CLAIM

The ornamental design for a permanent briquette for
gas fired barbecue grills, substantially as shown and
described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a permanent briquette
for gas fired barbecue grills showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof, the rear and
both side elevational views being mirror images;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a second embodiment of the permanent bri-

FIG. 8 is a bottom plan view thereof.

















FIG. 7**FIG. 8**
