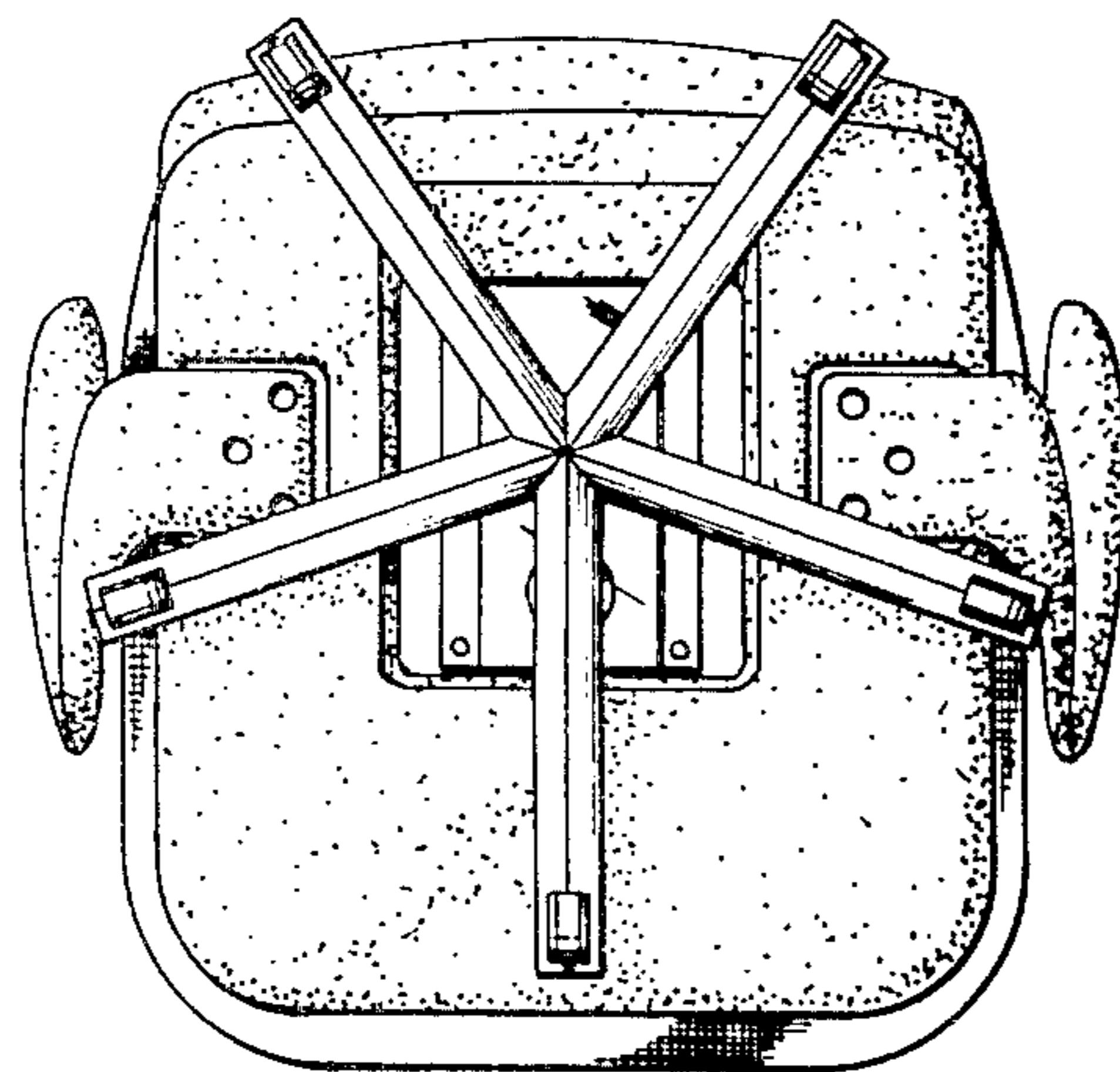

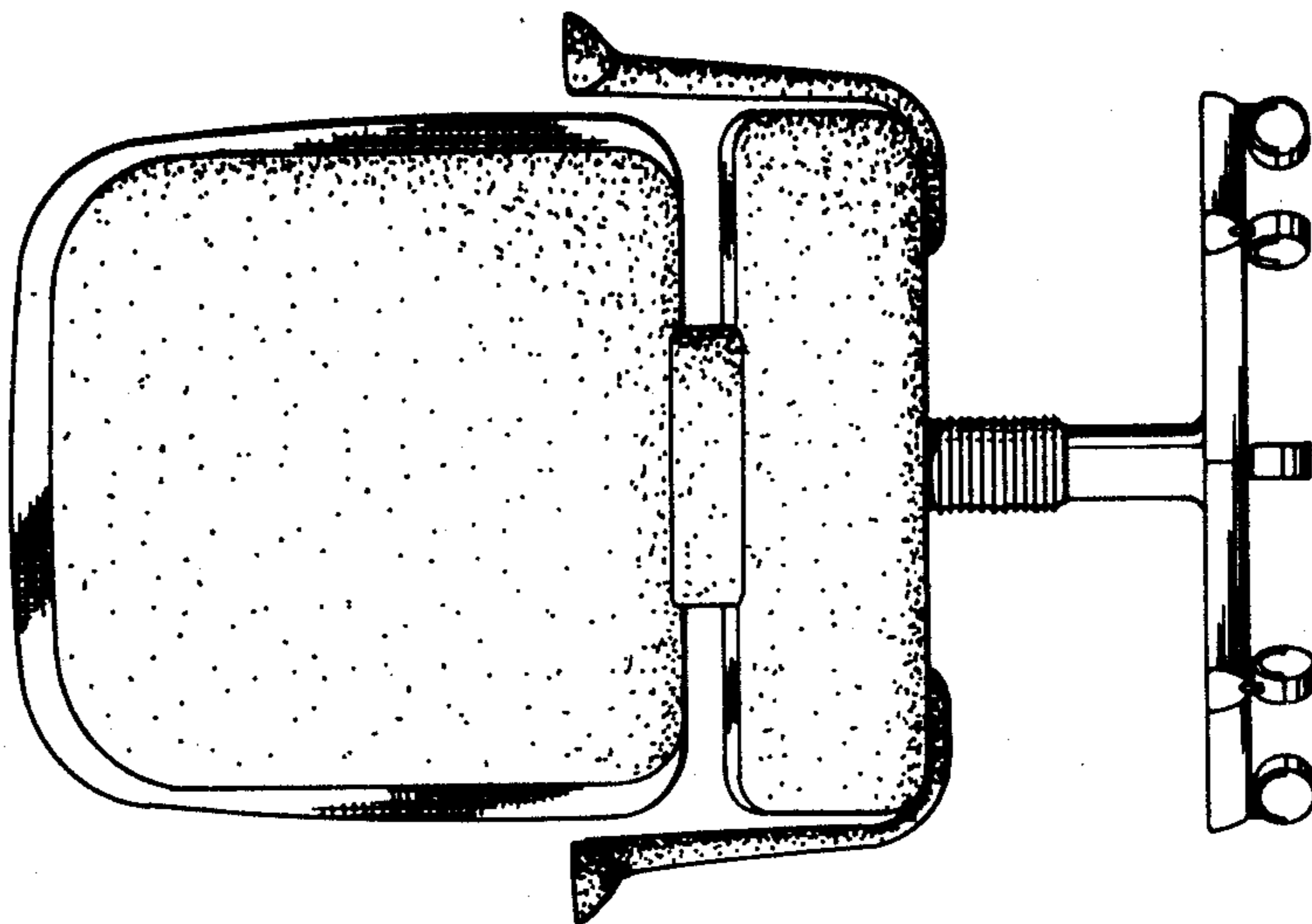

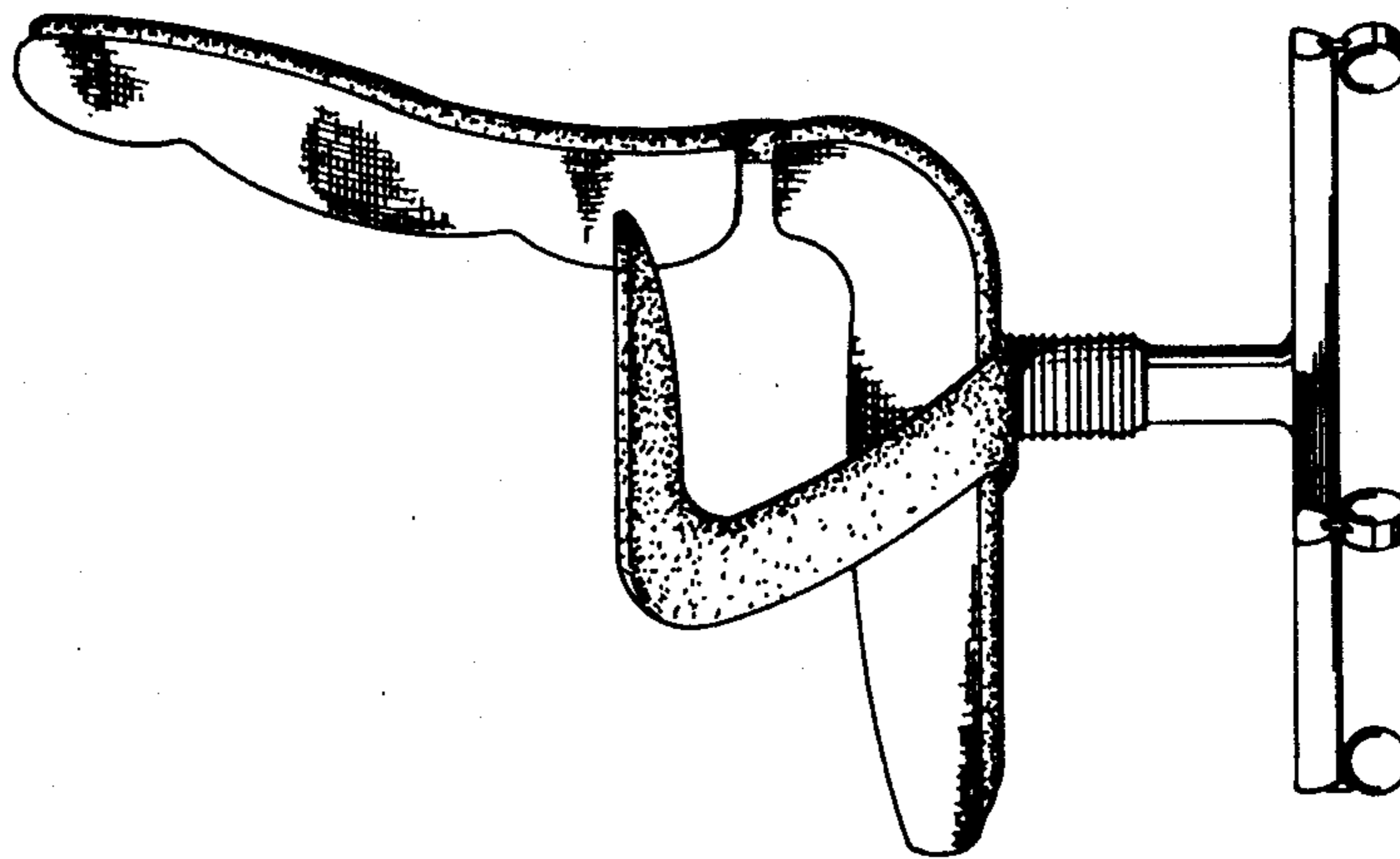

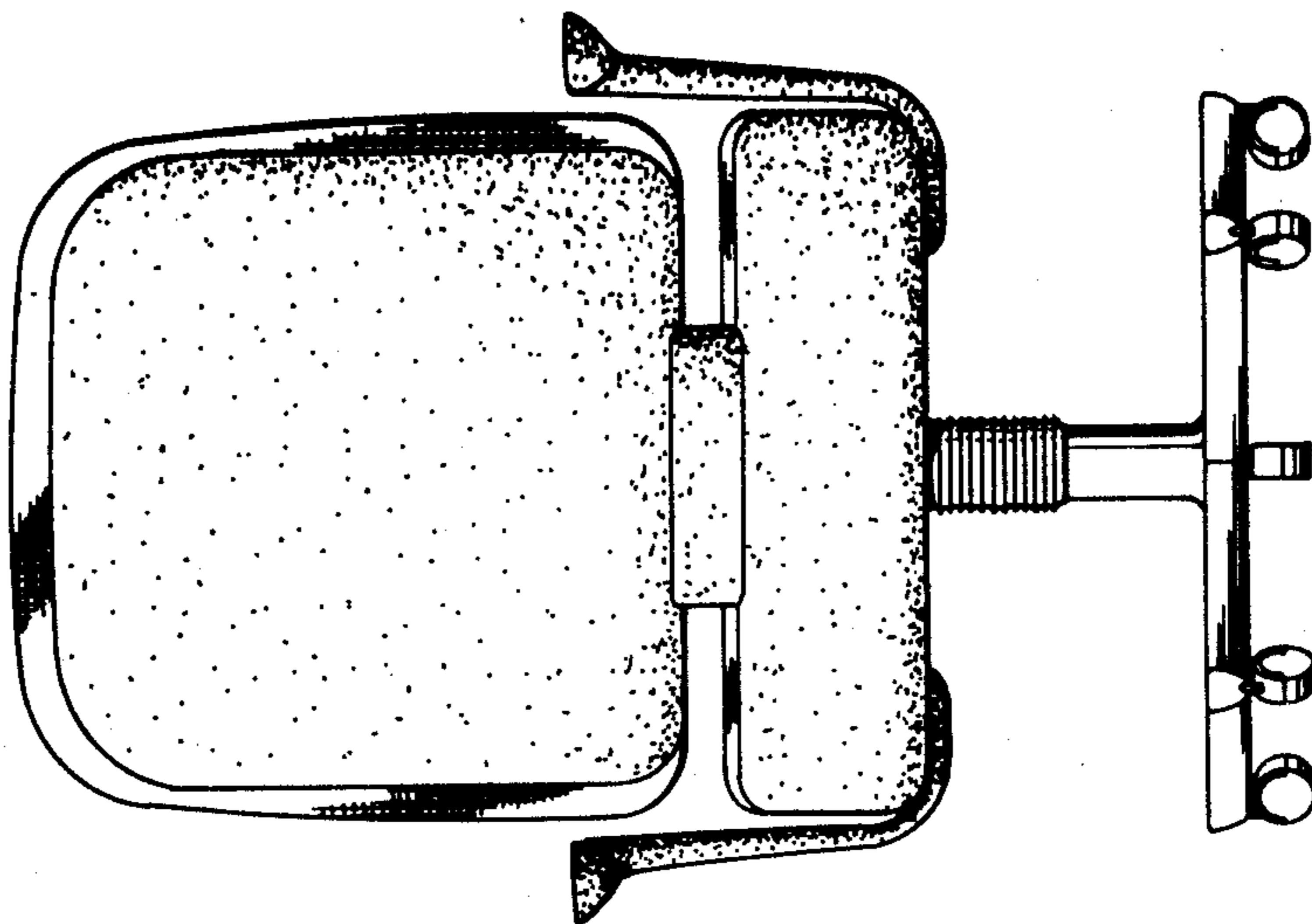
