The ornamental design for a combined water storage tank and building, as shown and described.

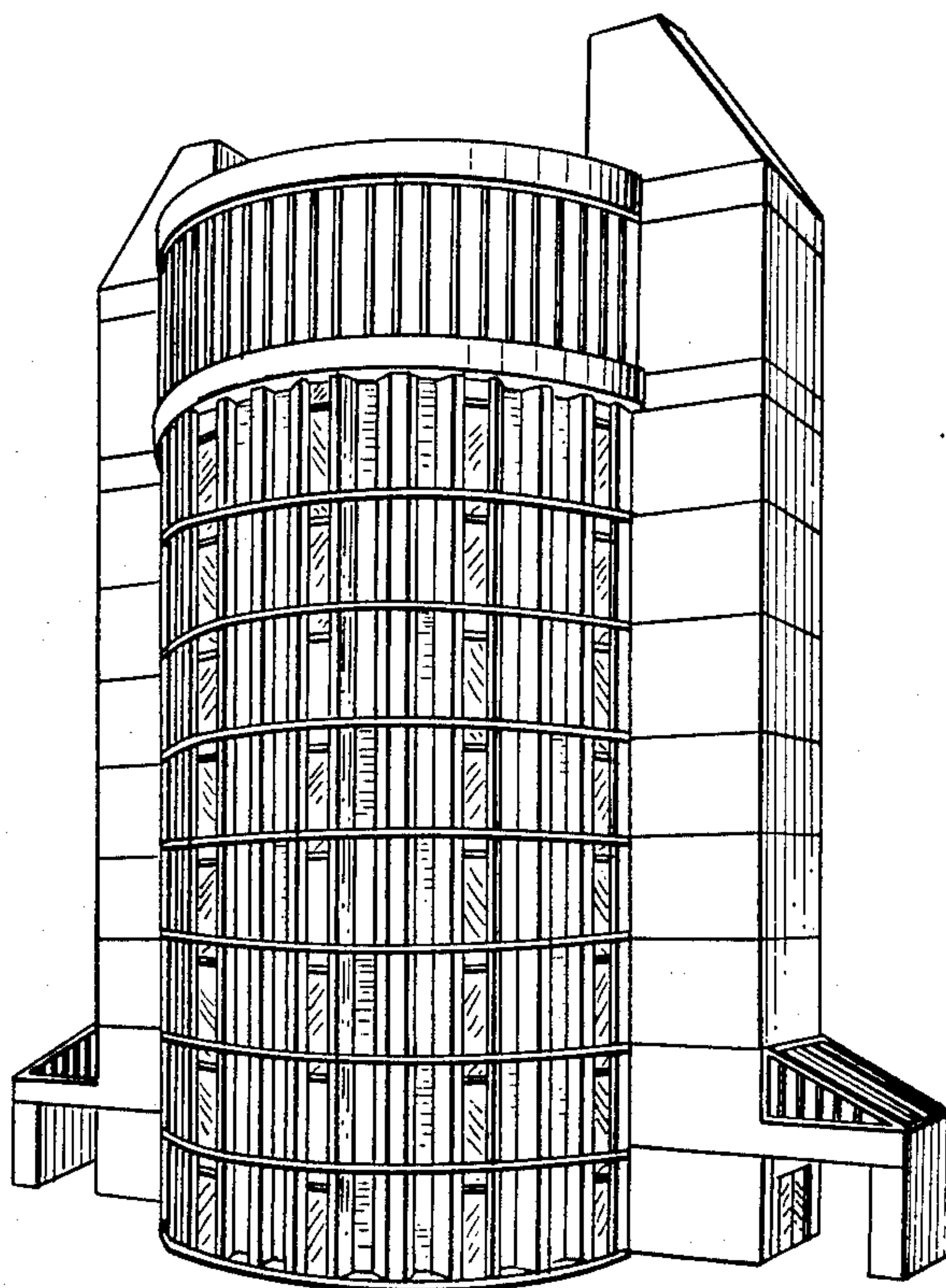

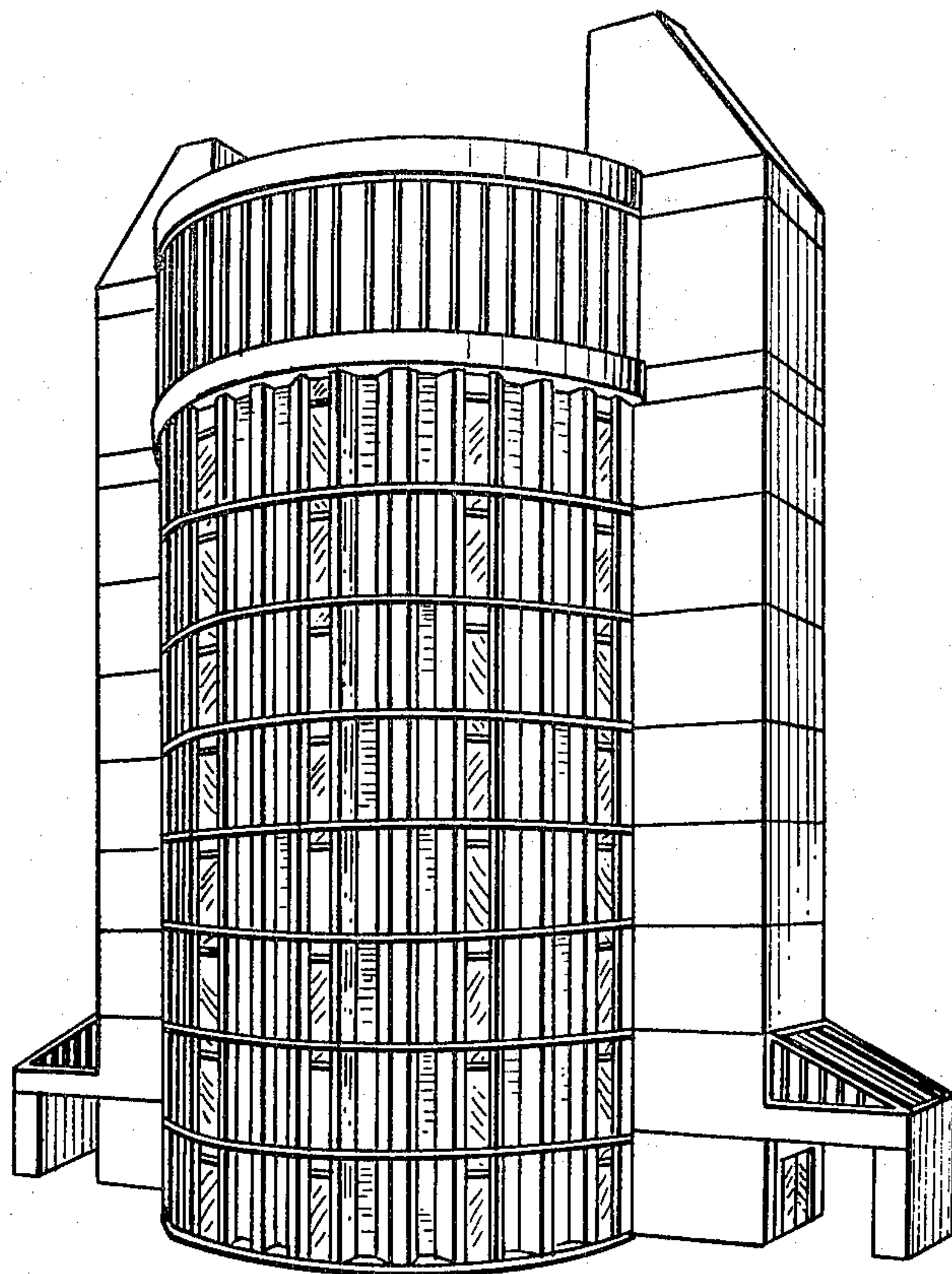

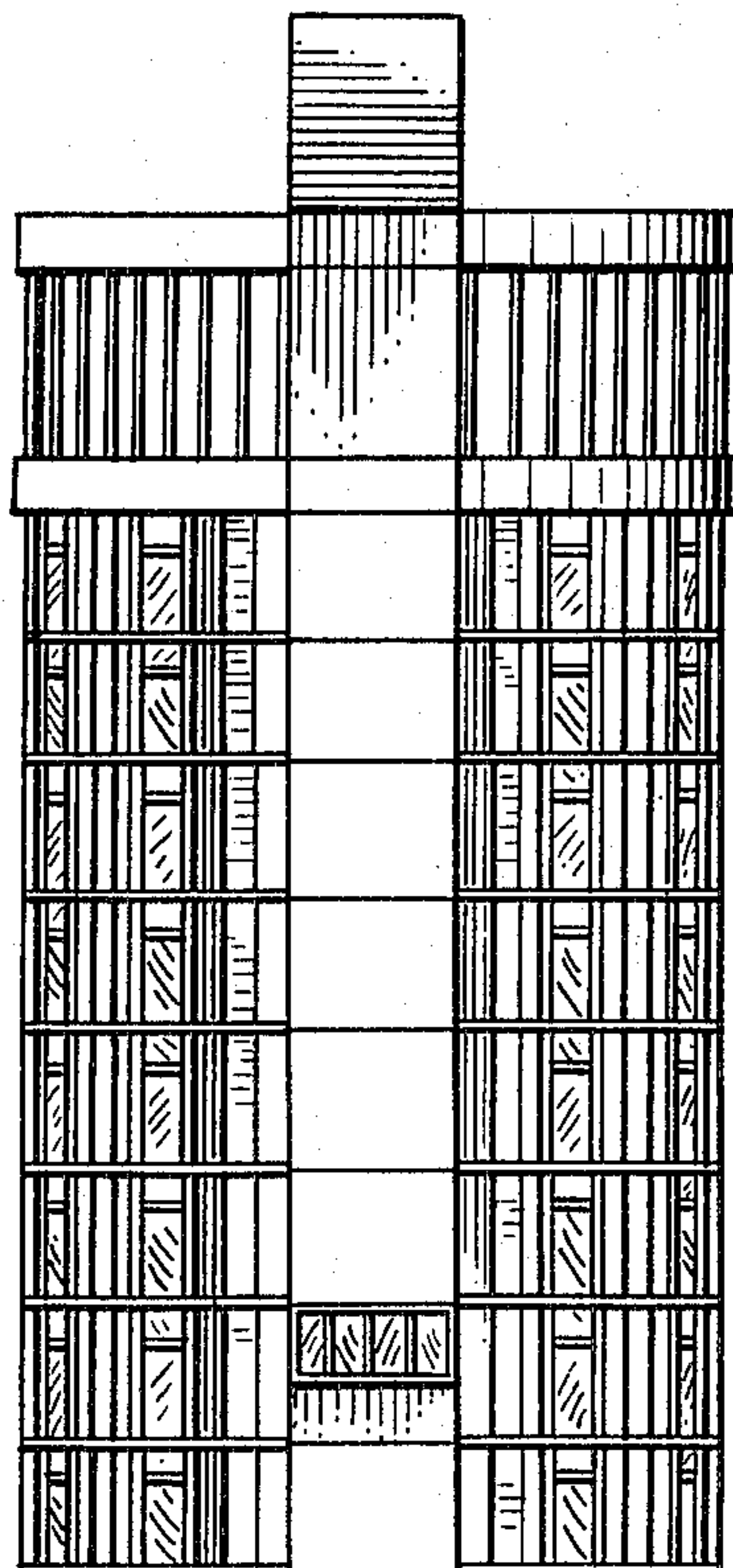

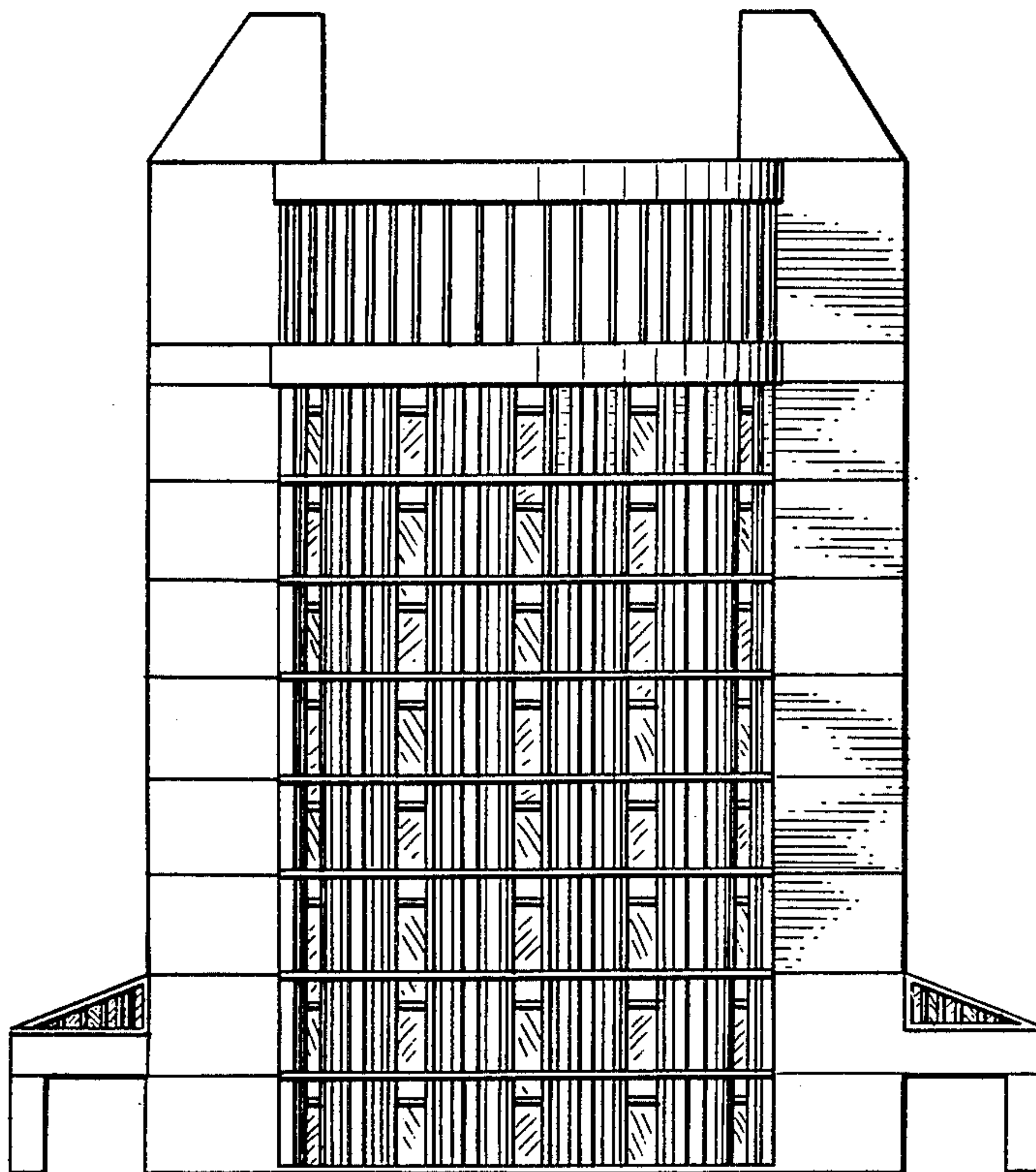
