[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a puzzle toy, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a puzzle toy showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof; and

FIG. 3 is a perspective view of the design shown in FIGS. 1 and 2 with the parts shown in exploded relationship, the perspective view of the side opposite that shown being substantially a mirror image.

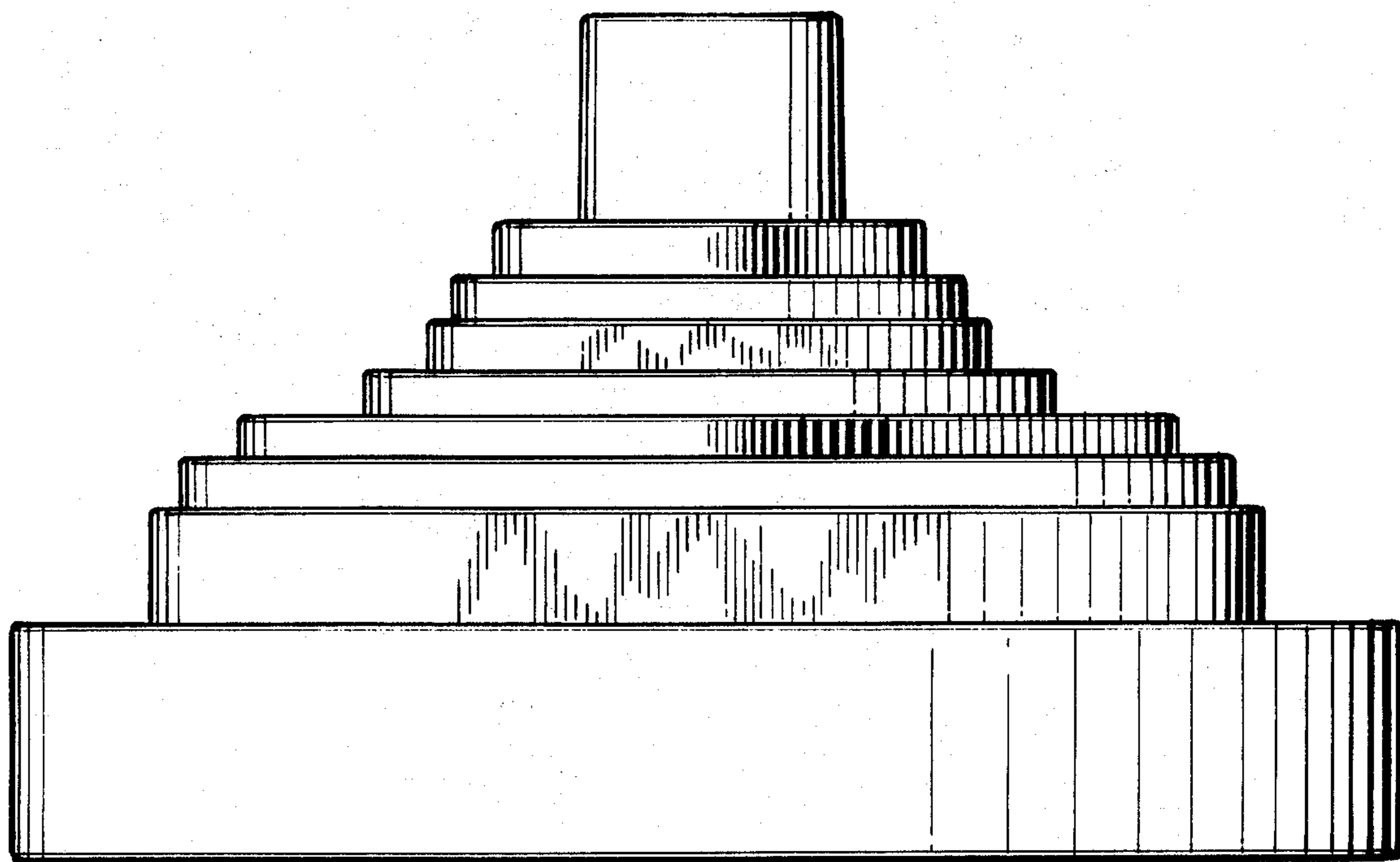

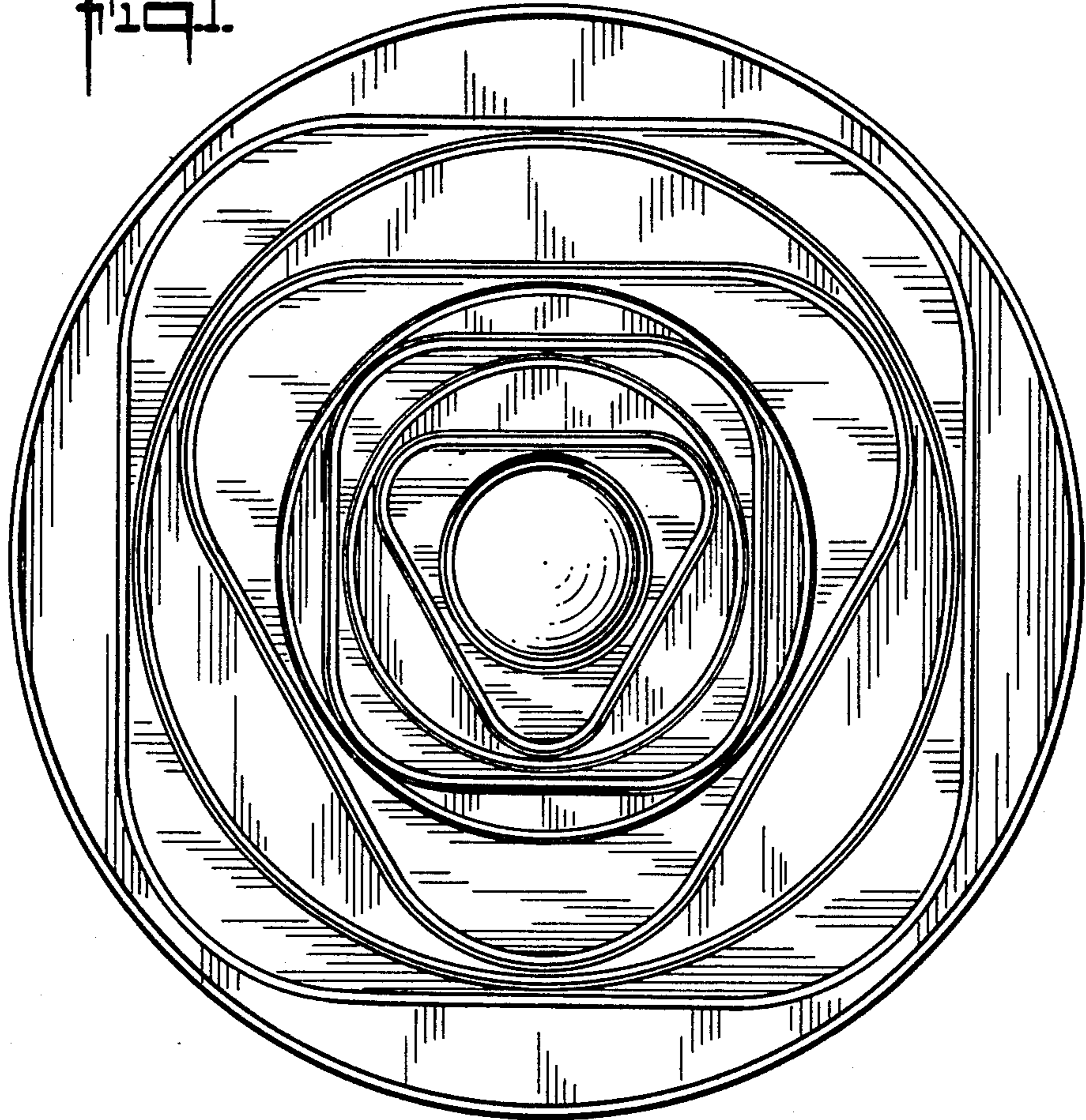
