DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a portable reading lamp showing my new design;

FIG. 6 is a perspective view thereof on a reduced scale, a book being shown in broken lines for illustrative purposes only.

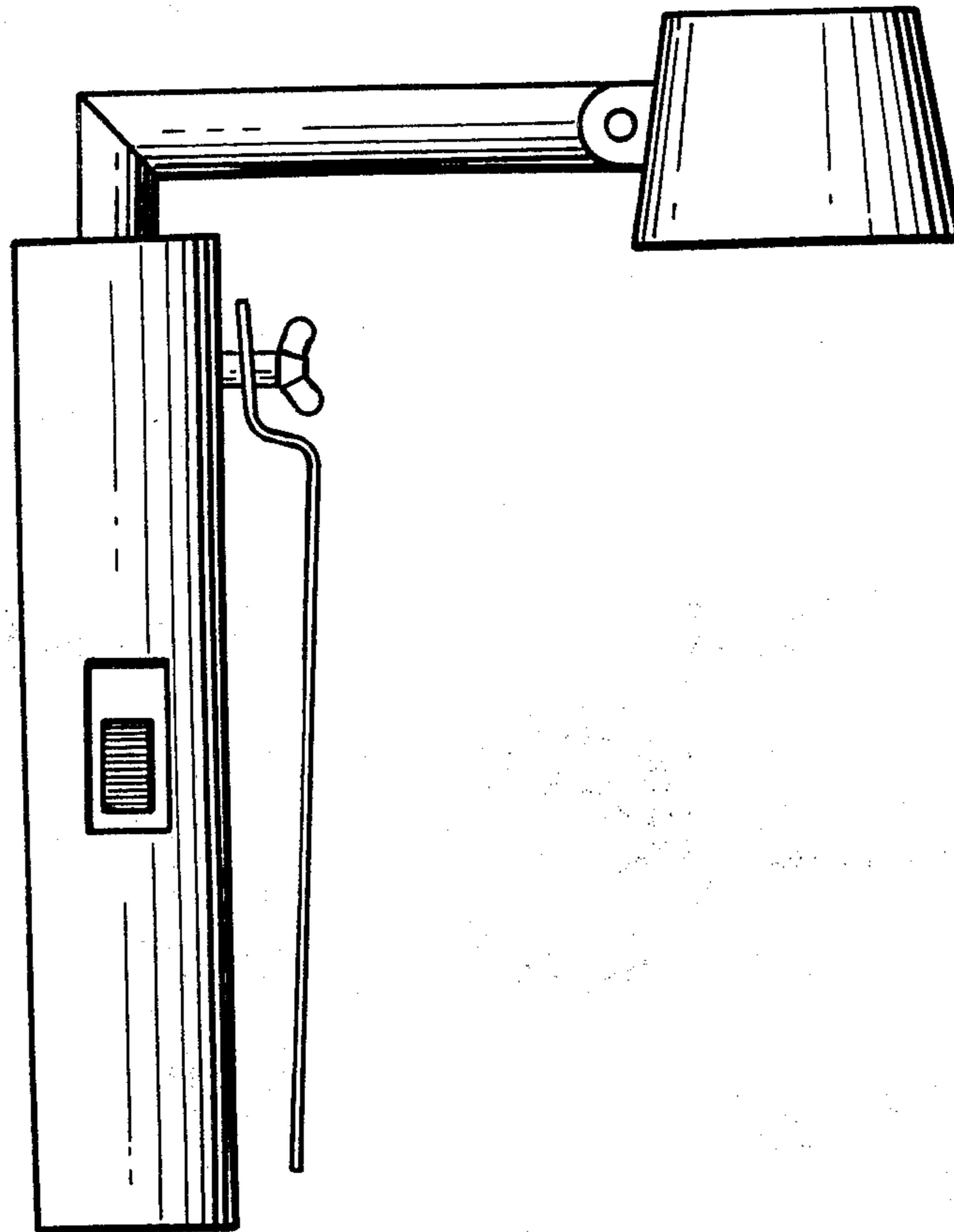

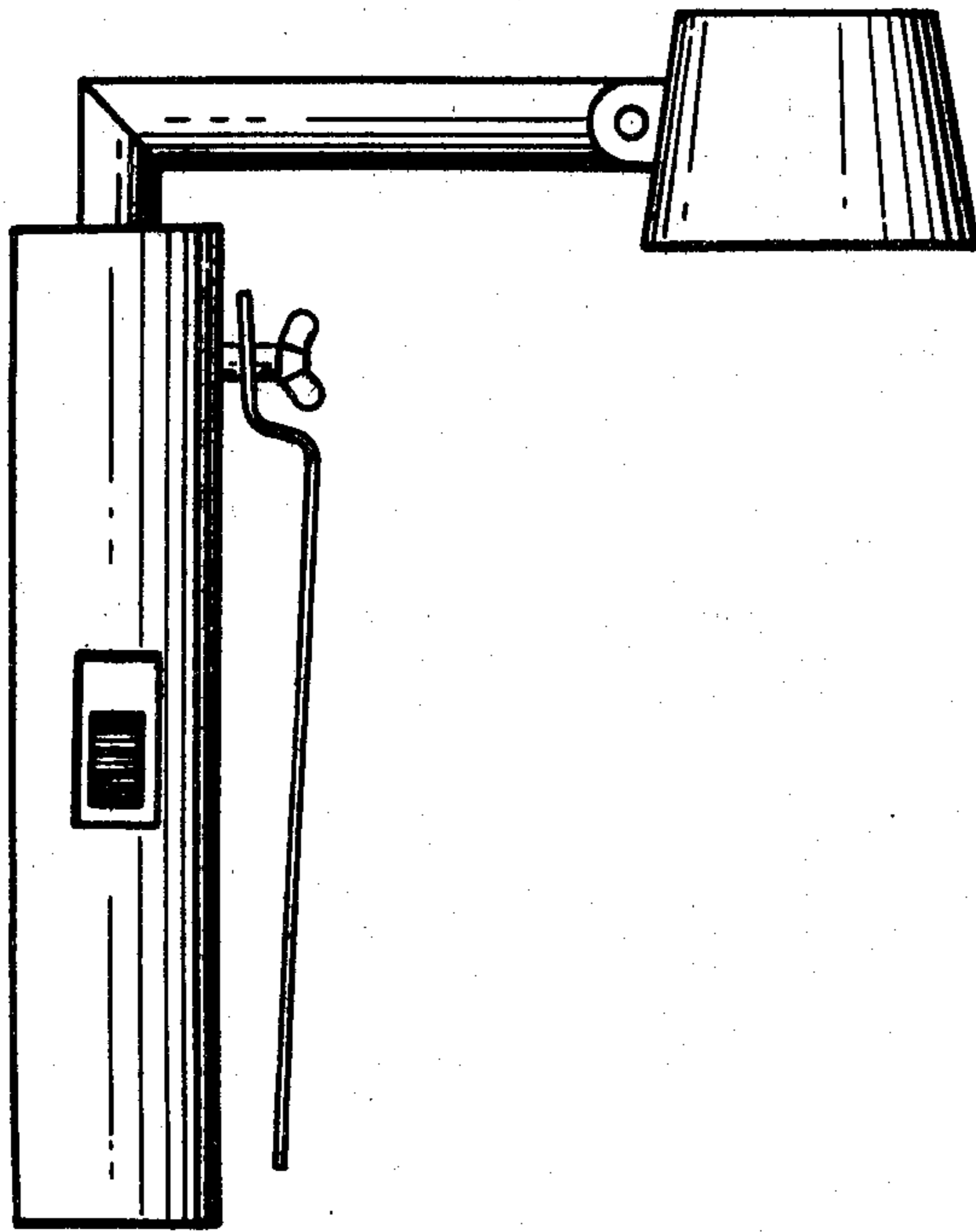

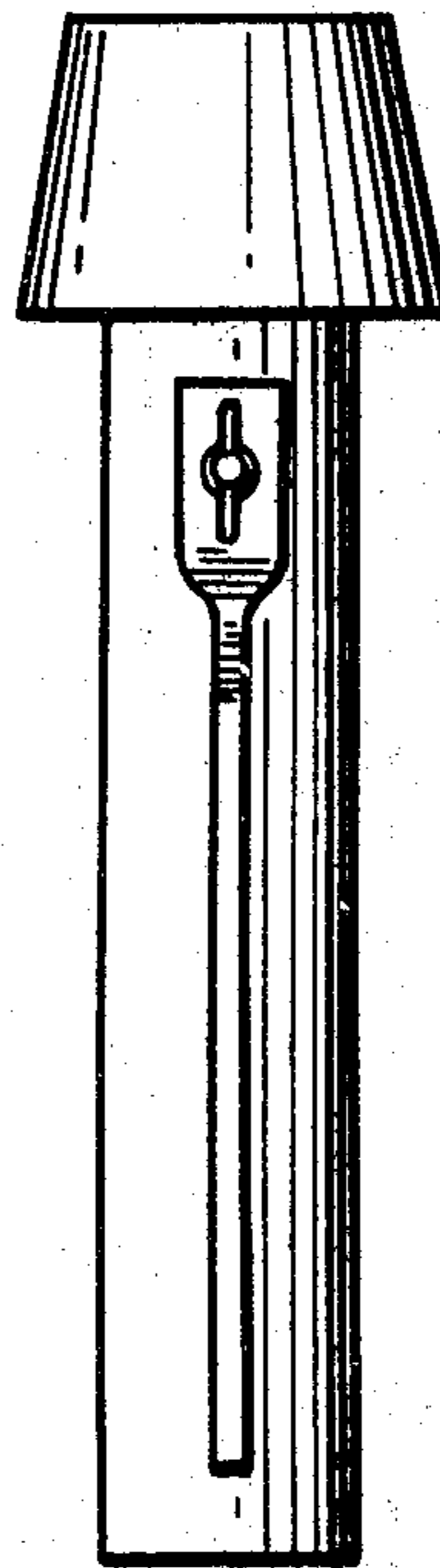

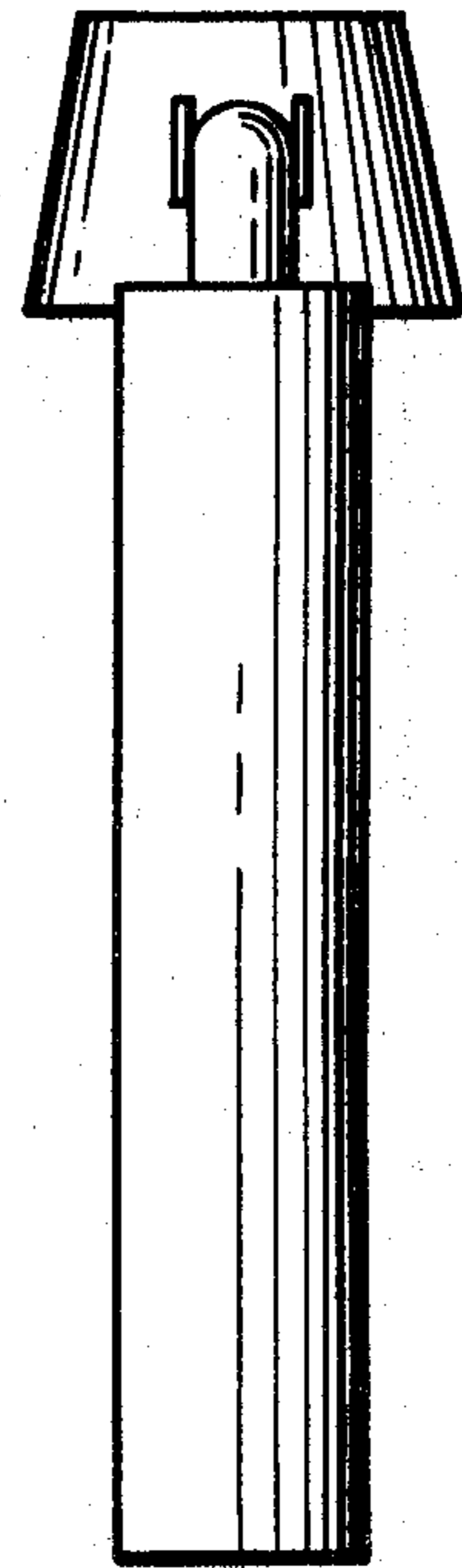

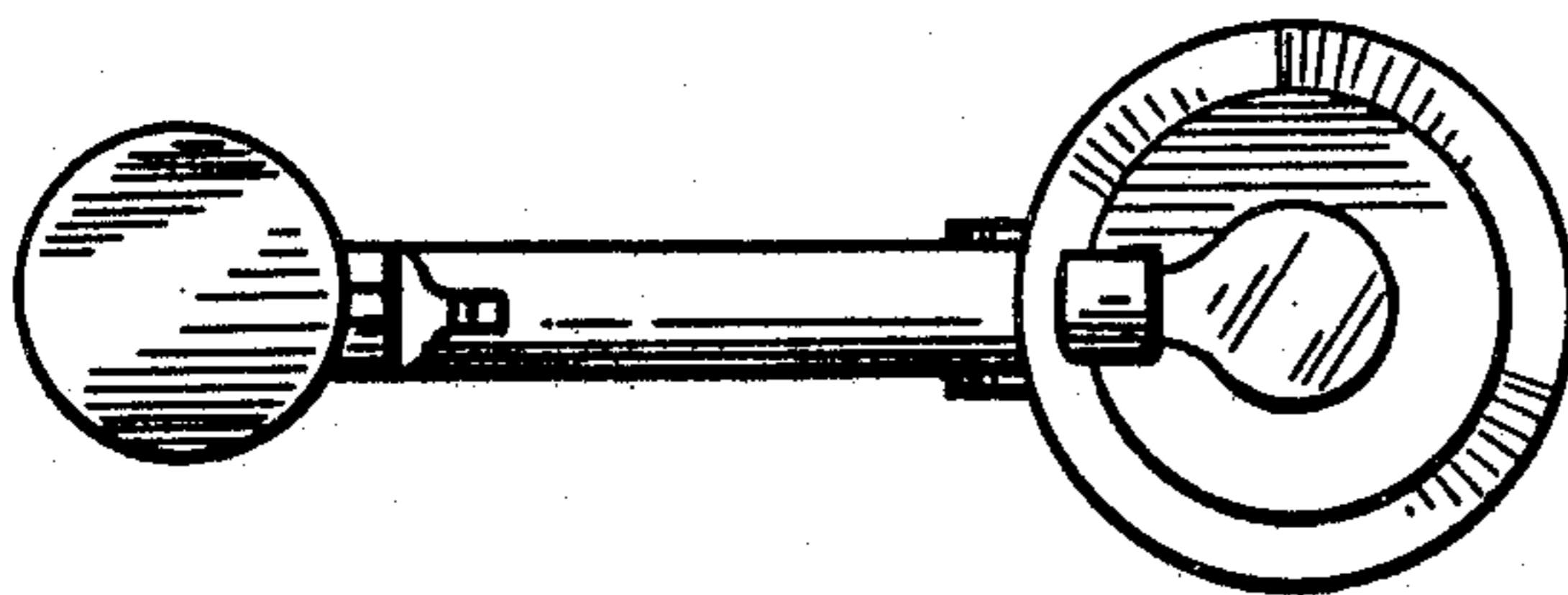

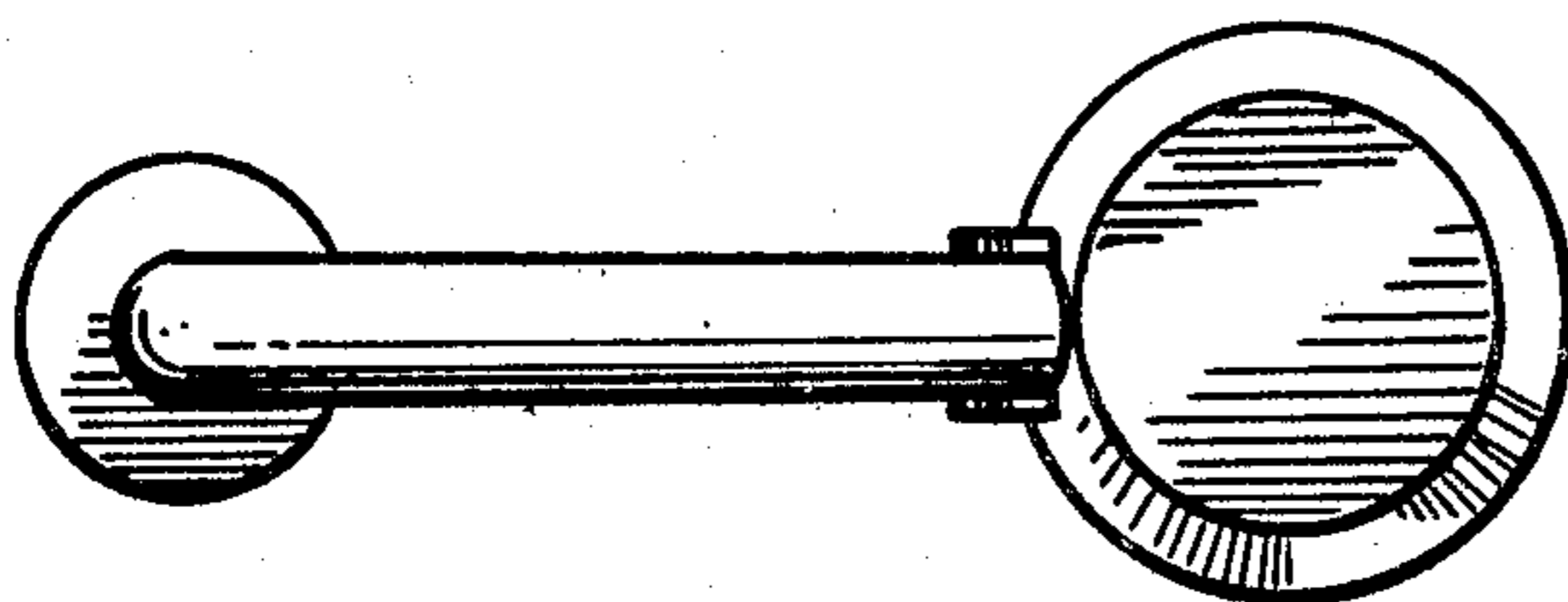
