DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front view, slightly in perspective, of a chair embodying my invention.

FIG. 2 is a rear view, slightly in perspective, of the chair of FIG. 1.

FIG. 3 is a right-side view, slightly in perspective, of the chair of FIG. 1.

FIG. 4 is a left-side view, slightly in perspective, of the chair of FIG. 1.

FIG. 5 is a front view, slightly in perspective, of another chair embodying my invention.

FIG. 6 is a rear view, slightly in perspective, of the chair of FIG. 5.

FIG. 7 is a right-side view, slightly in perspective, of the chair of FIG. 5.

FIG. 8 is a left-side view, slightly in perspective, of the chair of FIG. 5.

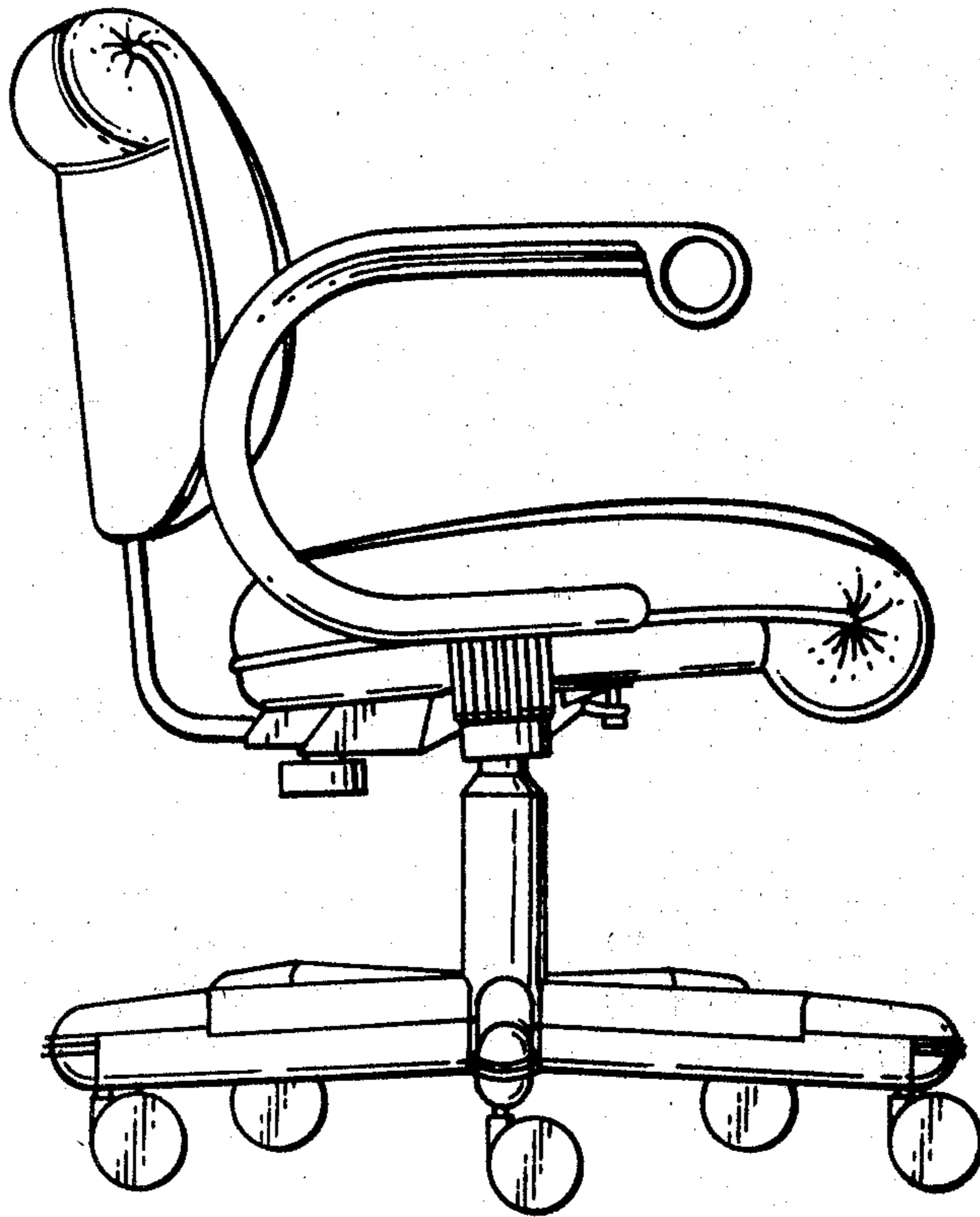

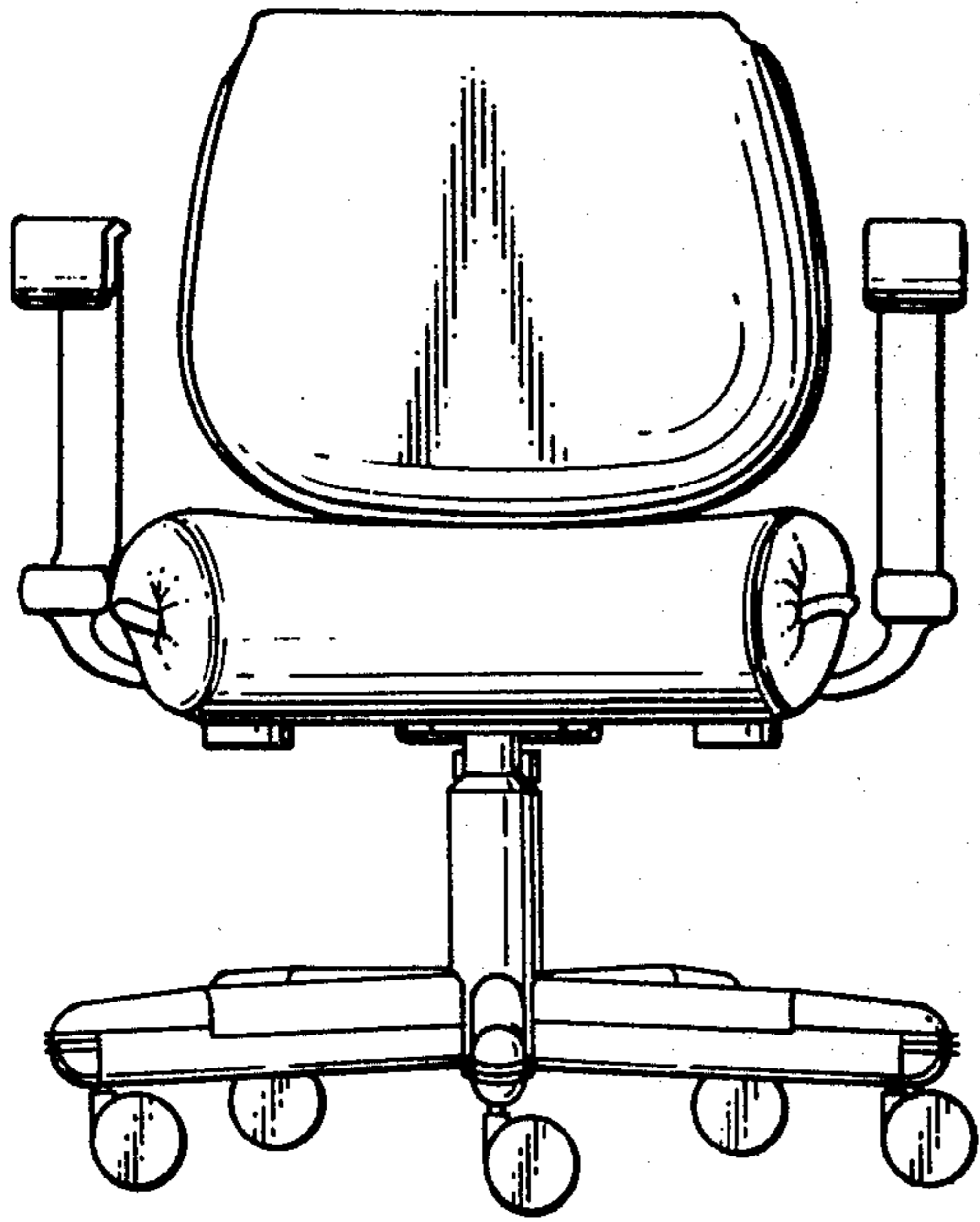

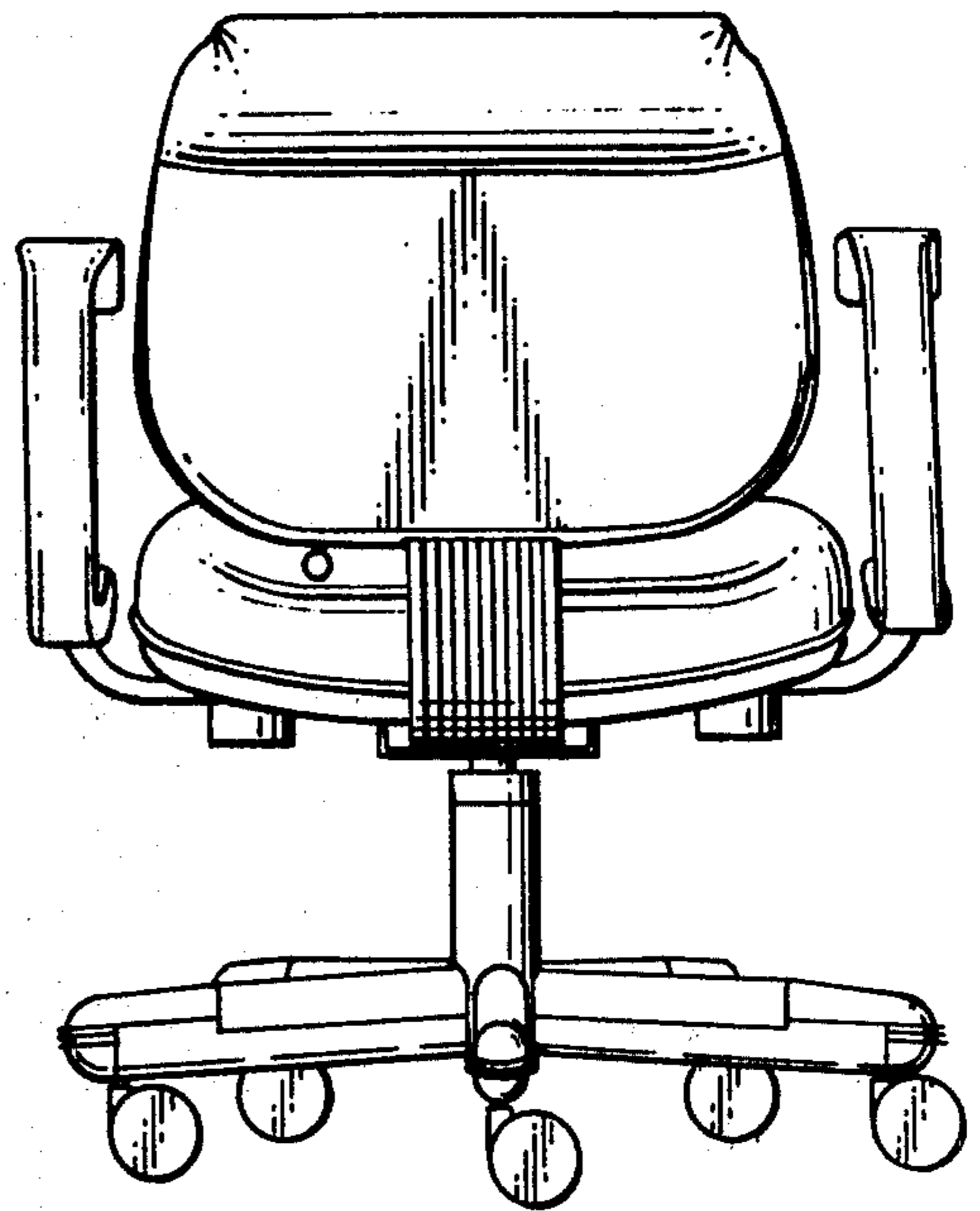

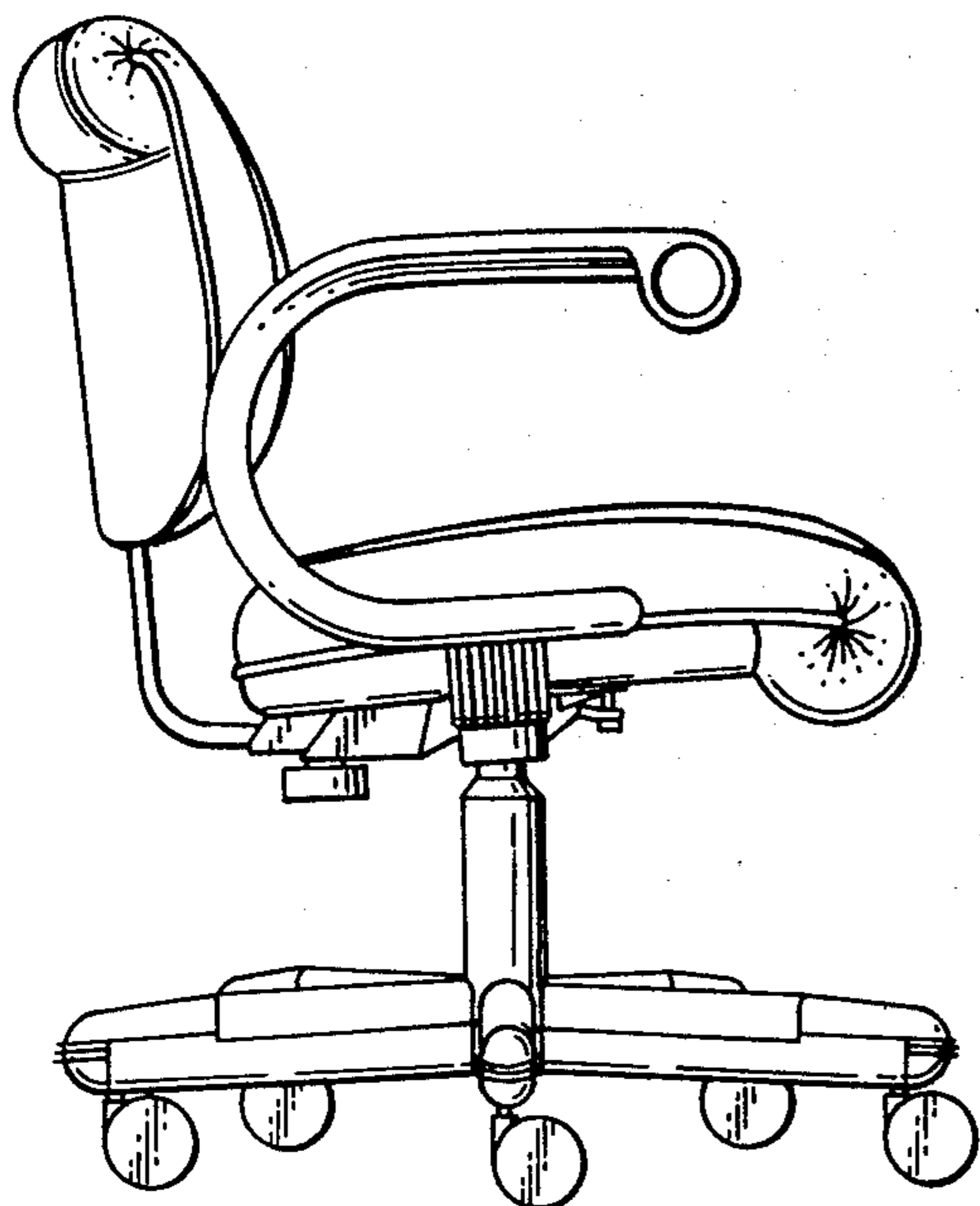

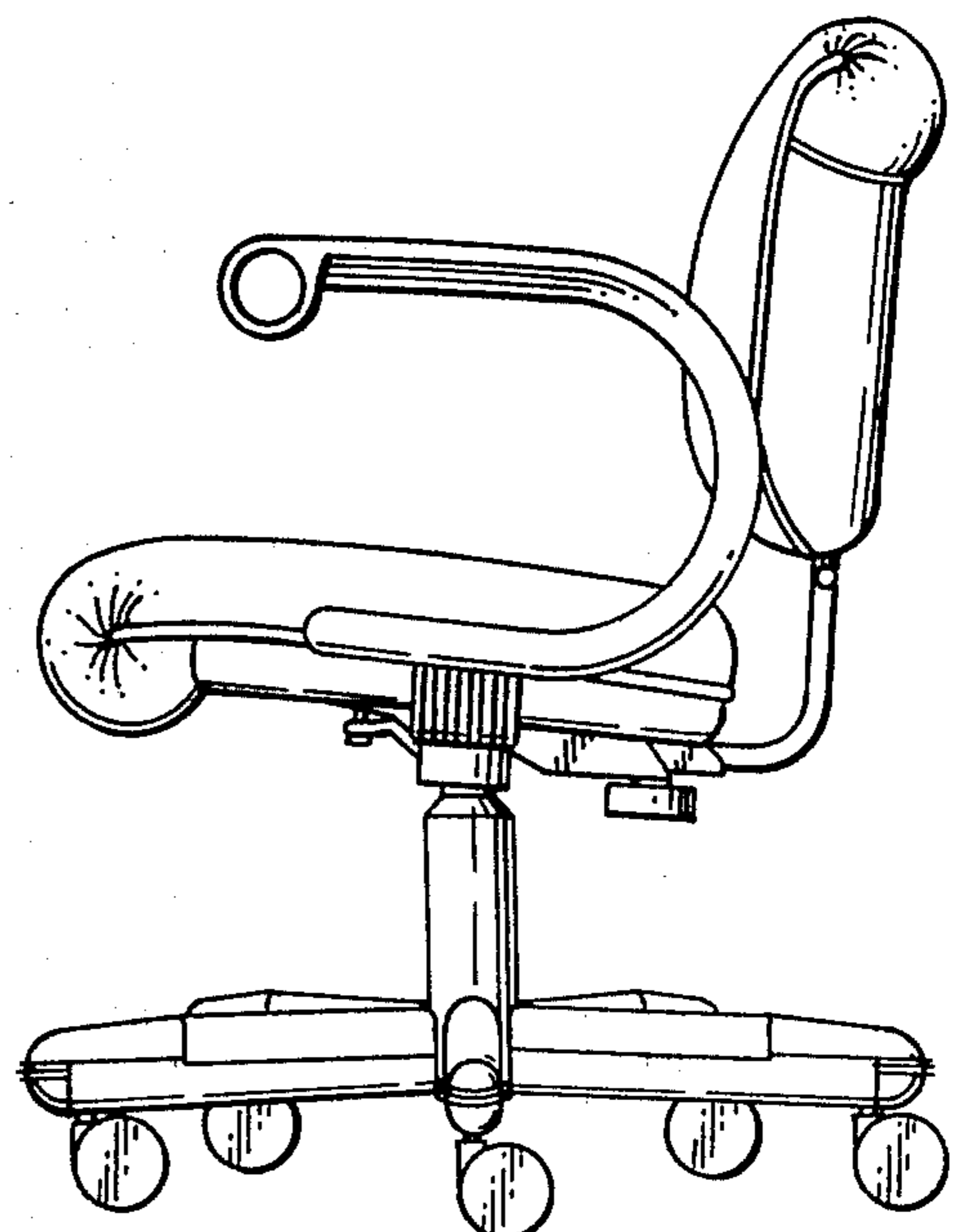

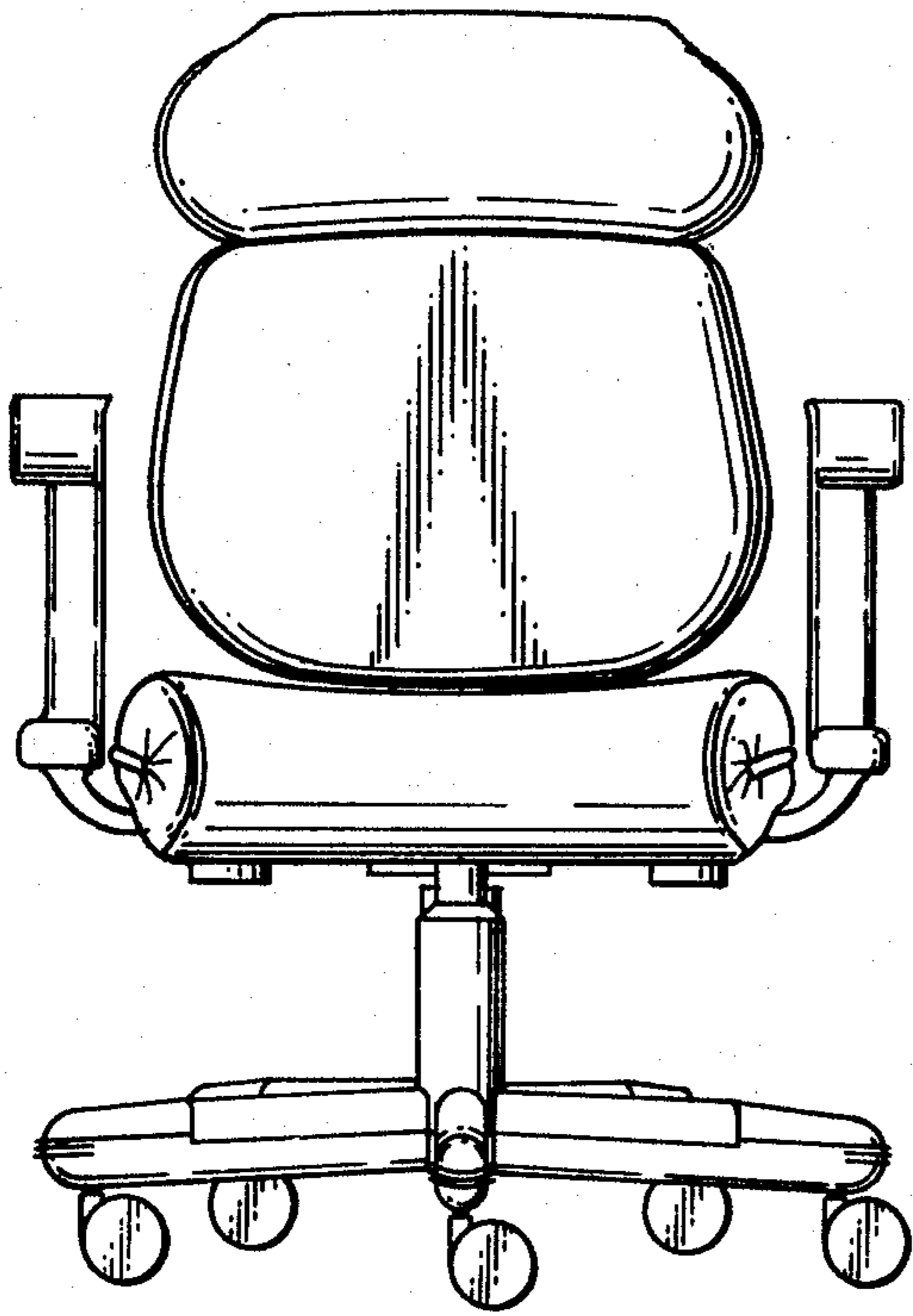

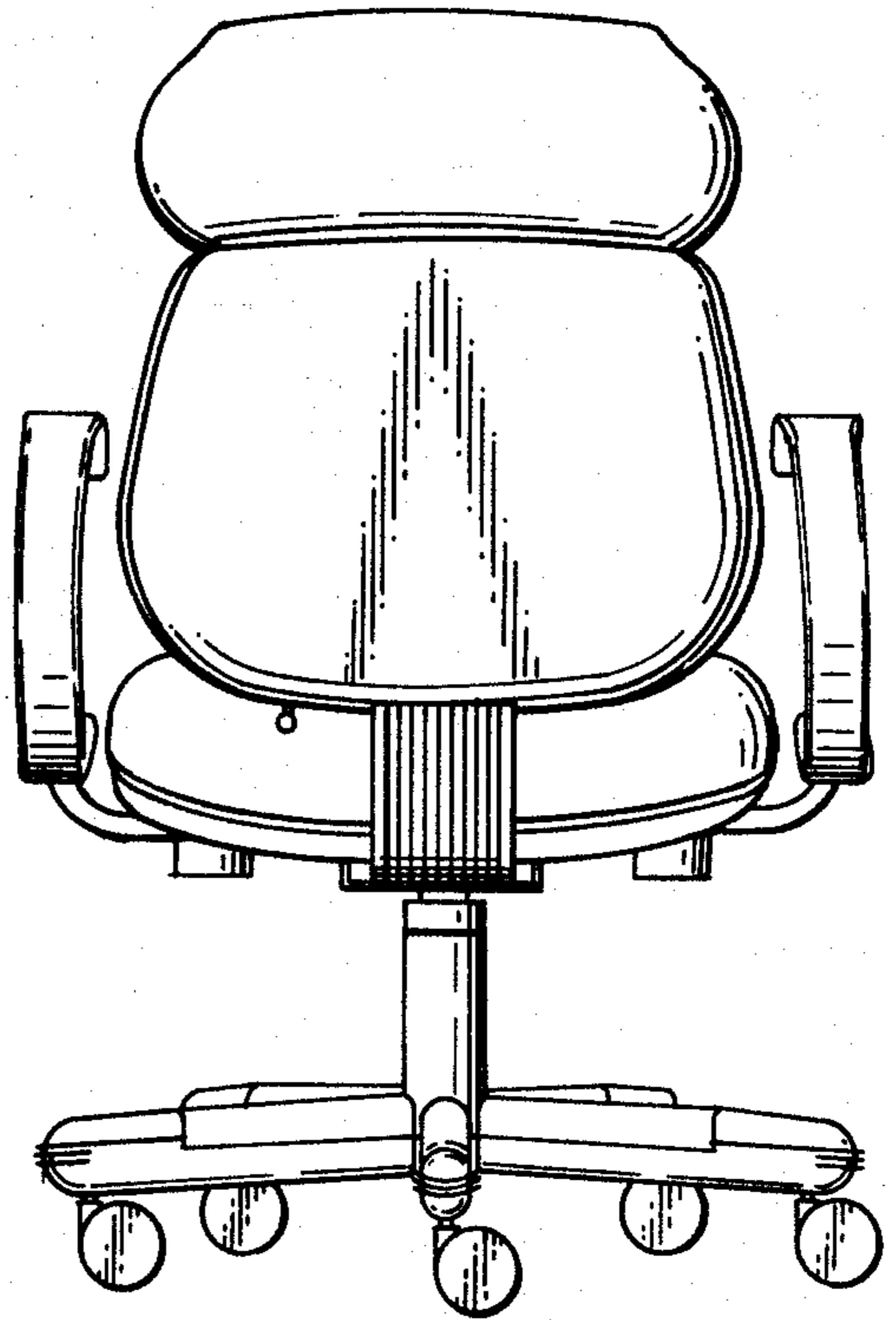

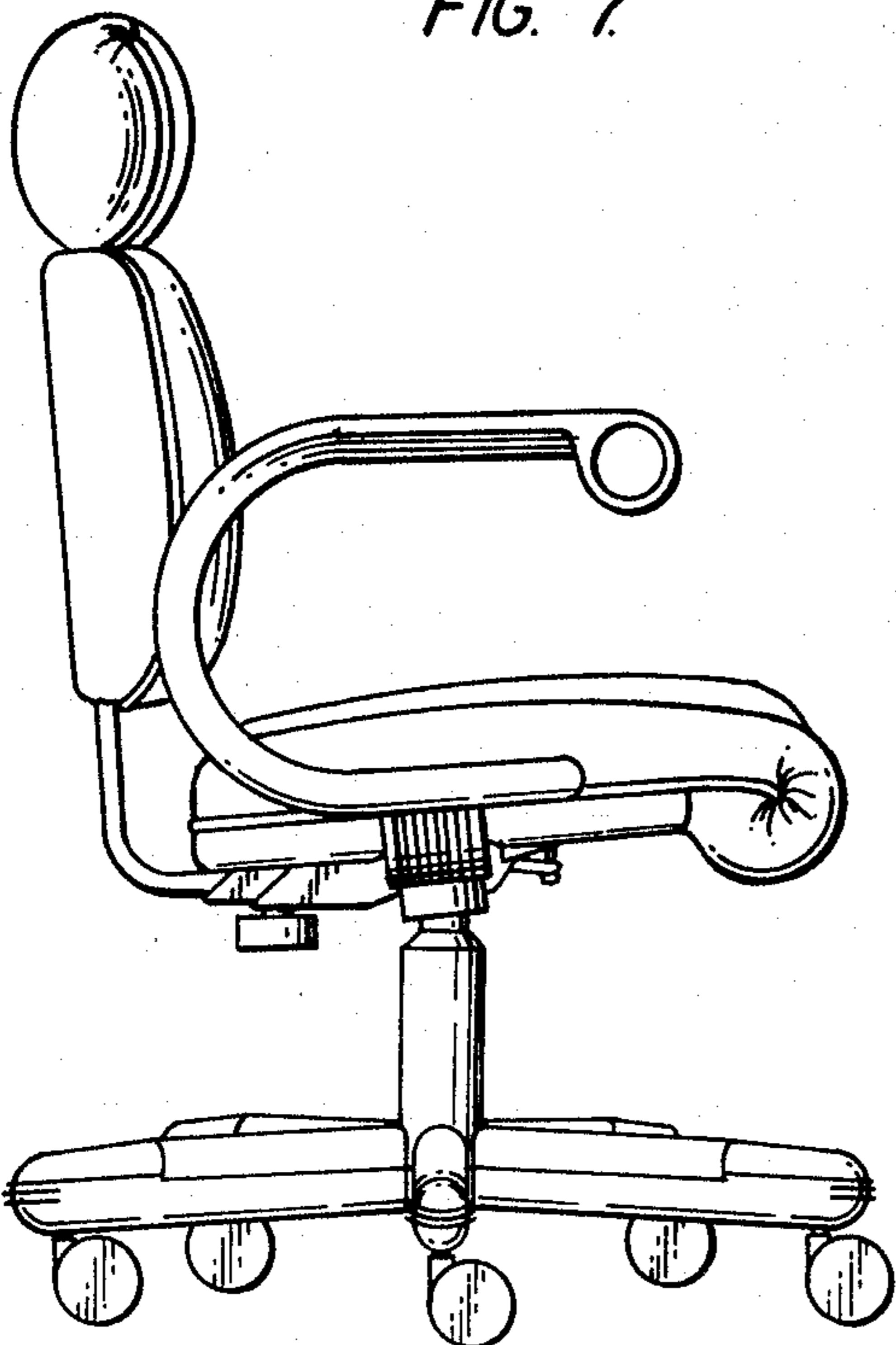
