DESCRIPTION

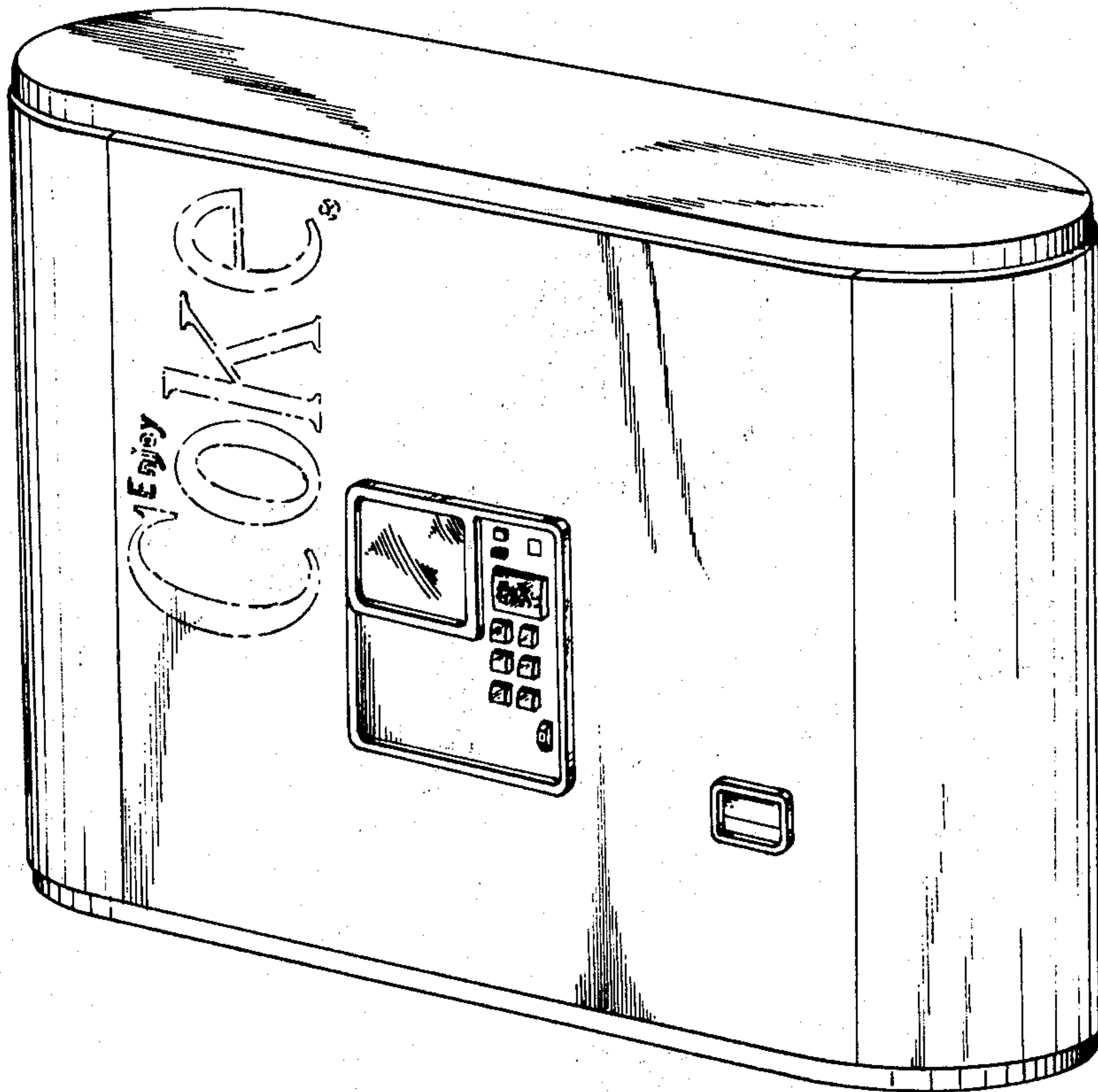

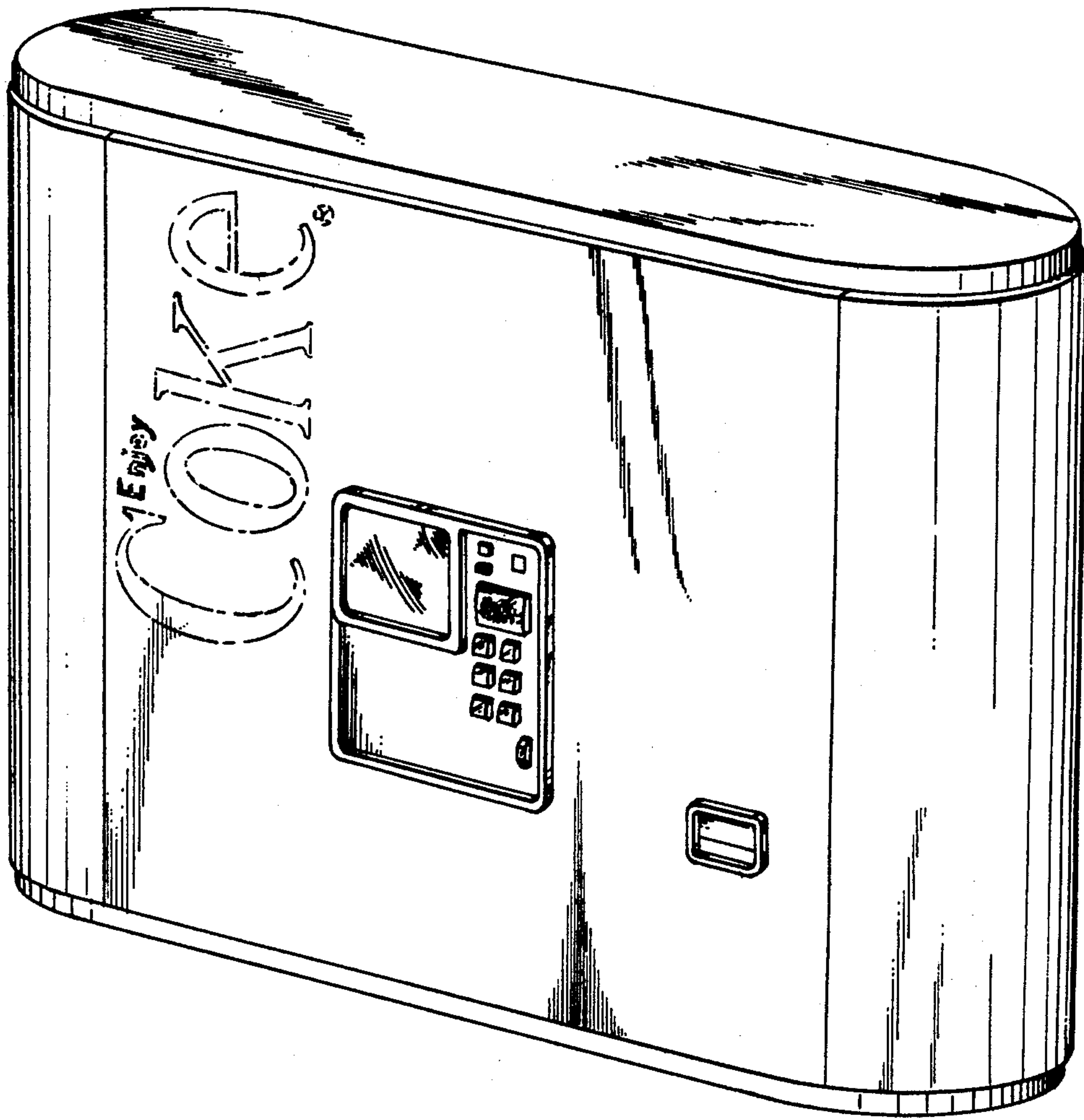

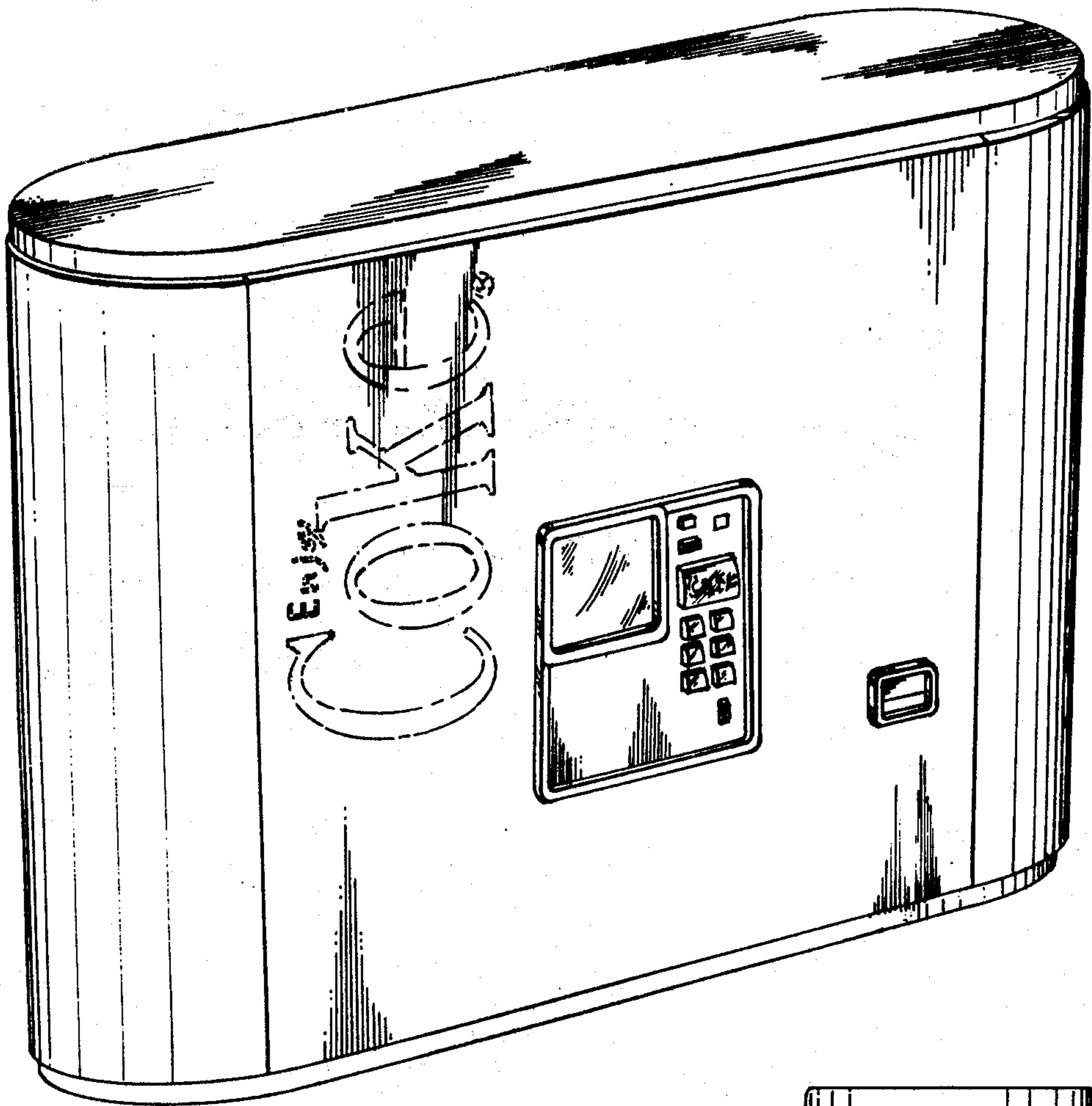

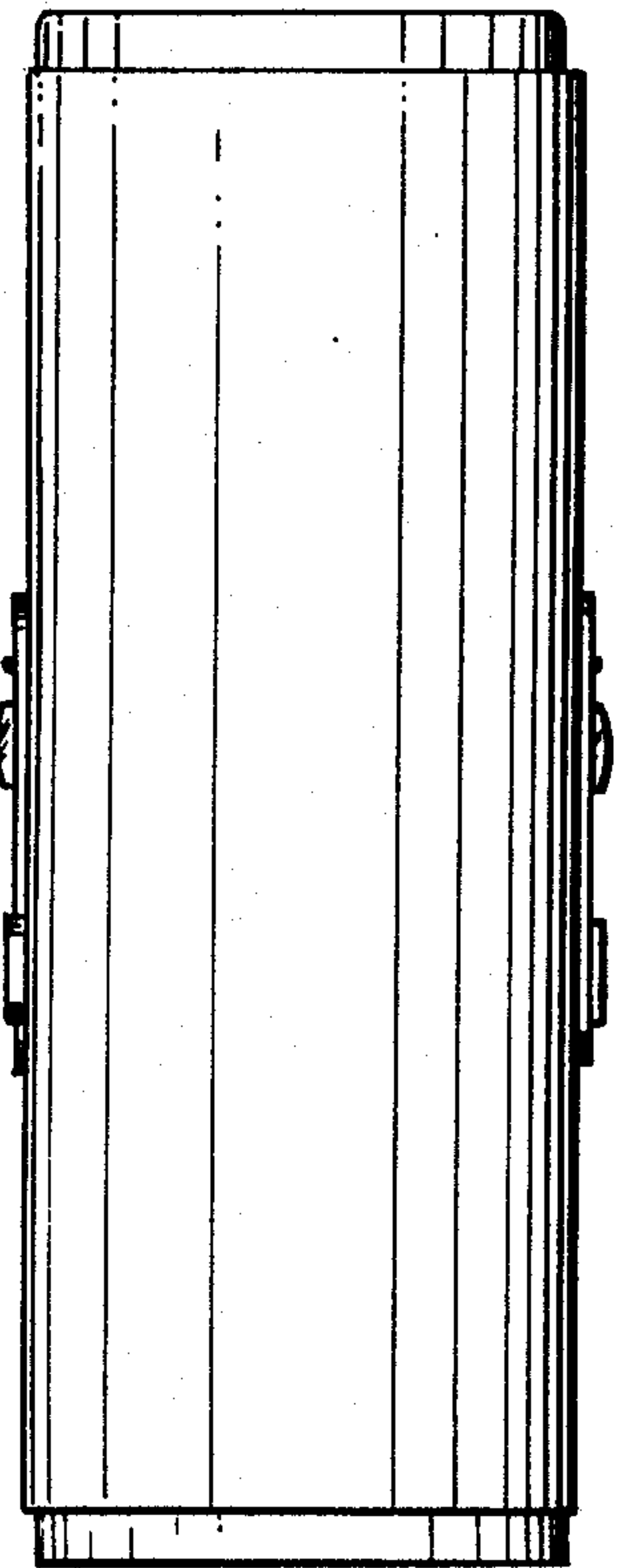

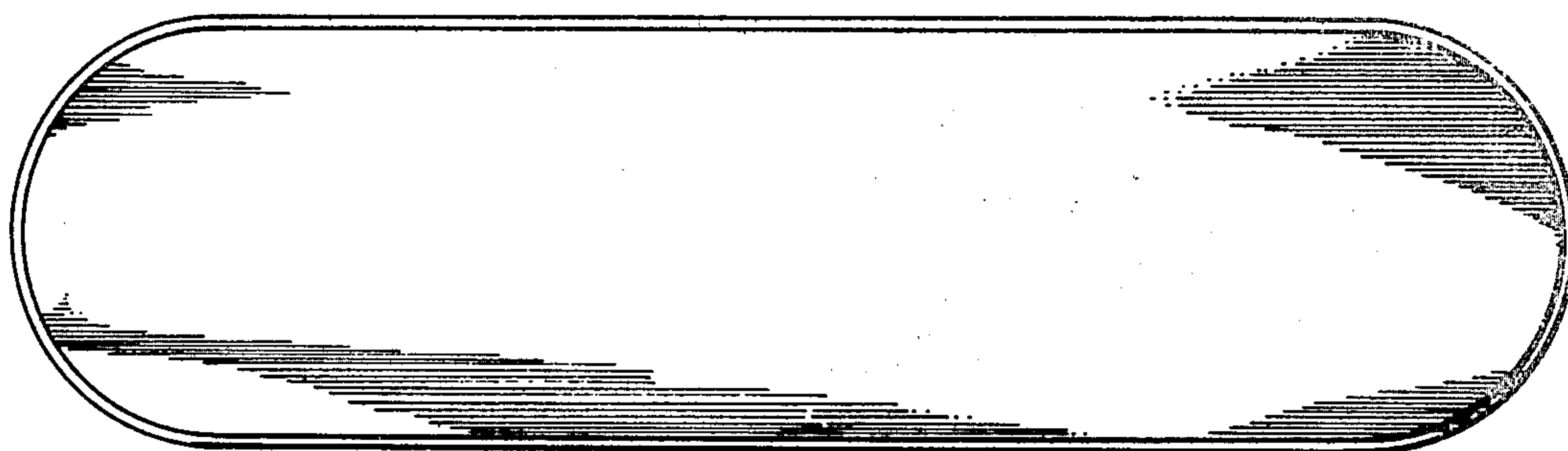
