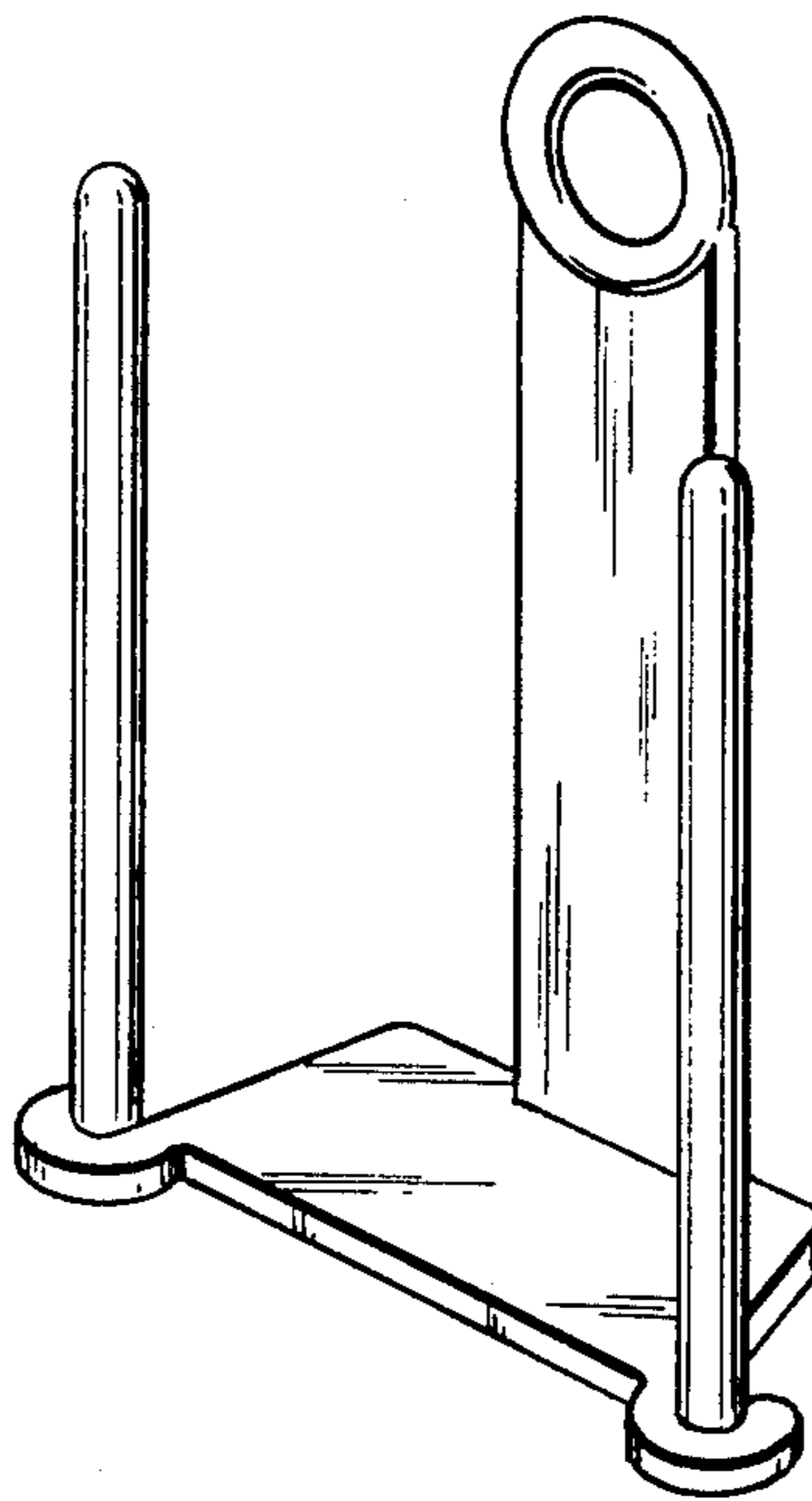

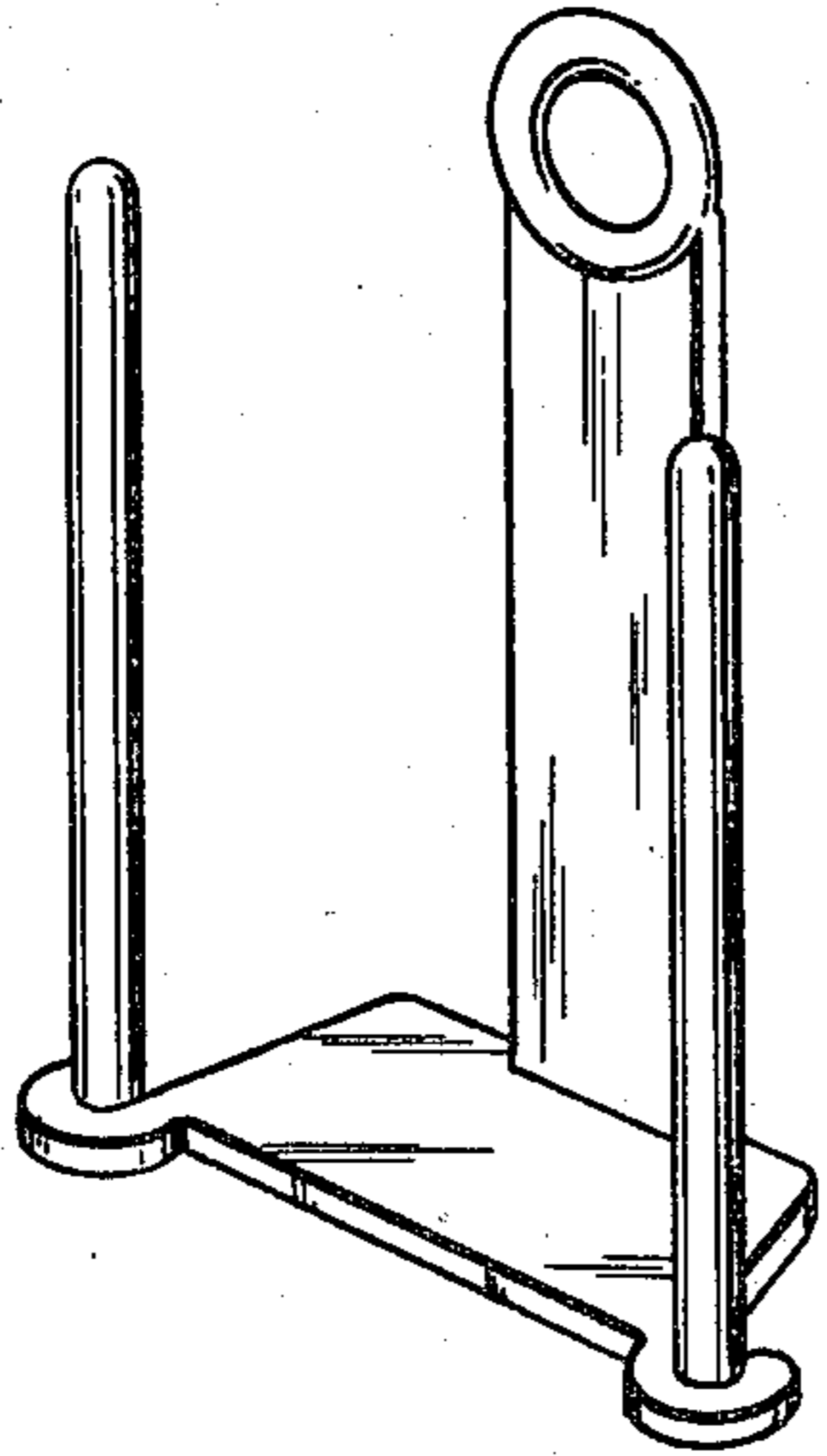

The ornamental design for surgical instrument holder, as shown and described.

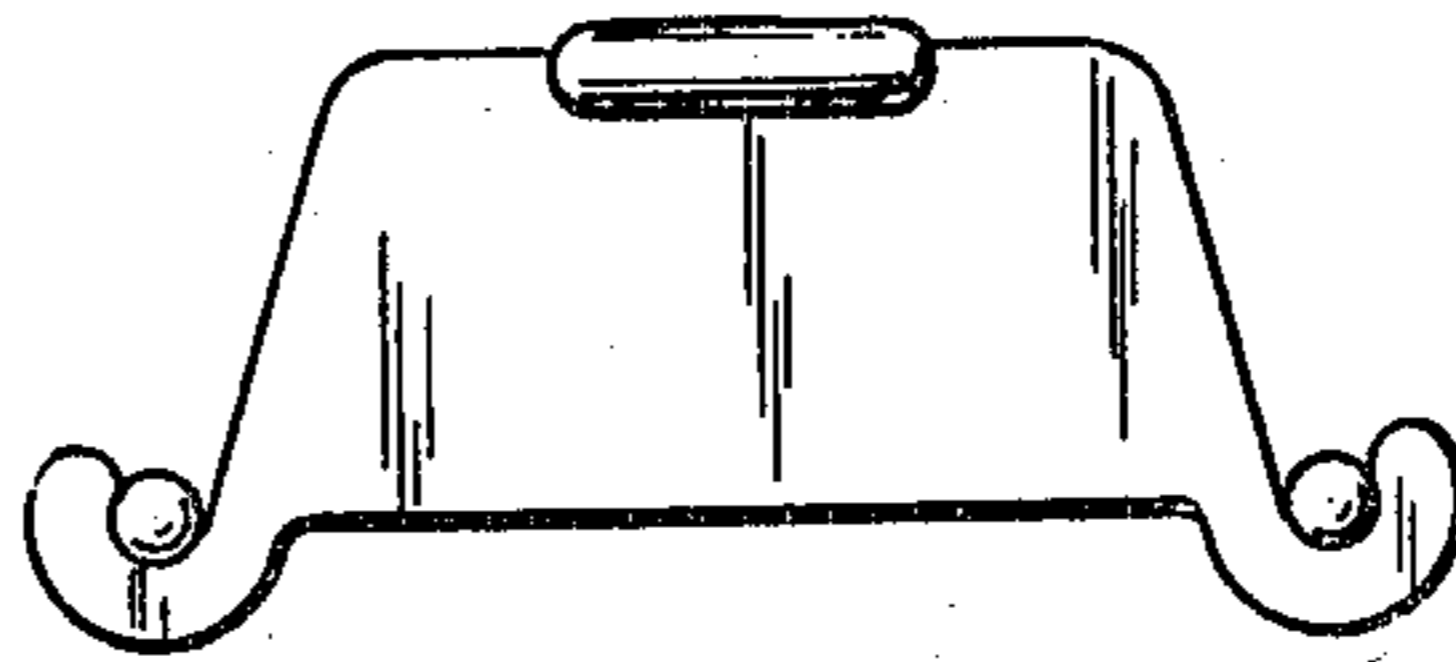
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a surgical instrument holder, showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof; and FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof which is a mirror image of the left side elevational view.

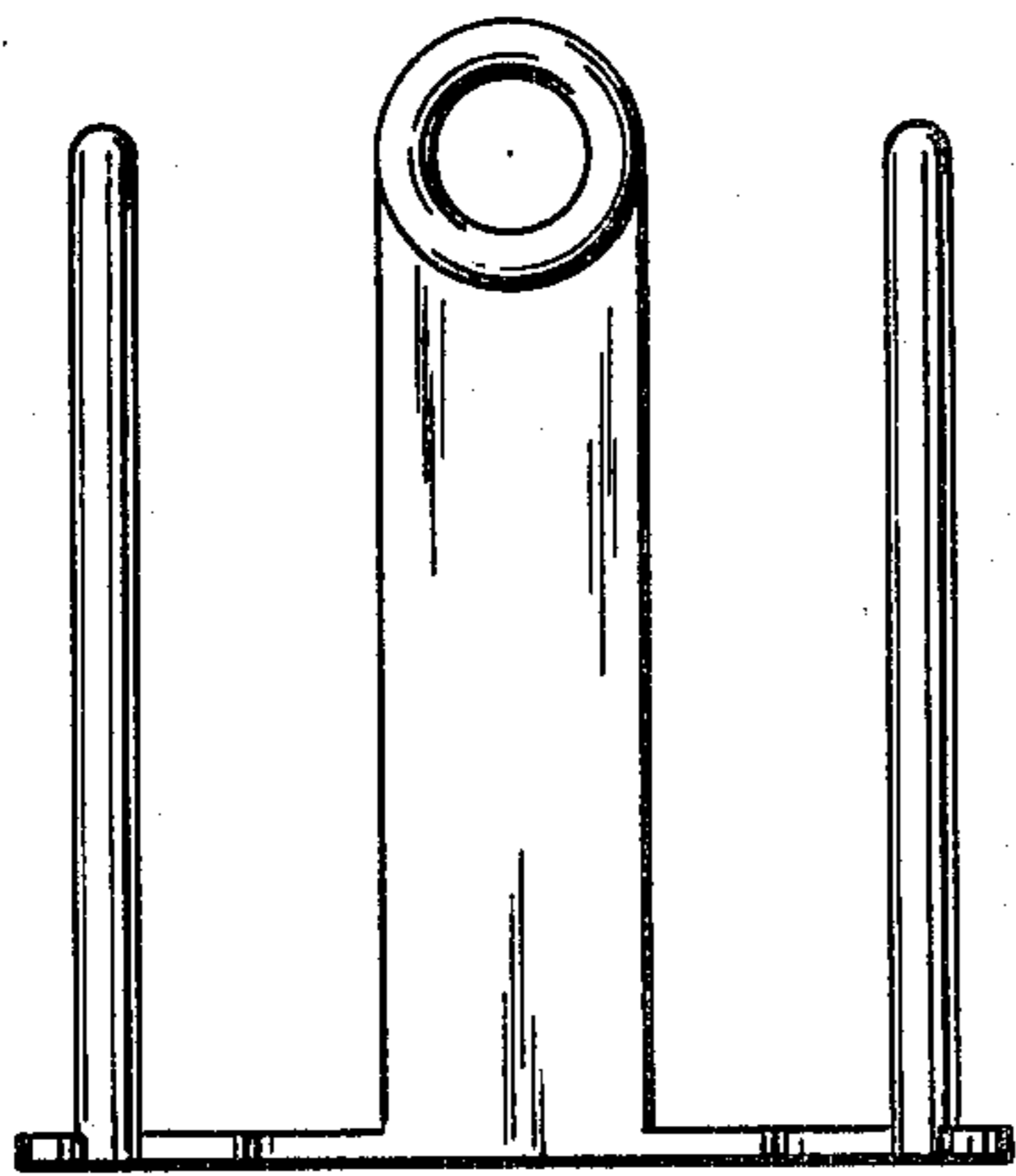




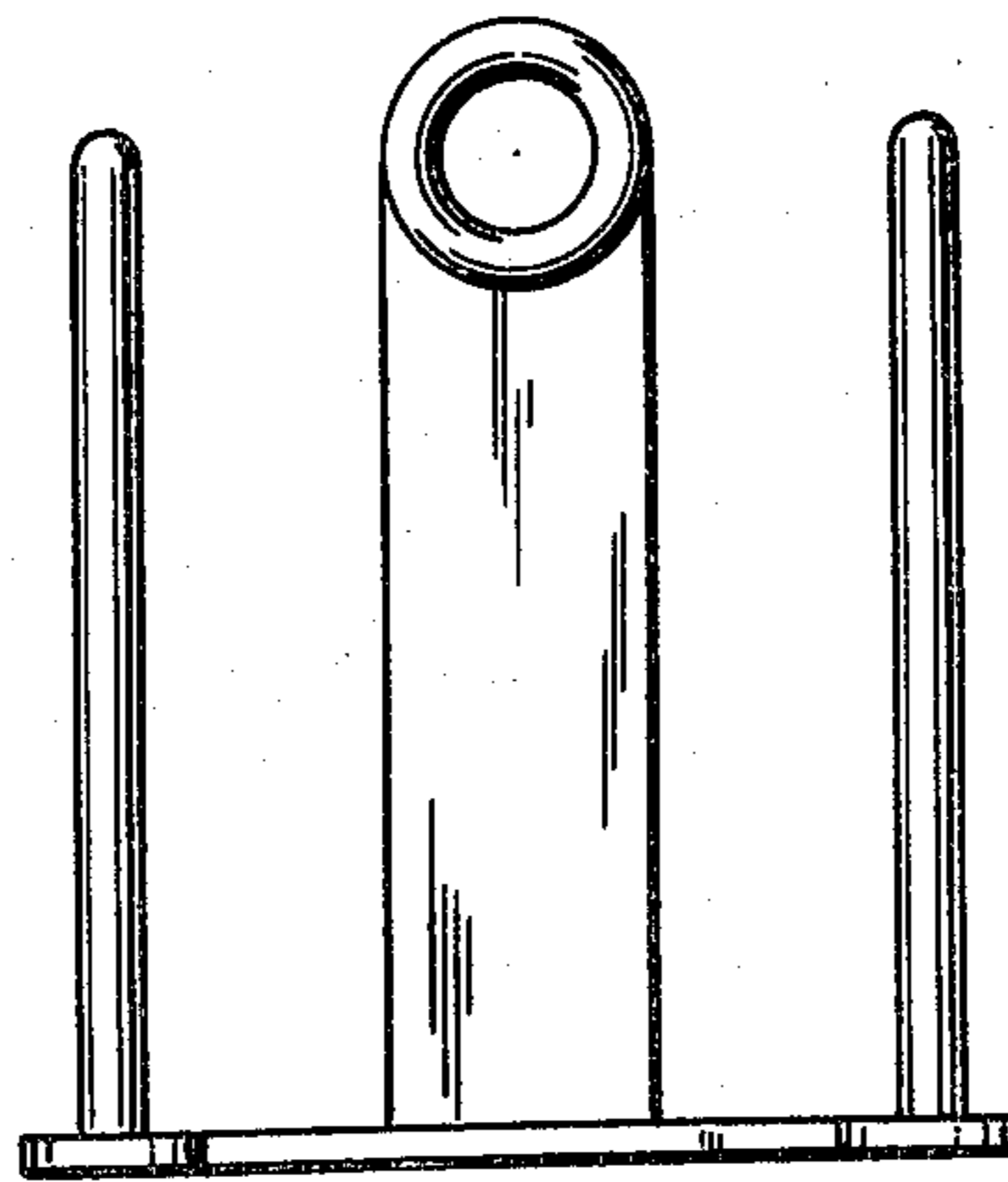

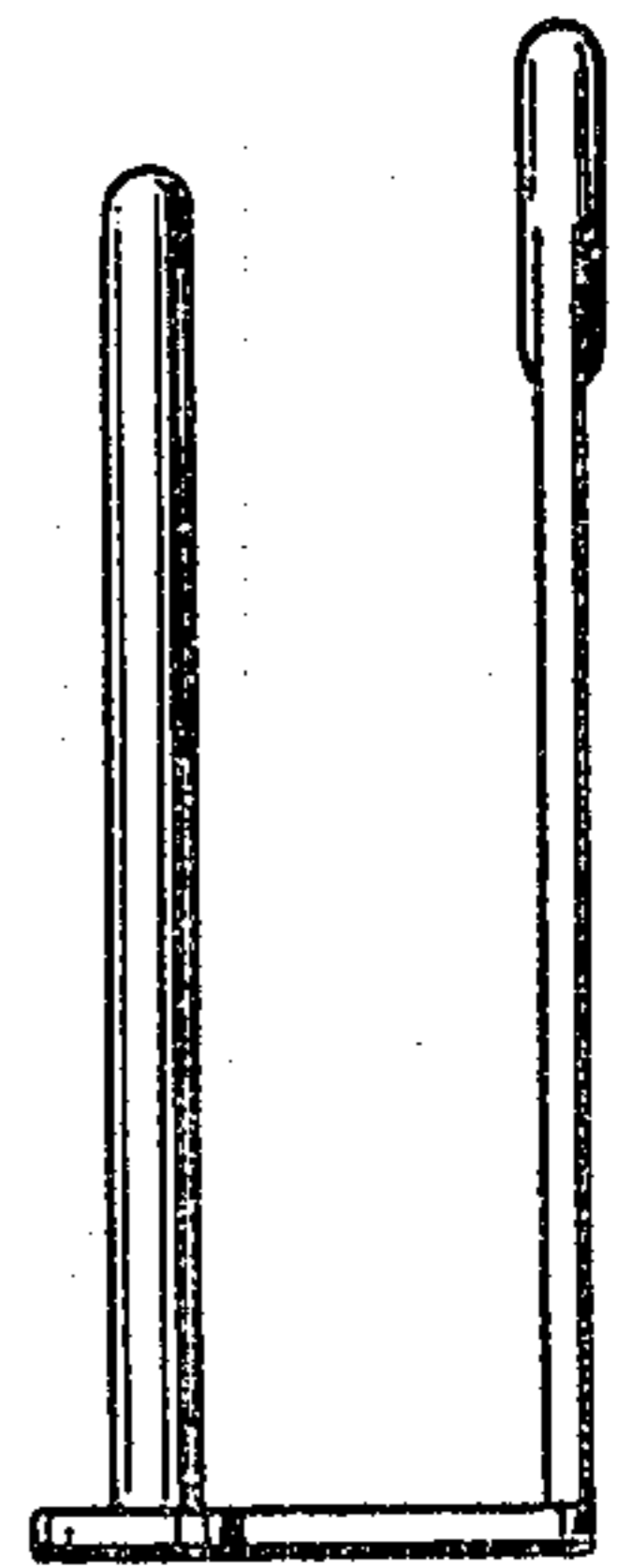
