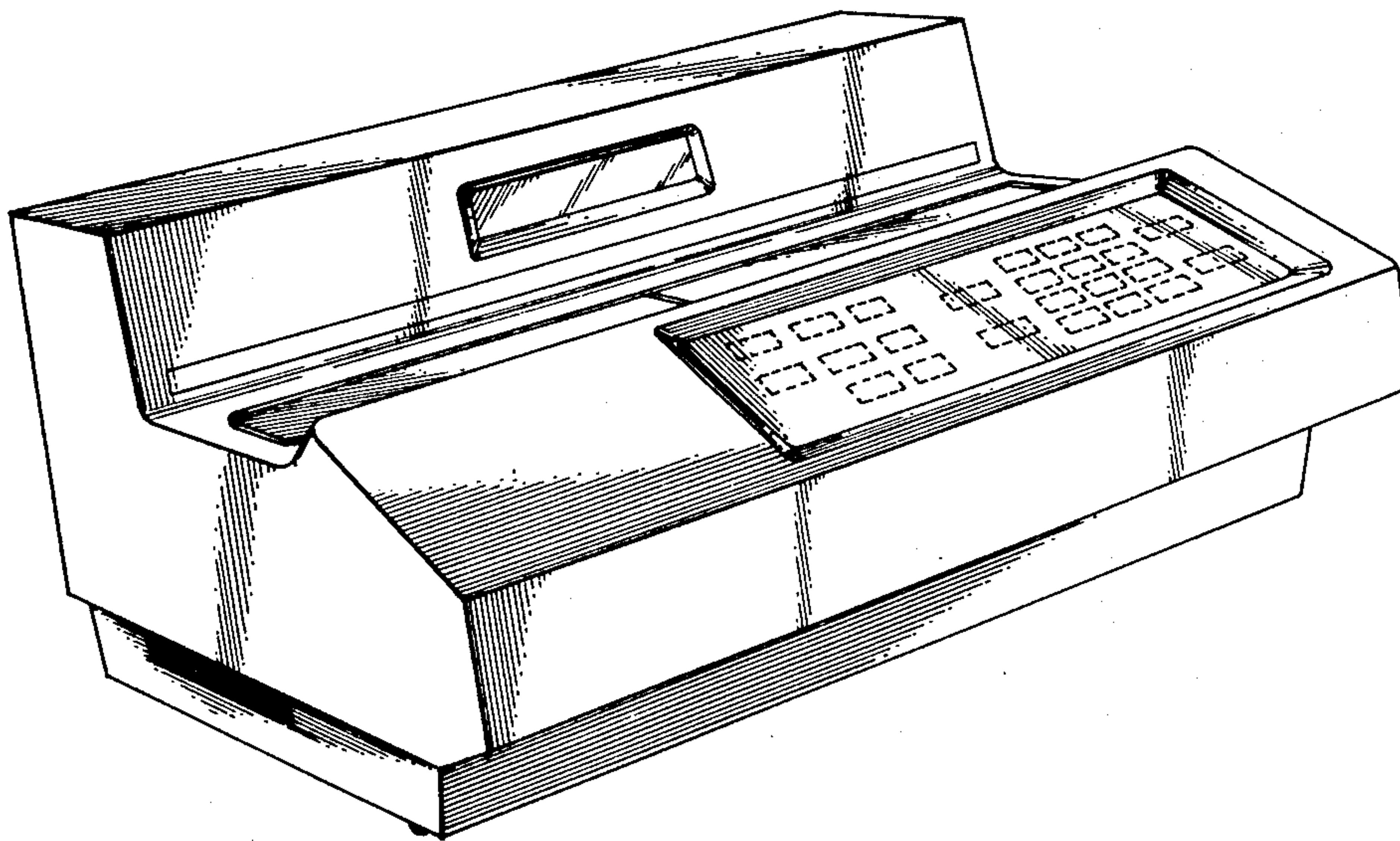
The ornamental design for a medical analyzer cabinet, as shown and described.

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a medical analyzer cabinet showing my new design; and FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof.

The broken lines are shown for illustrative purposes only.



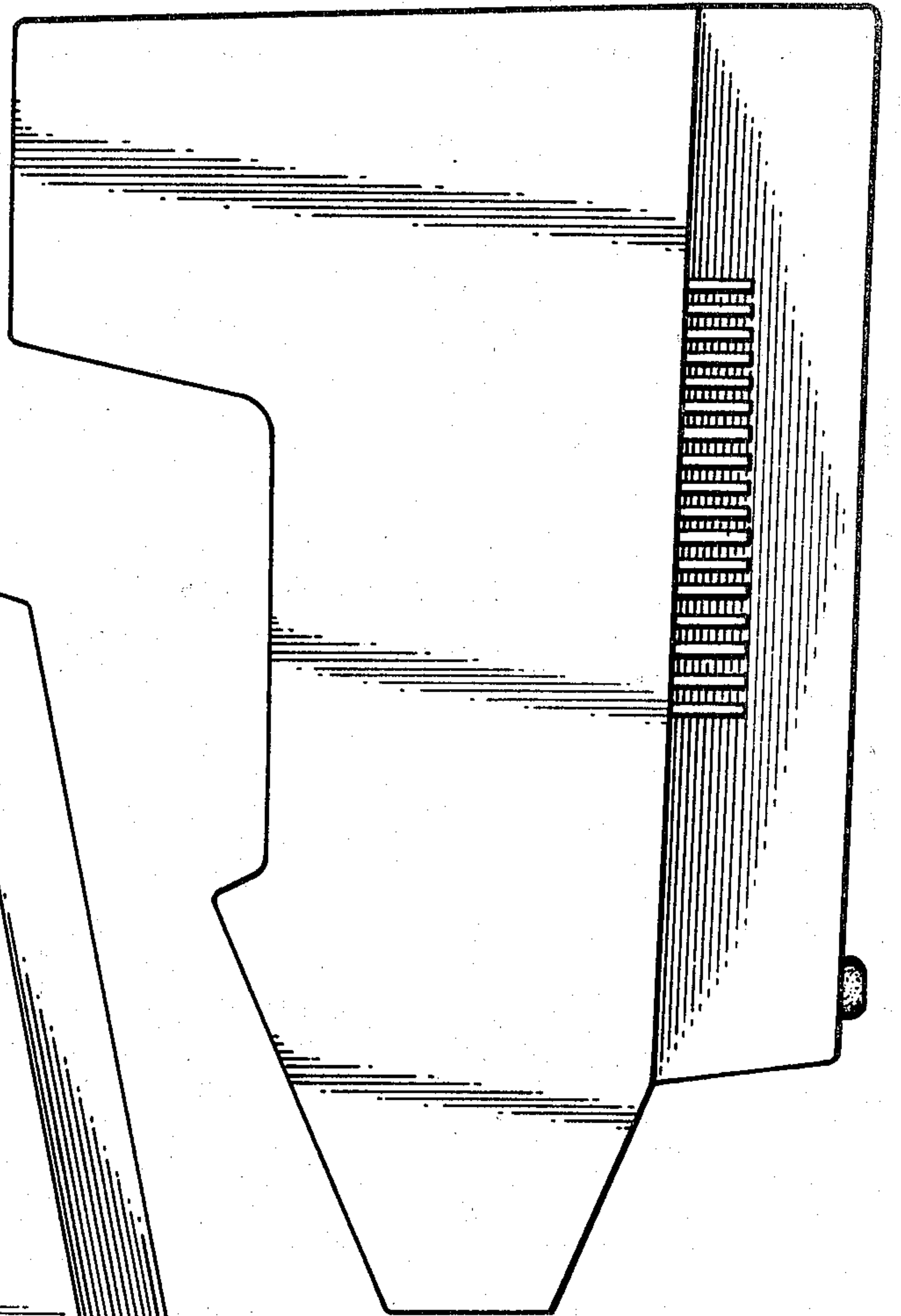
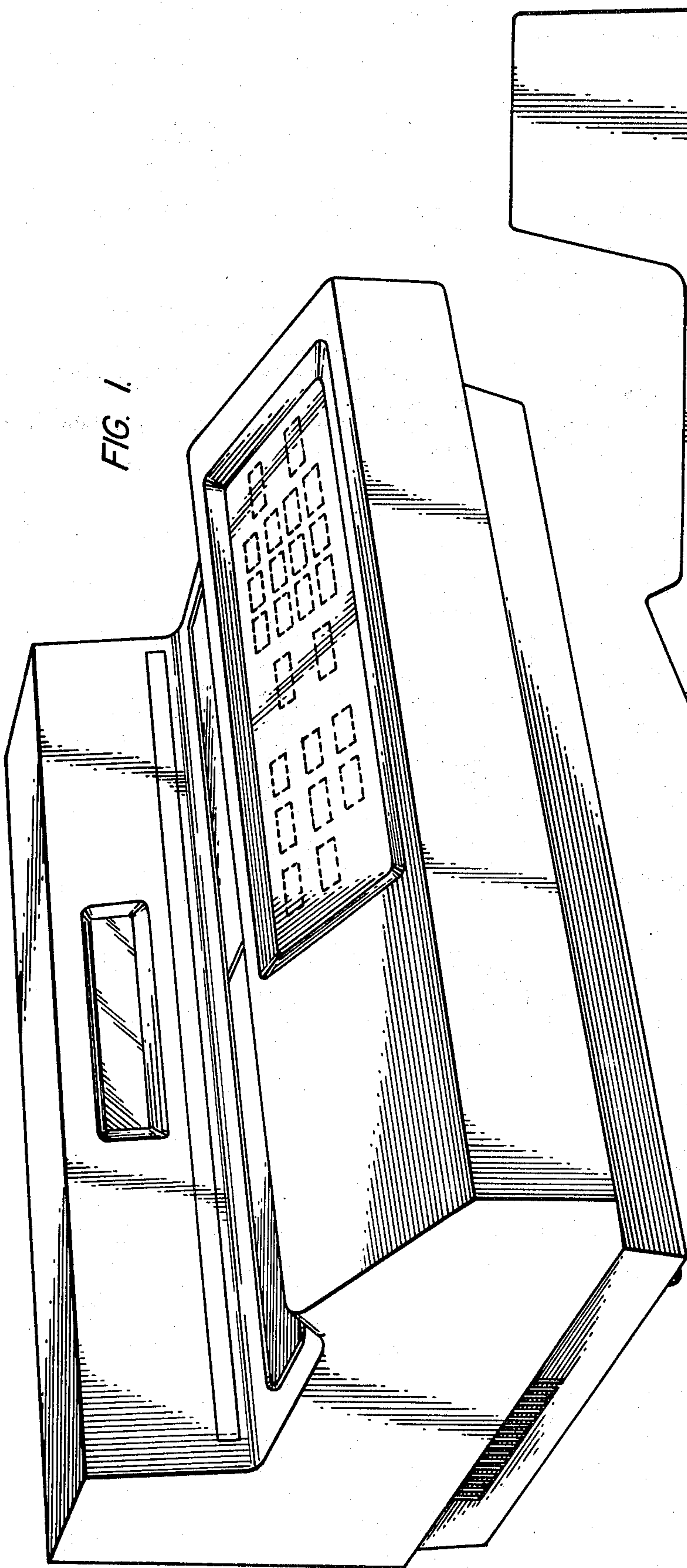
