[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for an animal ear tag insecticide dispenser, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of an animal ear tag insecticide dispenser showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a side elevational view of the right side of FIG. 1, the left side view being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 3 is a top view of FIG. 1, the bottom view being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view of FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is a sectional view taken along the line 5—5 of FIG. 1.
