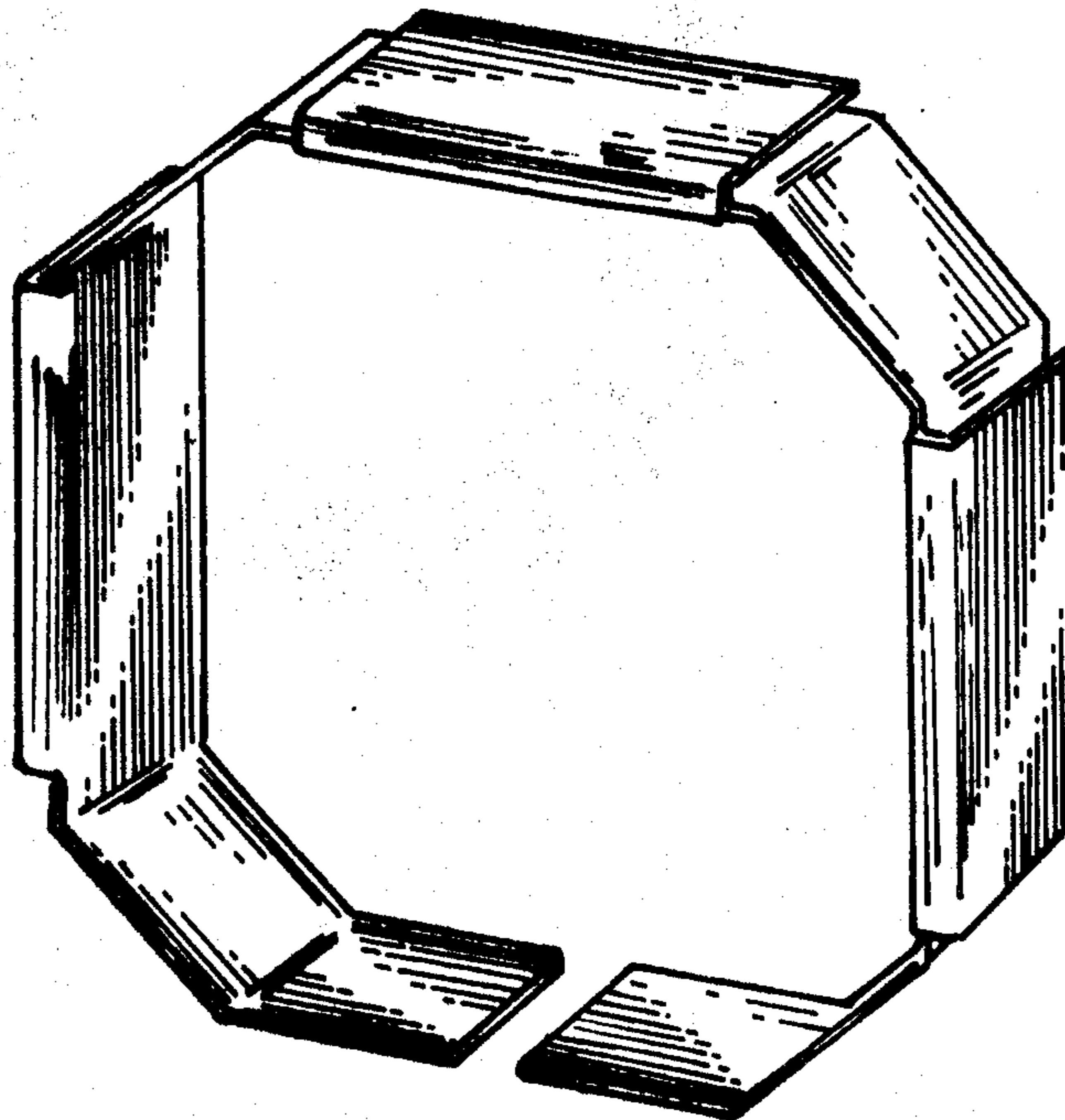

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a connector clip for the support bars of assemblable wine racks, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view from the front of a wine rack clip showing my new design for connecting the front of two wine racks together; and FIG. 2 is a perspective view from the rear of the clip shown in FIG. 1.



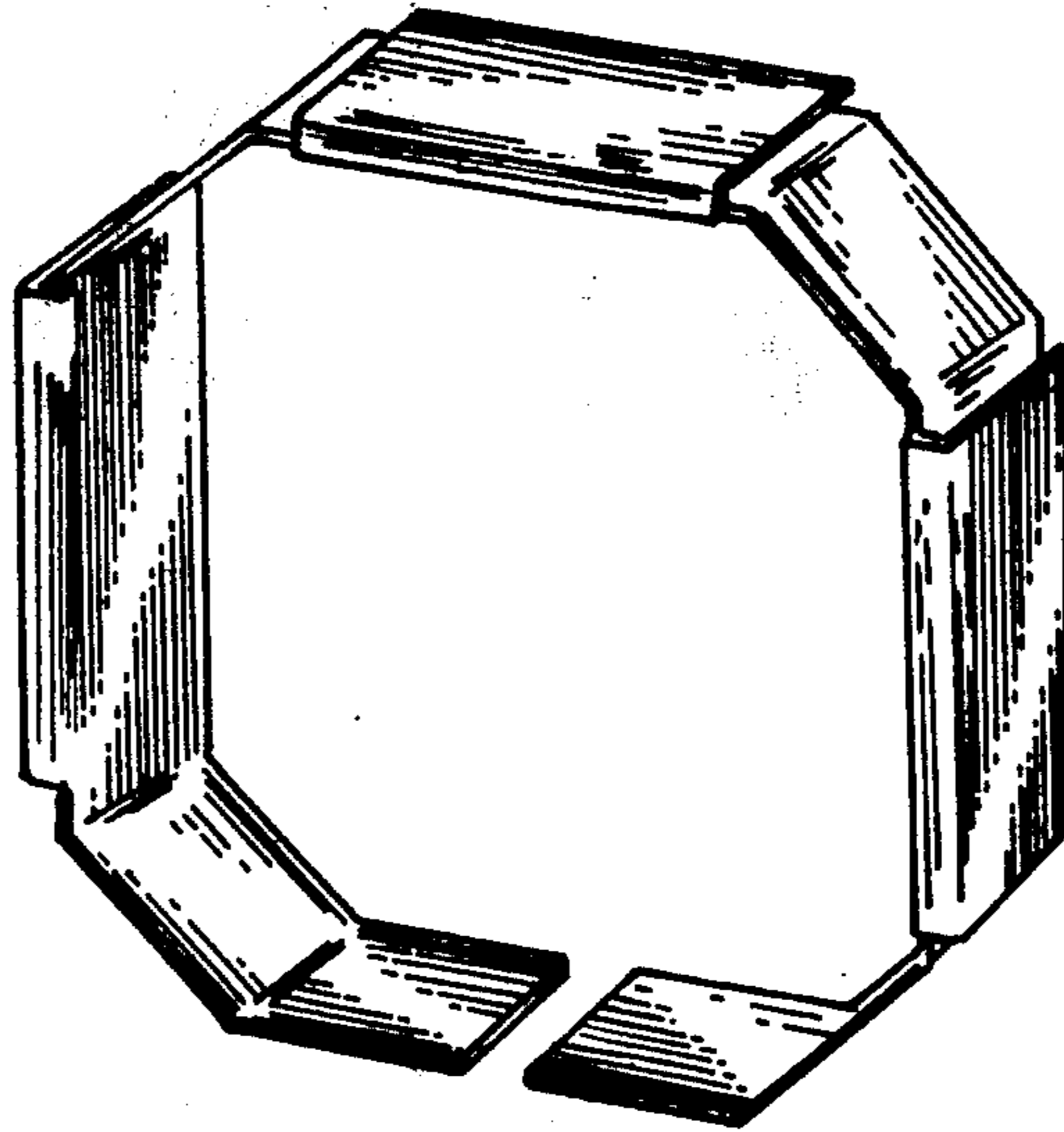

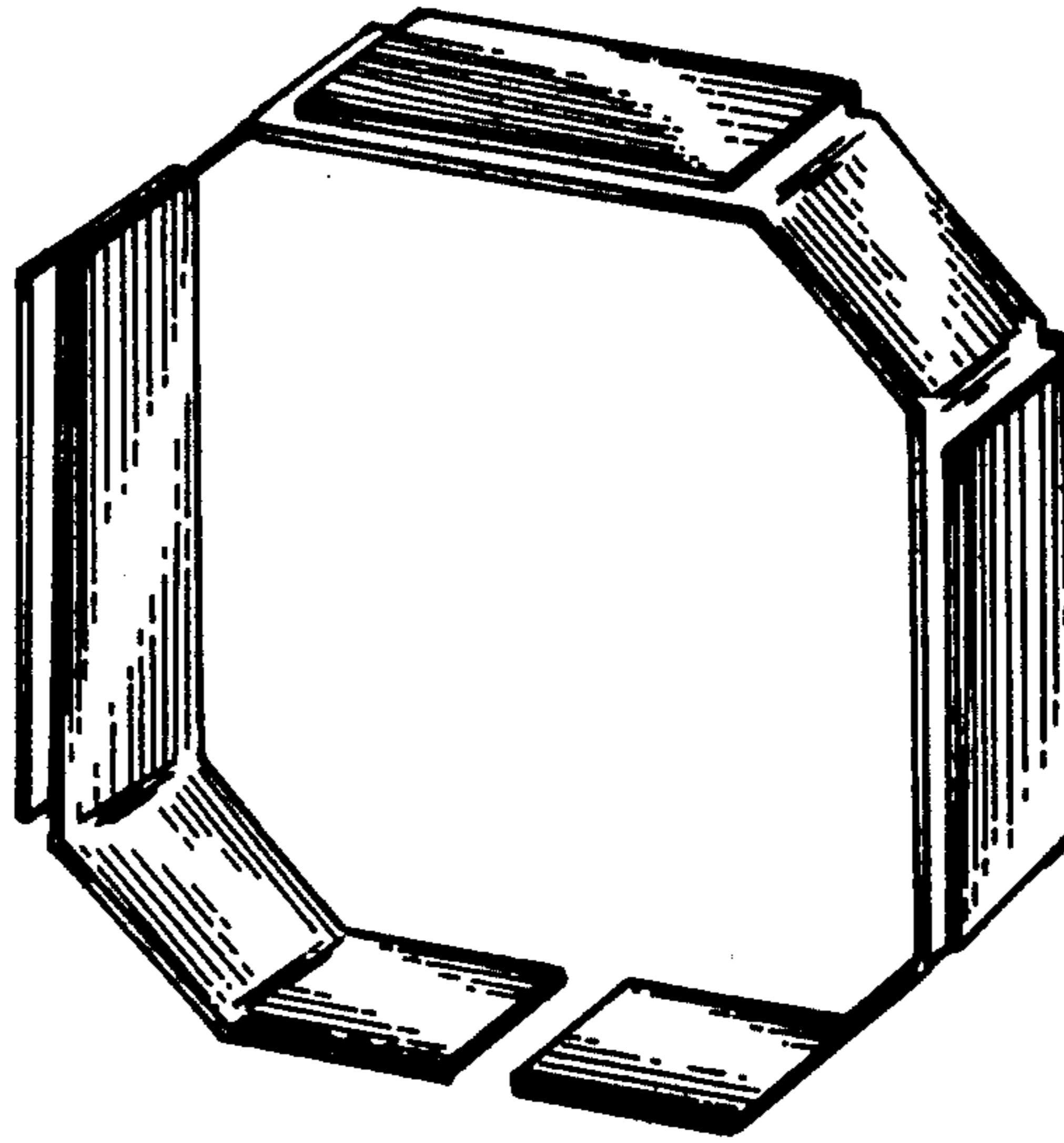
