CLAIM

The ornamental design for a bottle, substantially as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevation view of a bottle embodying my new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a partial sectional view of the bottle taken along lines 3—3 of FIG. 2; and
FIG. 4 is a sectional view taken along lines 4—4 of FIG. 1.
