The ornamental design for a lid for a container, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a lid for a container showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view;

FIG. 4 is a side elevational view;

FIG. 5 is an enlarged sectional view taken on the line 5—5 of FIG. 2;

FIG. 6 is a view similar to FIG. 5 but showing the tab portion in a depressed drinking position;

FIG. 7 is a fragmentary top plan view of FIG. 6;

FIG. 8 is a perspective view showing a modified form of our new design;

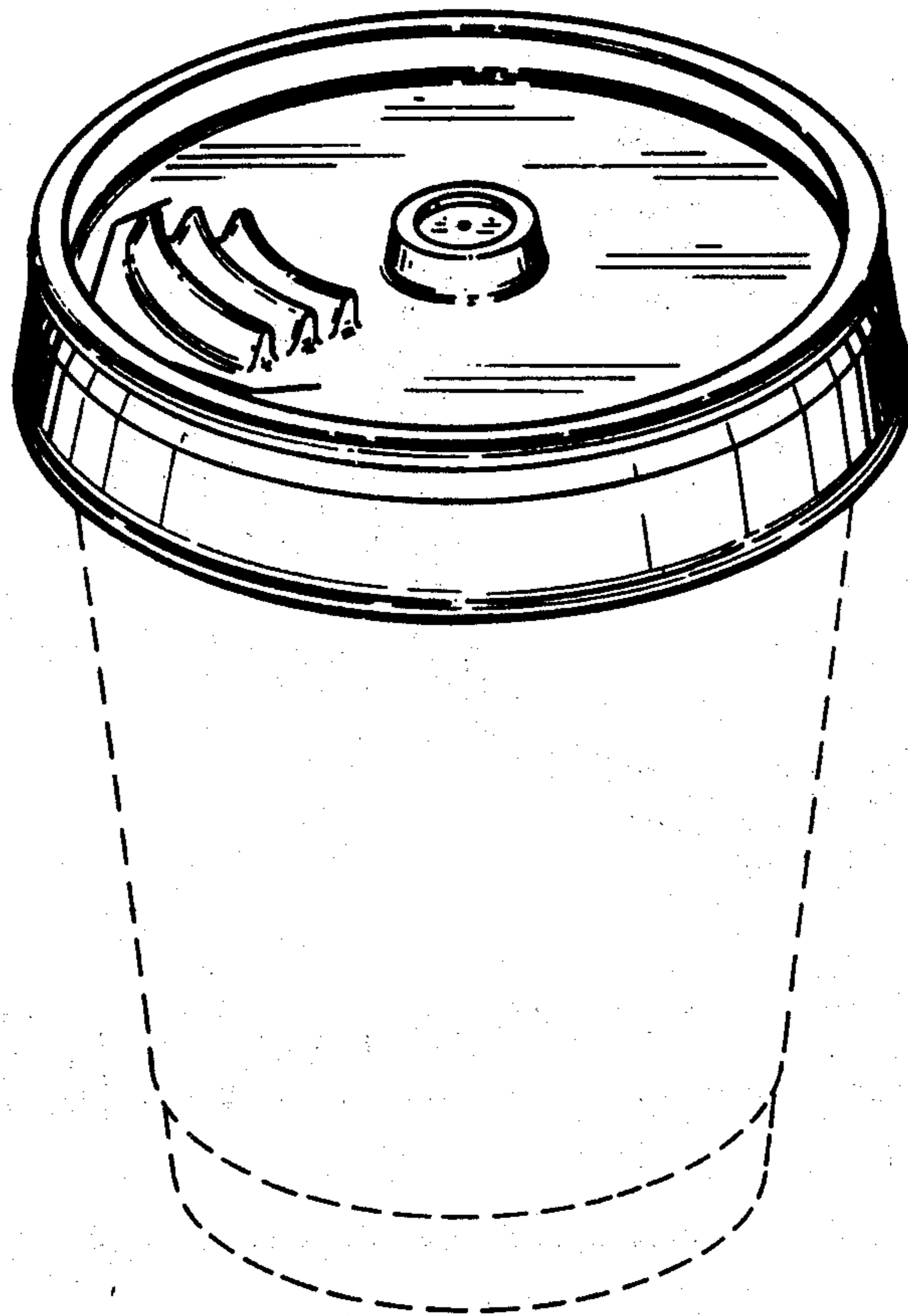
FIG. 9 is a top plan view thereof;

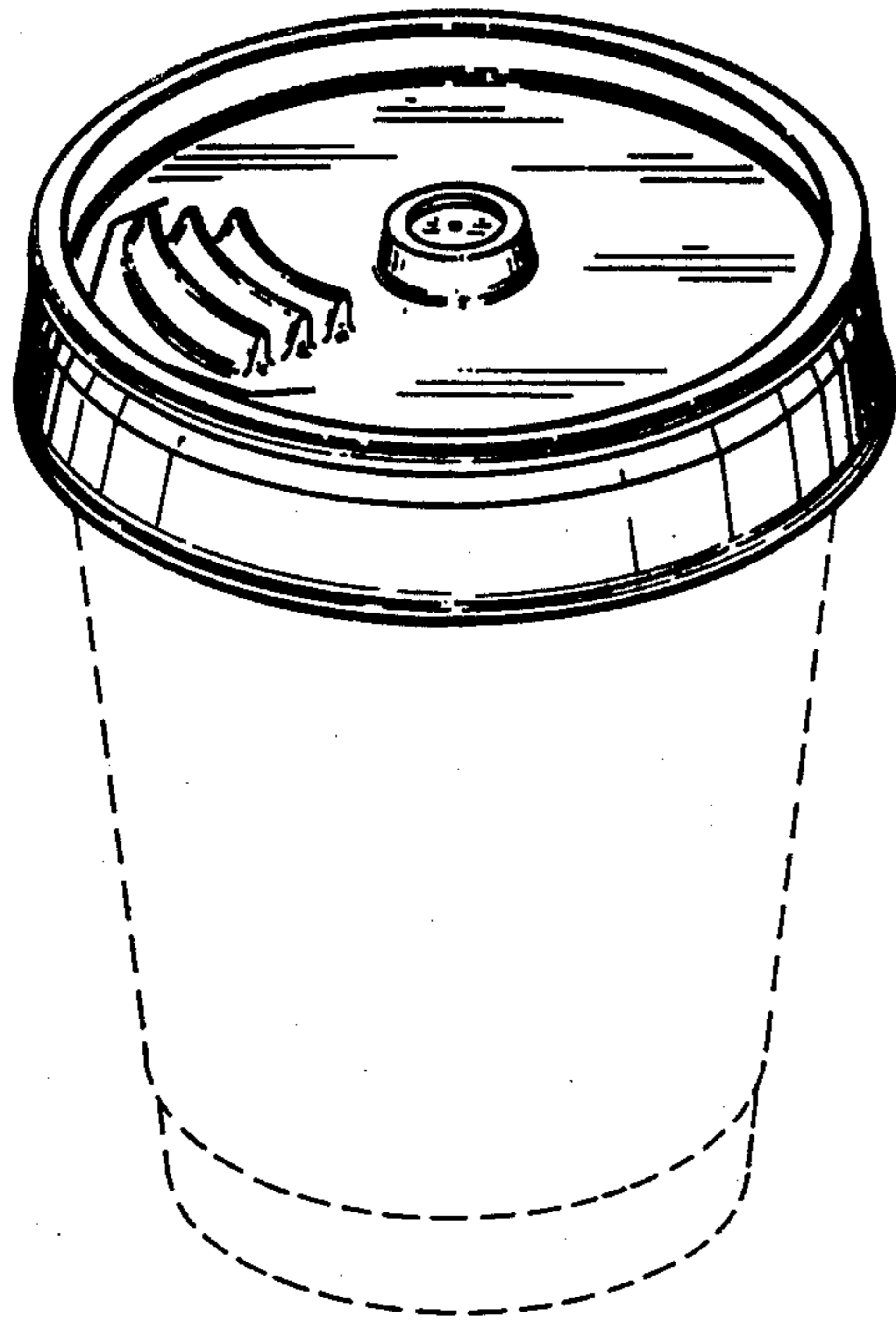
FIG. 10 is a bottom plan view;

FIG. 11 is a side elevational view; and

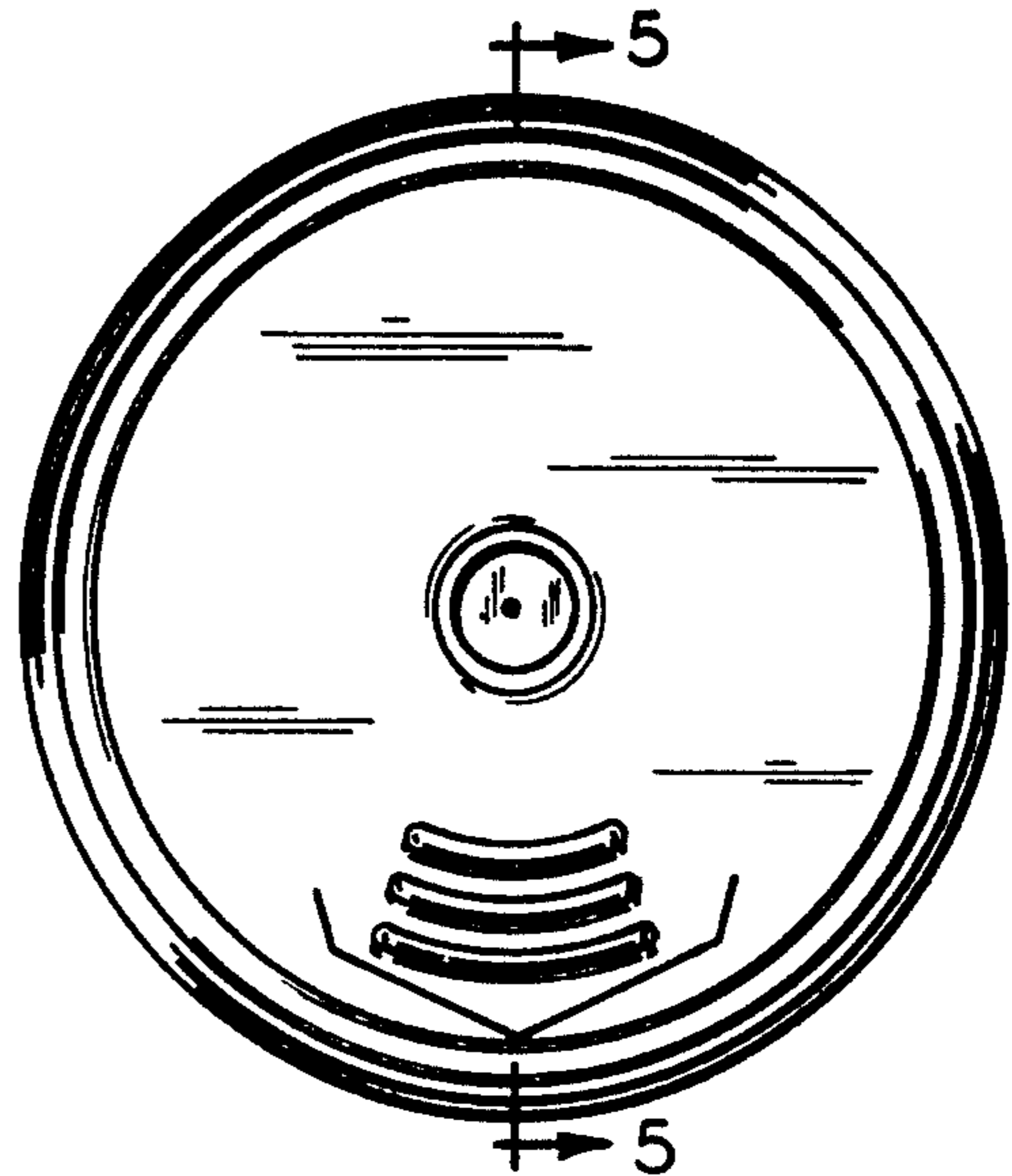
FIG. 12 is an enlarged sectional view taken on the line 12—12 of FIG. 9.

The broken lines showing a container are for illustrating environmental use only.

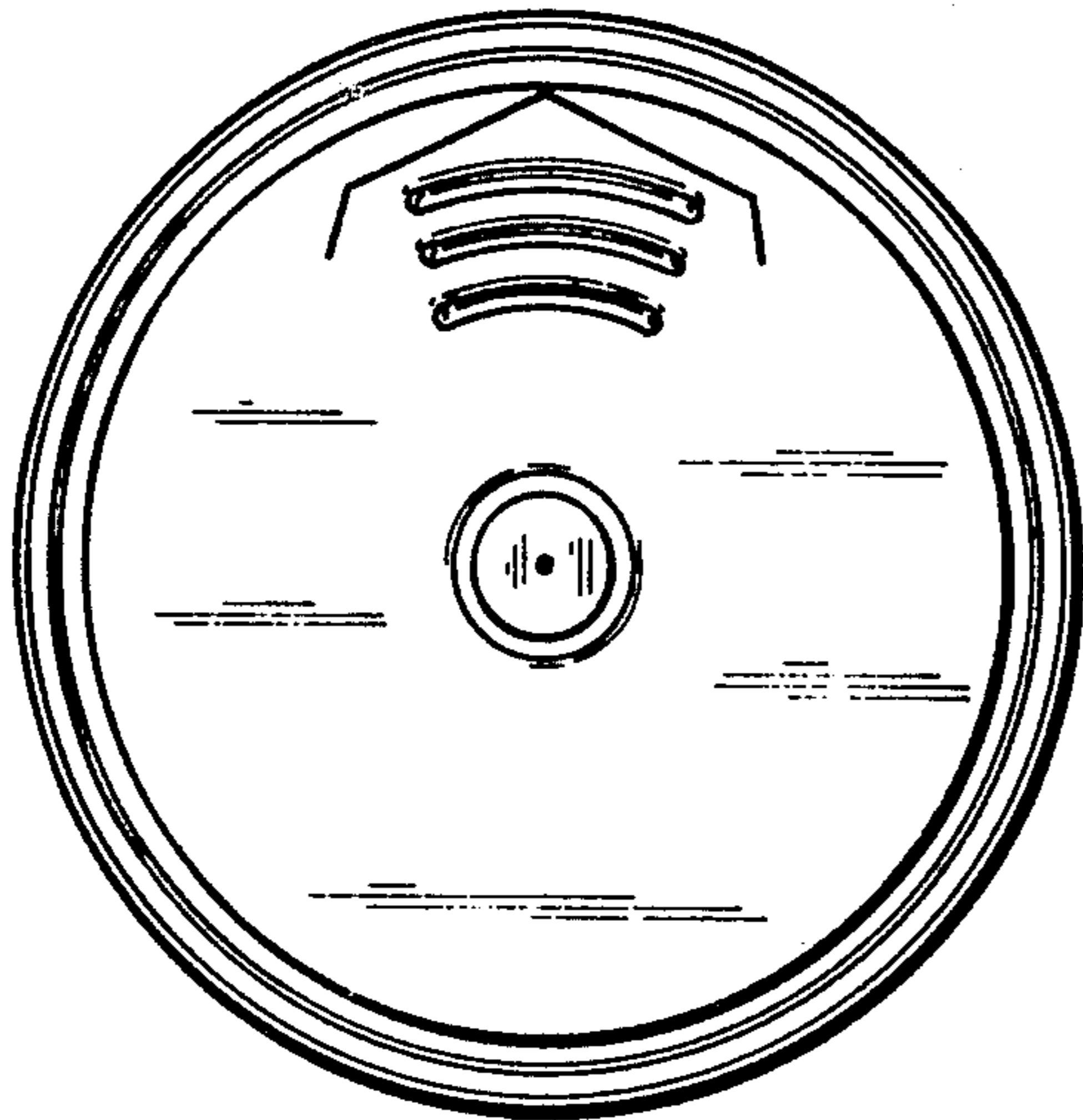




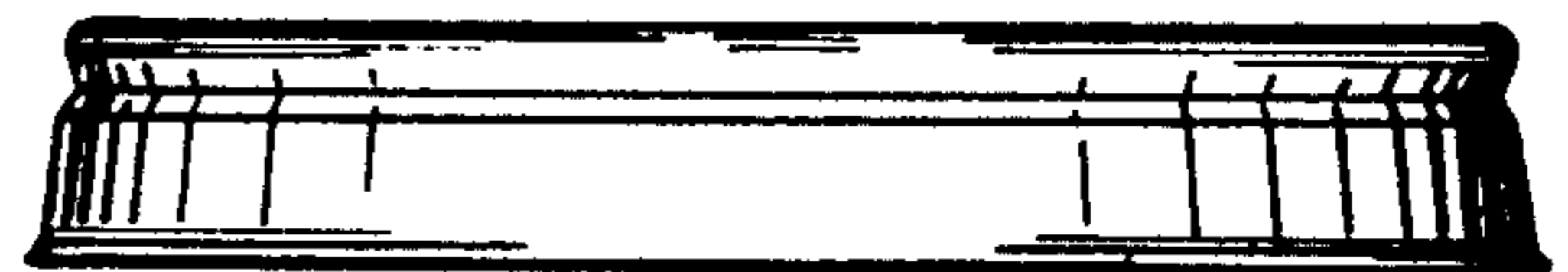

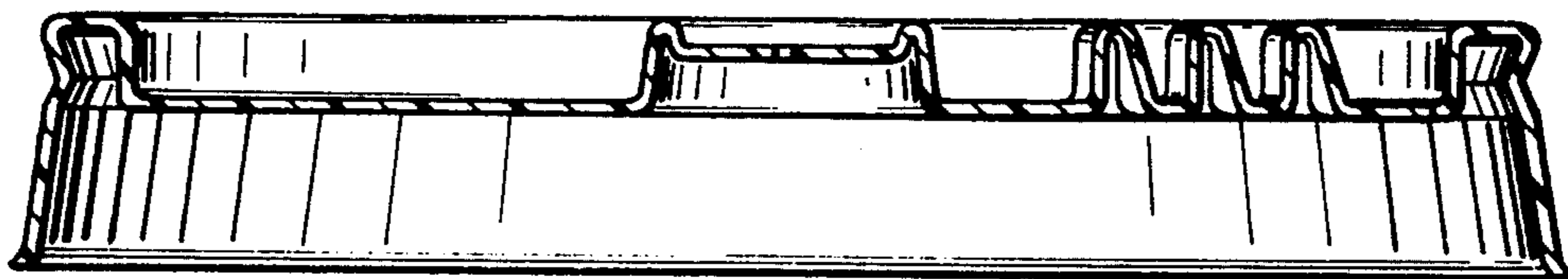

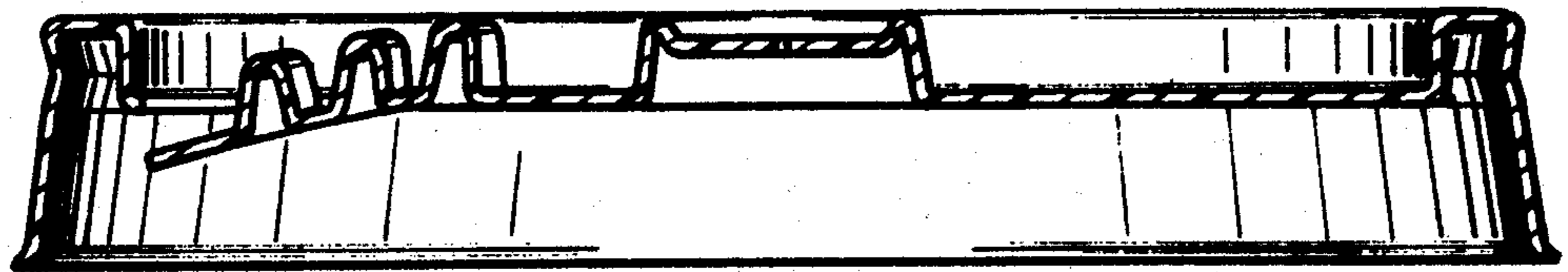

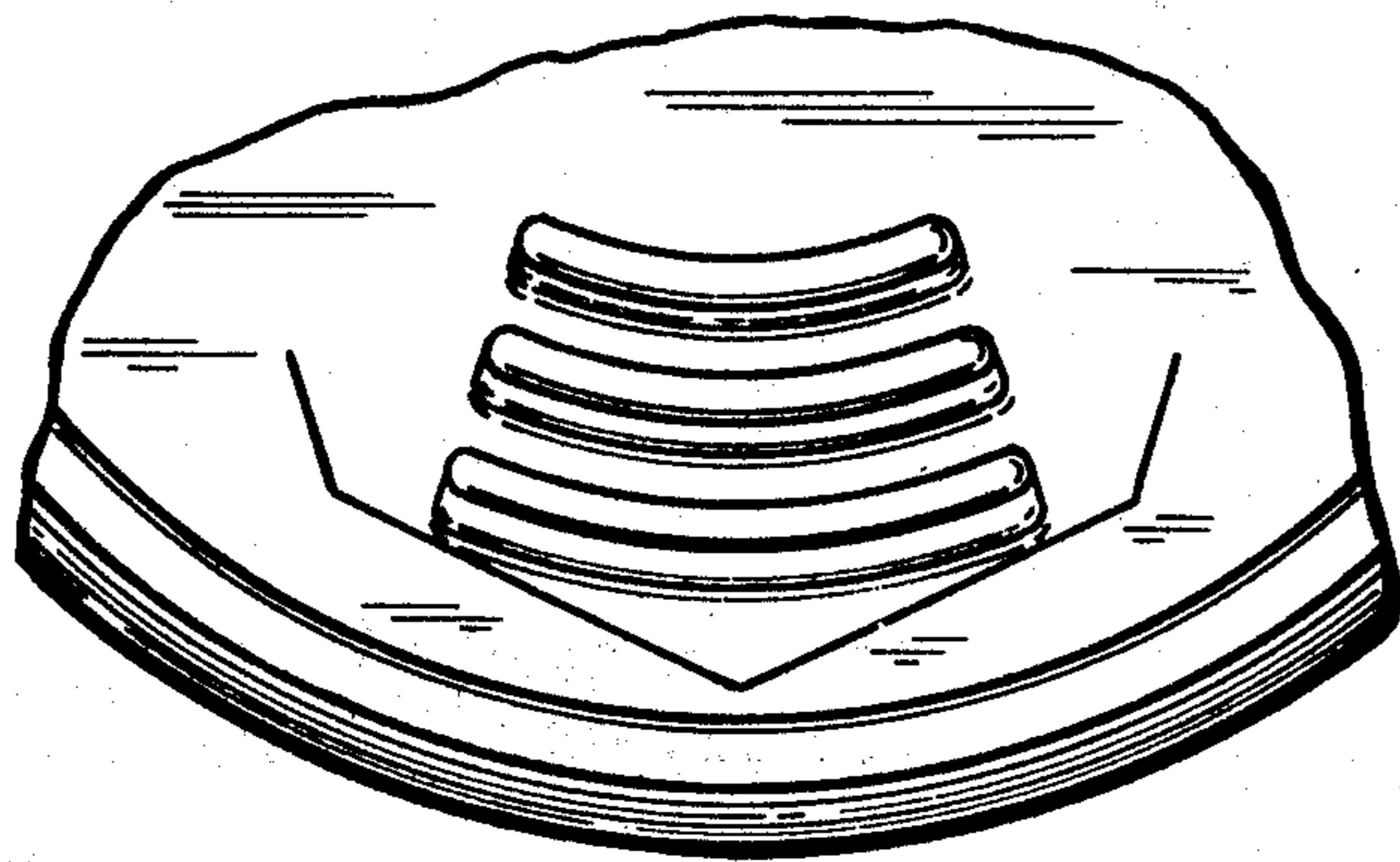

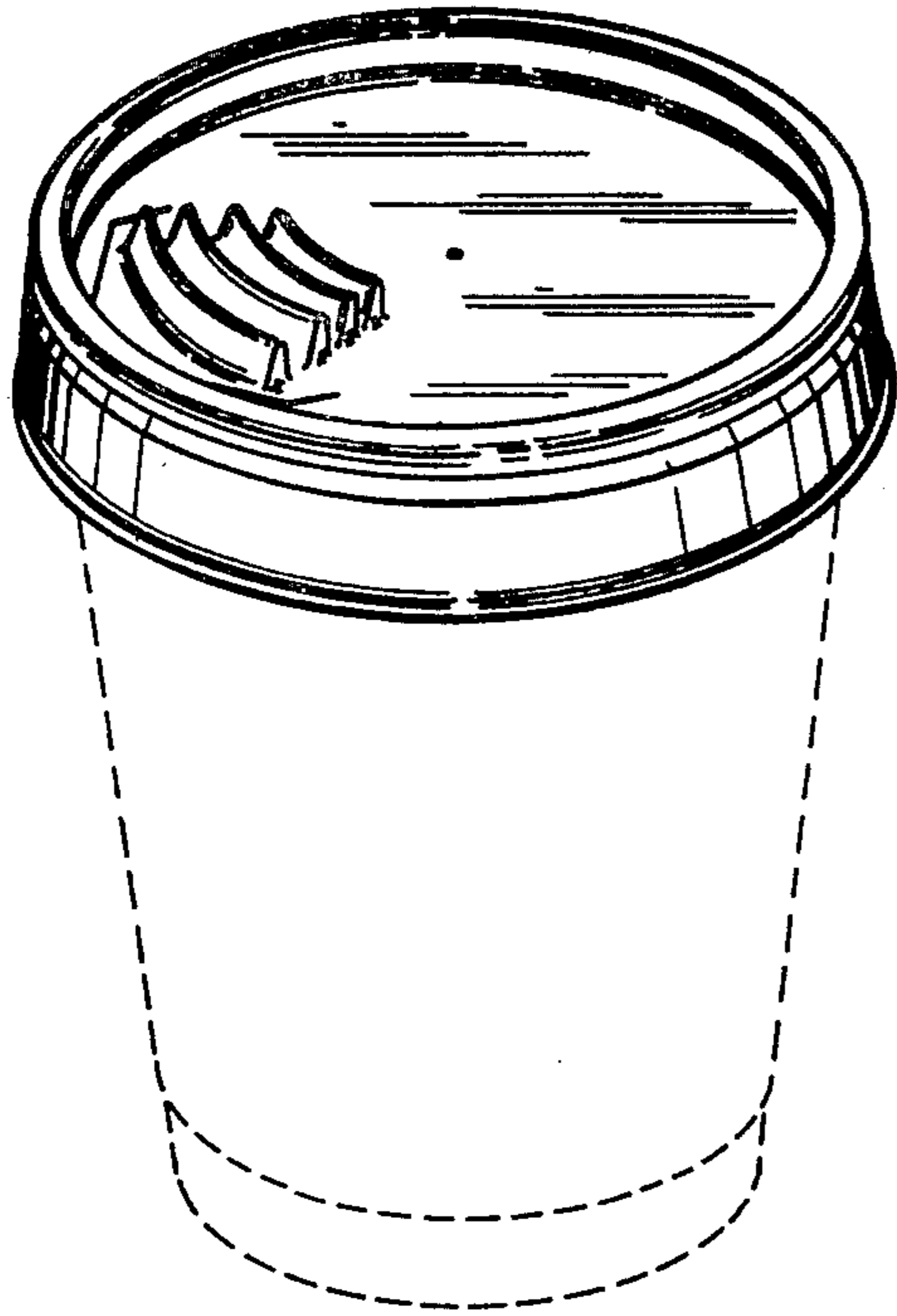

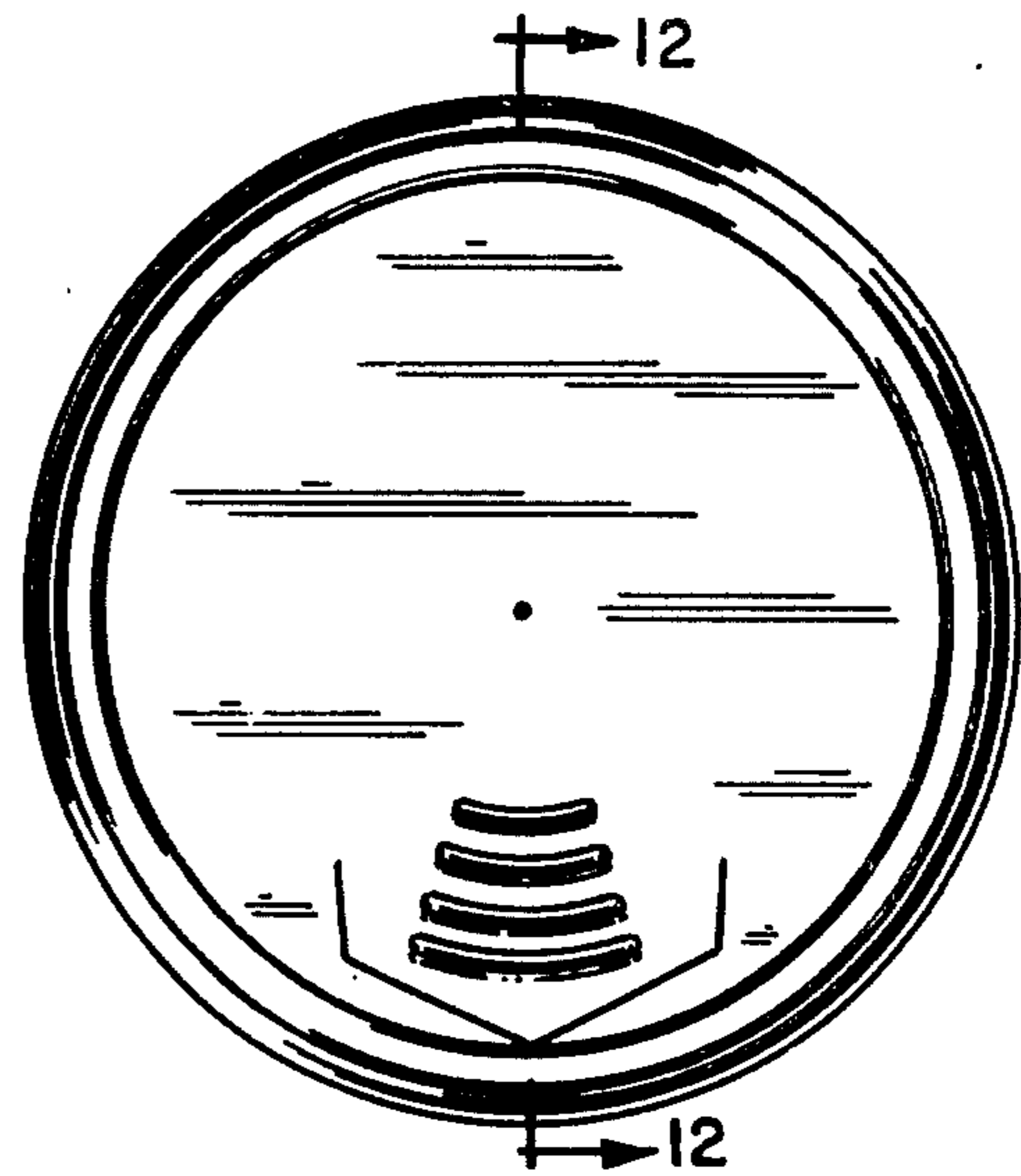

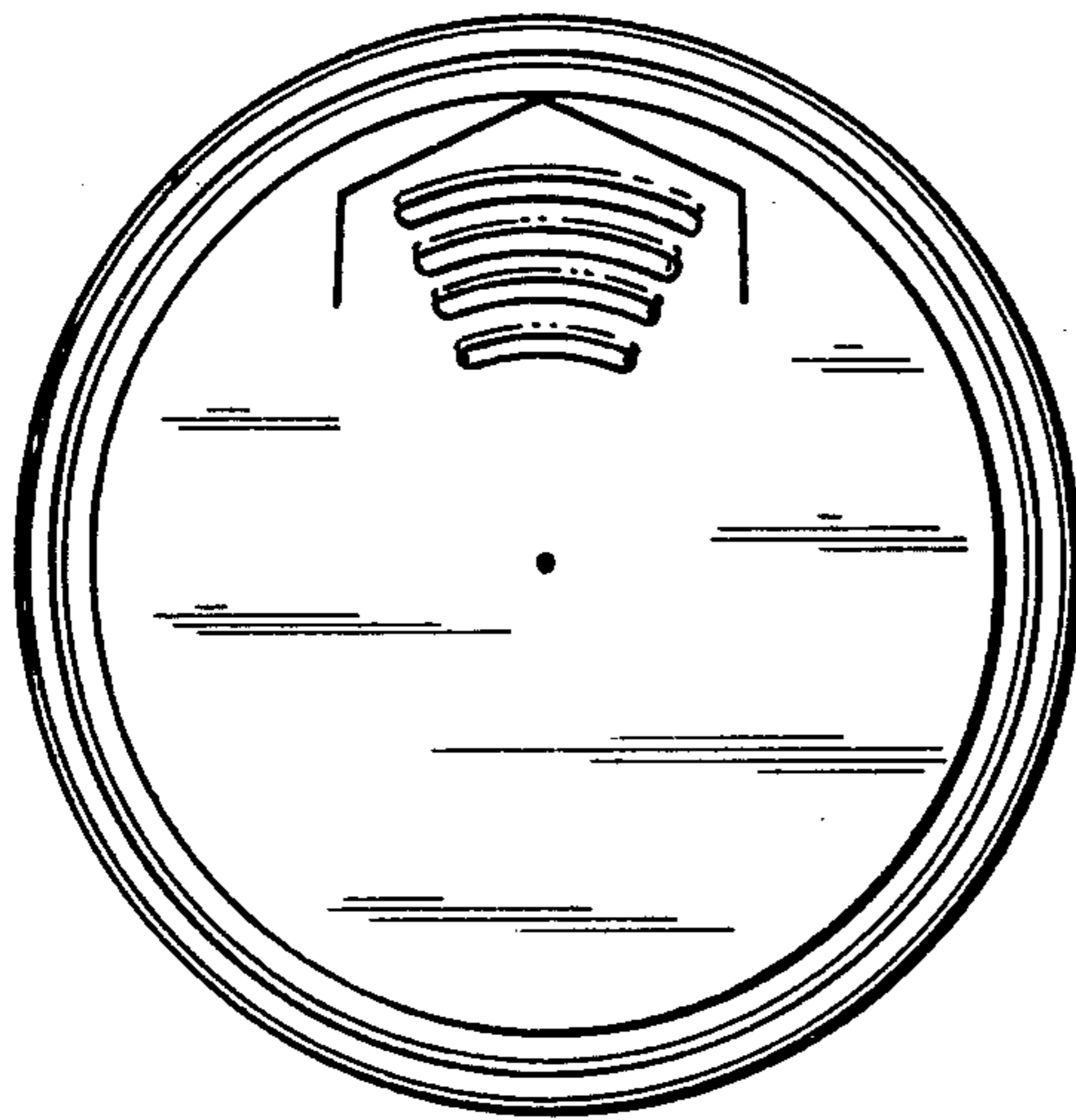

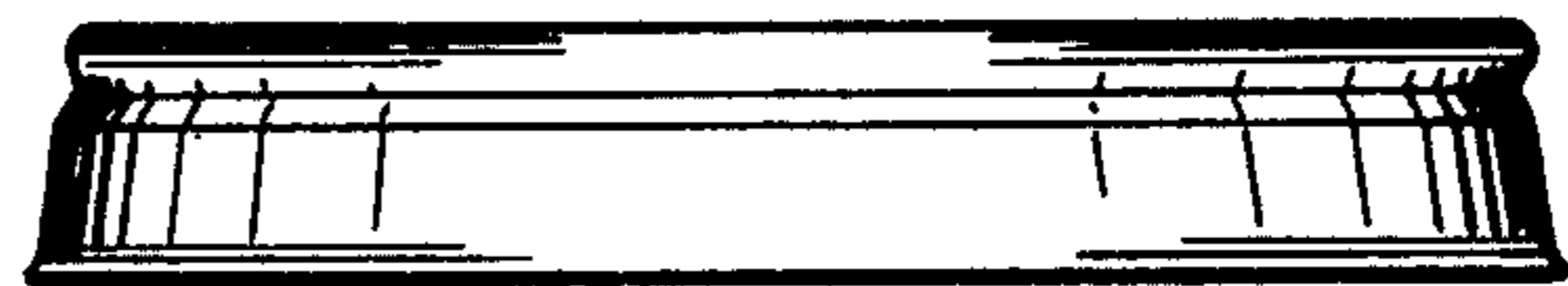

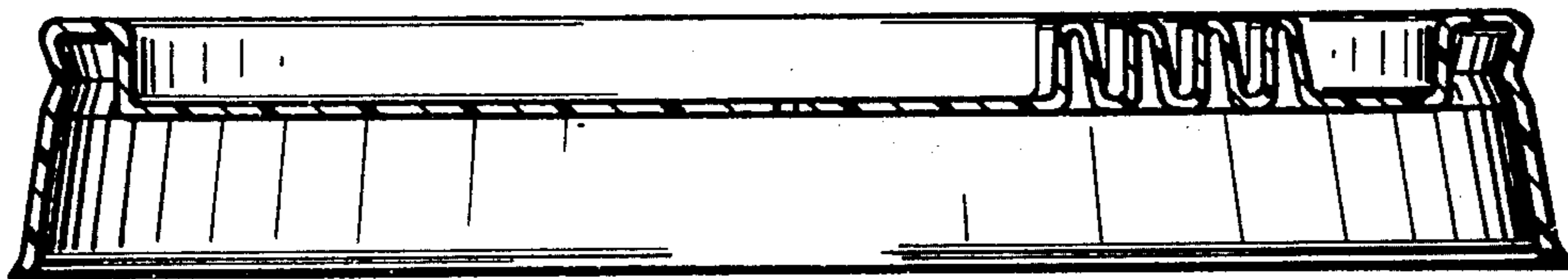
