[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a mug or similar article,  
substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a mug or similar  
article showing my new design;

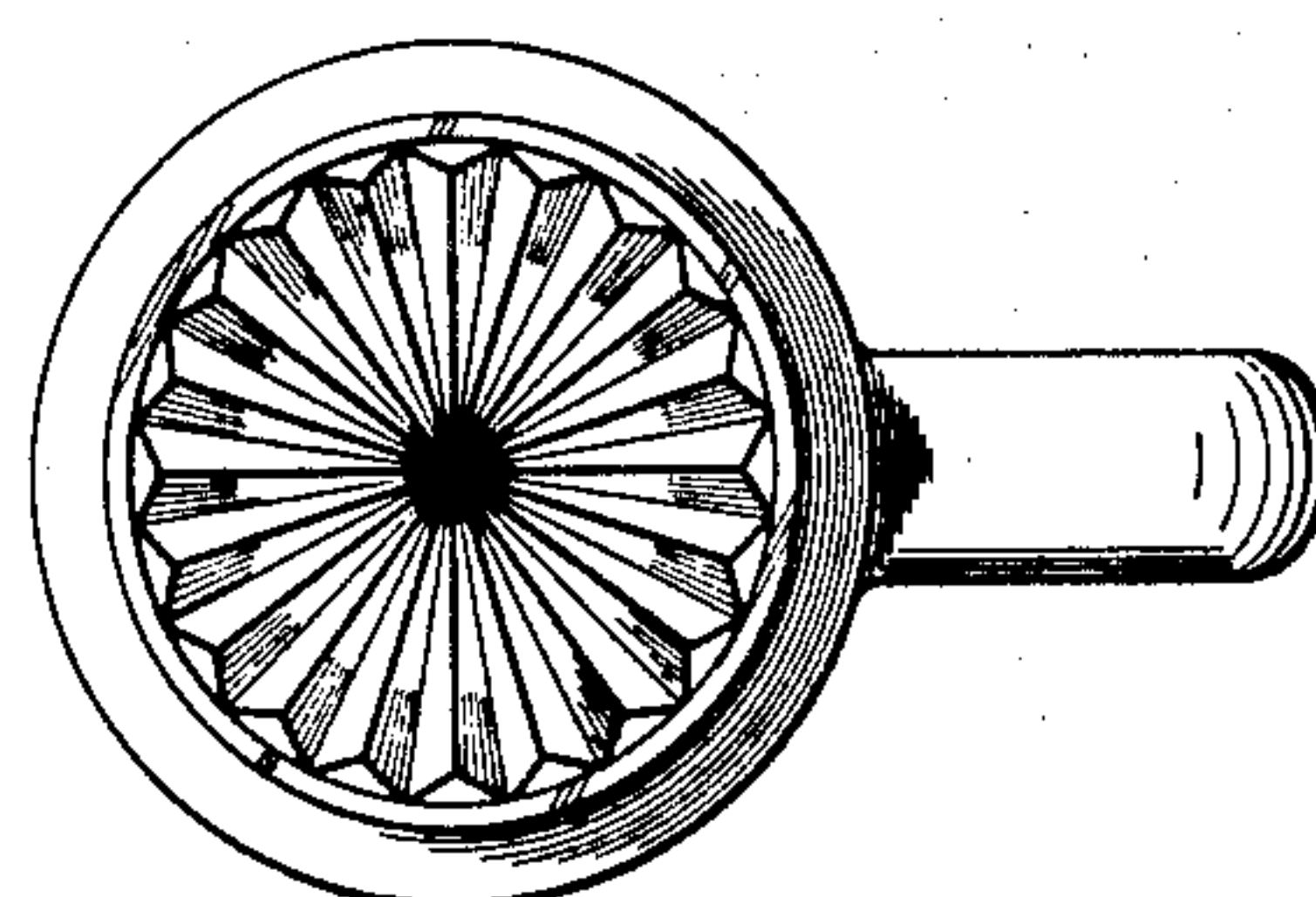
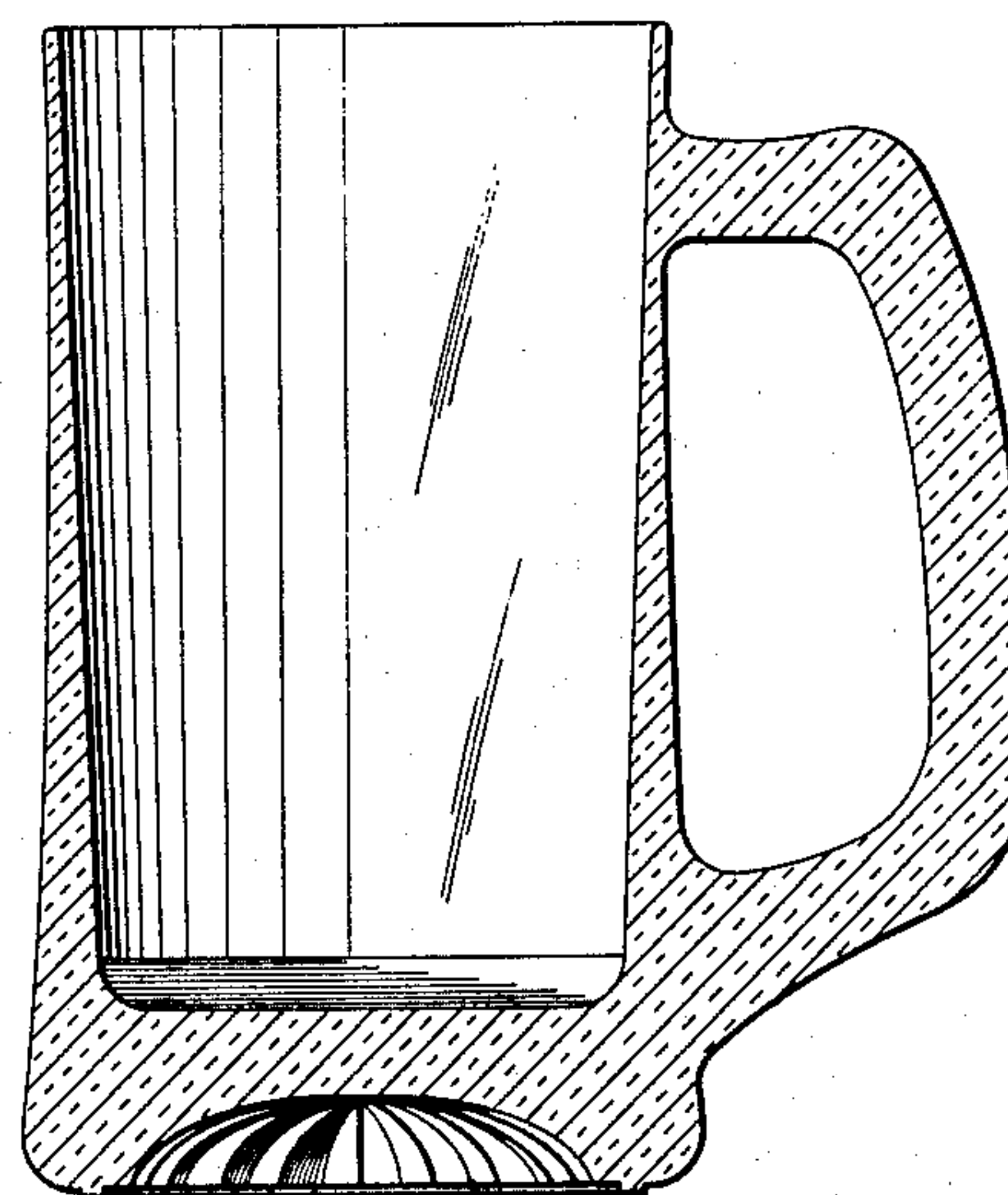
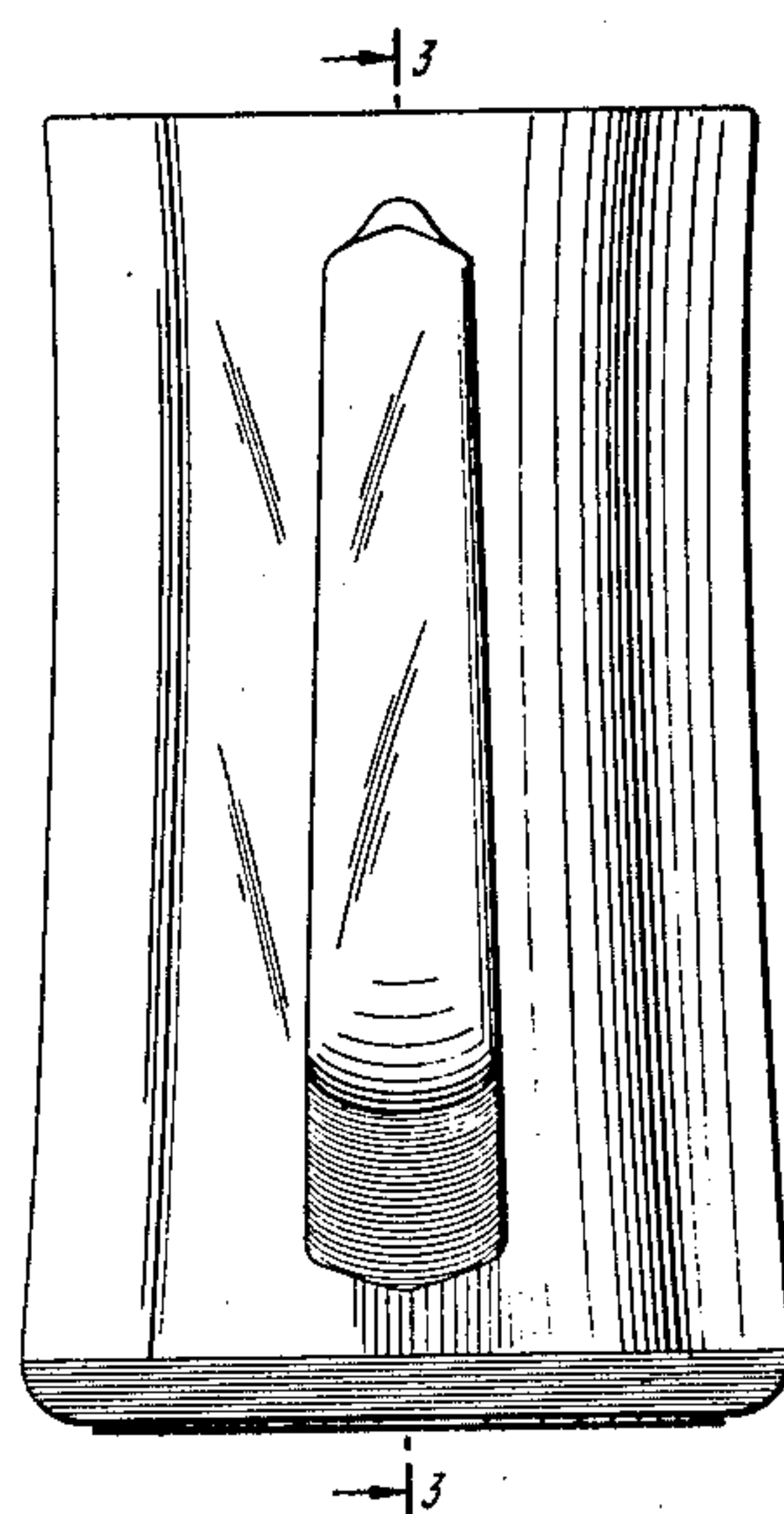
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view of the mug, as viewed  
from the opposite side;

FIG. 3 is a sectional view thereof taken along the lines  
3—3 of FIG. 1;

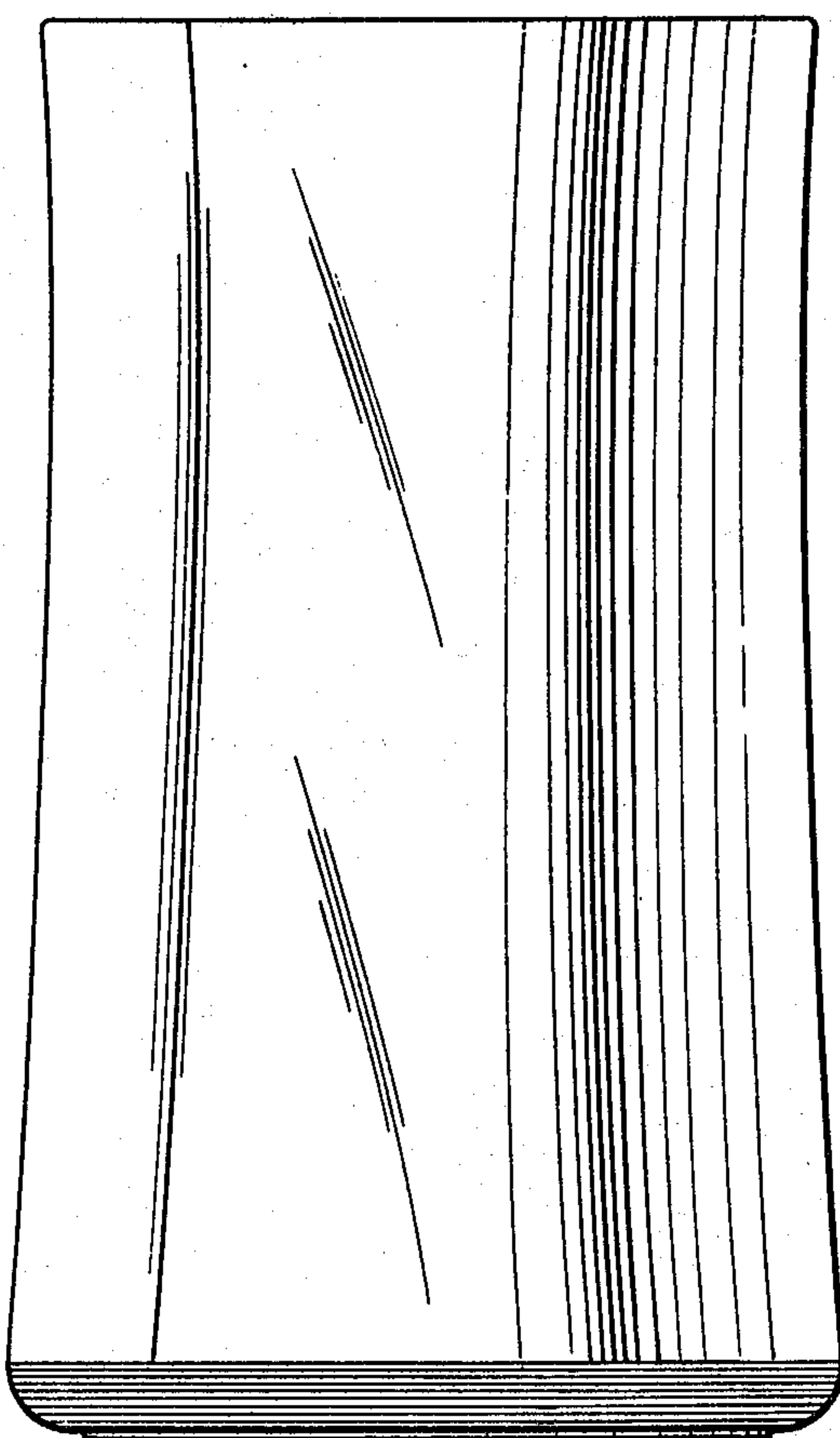
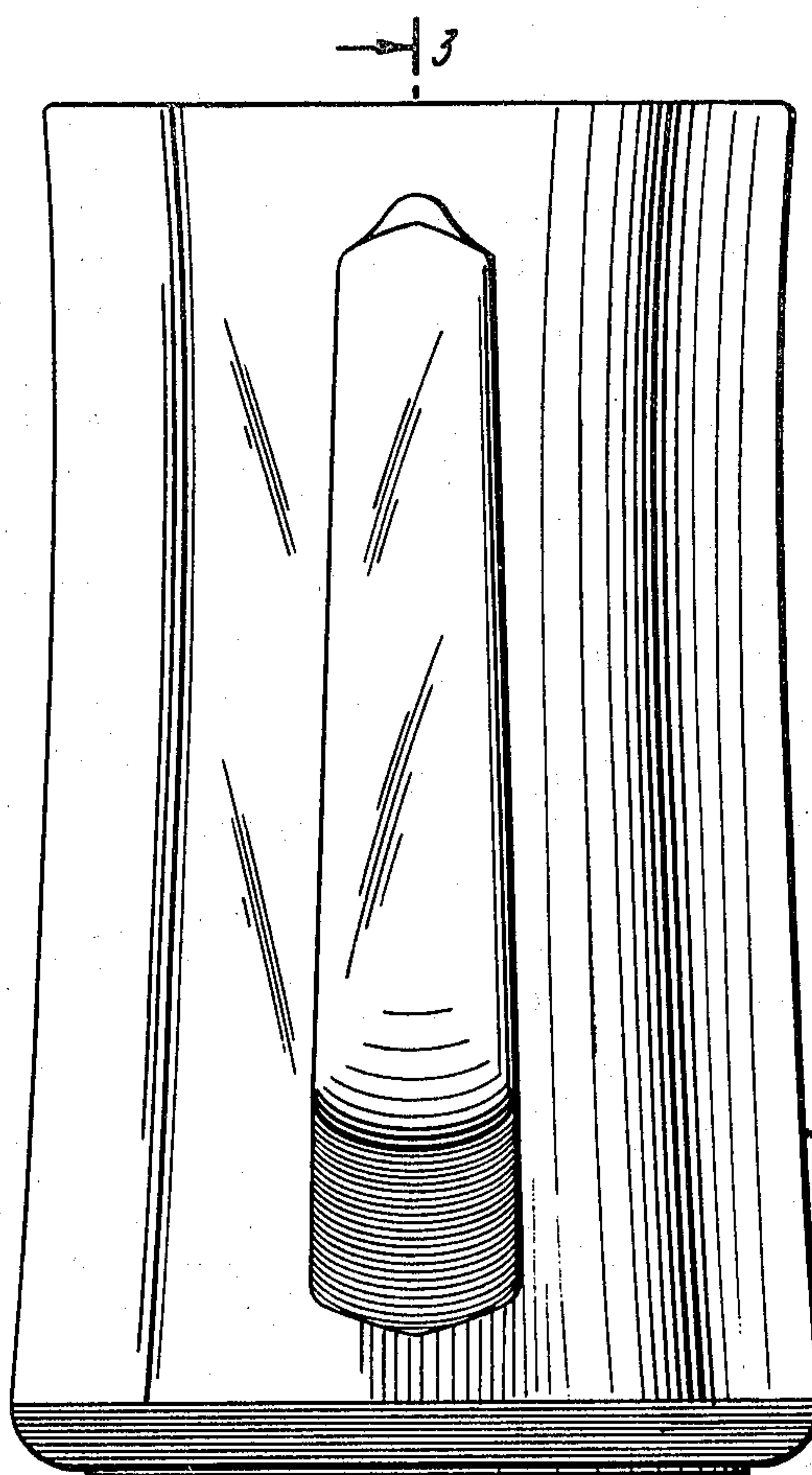
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof on a reduced scale;

FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof on a reduced scale,  
with the bottom facets having been omitted for clarity  
of illustration.

The thickness of the side wall and of the bottom which

elevational views has been eliminated from FIGS. 1,  
and 2.

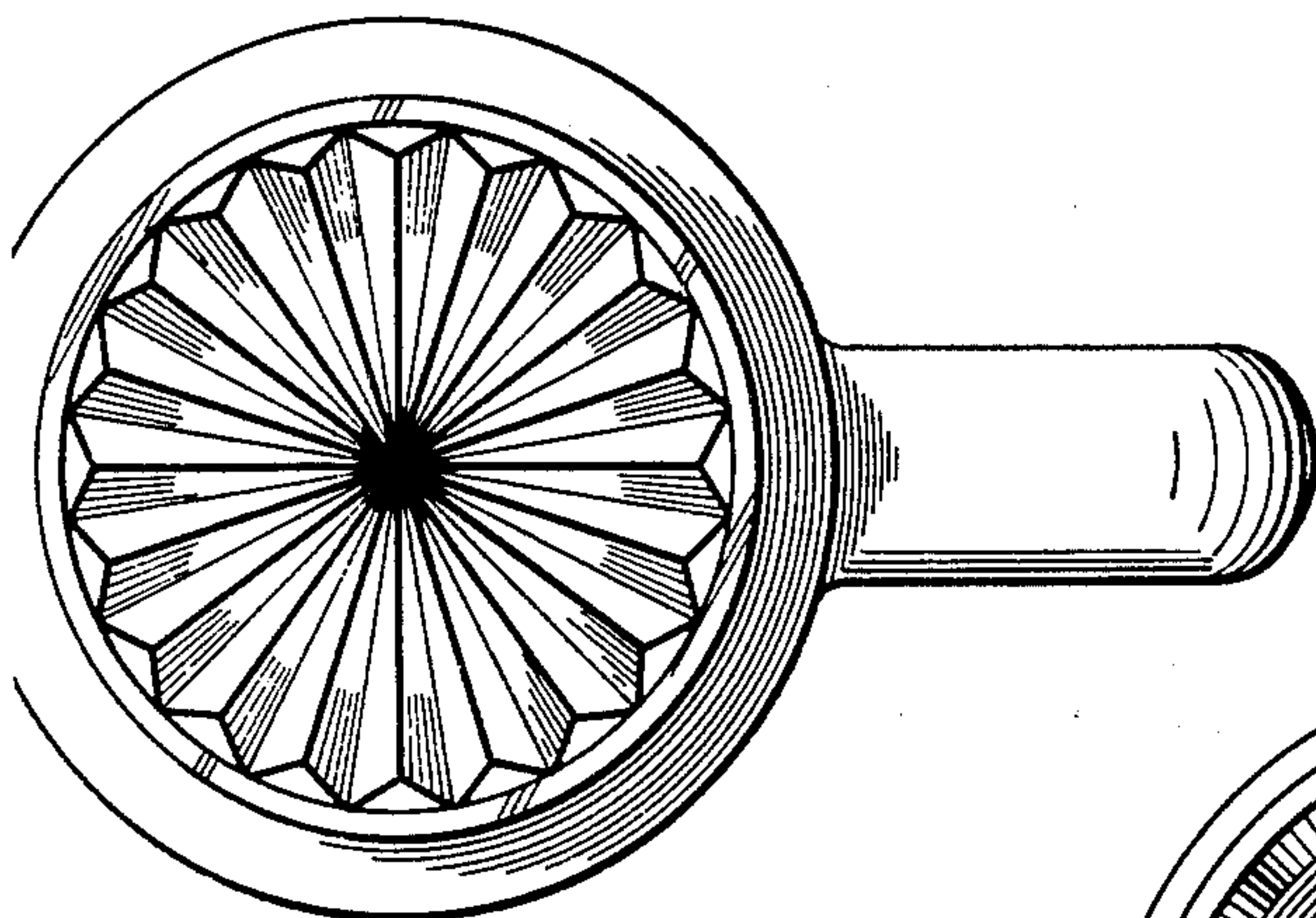
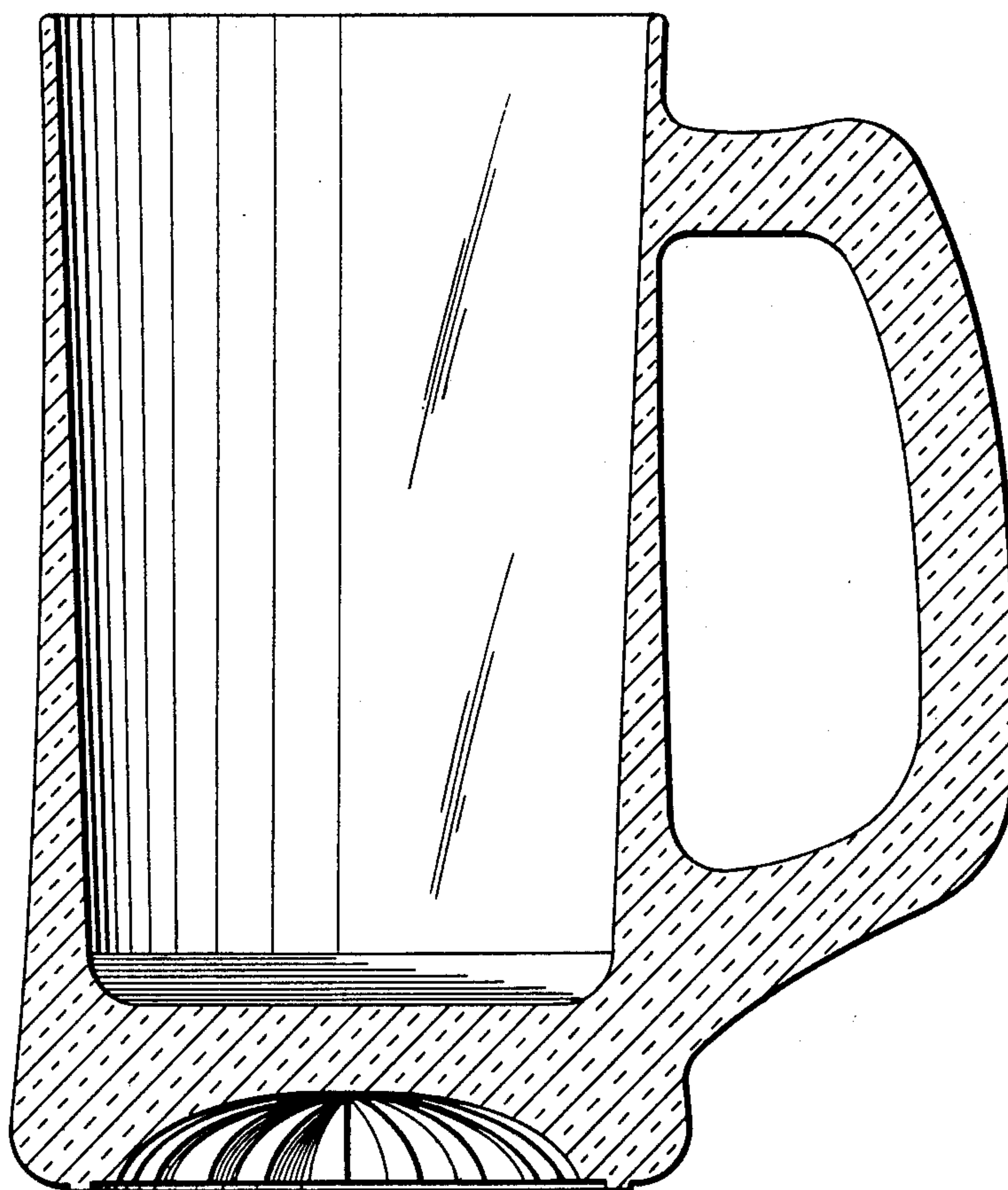
