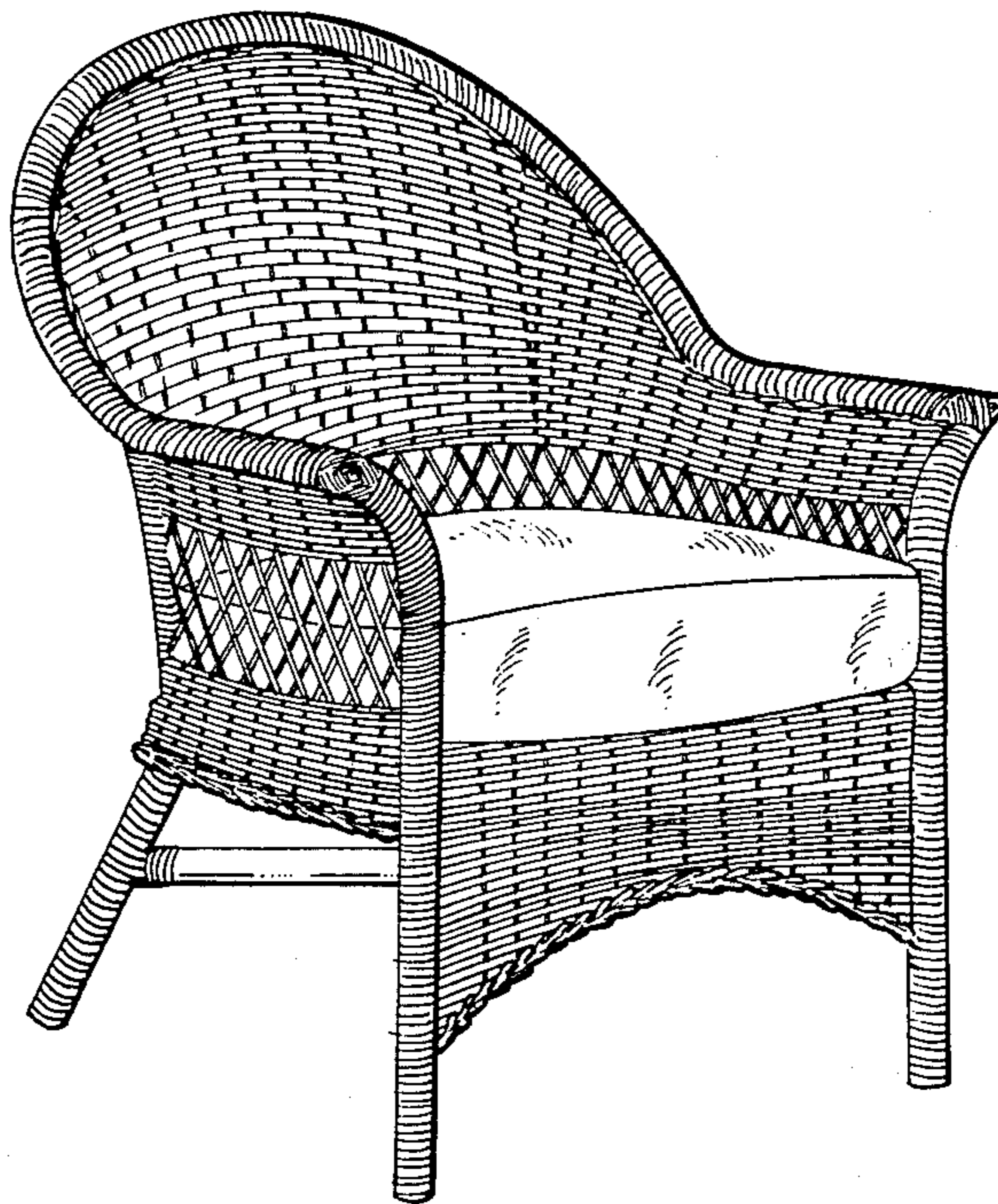

DESCRIPTION

 The cushion shown in FIGS. 1 and 2 has been omitted from FIGS. 3-5 for convenience of illustration.



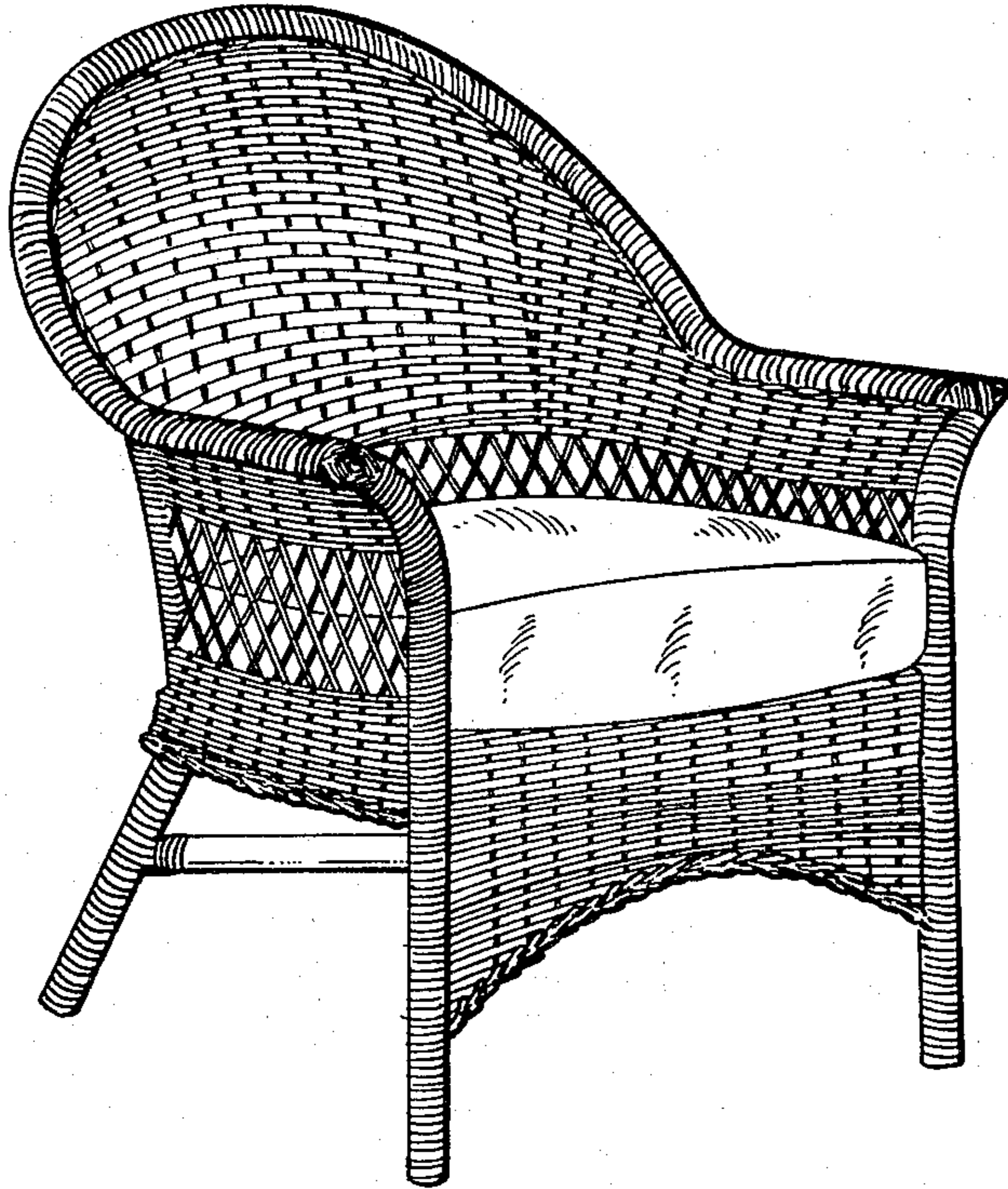

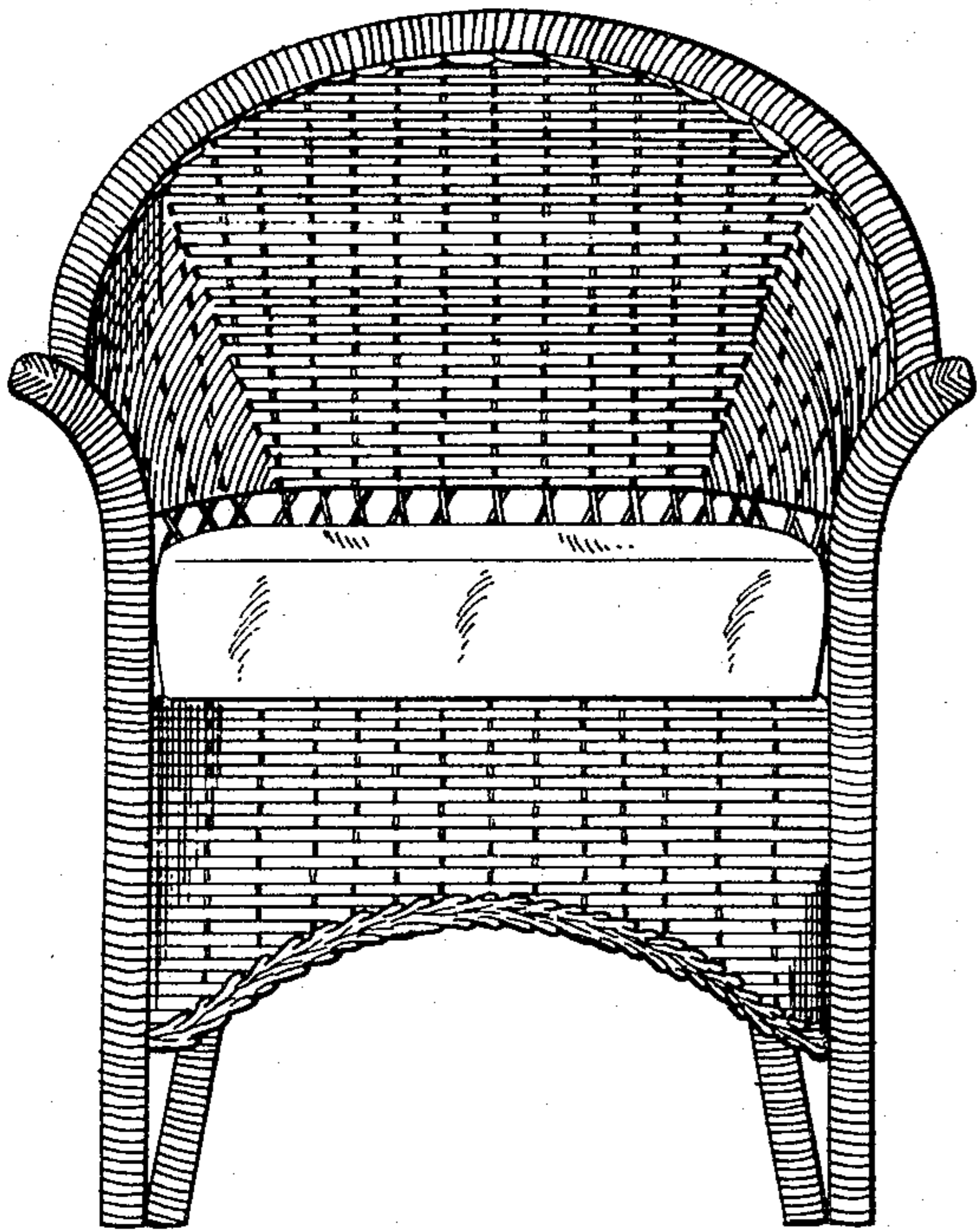
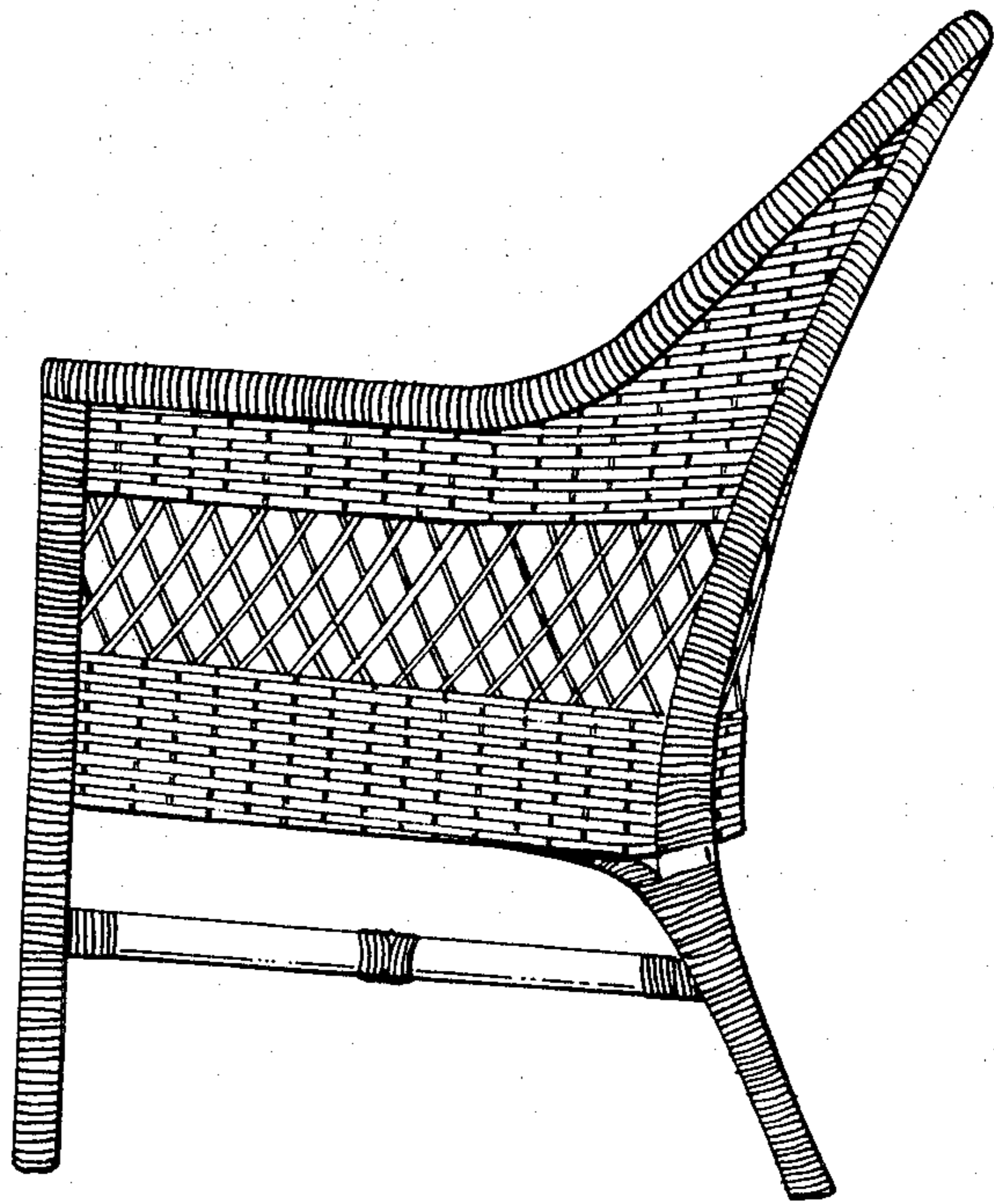

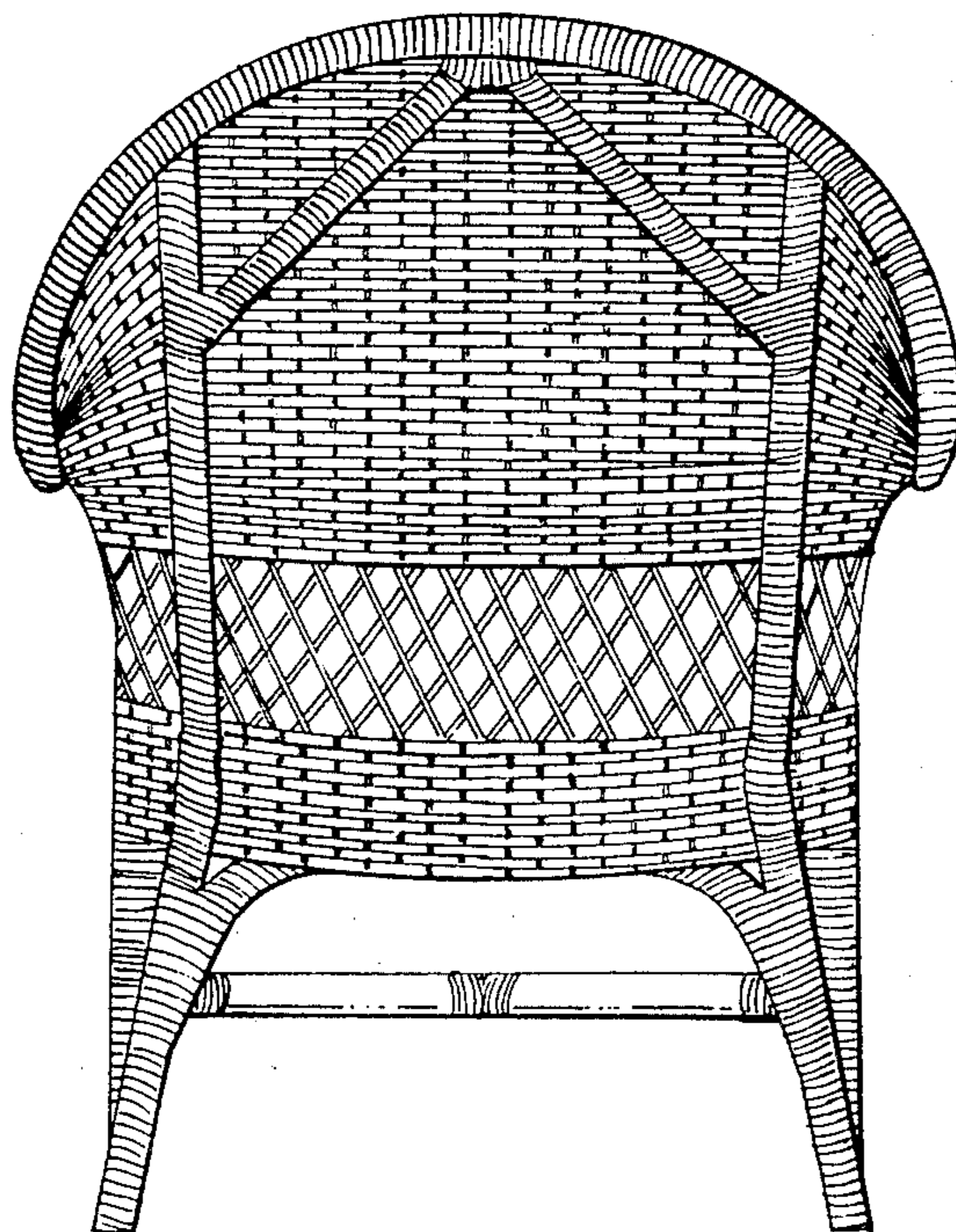
