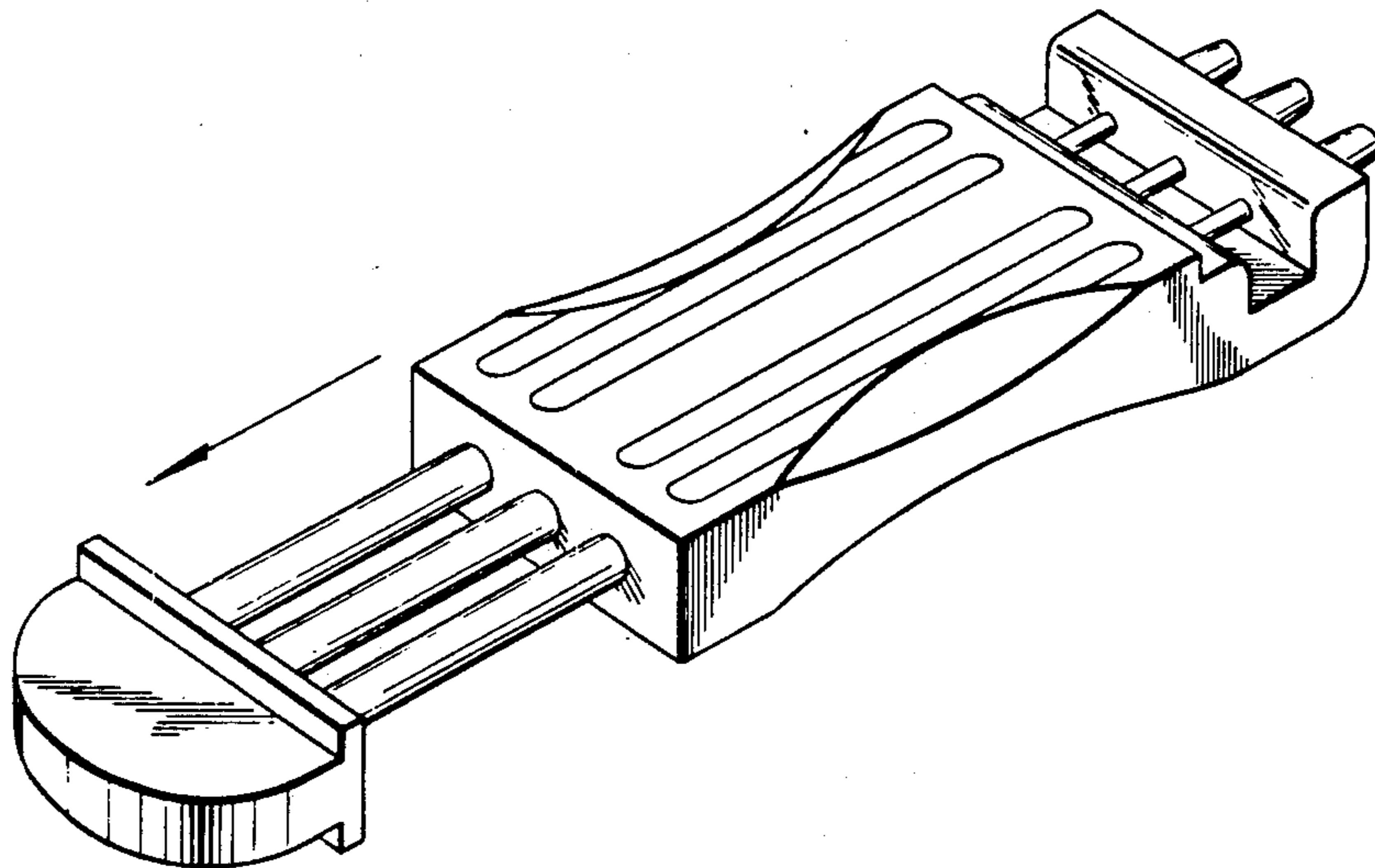

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a microbiological testing syringe, substantially as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a microbiological testing syringe showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof; FIG. 4 is a top and left-front perspective view thereof with the plunger in an extended position.



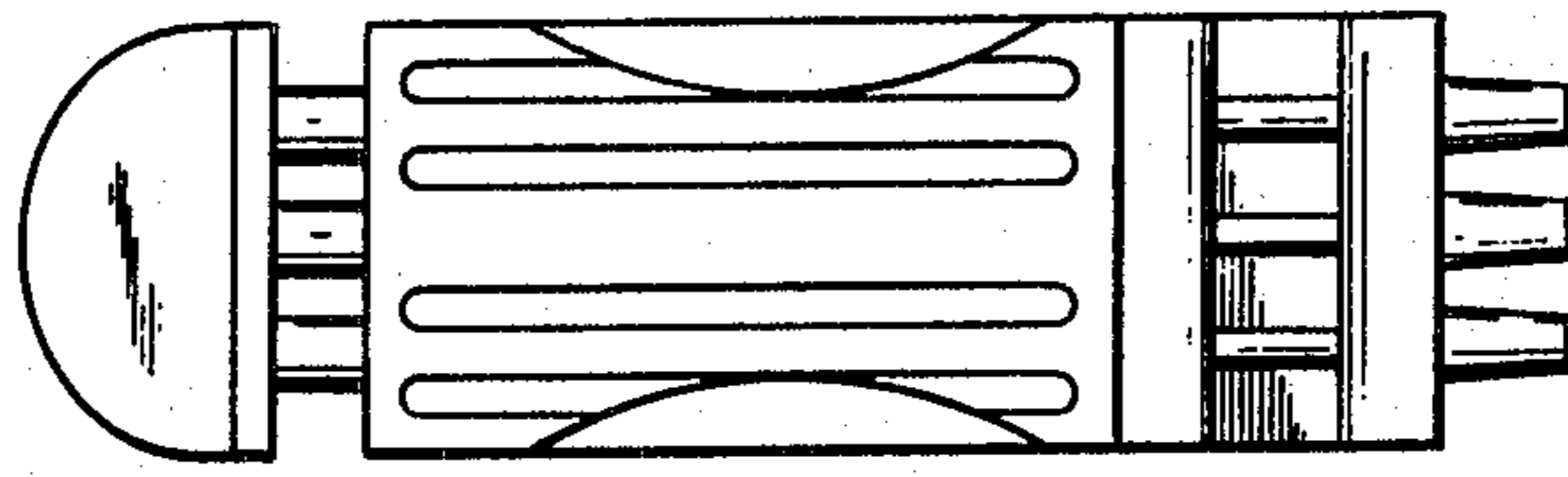

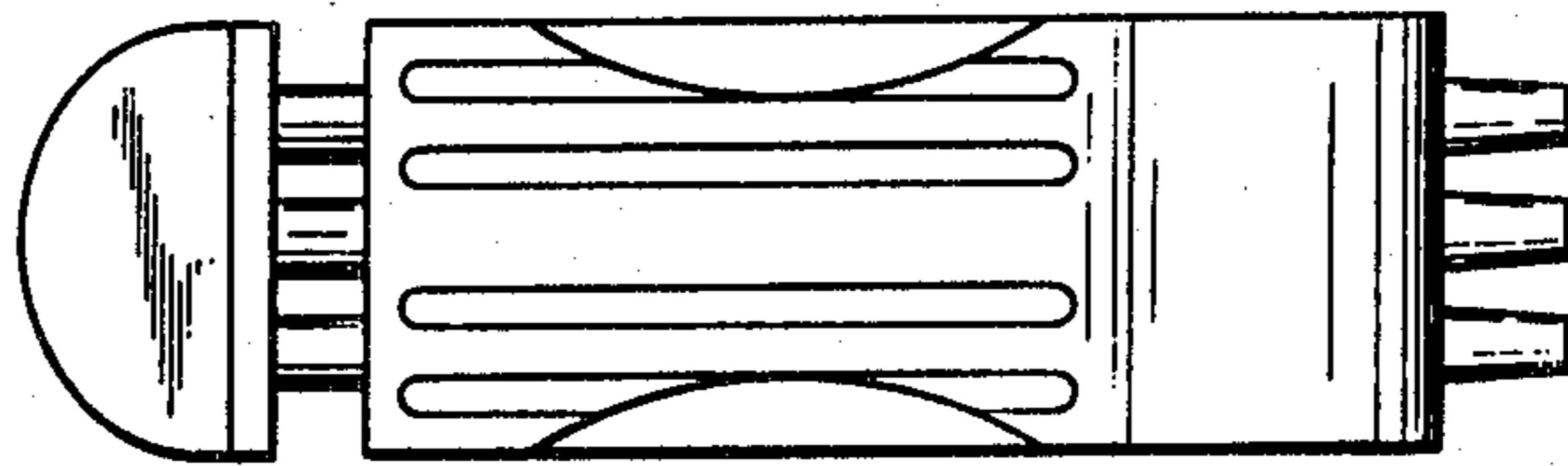

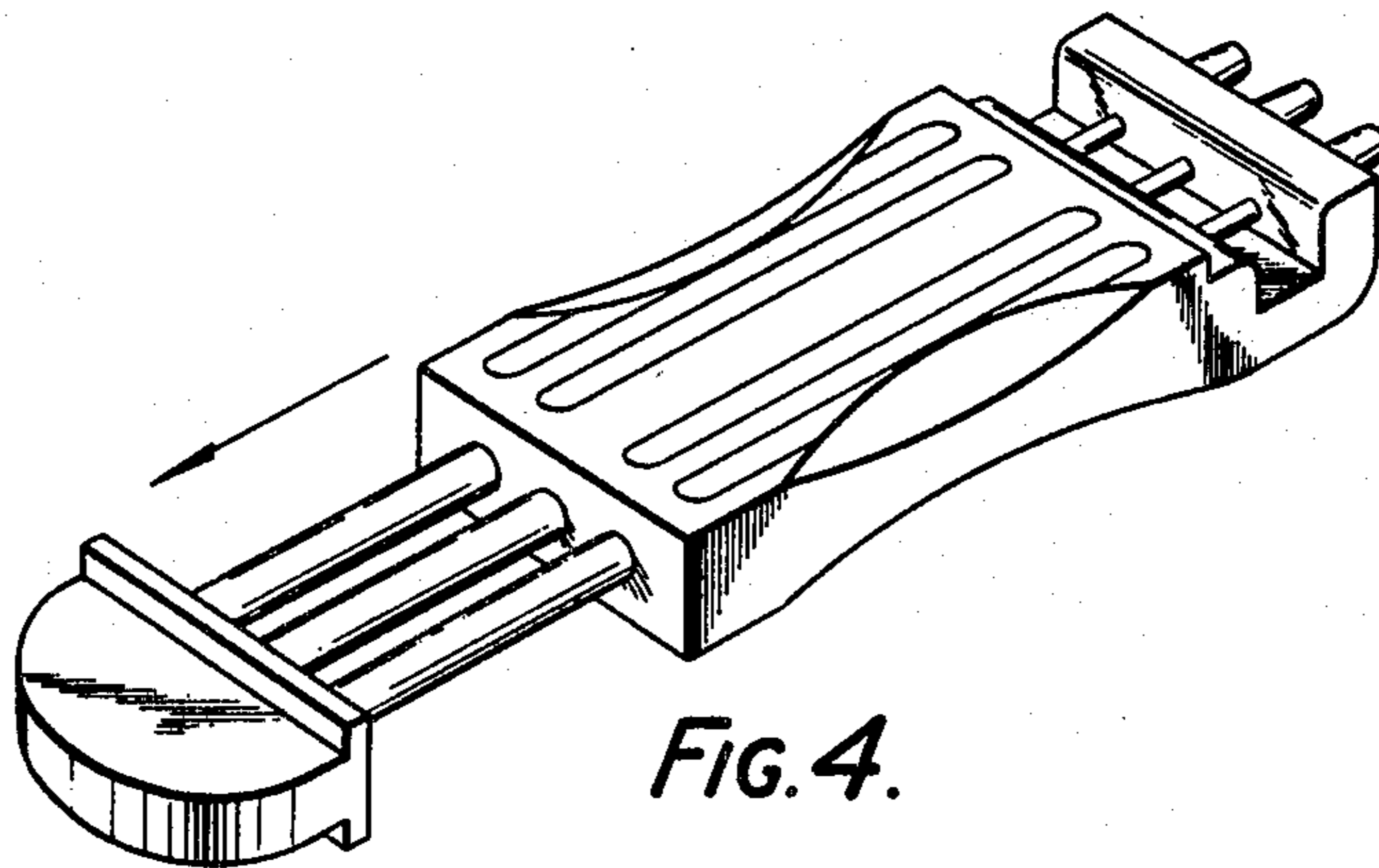
