[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a set of blocks for a children's clock, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a plan view of a set of blocks for a children's clock showing my new design.
FIG. 2 is a plan view of a second side thereof;
FIG. 3 is a plan view of a third side thereof;
FIG. 4 is a plan view of a fourth side thereof;
FIG. 5 is a perspective view of three sides of a typical block;
FIG. 6 is a perspective view of the opposite side of FIG. 5; and
FIG. 7 is a plan view of a fifth side of the set.
The sixth side of the set of blocks is blank.

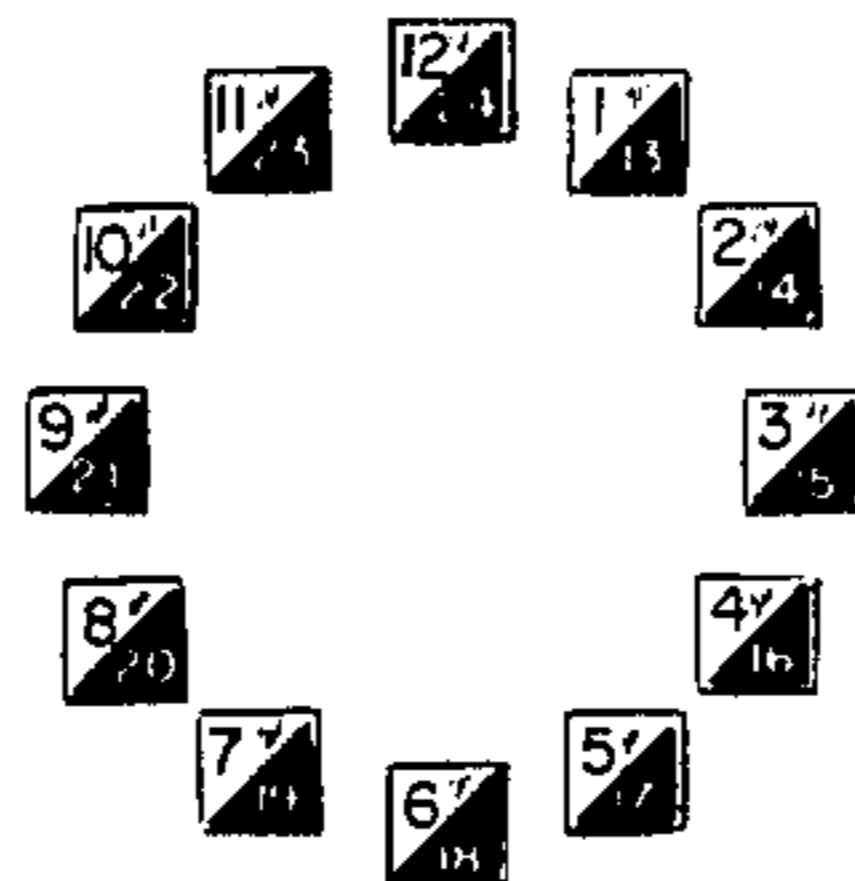

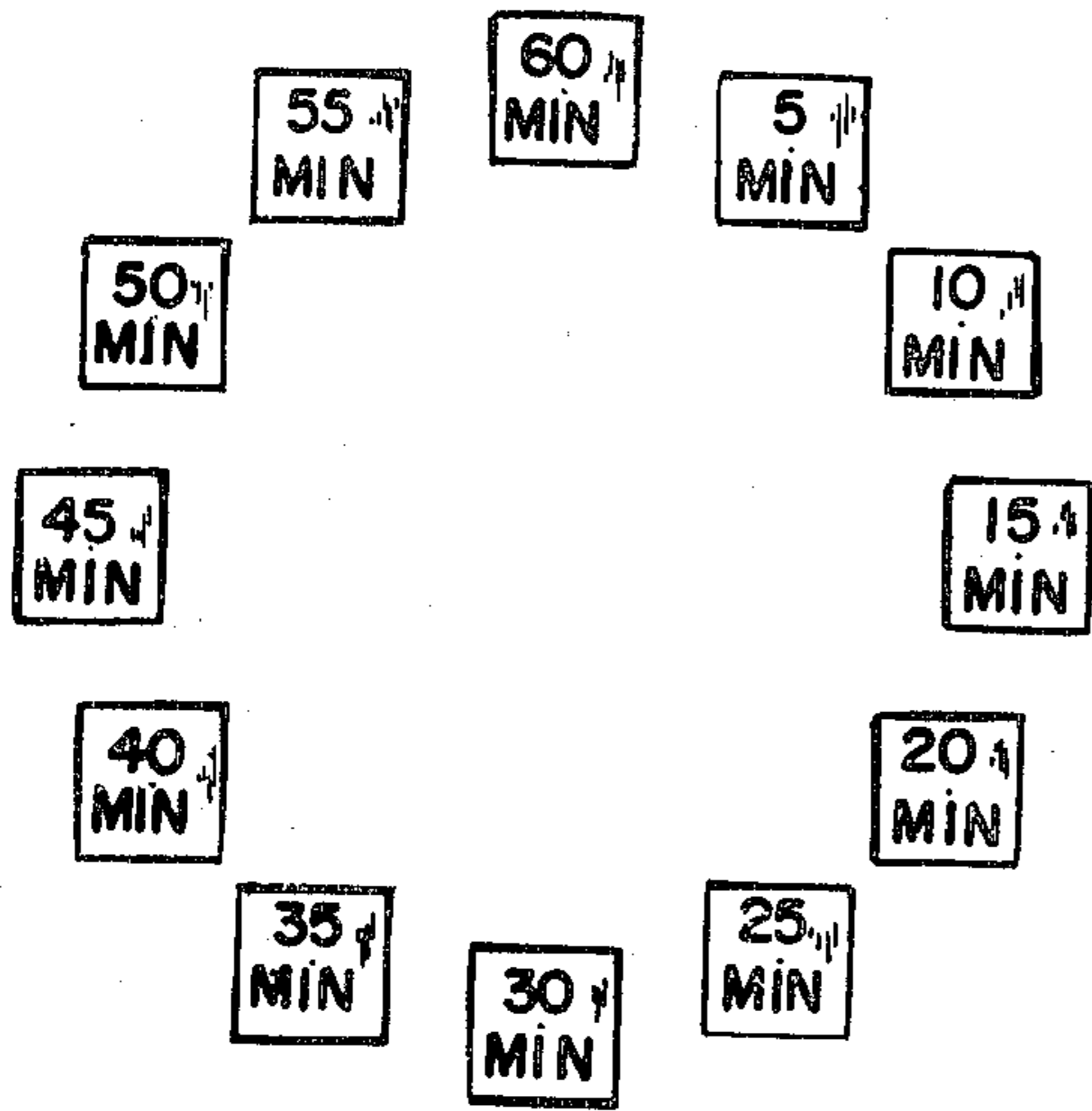

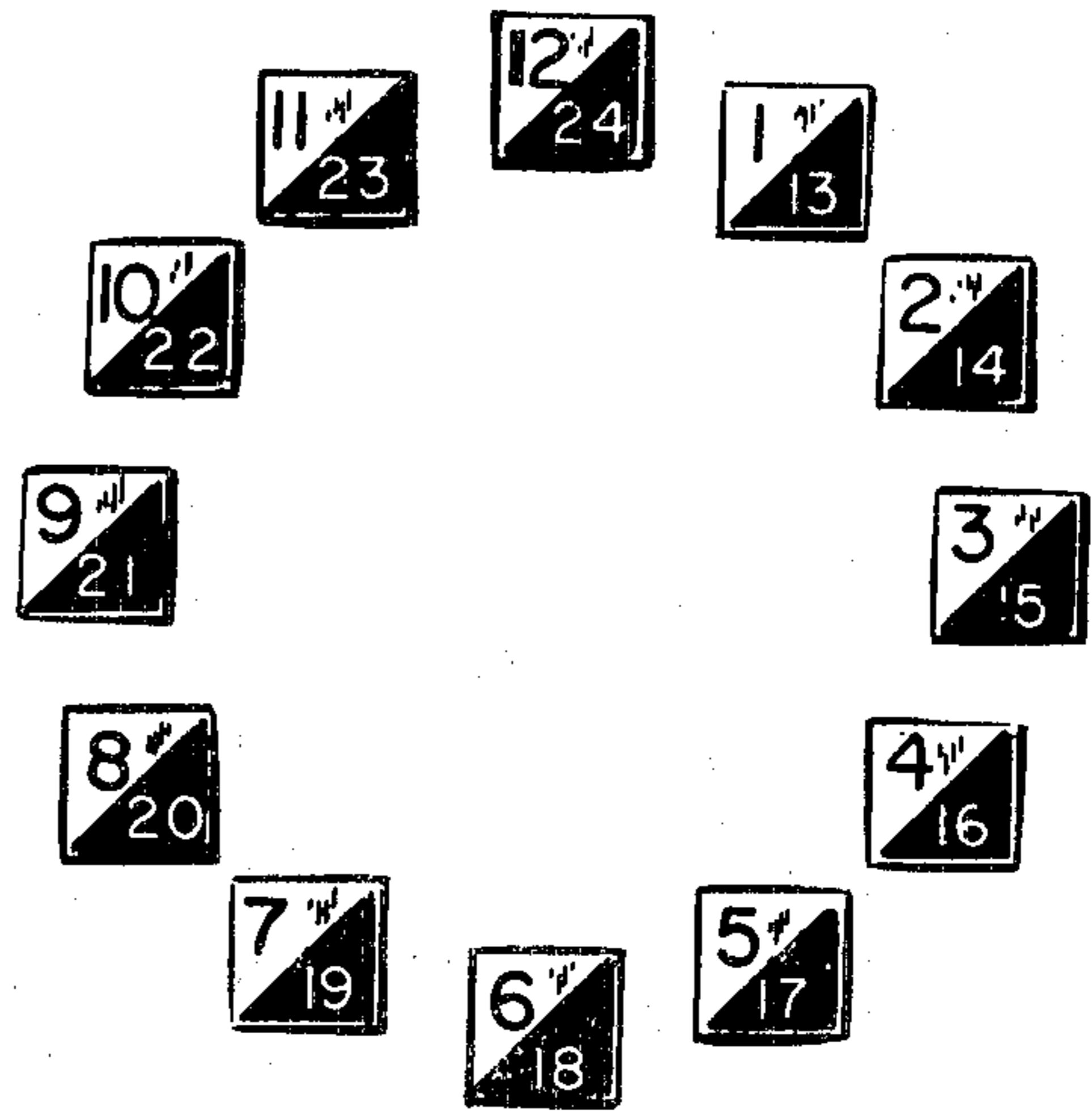

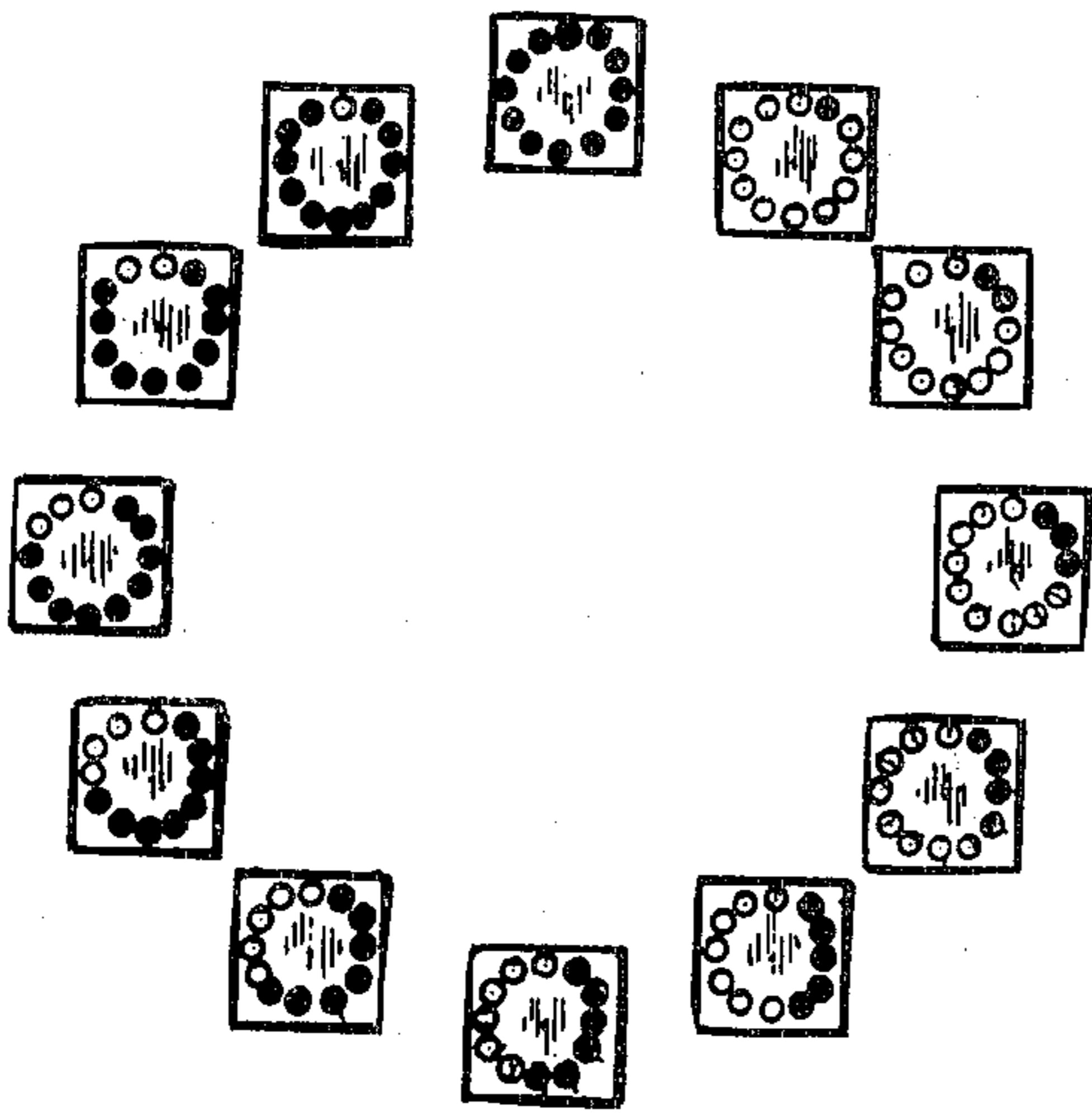

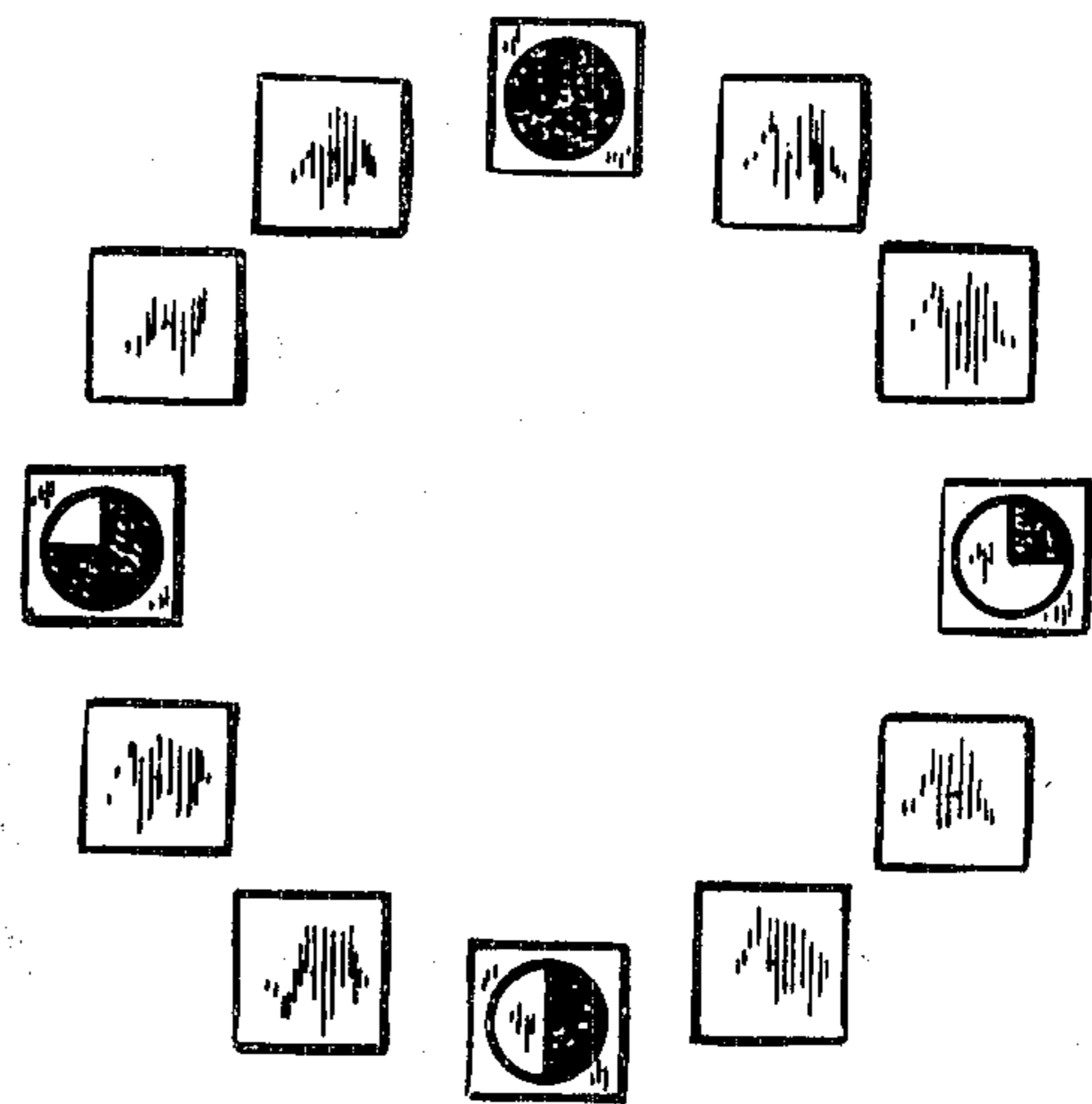

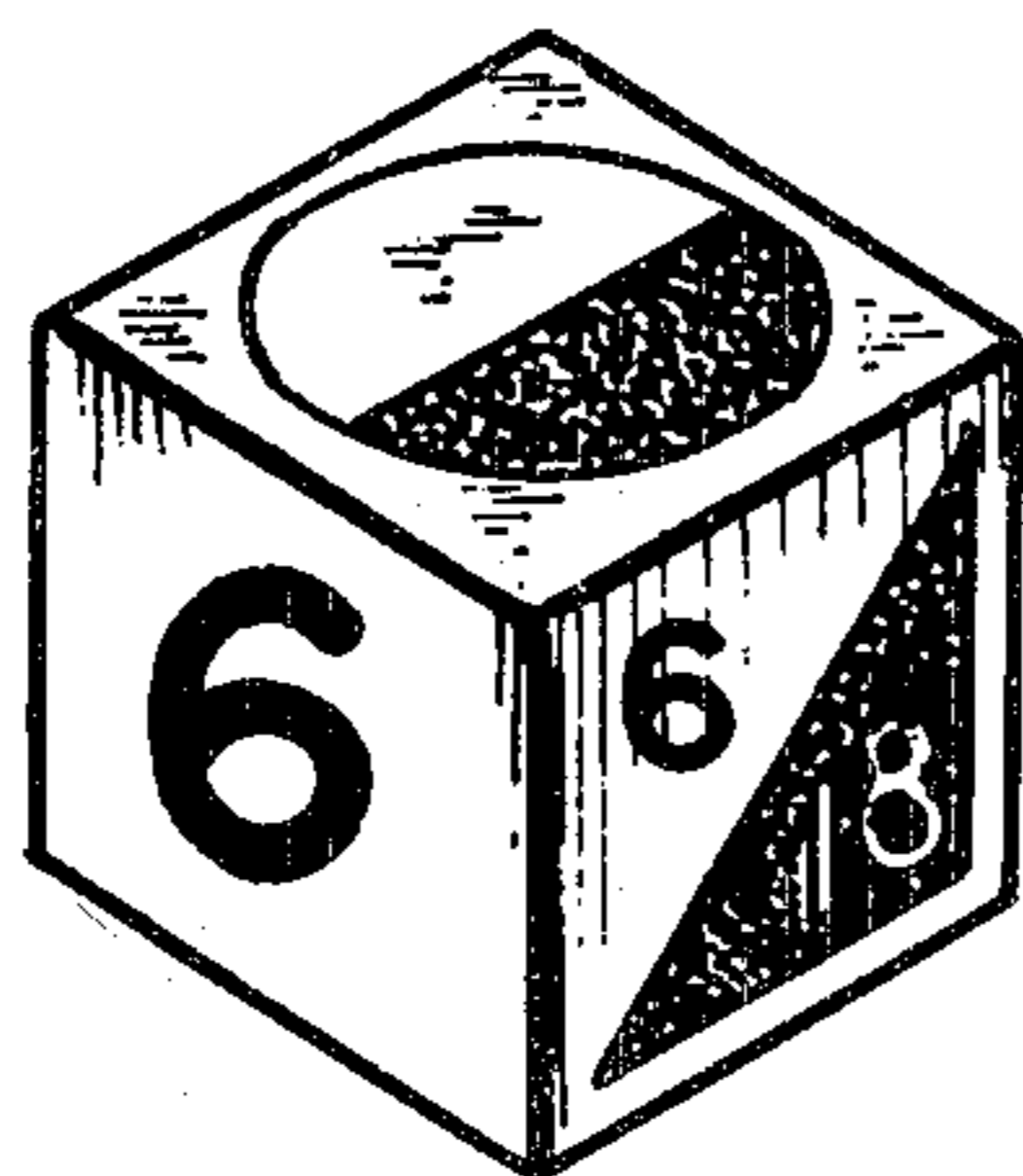
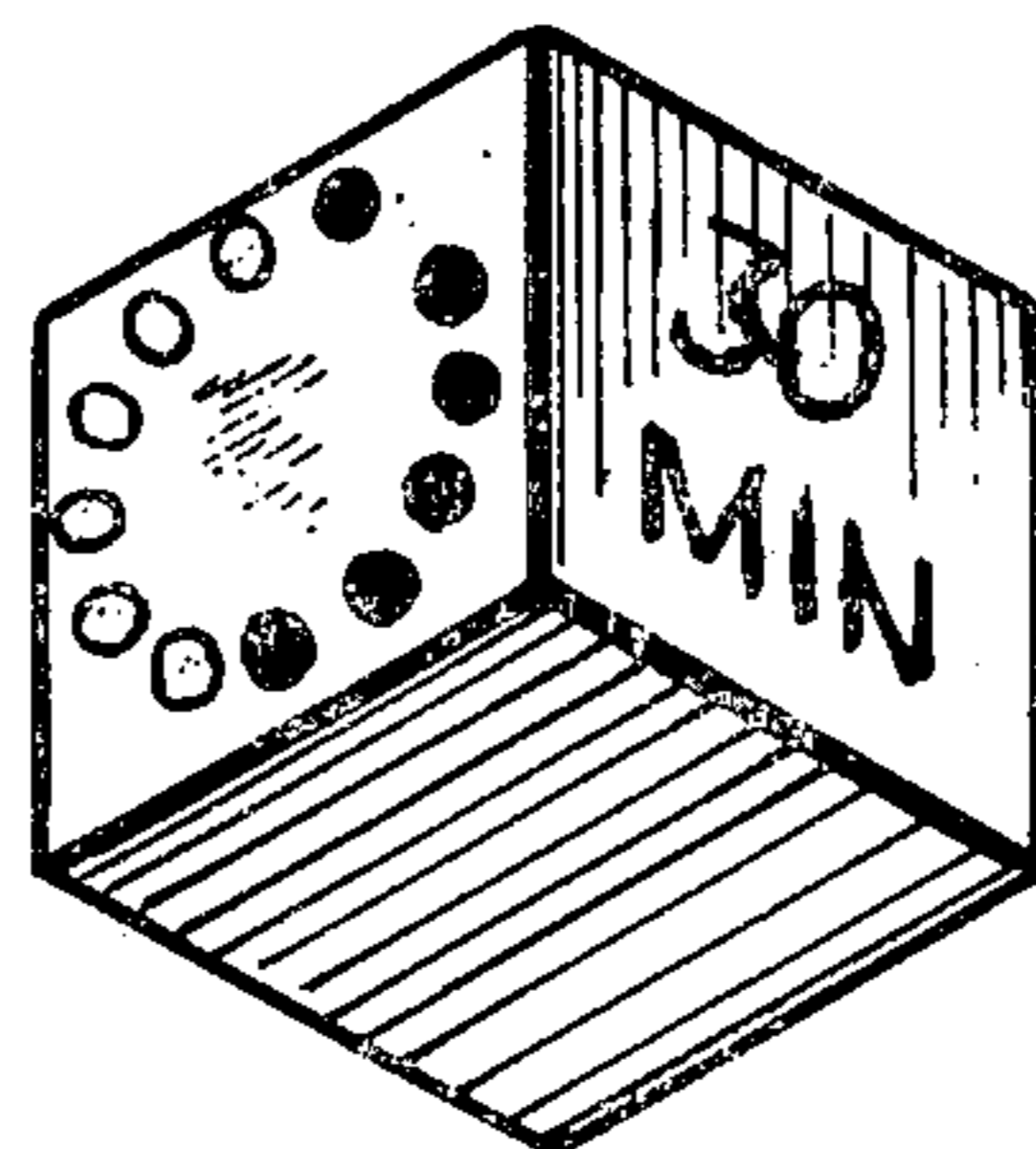

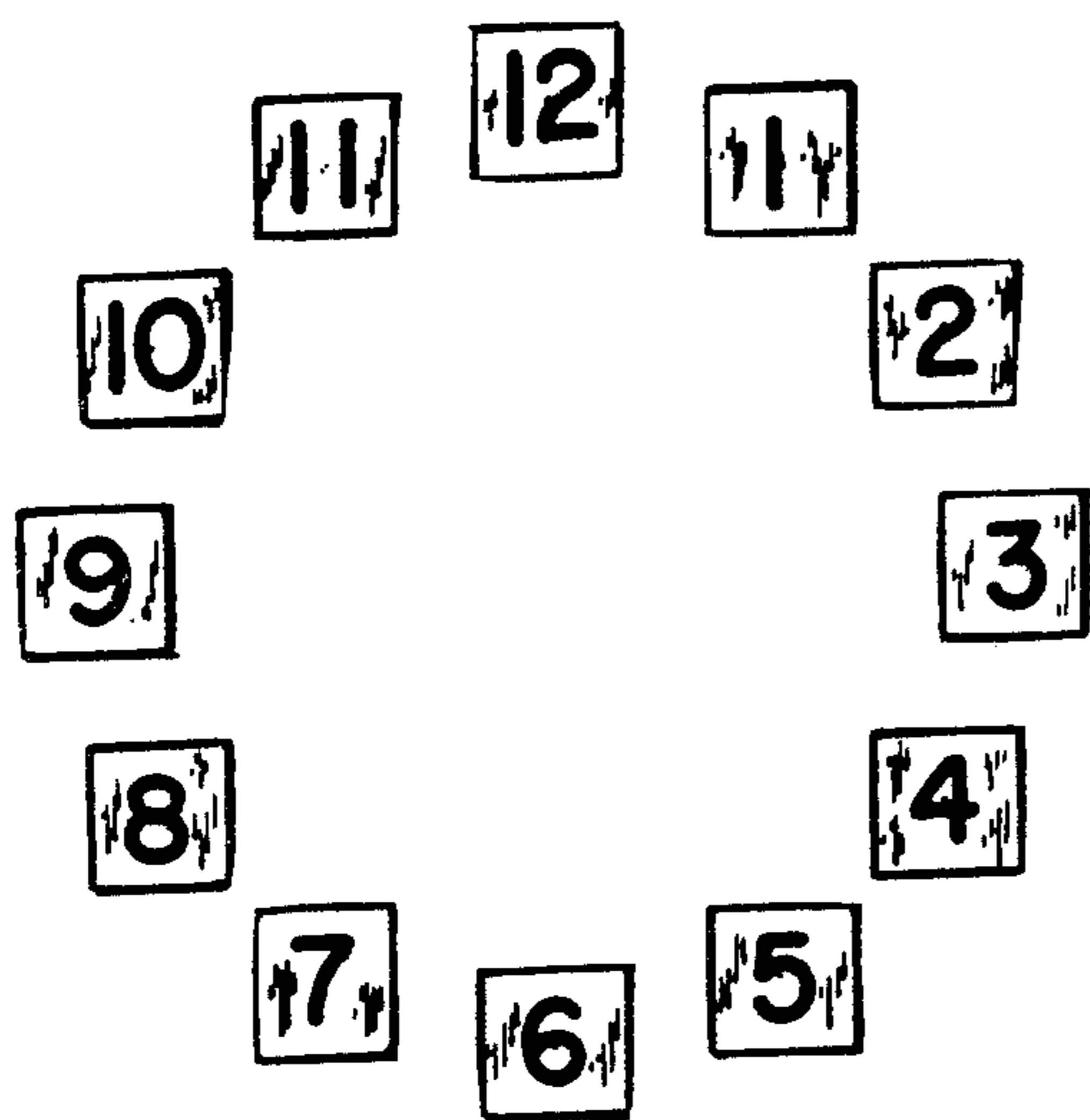
