[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a suspended support for plants, flowers or the like, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a suspended support for plants, flowers or the like showing our new design; the rear being identical;
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof, both sides being identical;
FIG. 3 is a top view thereof, and
FIG. 4 is a bottom view thereof.

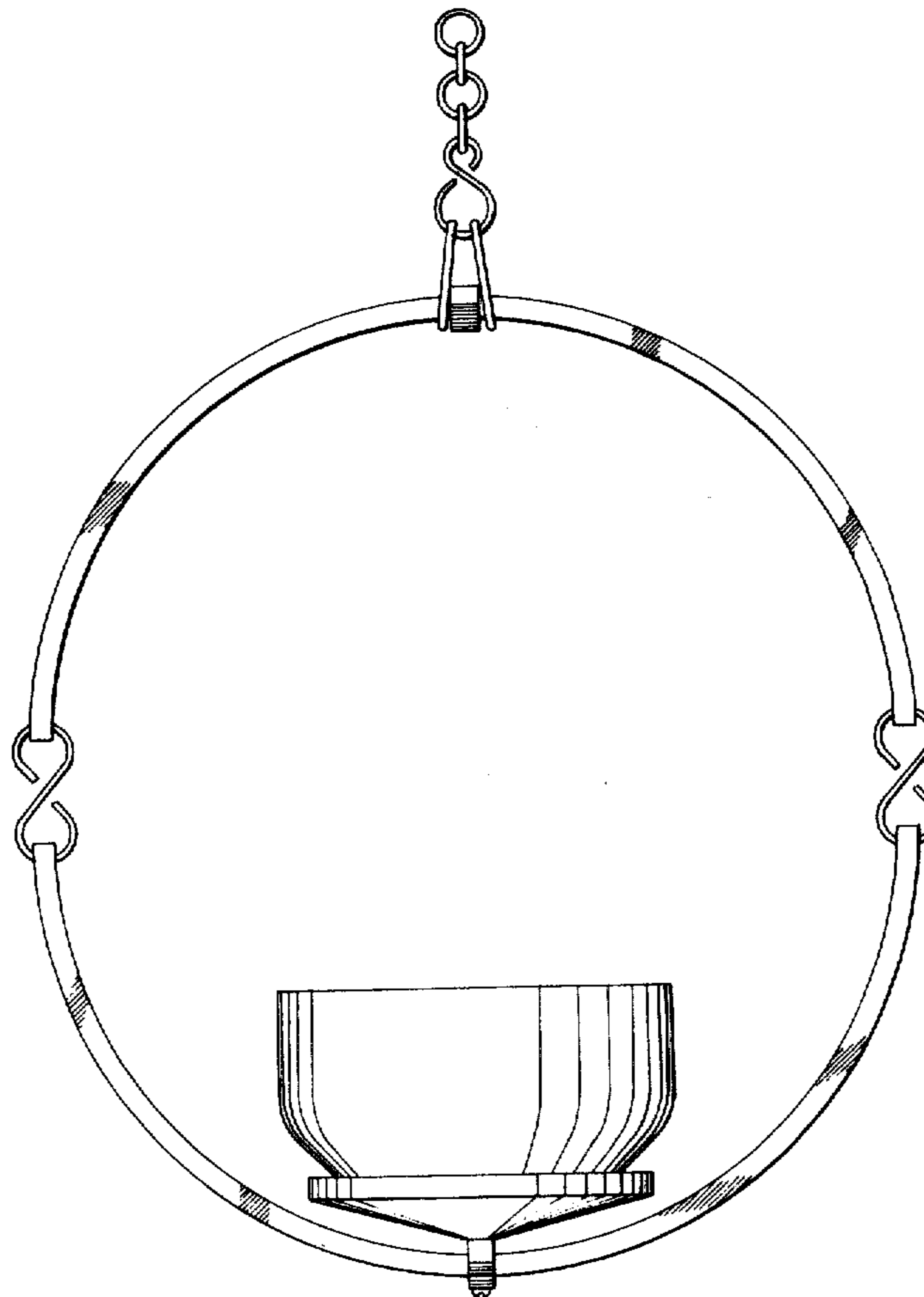
