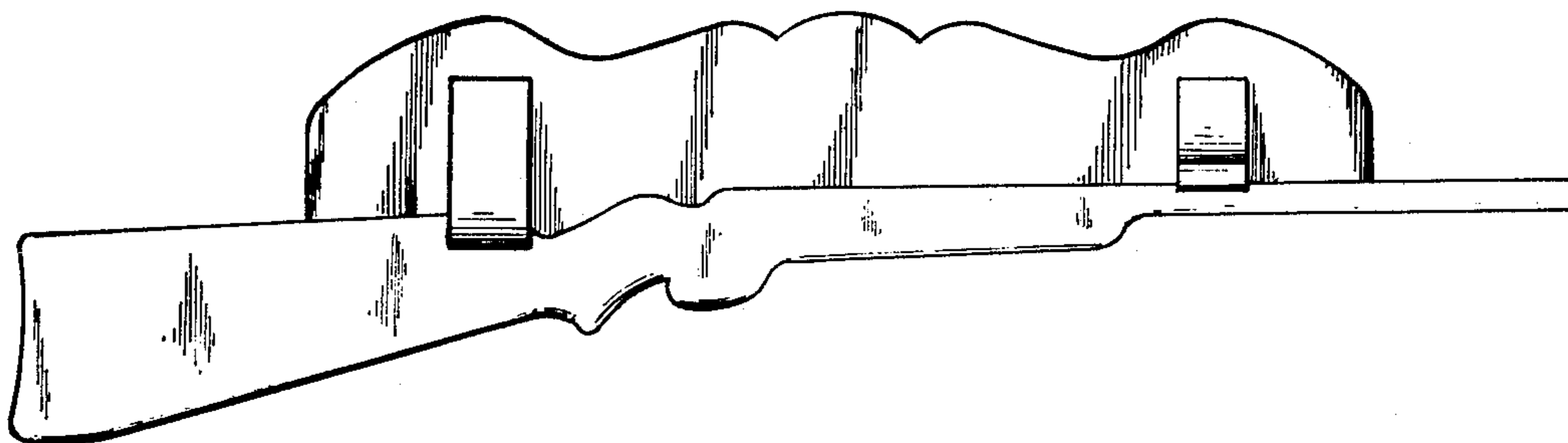

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a gun rack, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a gun rack showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;
 FIG. 4 is an end elevational view taken from the left of FIG. 1;
 FIG. 5 is an end elevational view taken from the right of FIG. 1;
 FIG. 6 is a front elevational view of a gun rack showing a second embodiment of my new design;
 FIG. 7 is a top plan view of FIG. 6;
 FIG. 8 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 6;
 FIG. 9 is an end elevational view taken from the left of FIG. 6; and
 FIG. 10 is an end elevational view taken from the right of FIG. 6.
 The claimed design can embody multiple paired hooks in excess of those explicitly disclosed in the embodiments of FIGS. 1-10.



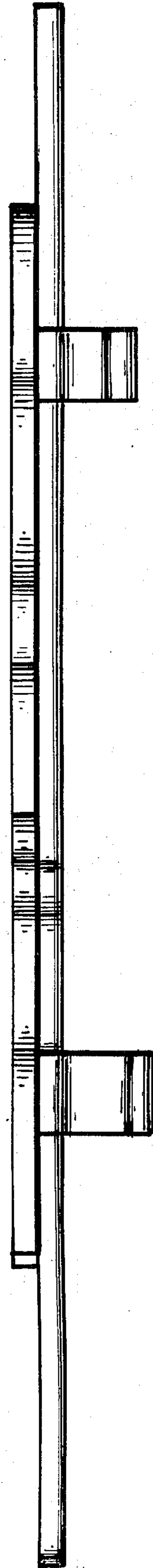
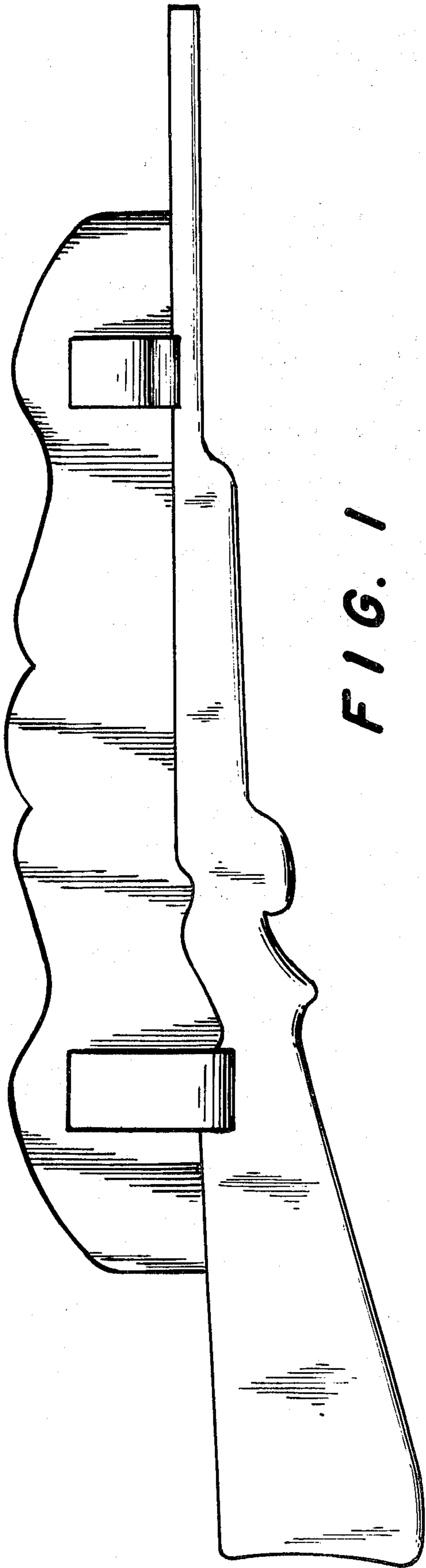

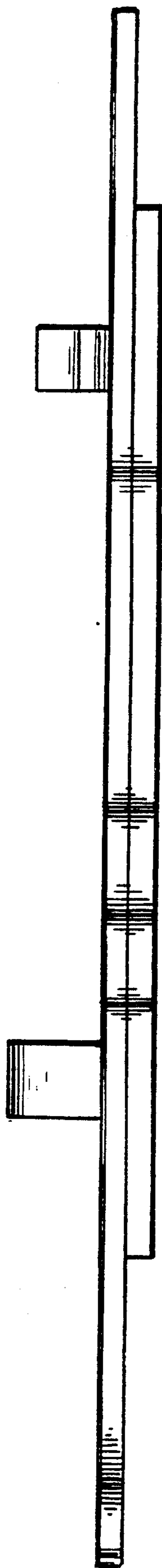

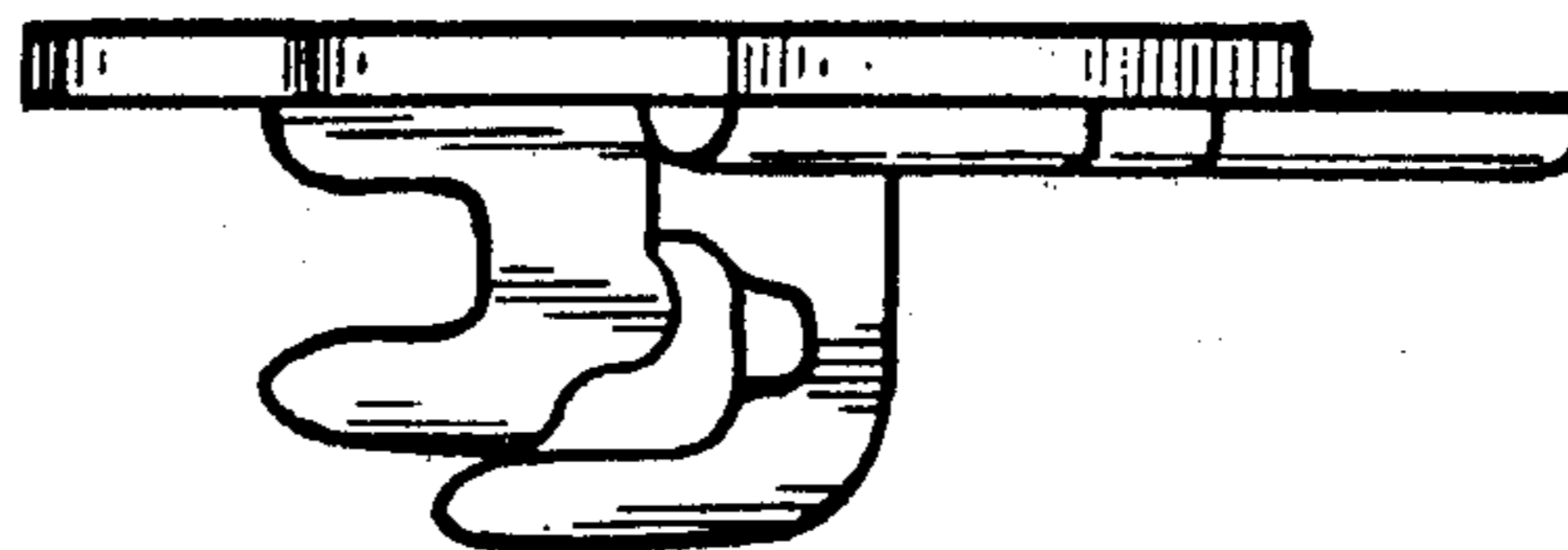
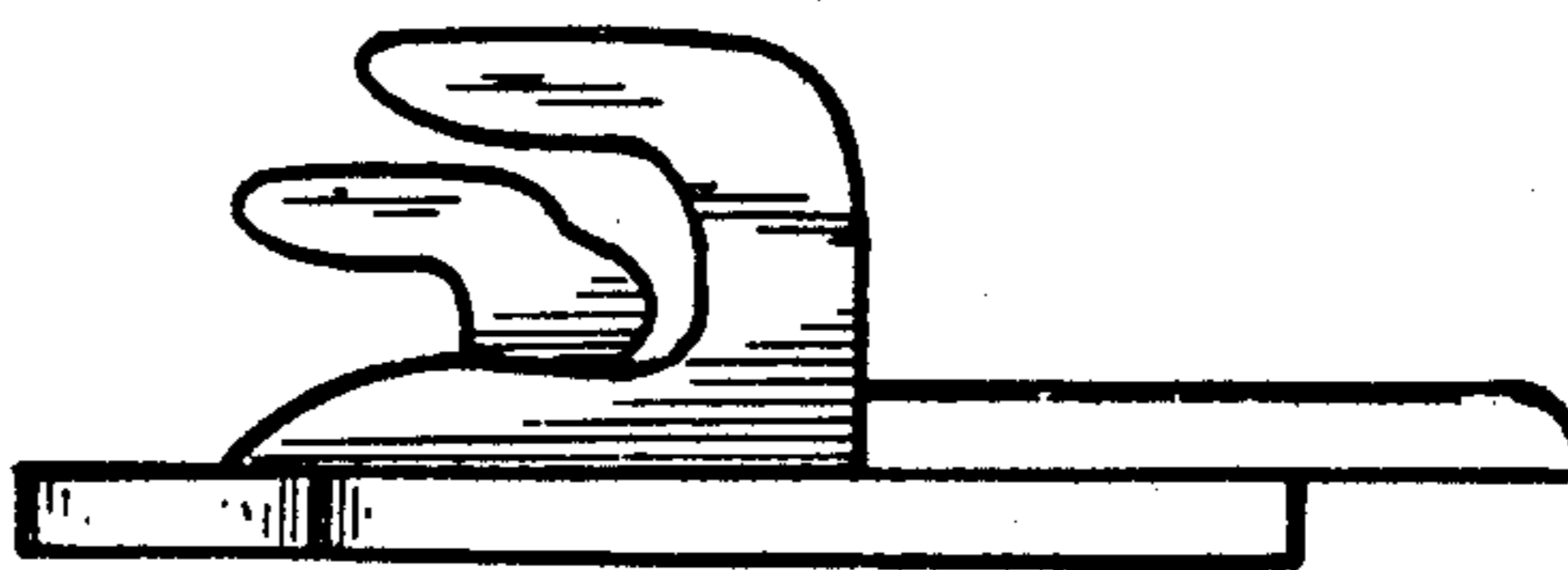

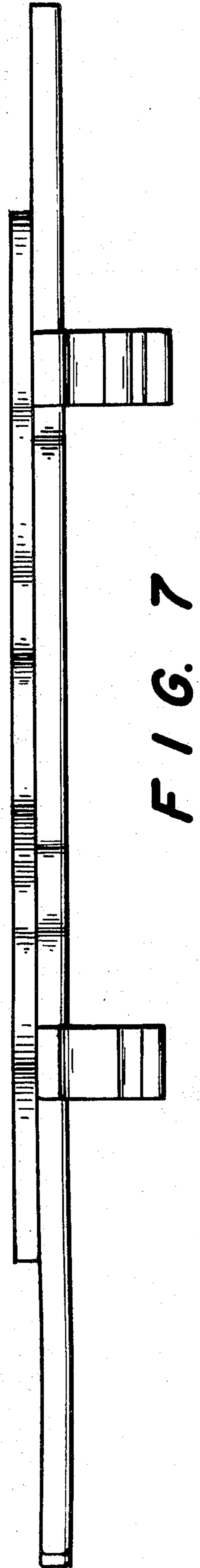
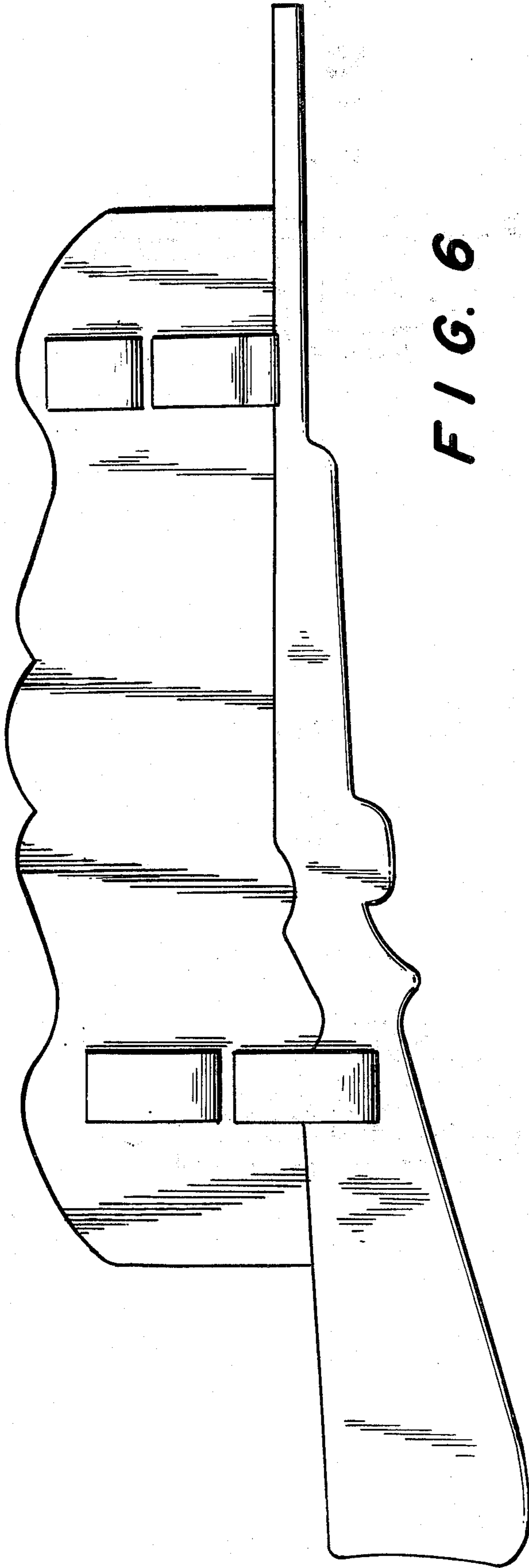

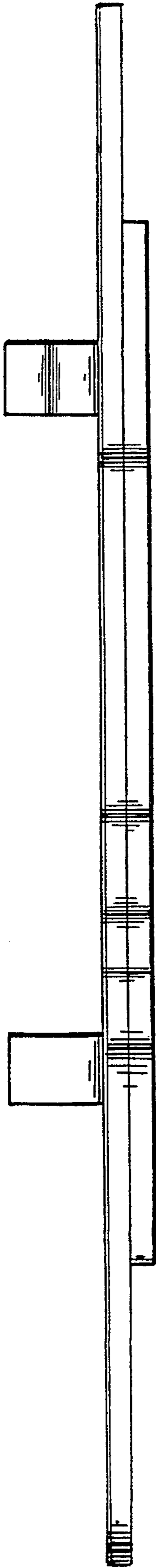

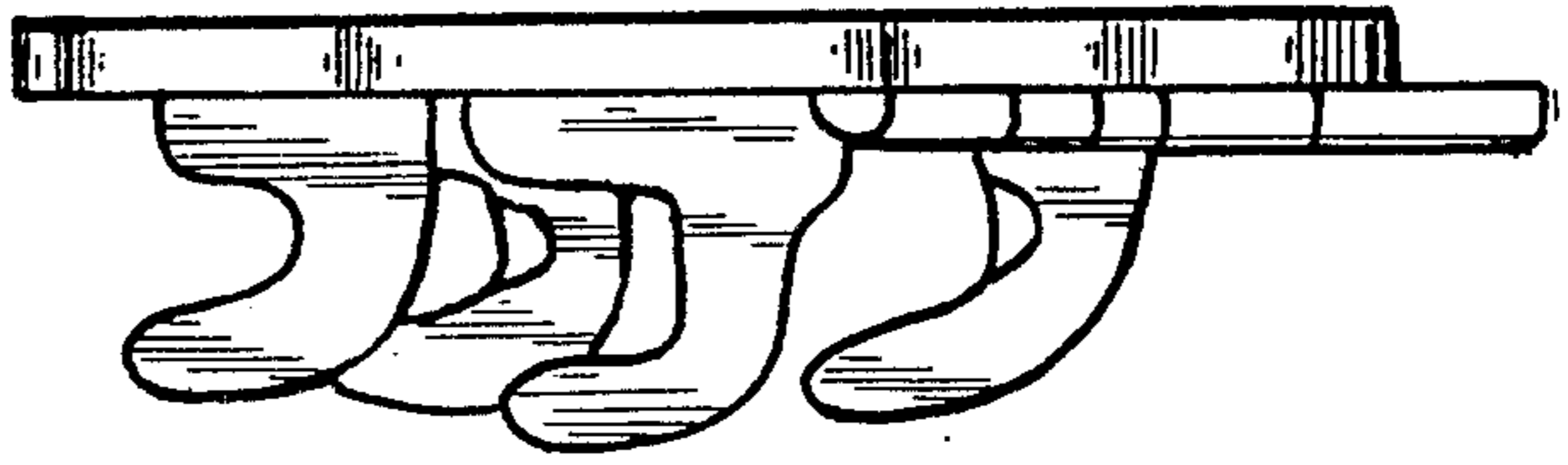
