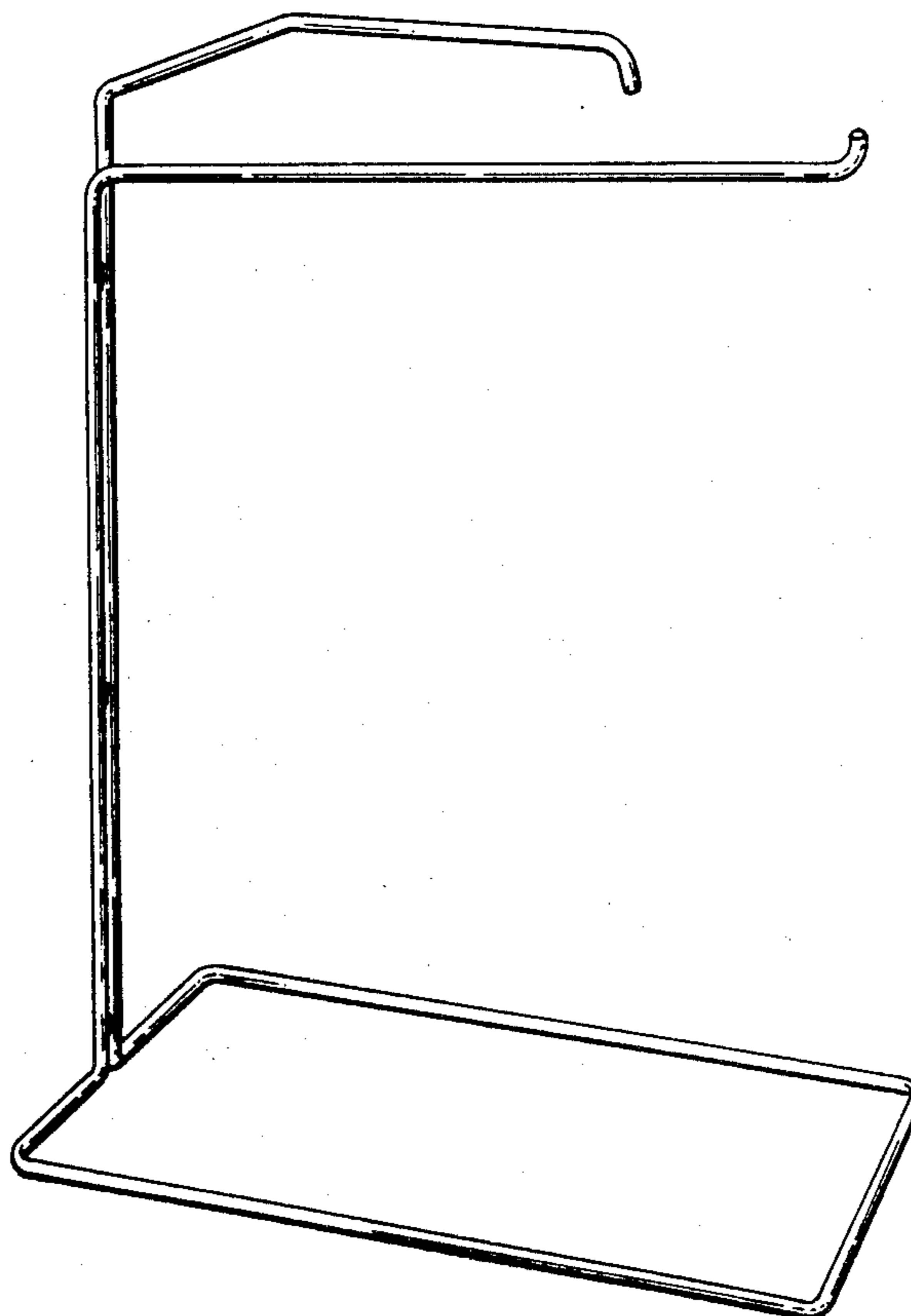

The sole FIGURE is a perspective view of a support stand for electronic components showing my new design.



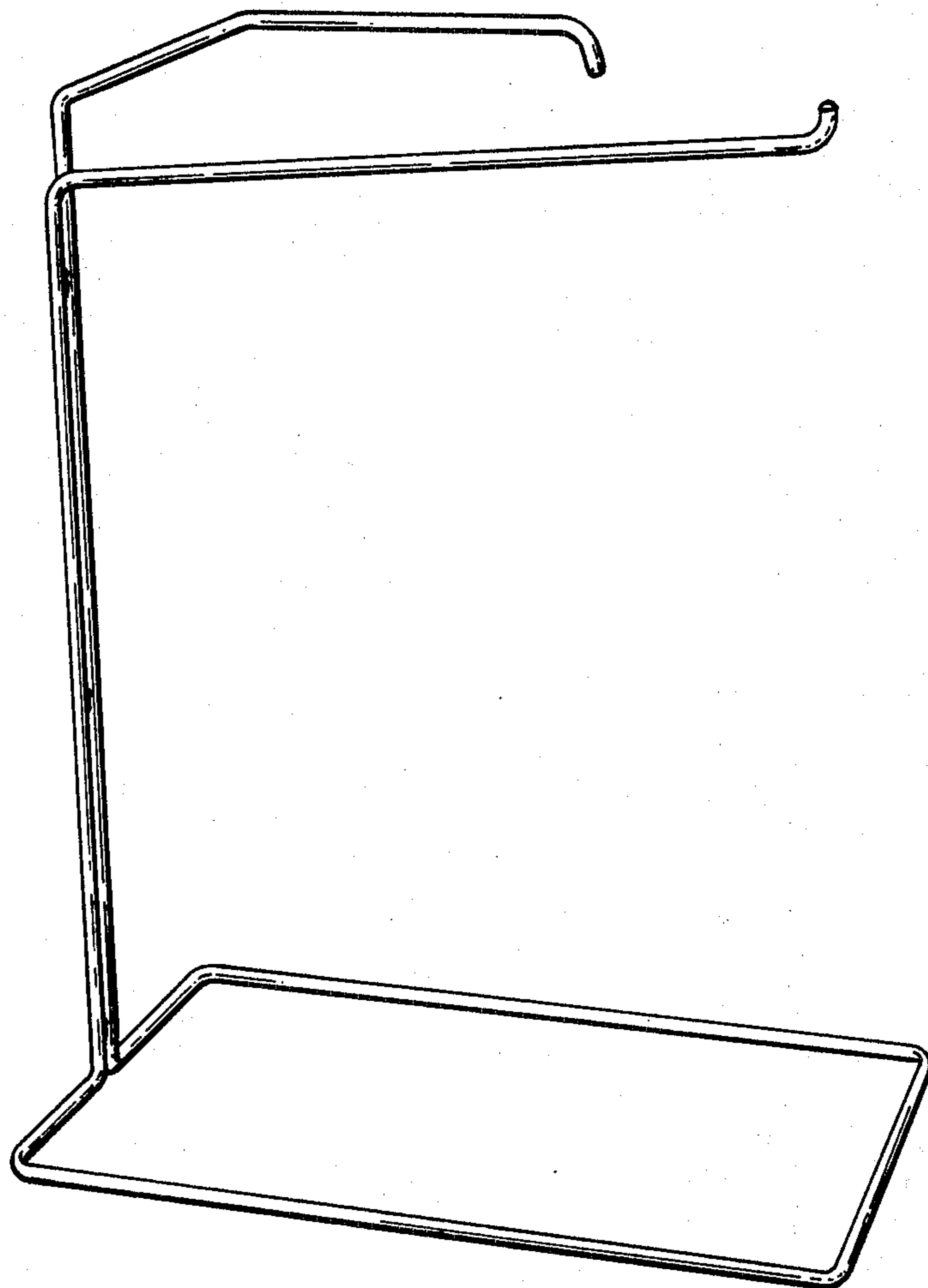
