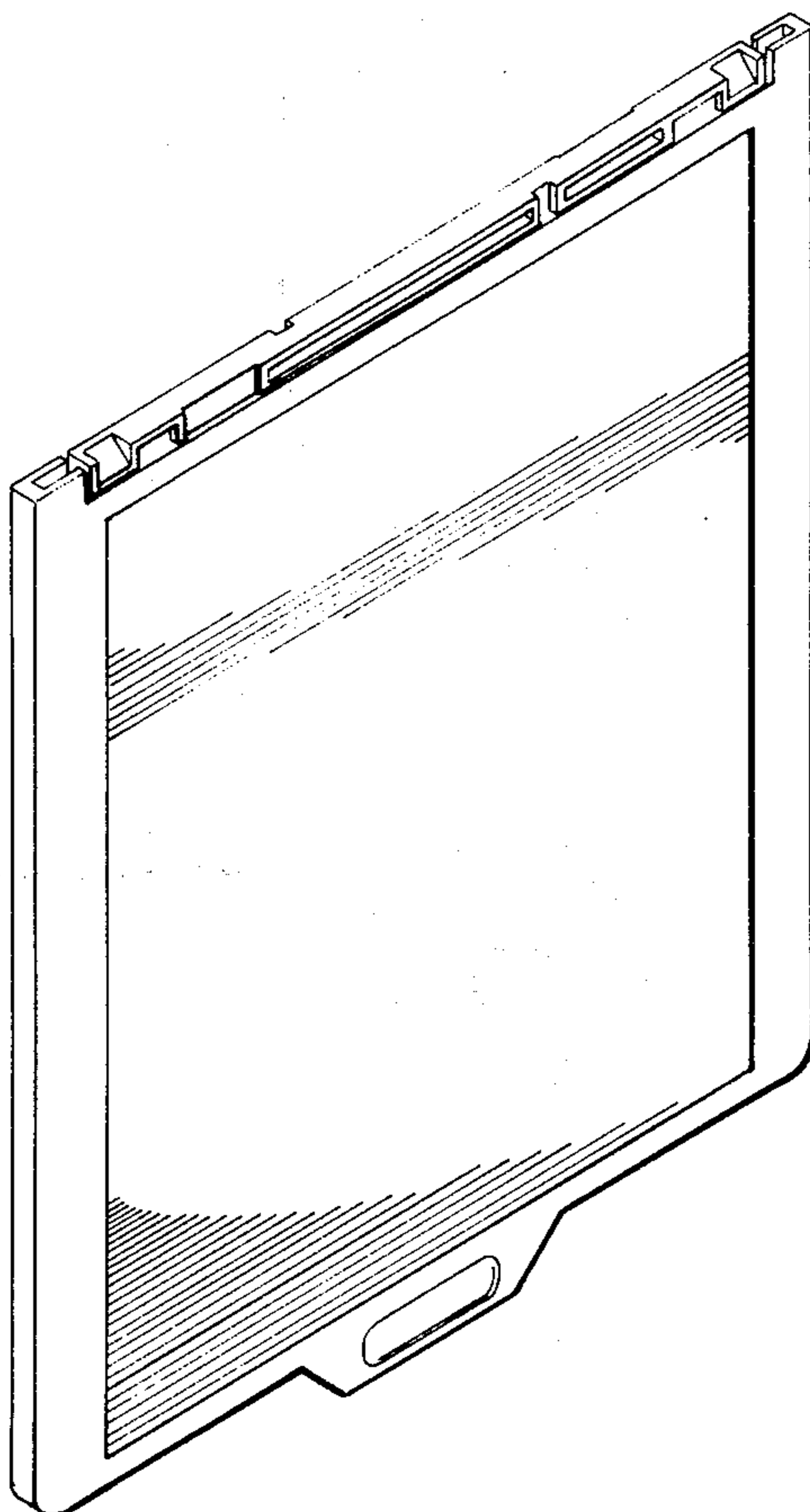

FIG. 4 is a back, top and right side perspective view.



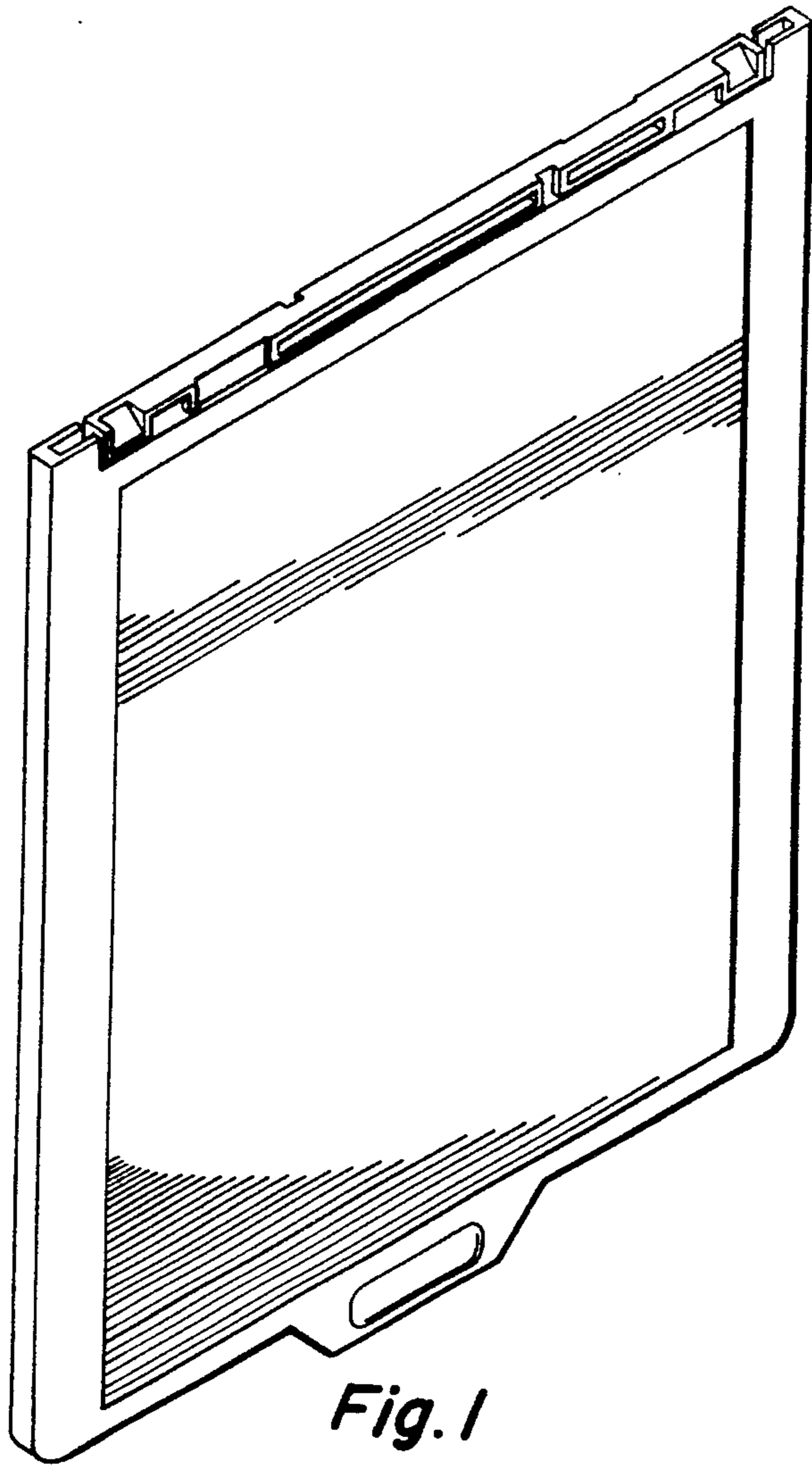

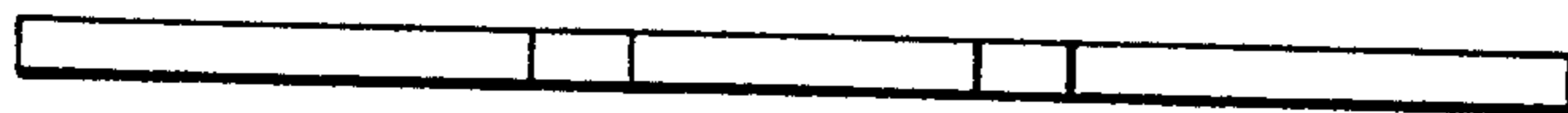

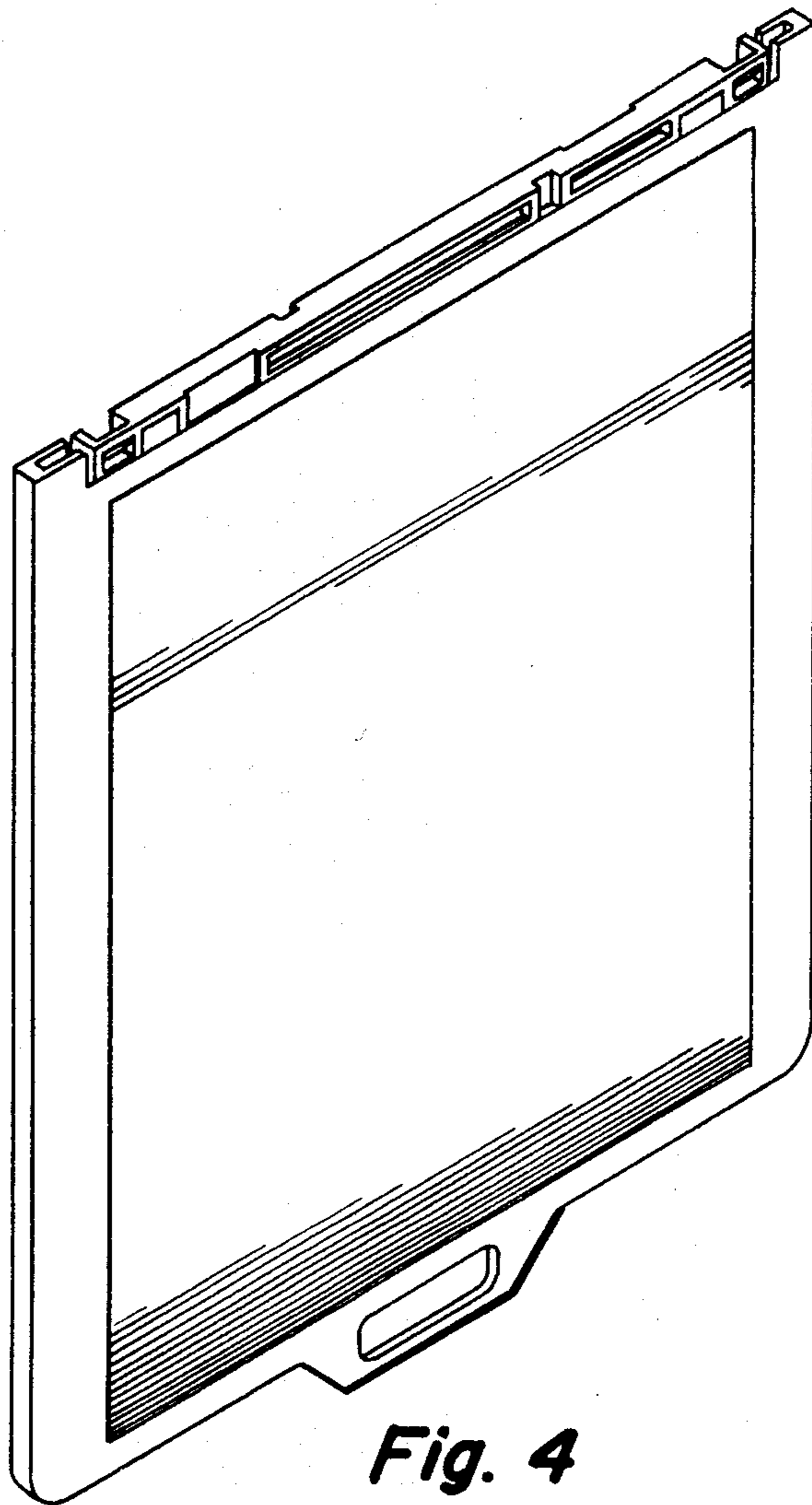
