FIG. 6 is a thumb support end view.

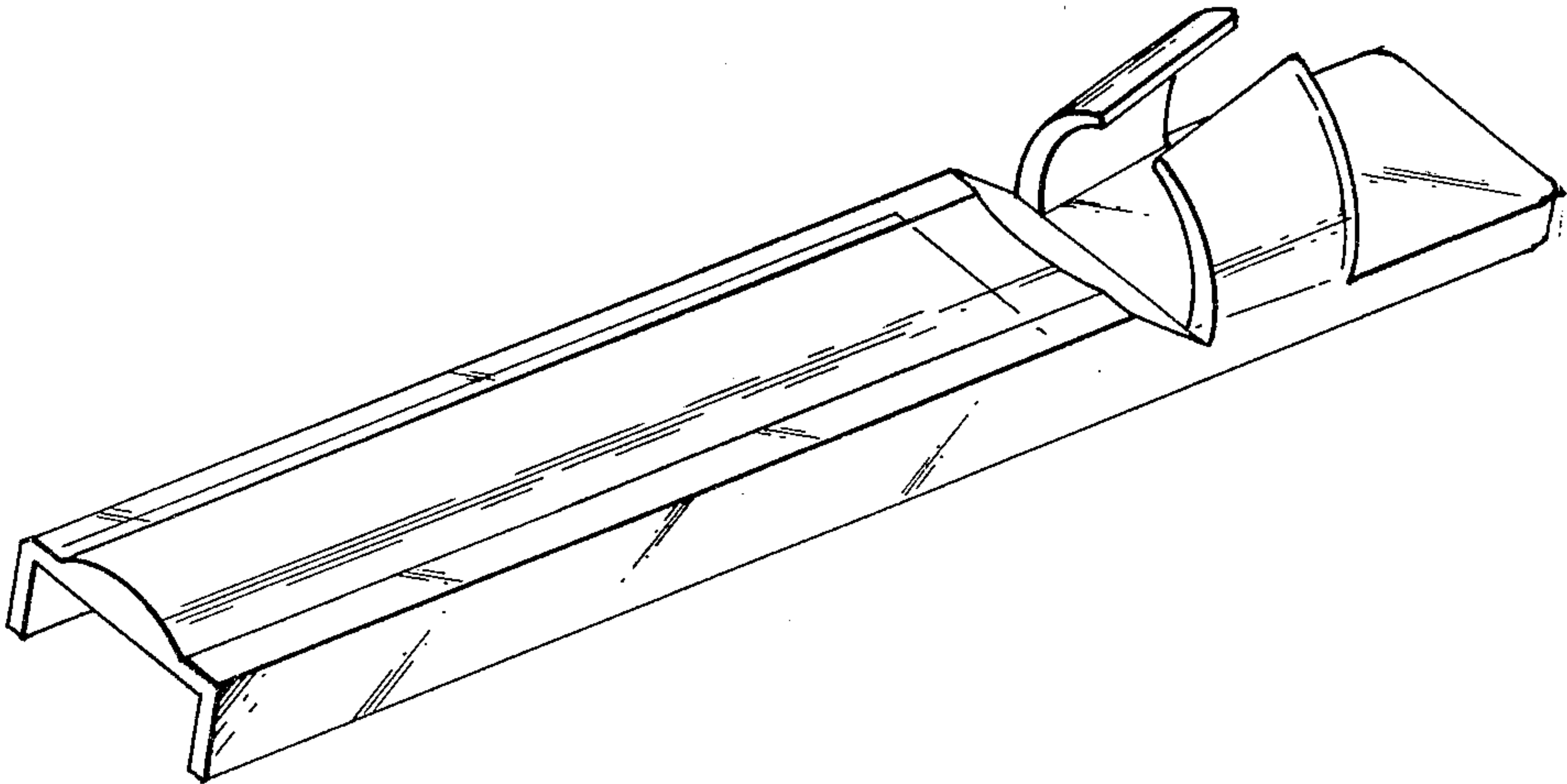

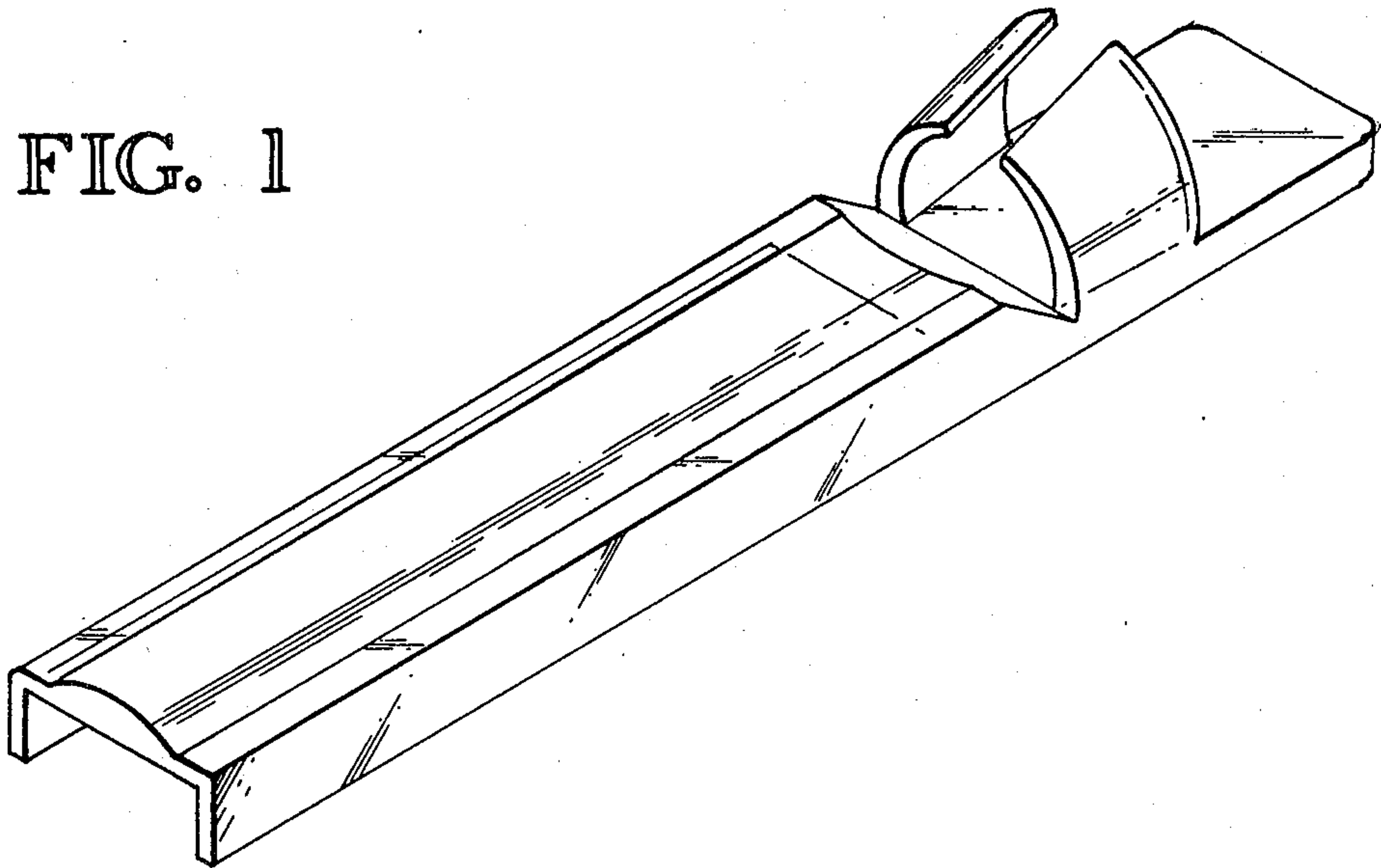

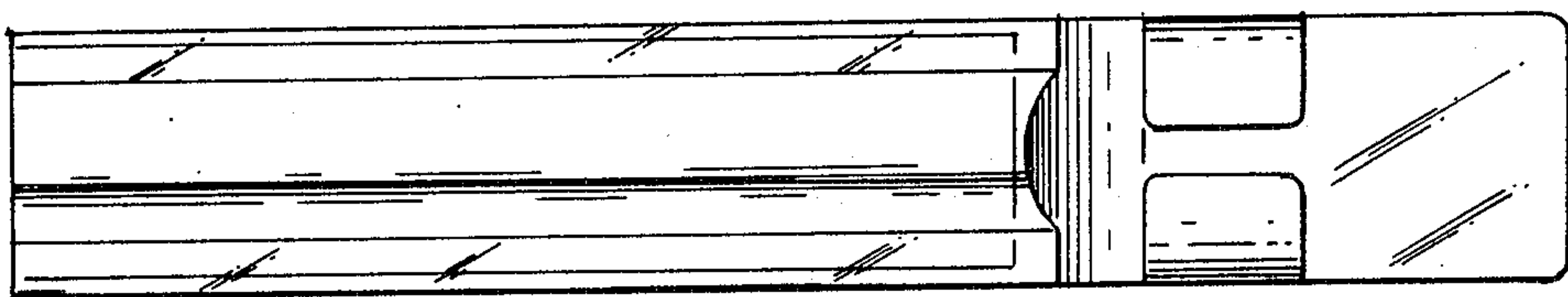

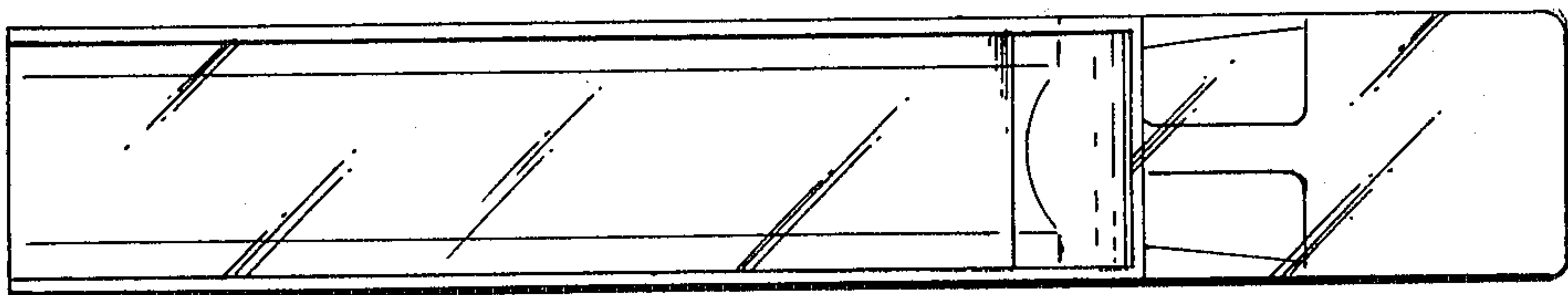

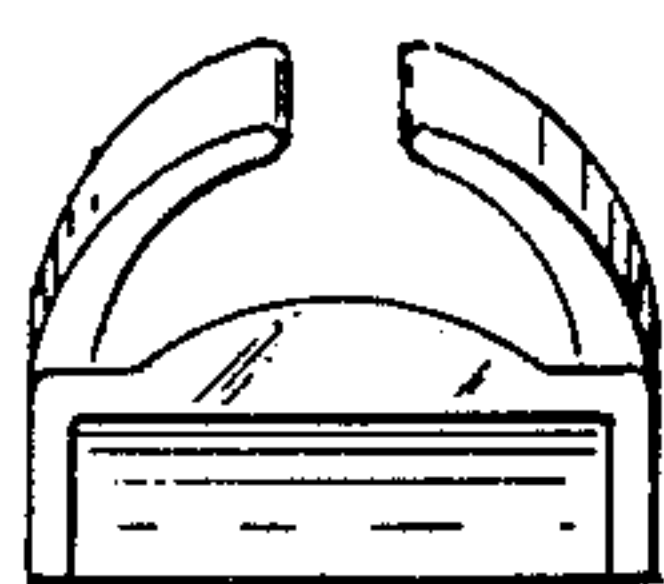
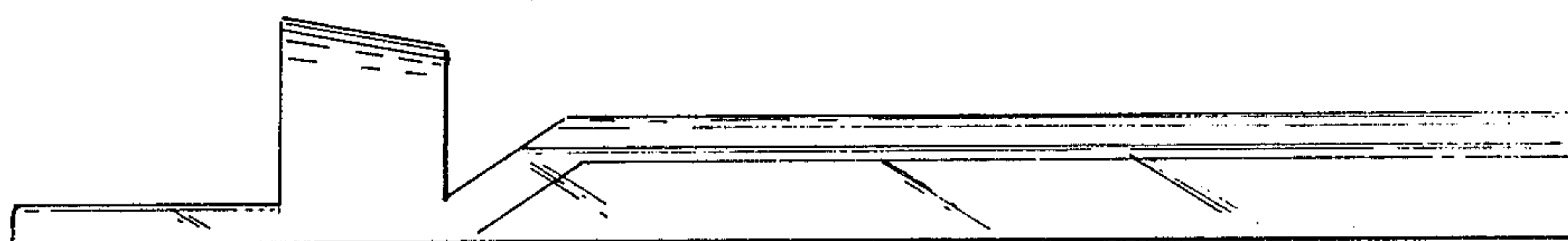

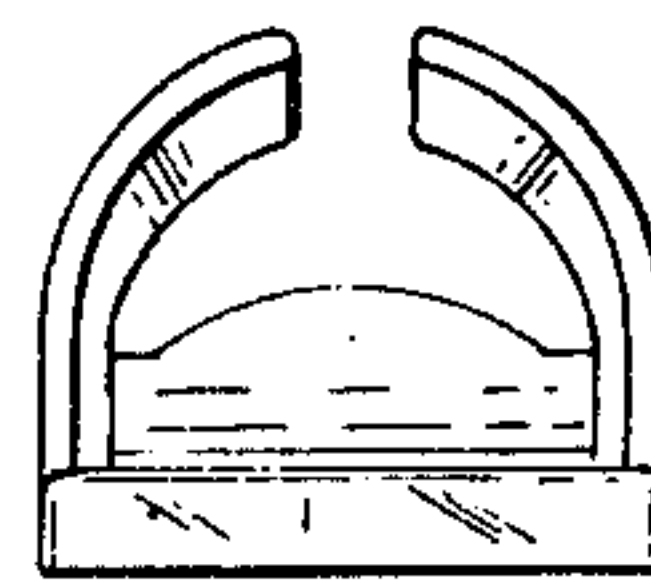
