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[57] CLAIM

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a riflescope showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a side elevational view of FIG. 1 along the line 2—2;

FIG. 3 is a side elevational view of FIG. 1 along the line 3—3;

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 5 is an elevational view looking from the left of FIG. 1; and

FIG. 6 is an elevational view looking from the right of FIG. 1.

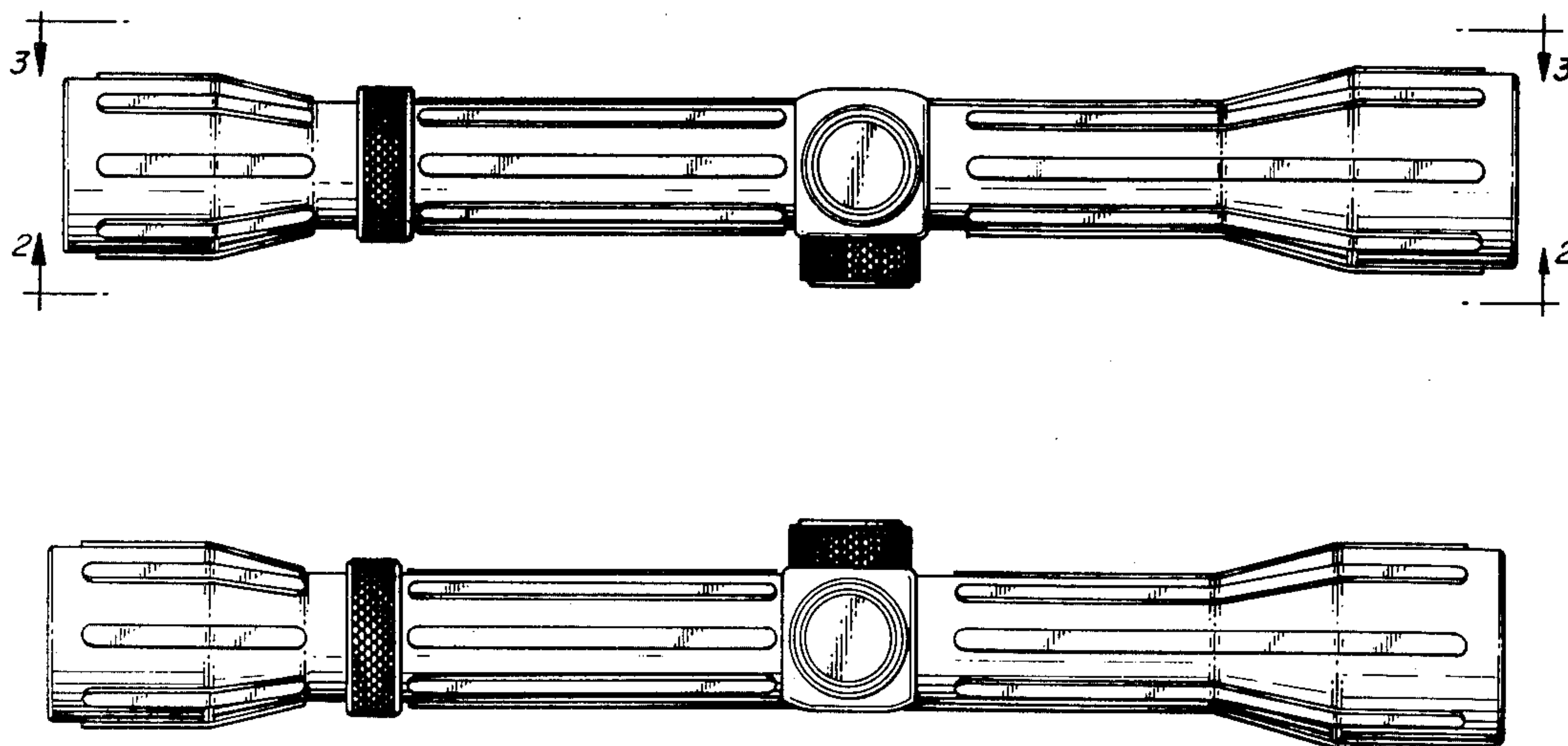

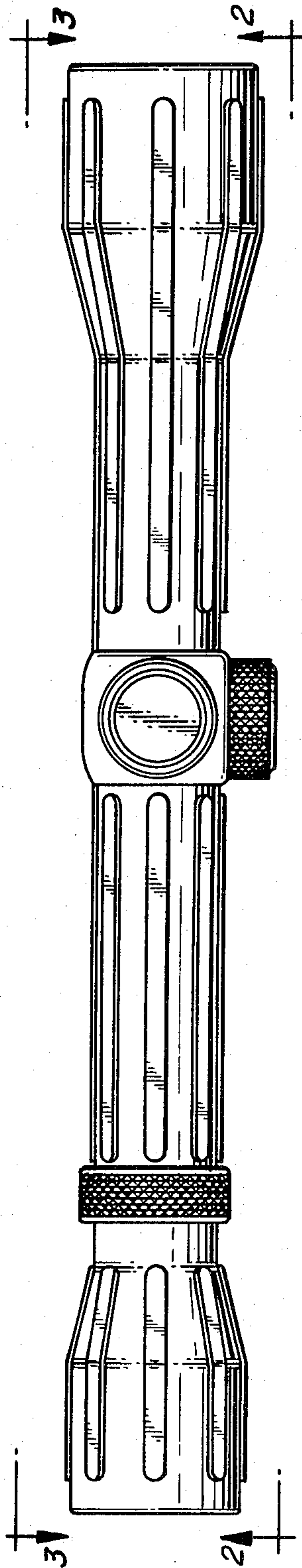

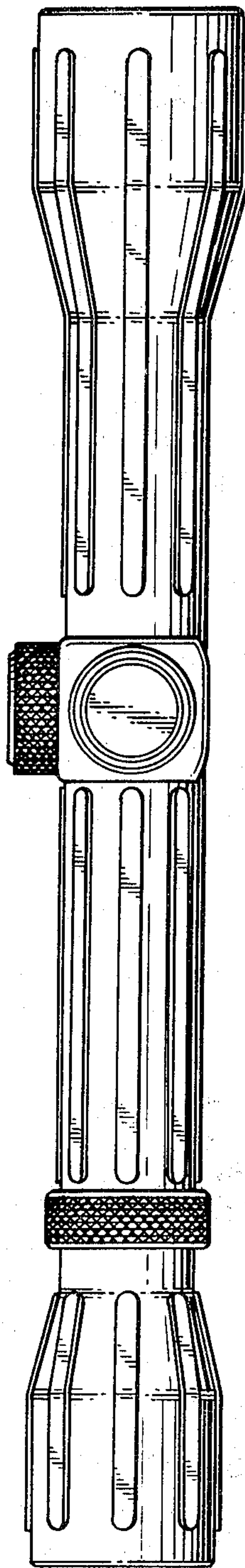

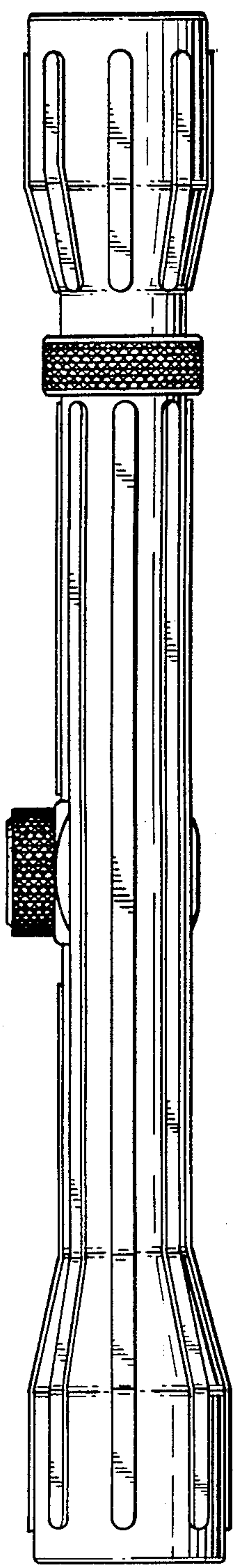

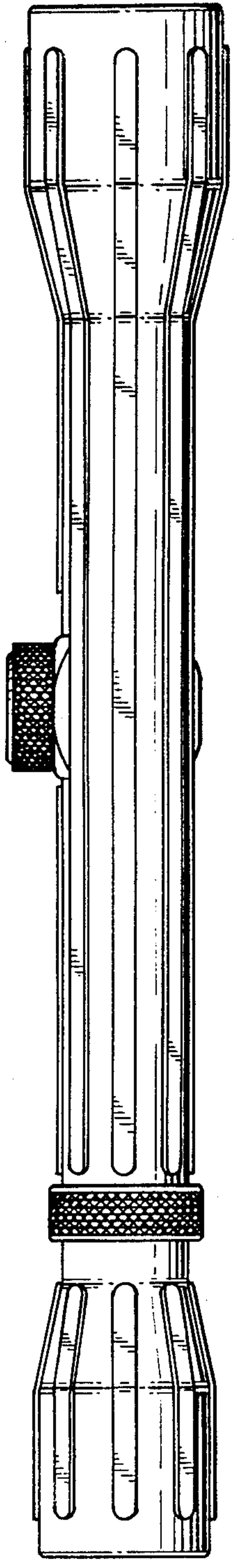

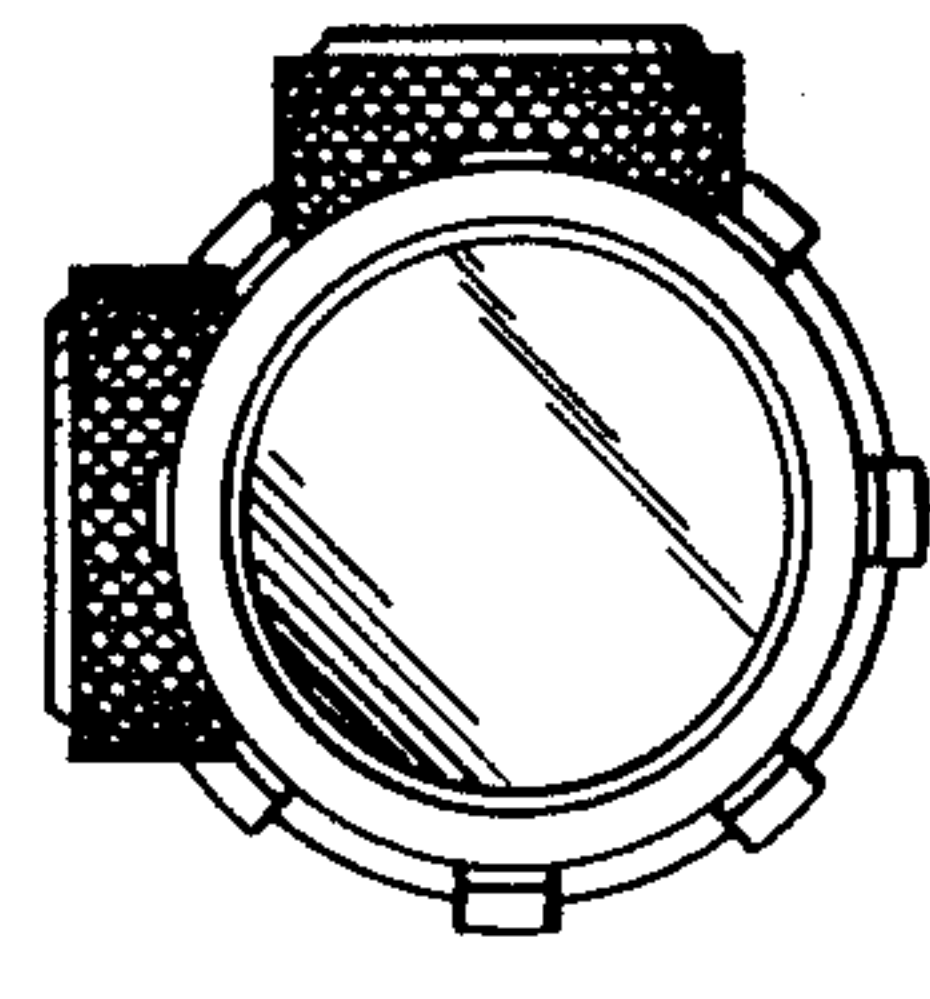
