The stippling shown along the top and bottom edges of FIG. 1 represents an adhesive used to affix the label to a window of a used automobile.

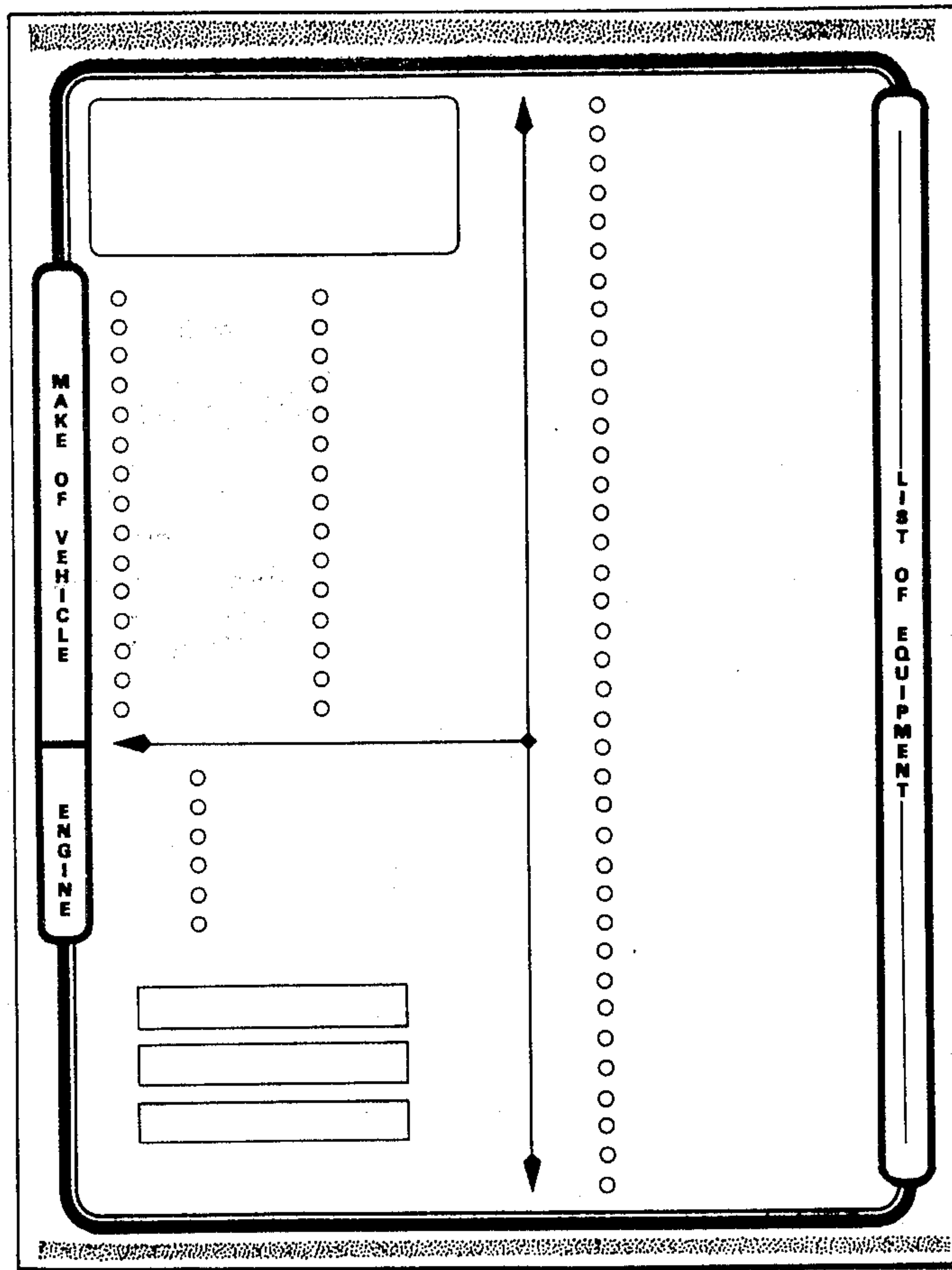

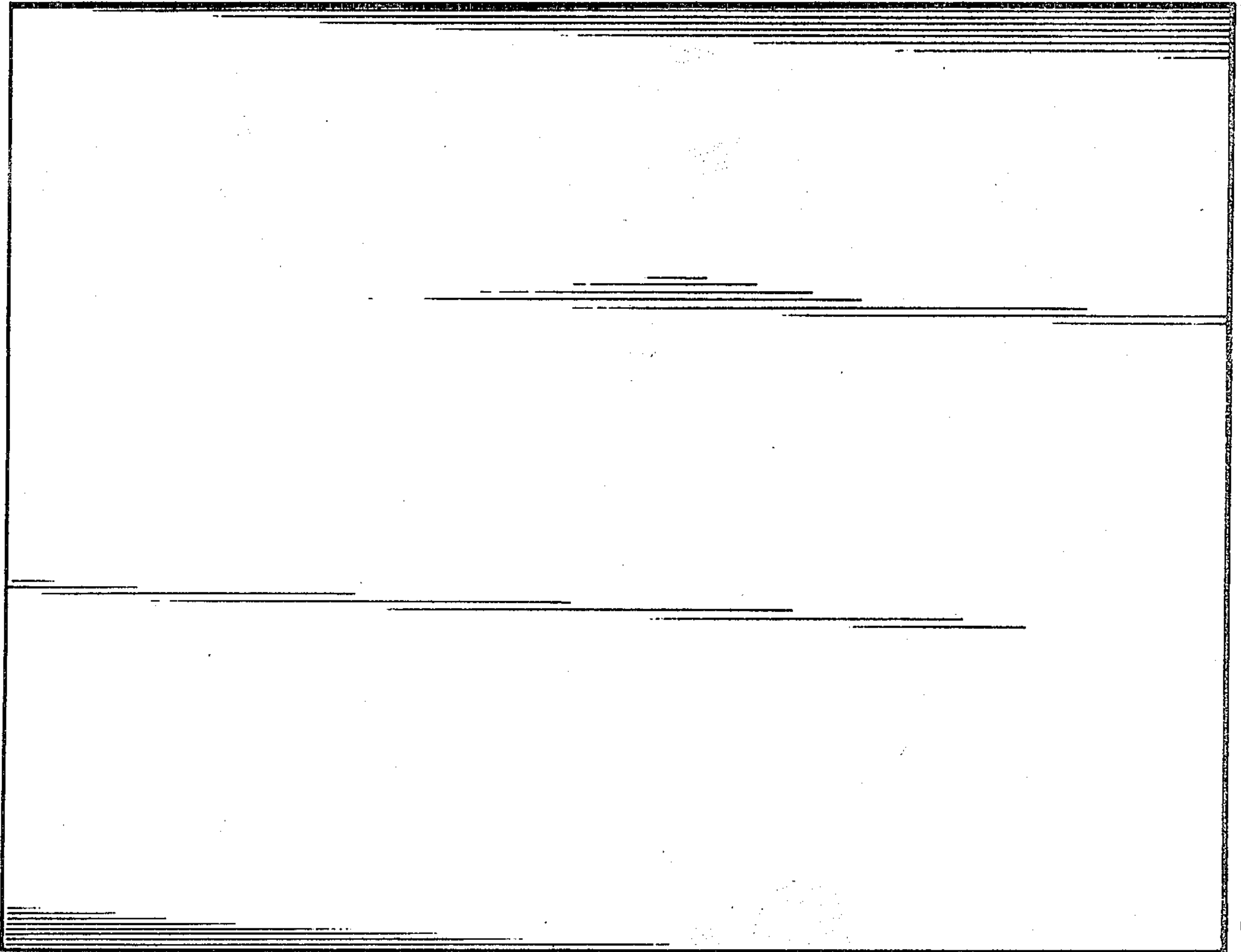

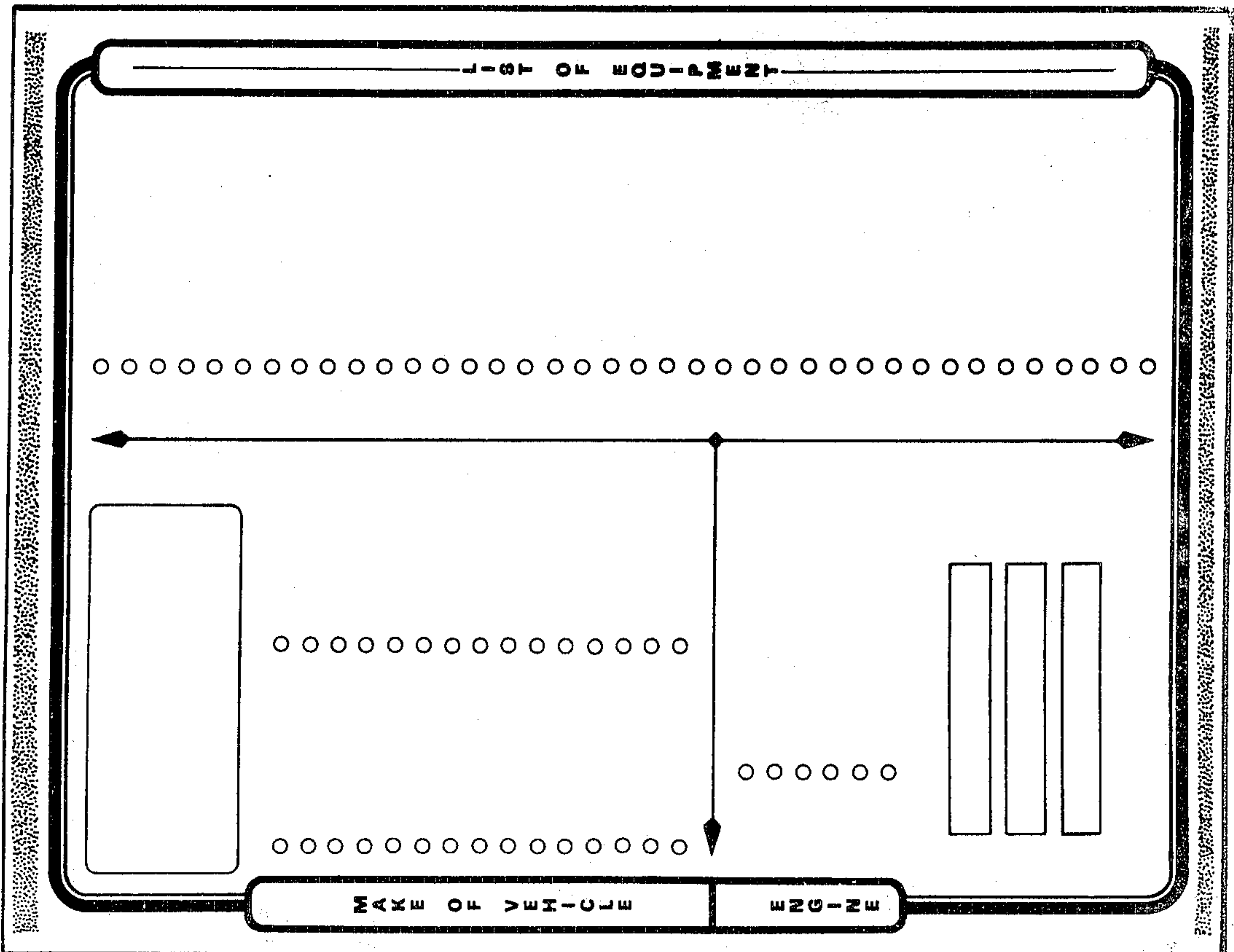
