FIG. 1 is an exploded perspective view of the game board showing our new design having the game base with a playing card in place, with the remaining playing cards of the set adapted to rest in said base in seriatim and being shown exteriorly of the base for clarity of illustration;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view of the game base;


FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view of the game base;

FIGS. 4-7 are top plan views of the game playing cards; FIG. 8 is a front elevational view of the game base with playing cards in situ; and

The sides and bottom of the playing cards are plain throughout.
















