CLAIM

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a bottom plan view of a plate or similar article showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof, the reverse side being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof, the surface decoration as seen through the side and bottom having been left out for convenience of illustration; and

FIG. 4 is a sectional view thereof taken along the lines 4—4 of FIG. 3, showing the inner suface, the surface decoration as seen through the side having been left out for clarity of illustration.
