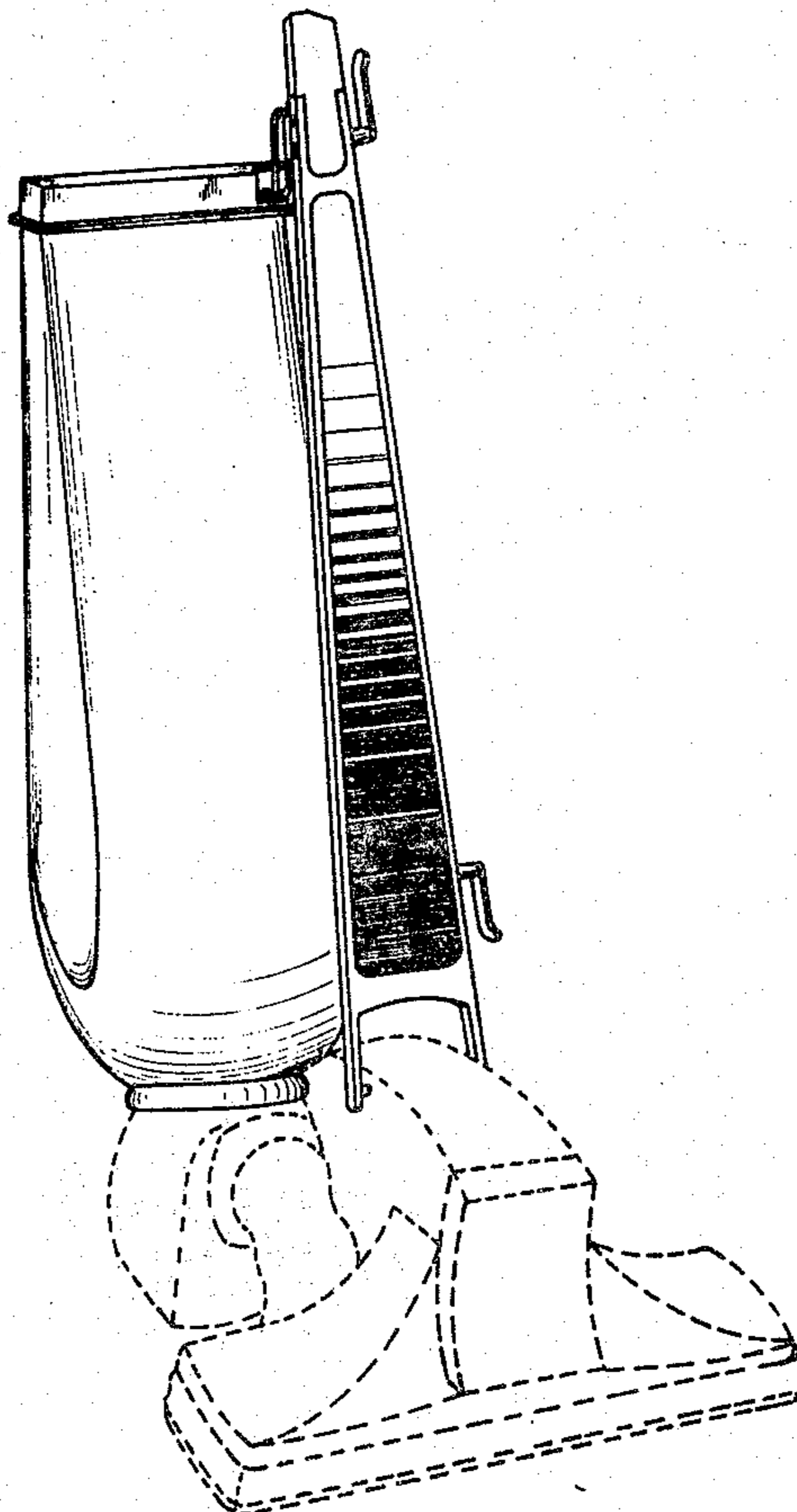
[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a combined bag and bag support for an upright vacuum cleaner, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of the combined bag and bag support for an upright vacuum cleaner embodying my new design; FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof; and FIG. 6 is a perspective view thereof.

The broken line disclosure shown in all views is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.



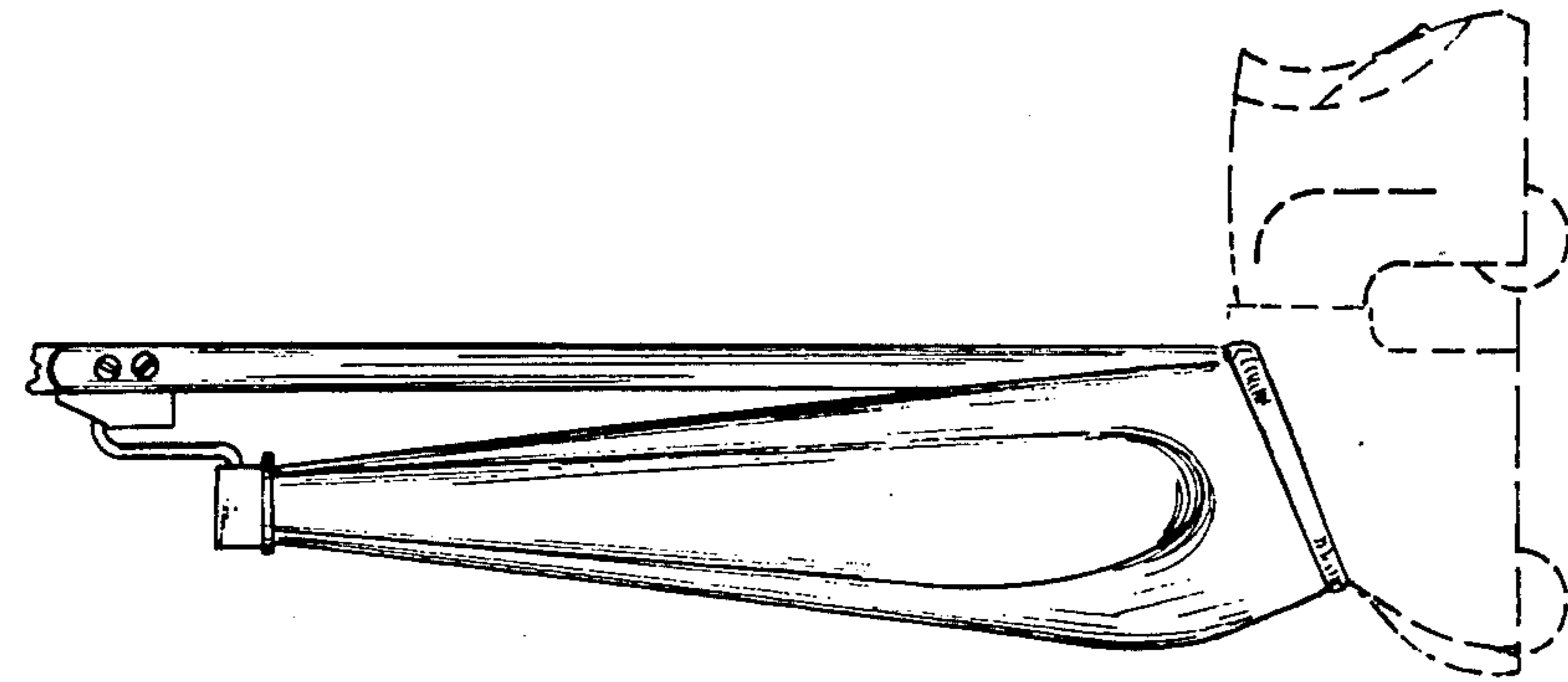

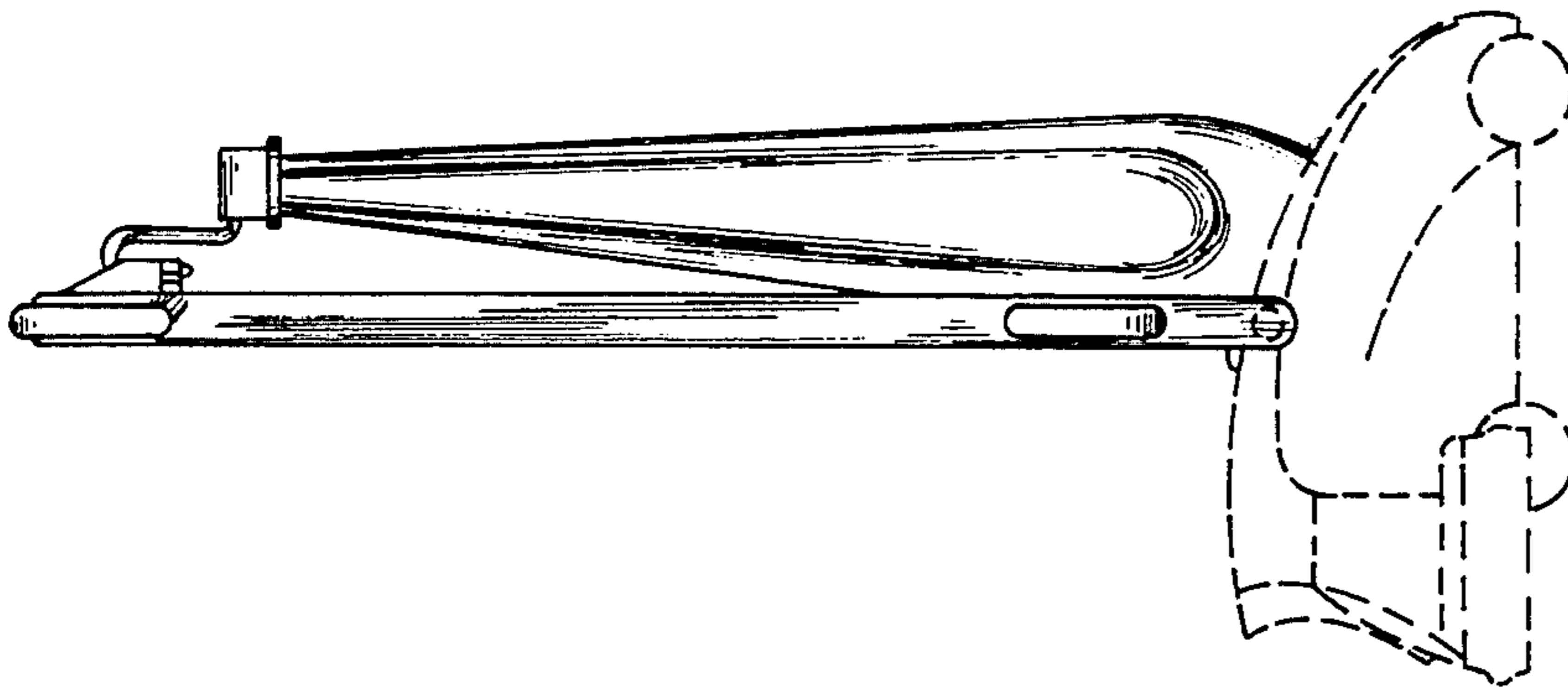

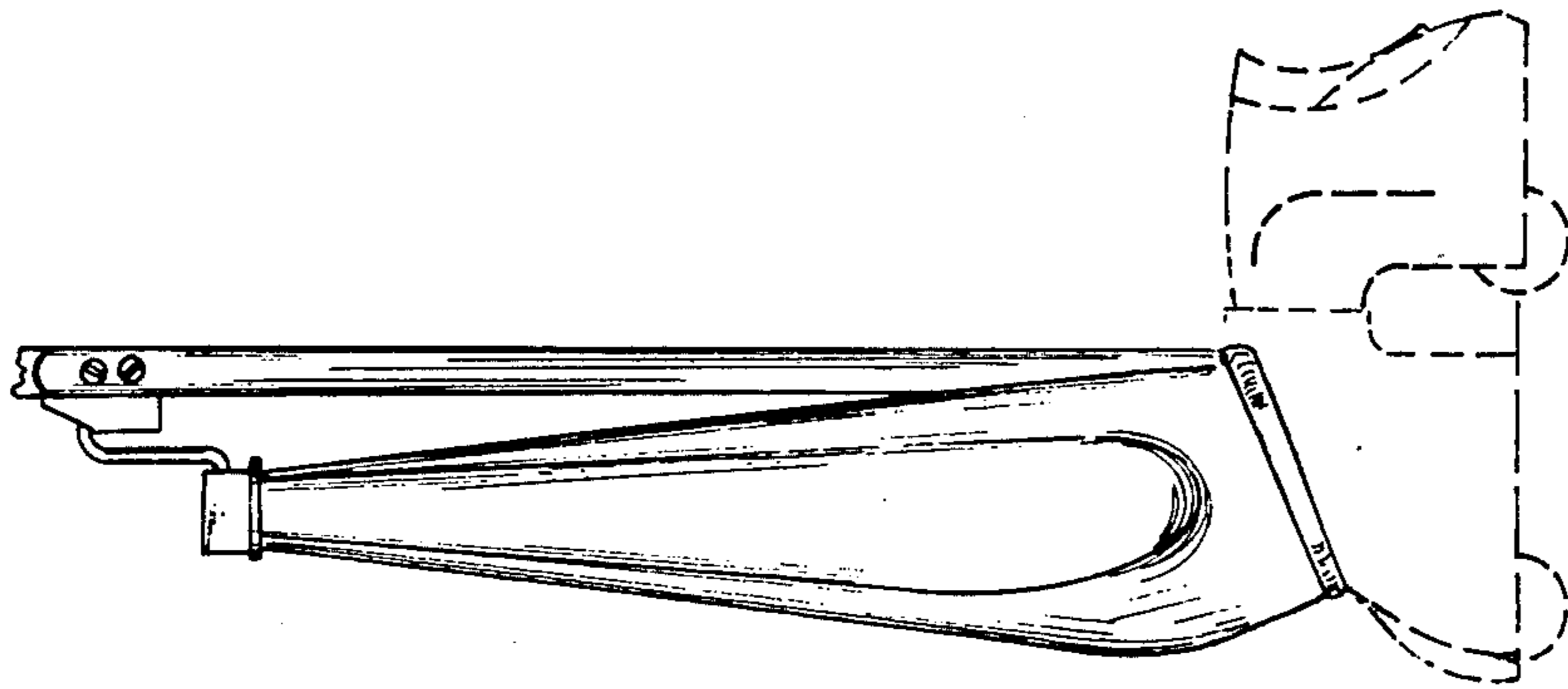

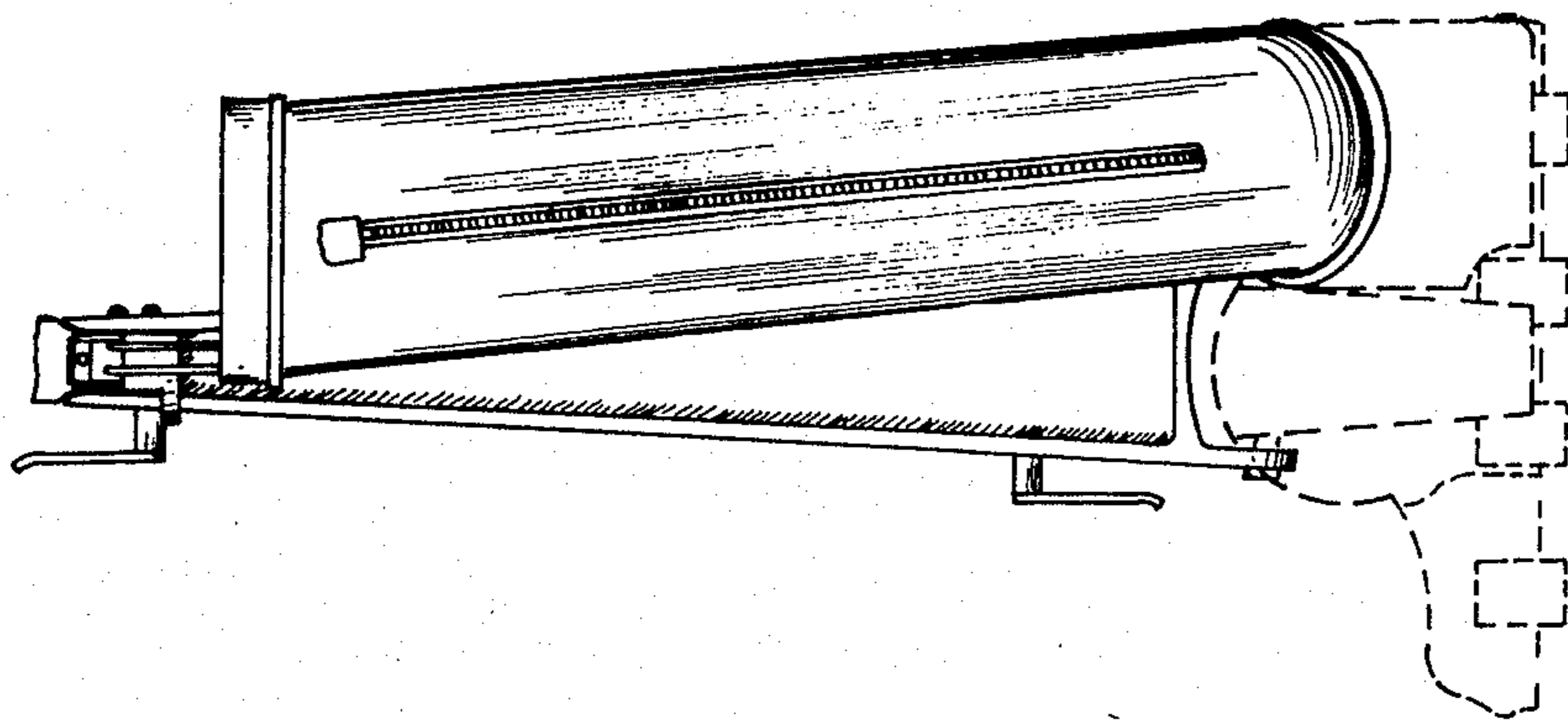

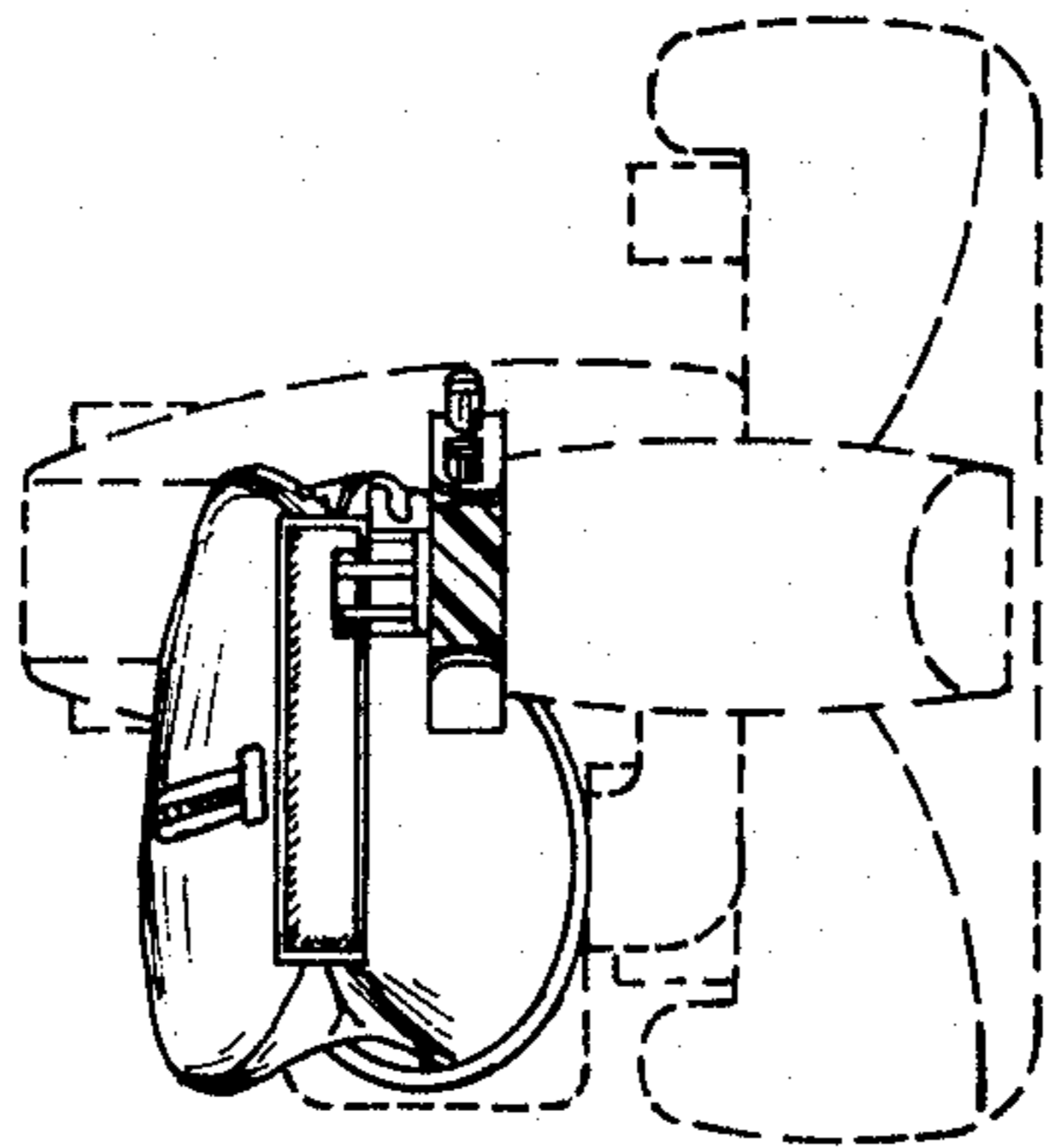

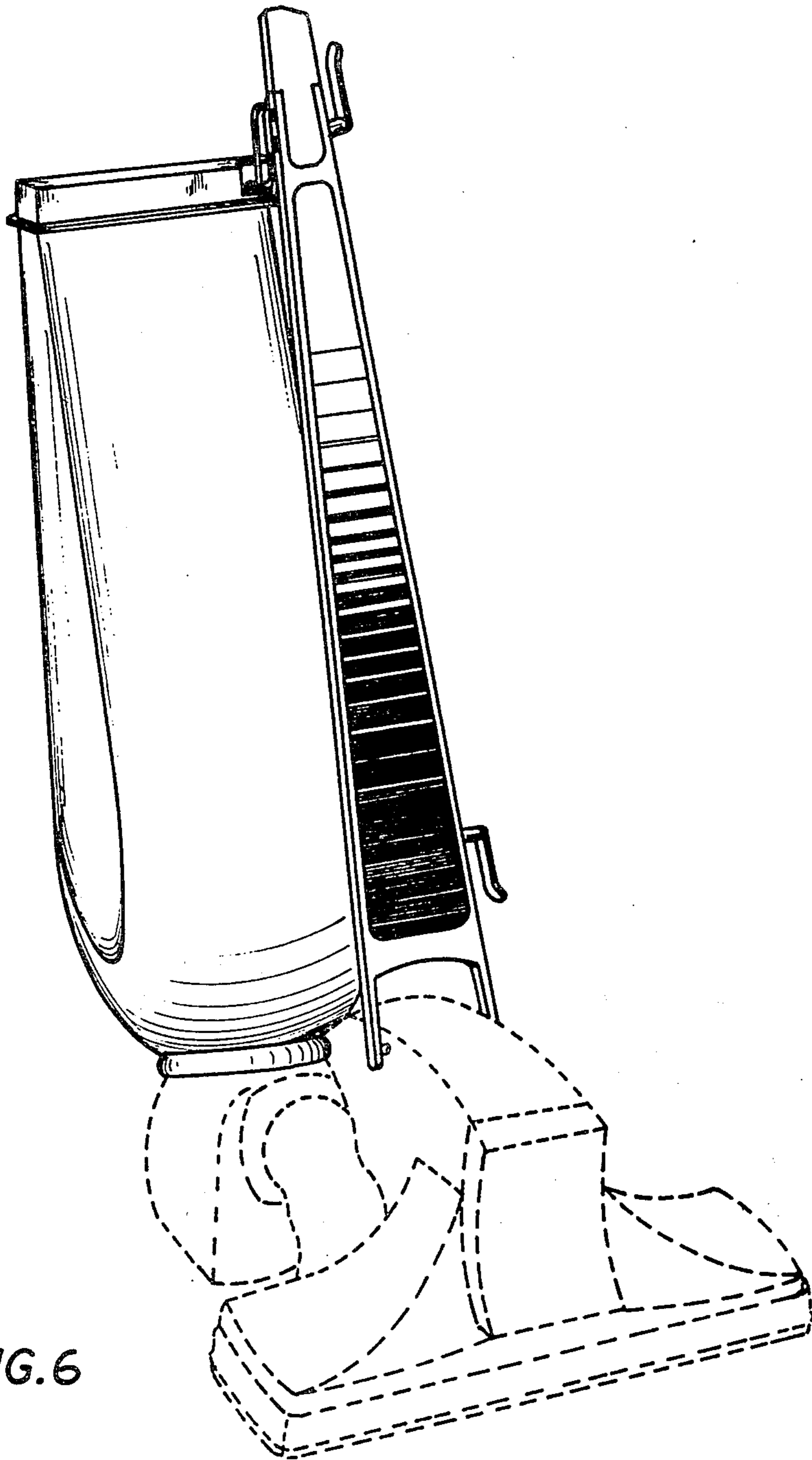
