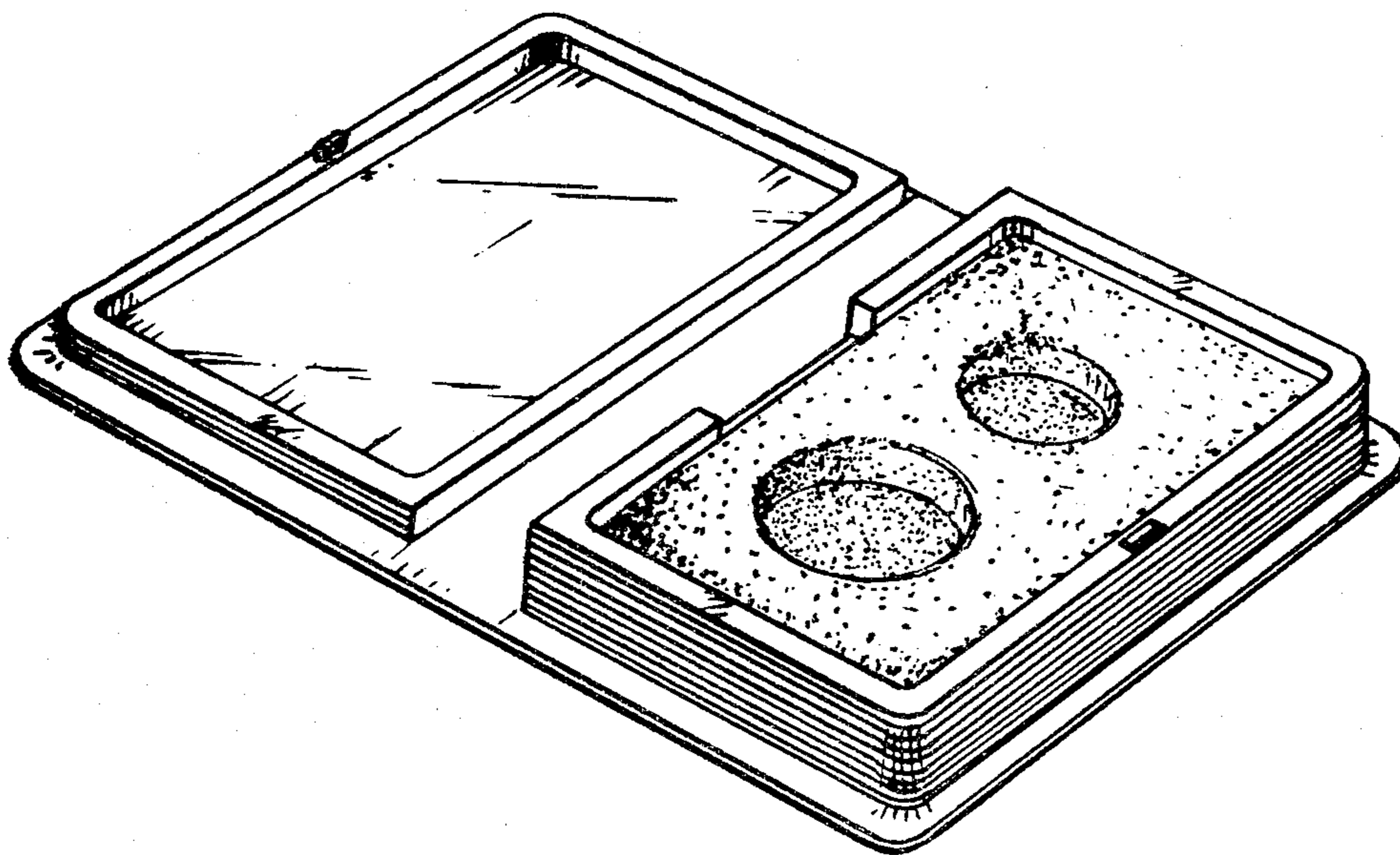

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a jewelry container, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a jewelry container showing my new design in the open condition;
 FIG. 2 is a plan view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a cross-sectional view taken along line 3—3 of FIG. 2;
 FIG. 4 is a perspective view of a modified form of the jewelry container in the open condition;
 FIG. 5 is a plan view thereof;
 FIG. 6 is a cross-sectional view taken along line 6—6 of FIG. 5;
 FIG. 7 is a front perspective view of the exterior of the jewelry container in a partially open condition; and
 FIG. 8 is an inverted rear perspective view thereof.



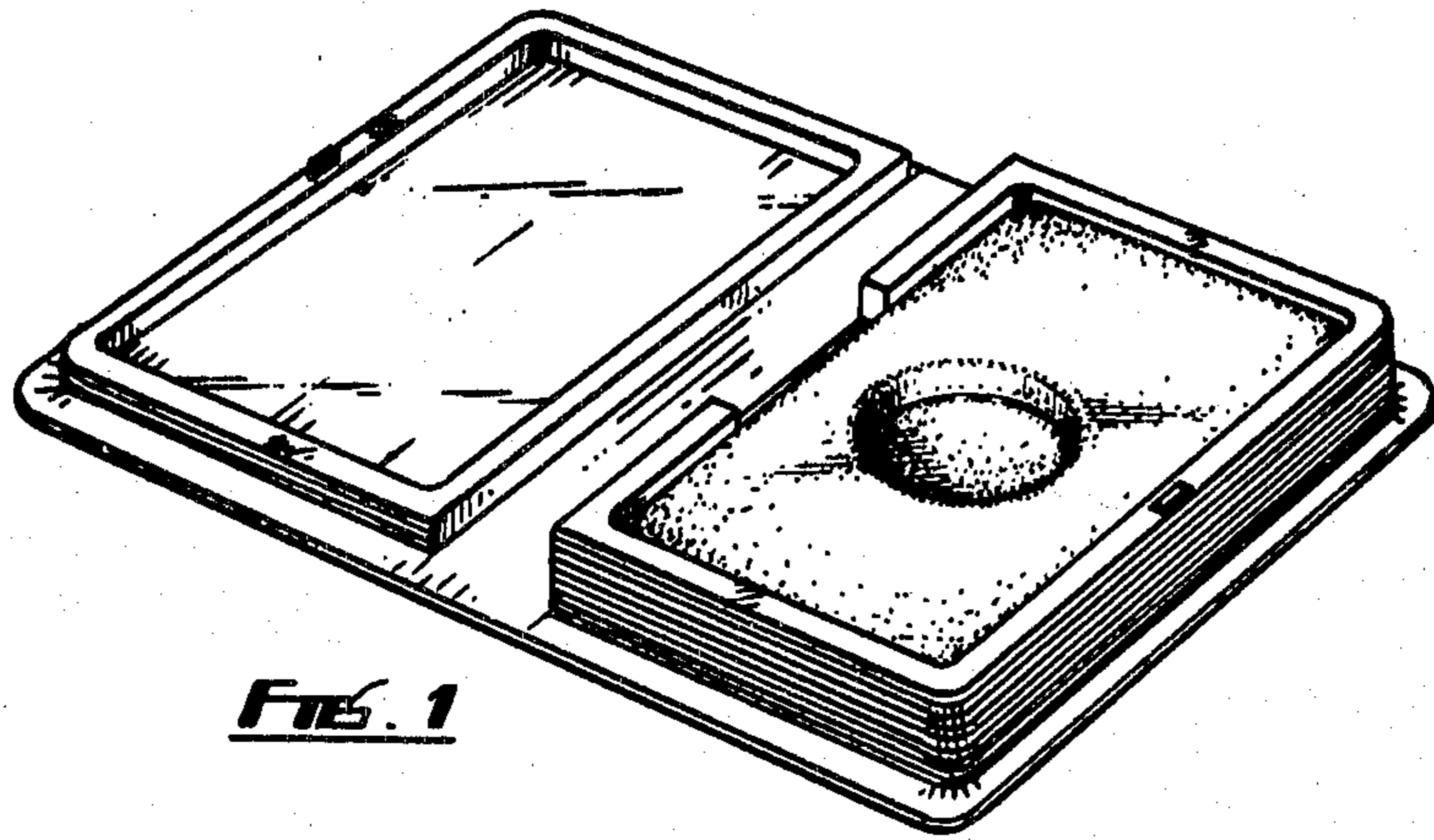

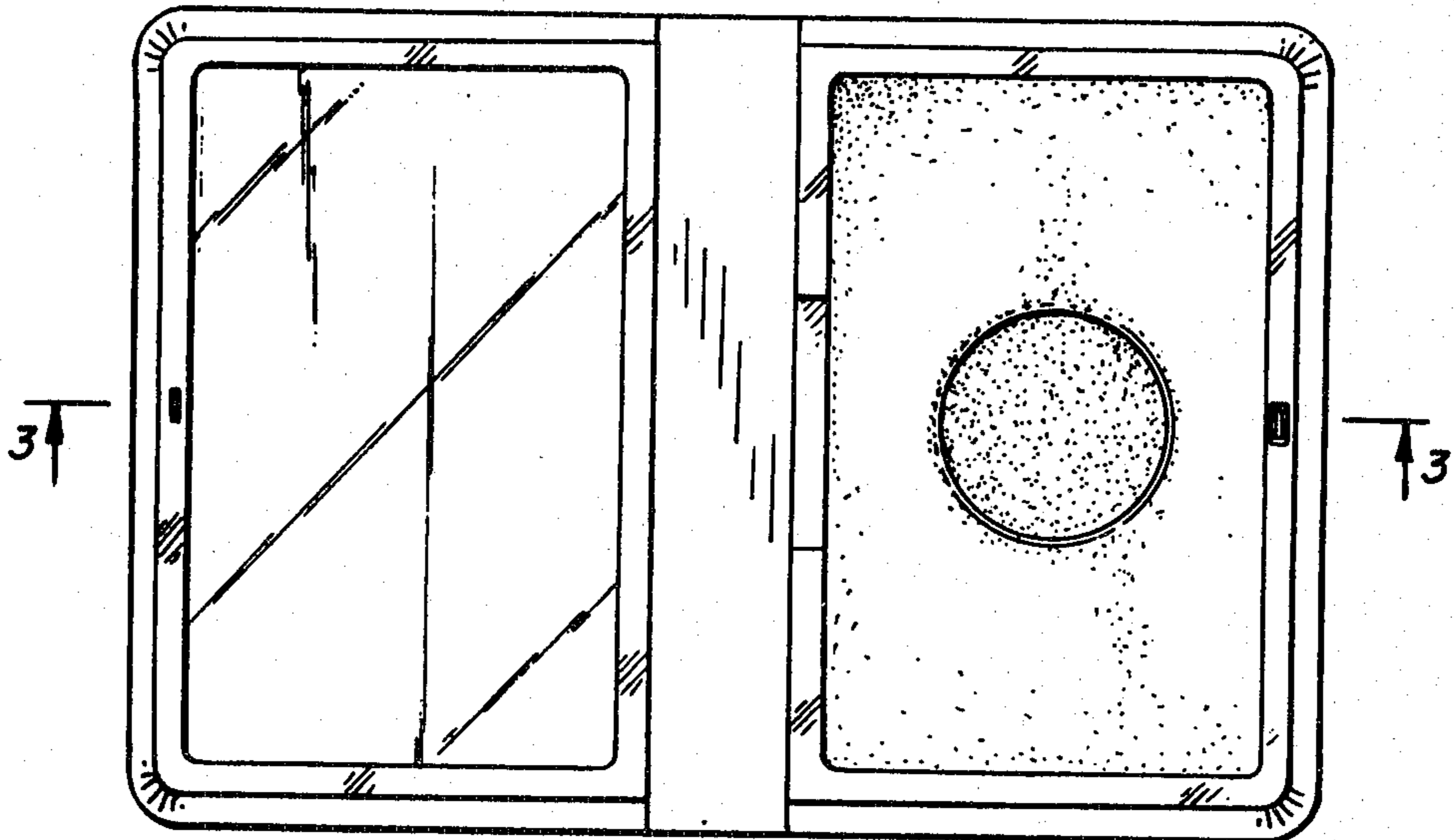

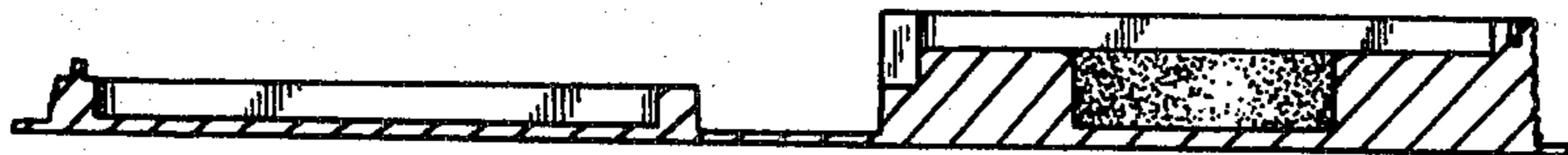

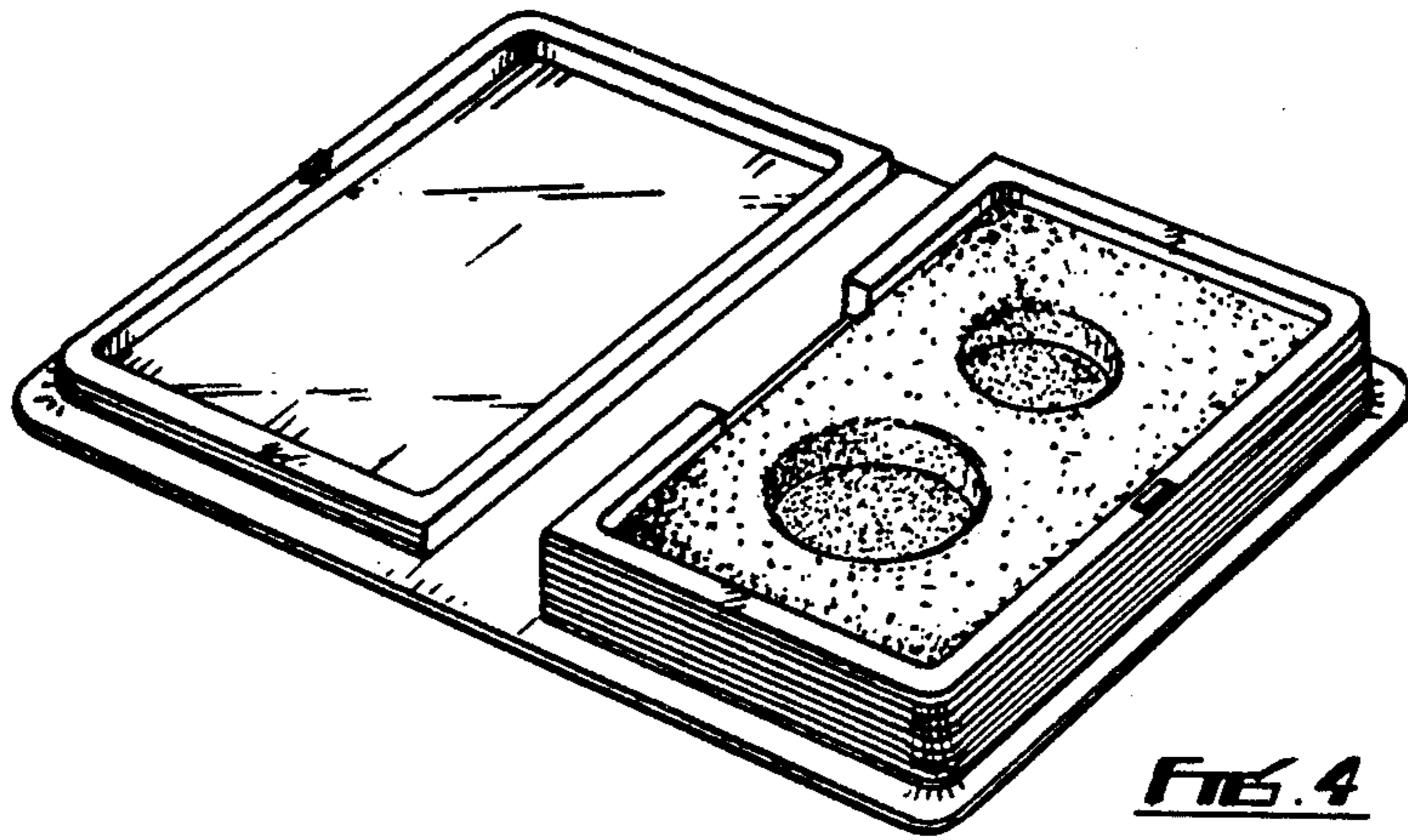

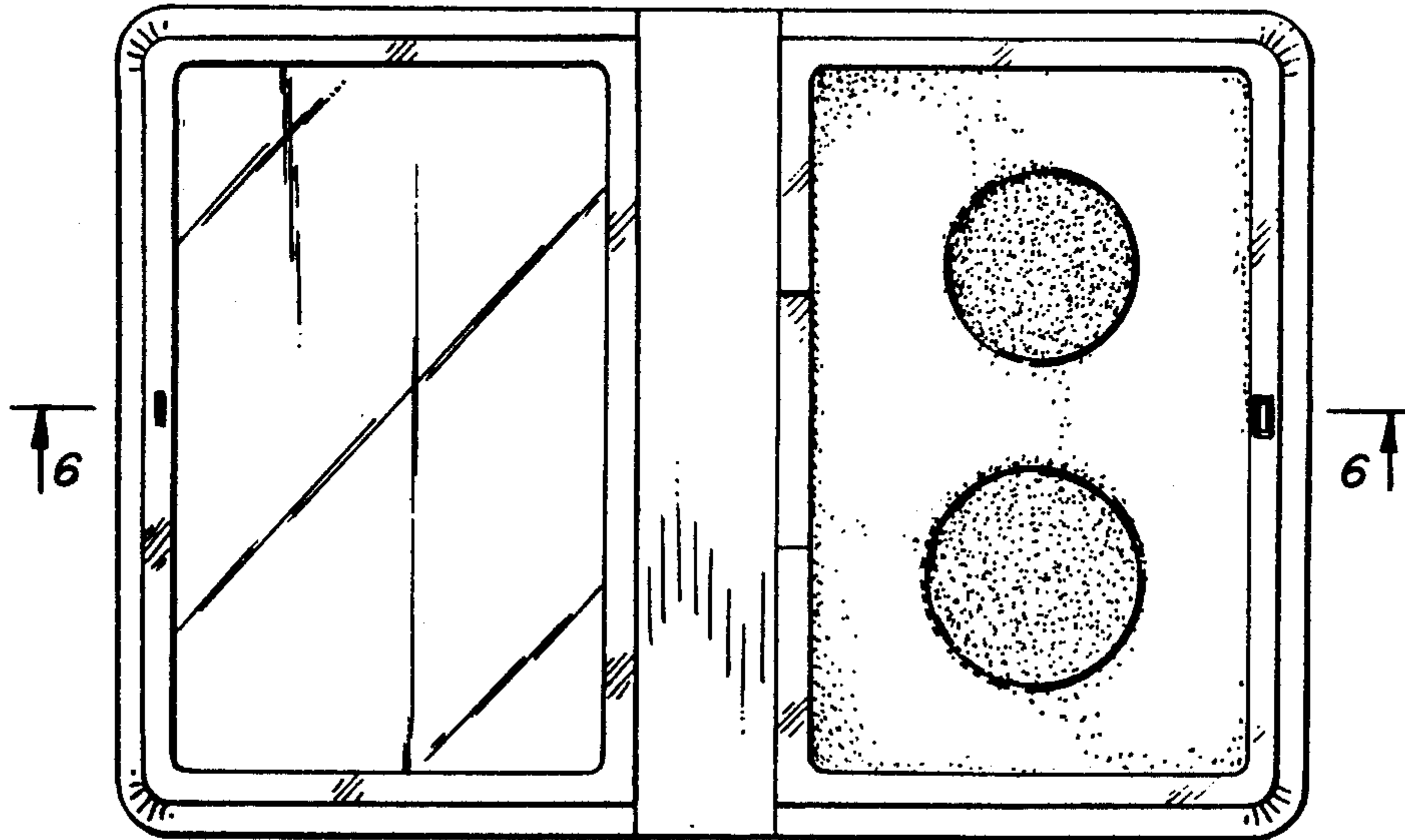

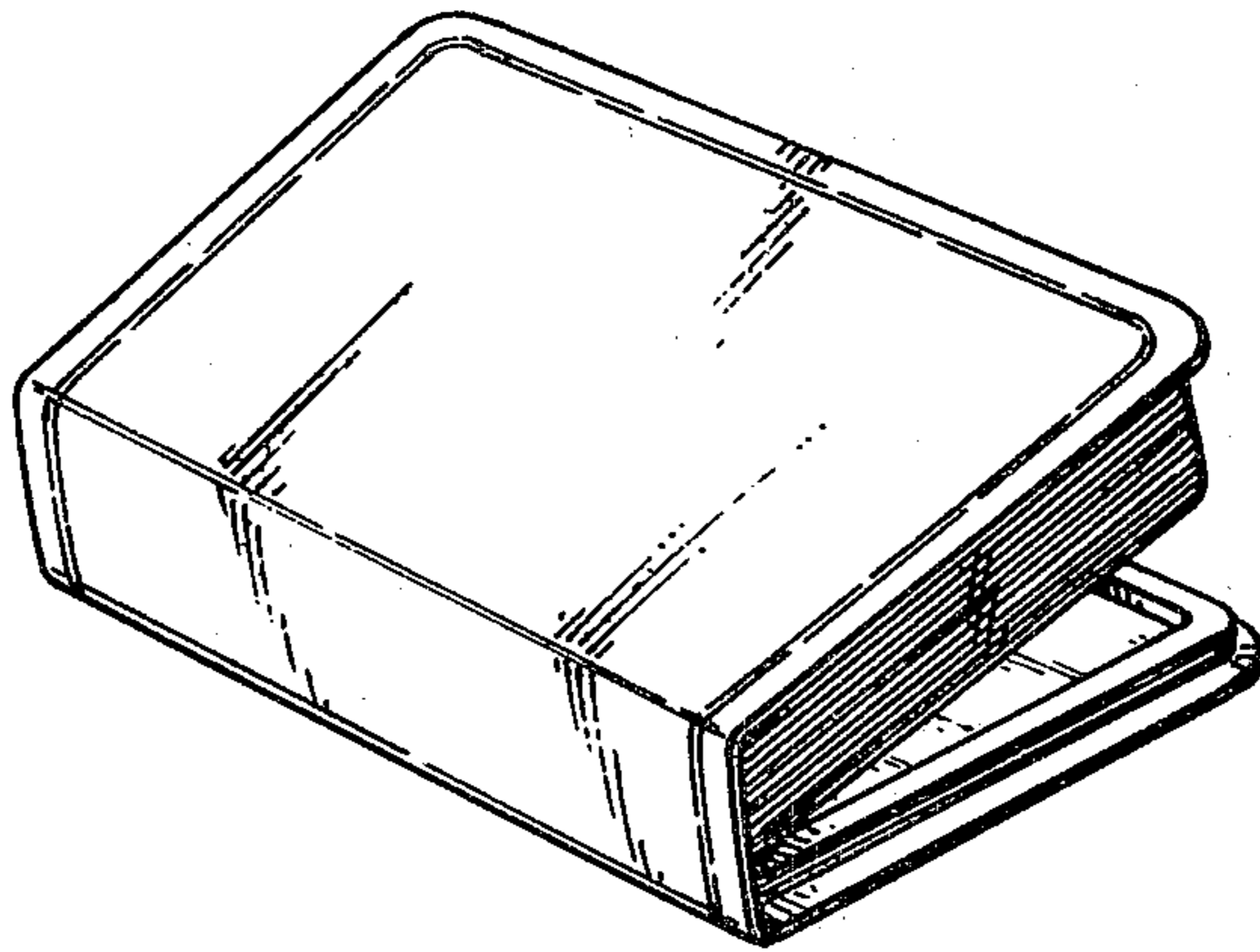
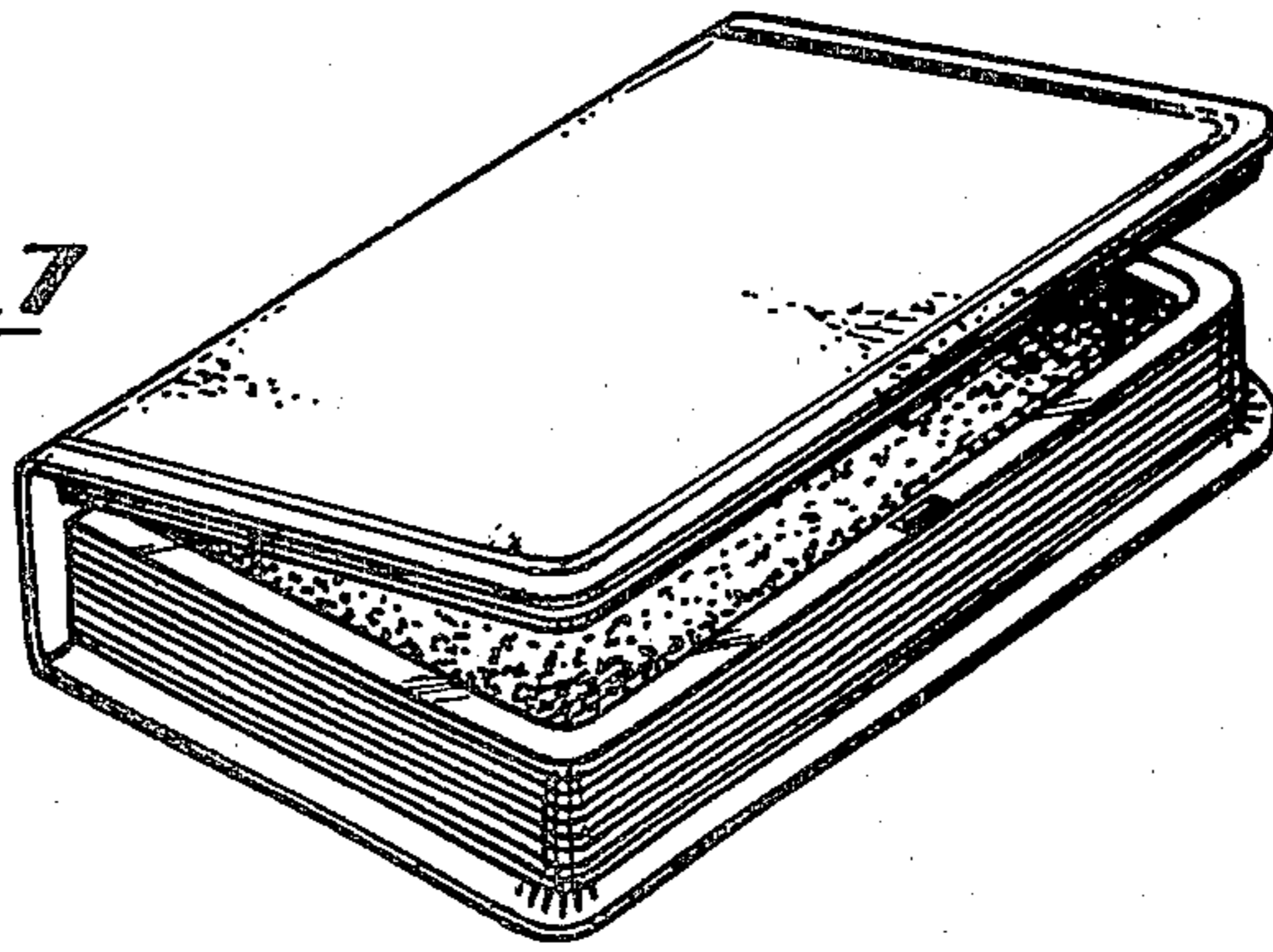
