**DESCRIPTION**

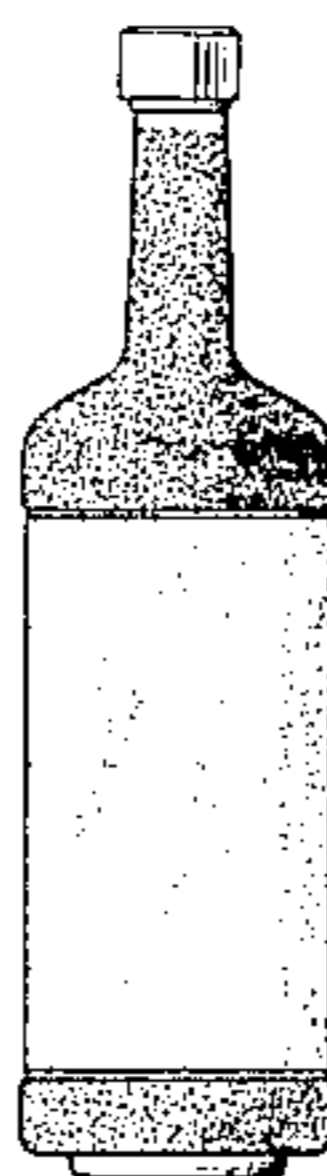
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a bottle showing my new design;

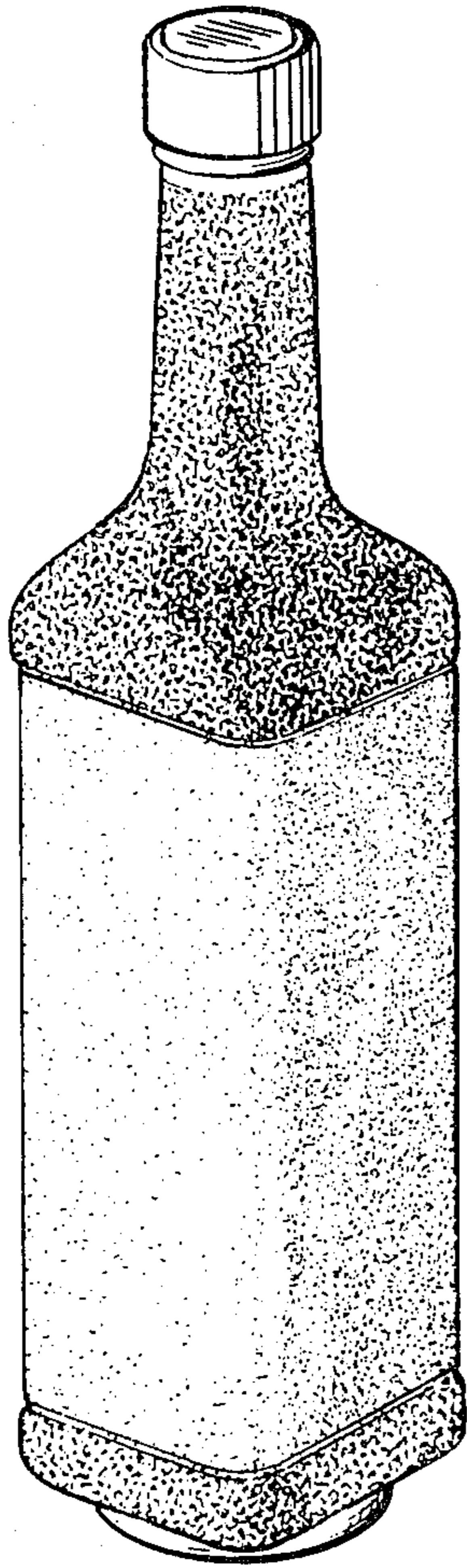
FIG. 2 is a front view thereof, the sides and rear, not shown, being identical;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof; and

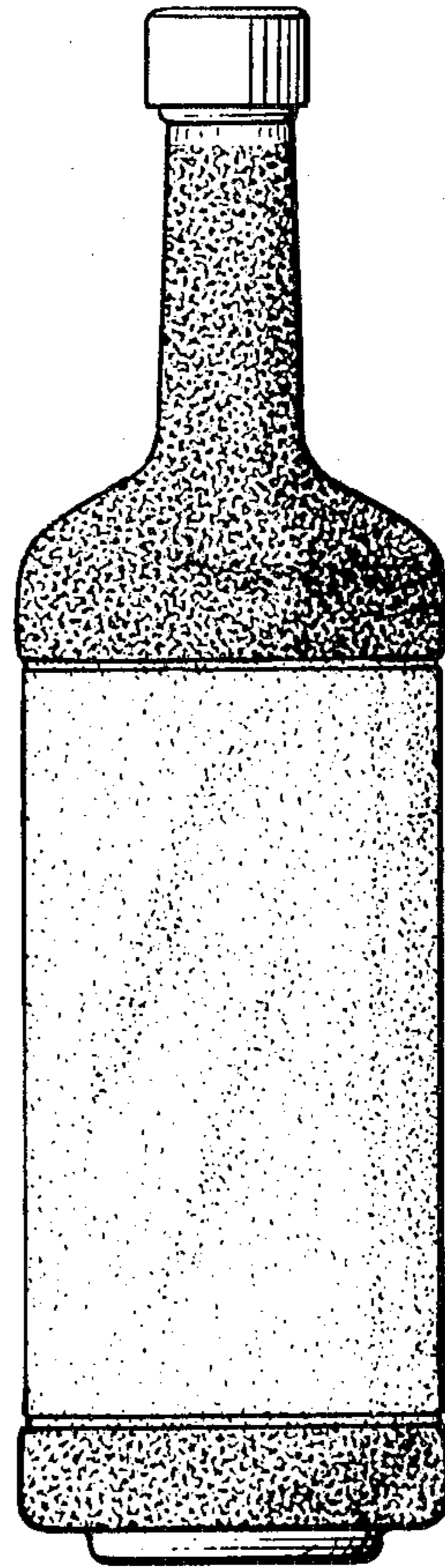
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof.

The light and dark shading indicates contrasting surface texture.

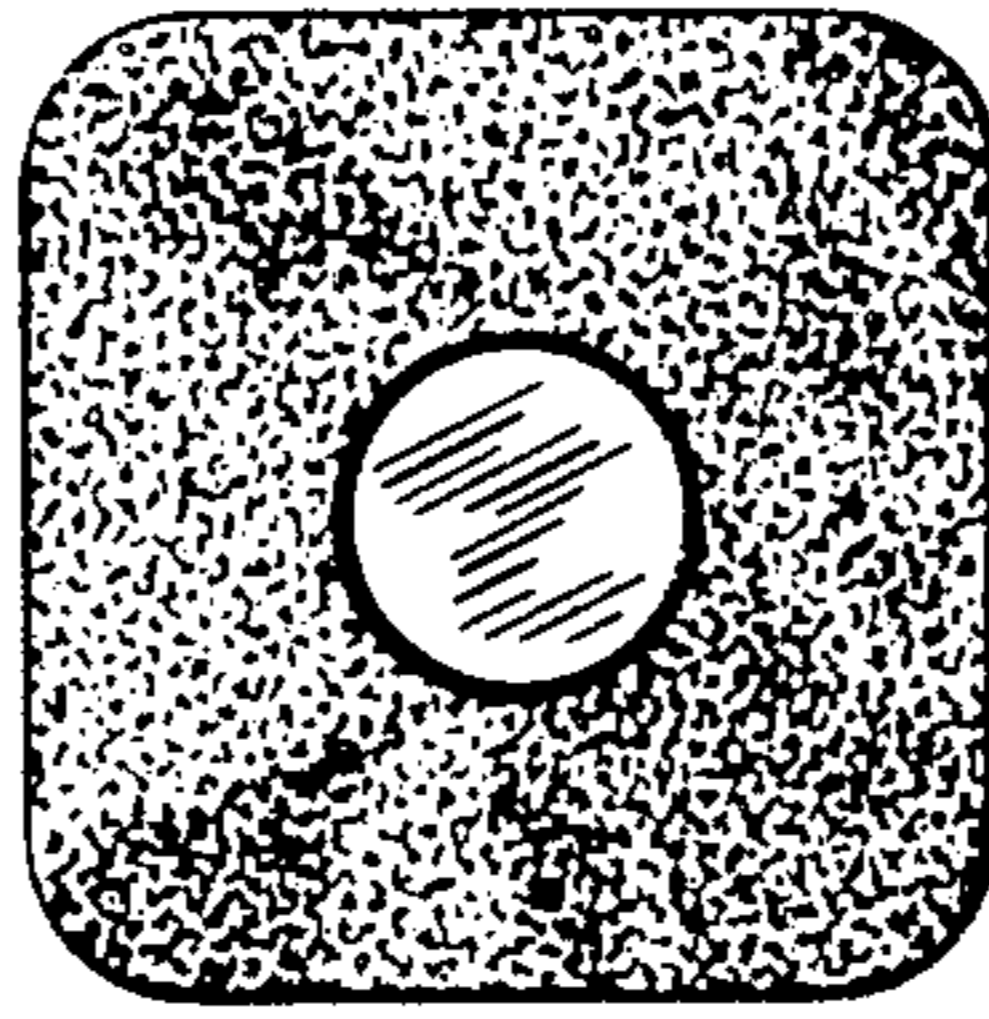




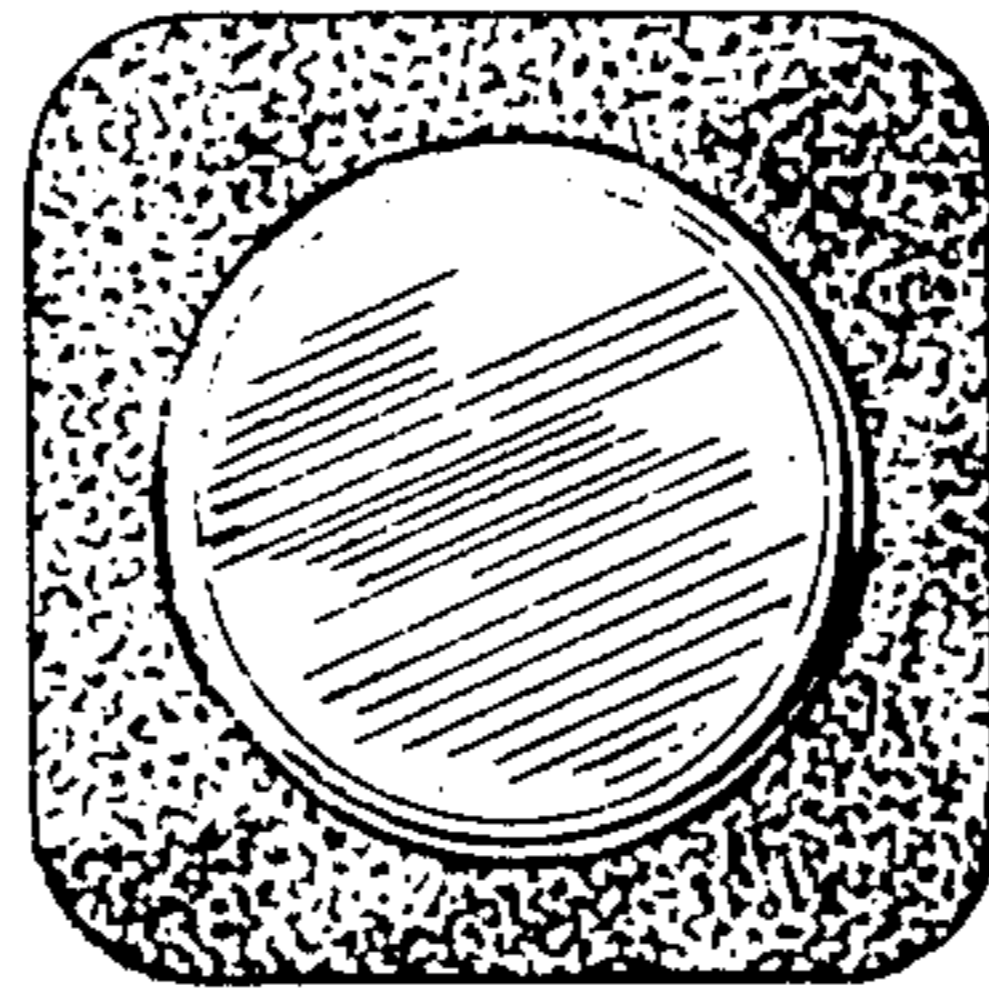
