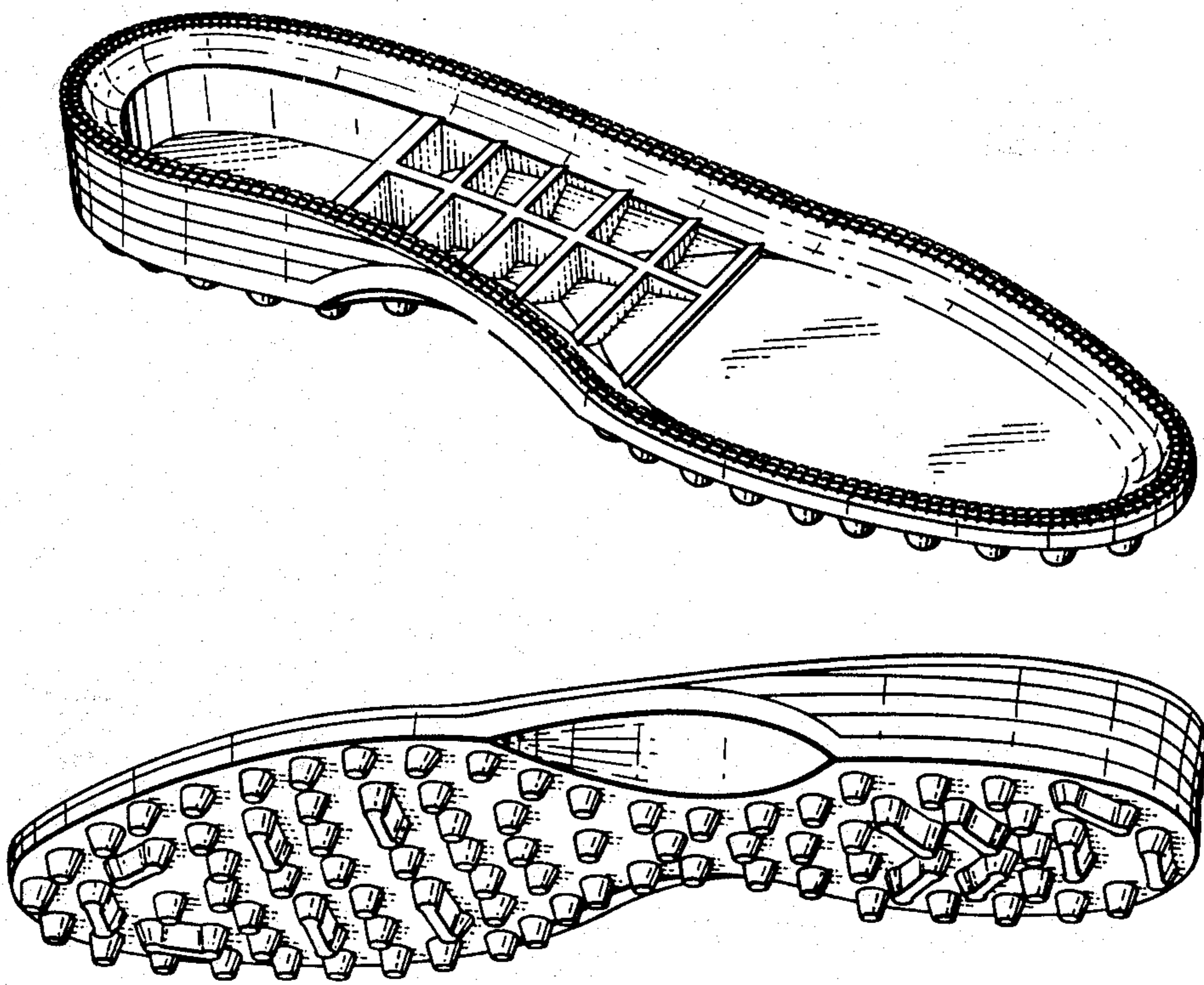

 FIG. 3 is a perspective view showing the bottom of the sole.



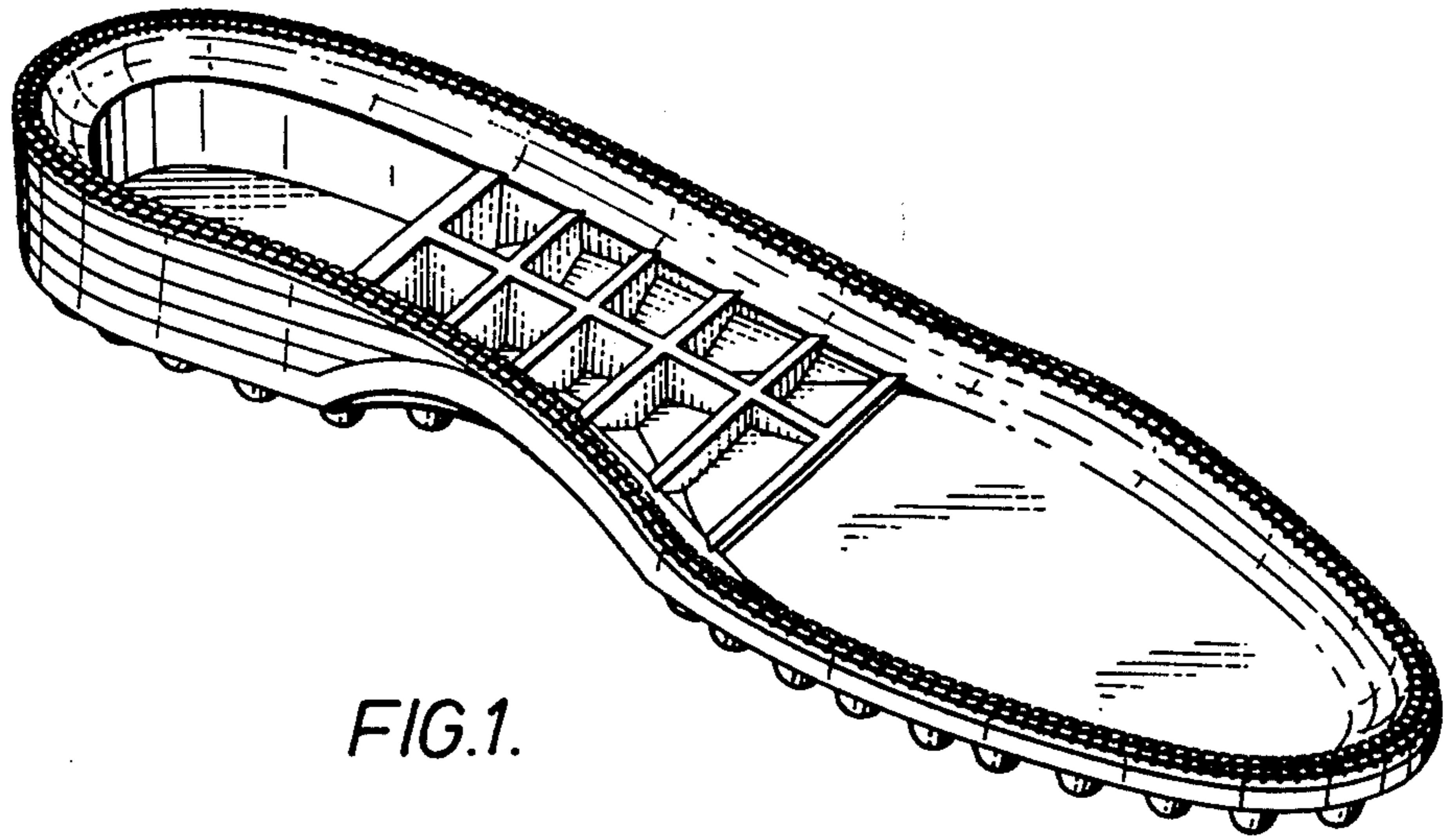

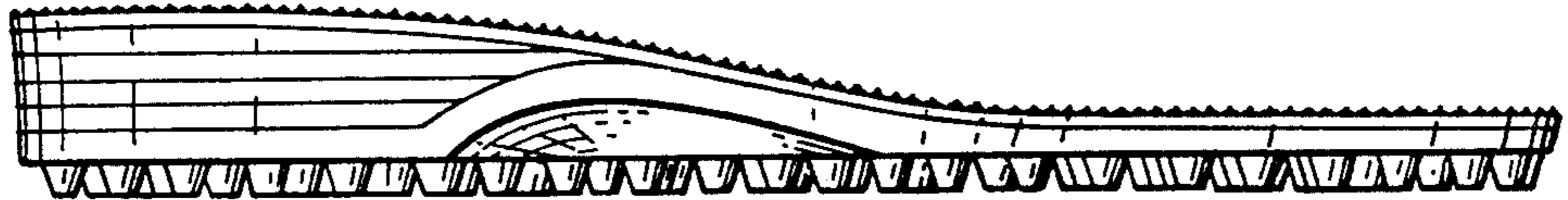

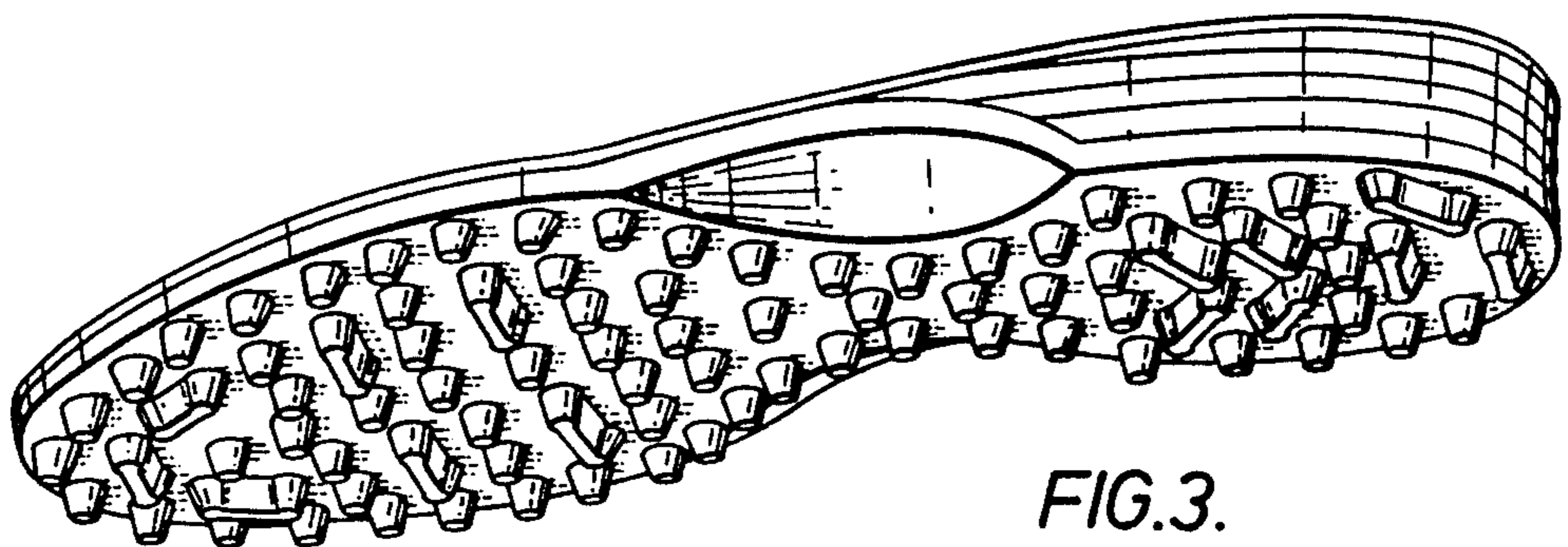
