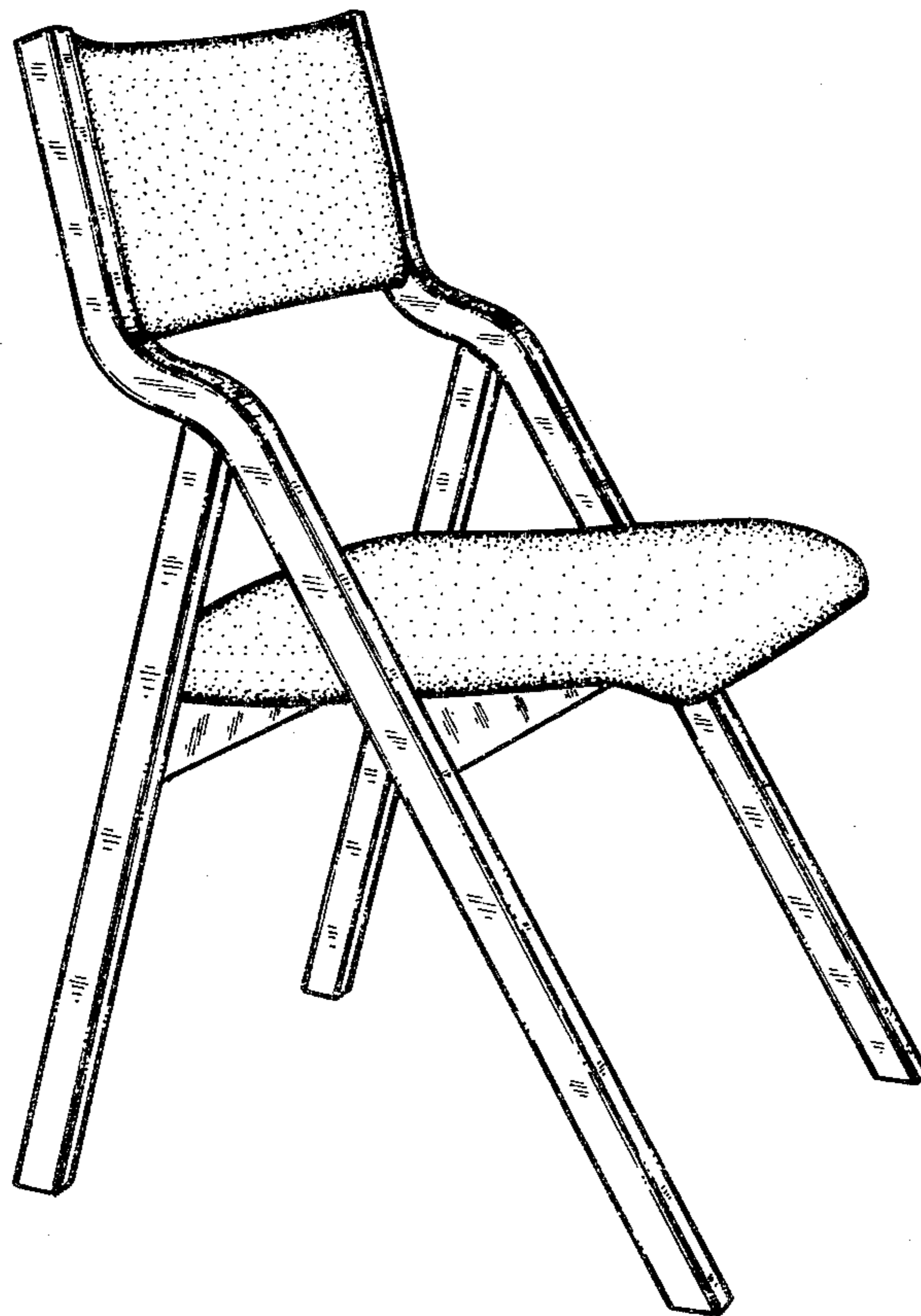

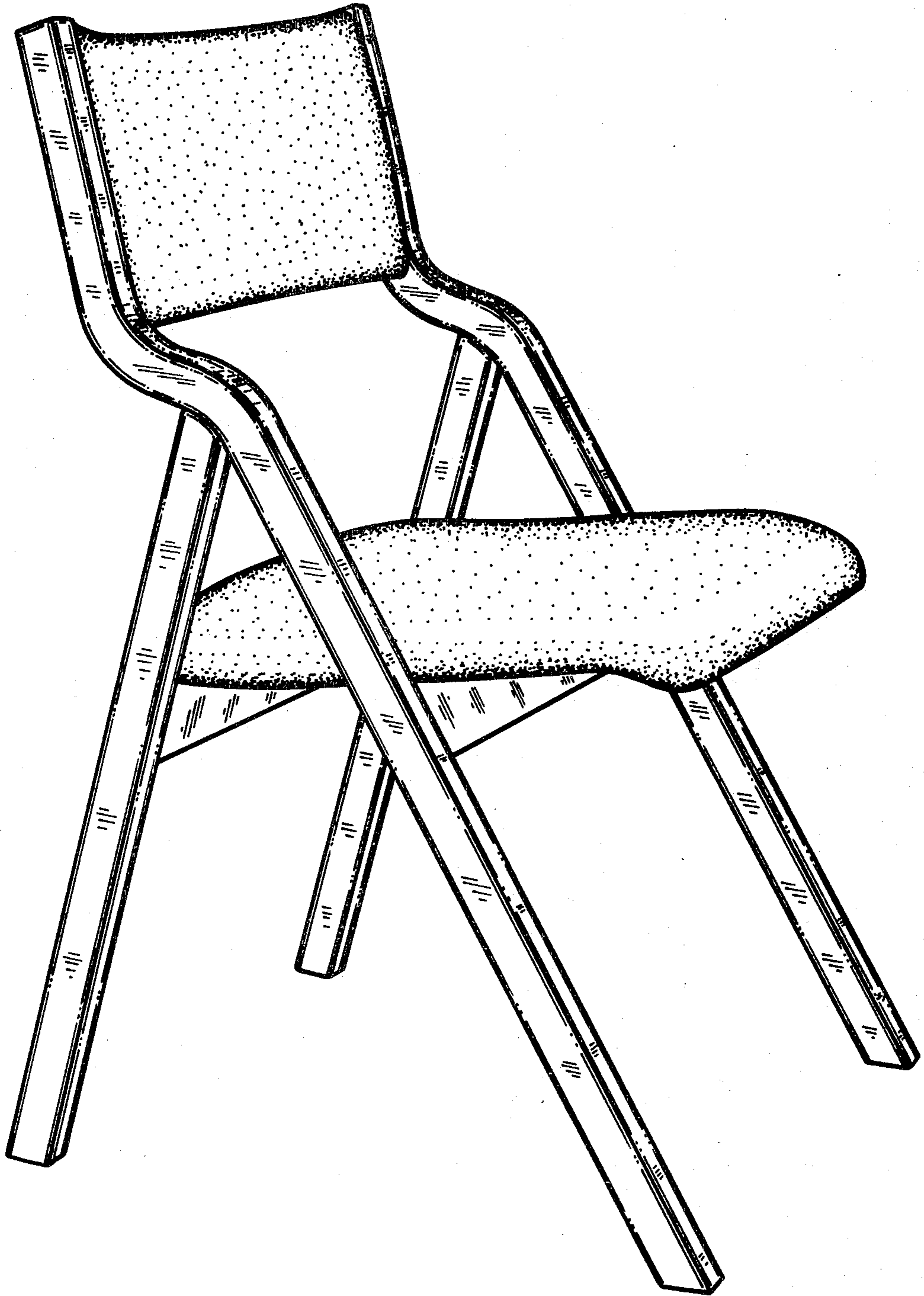

The ornamental design for a folding chair, as shown and described.

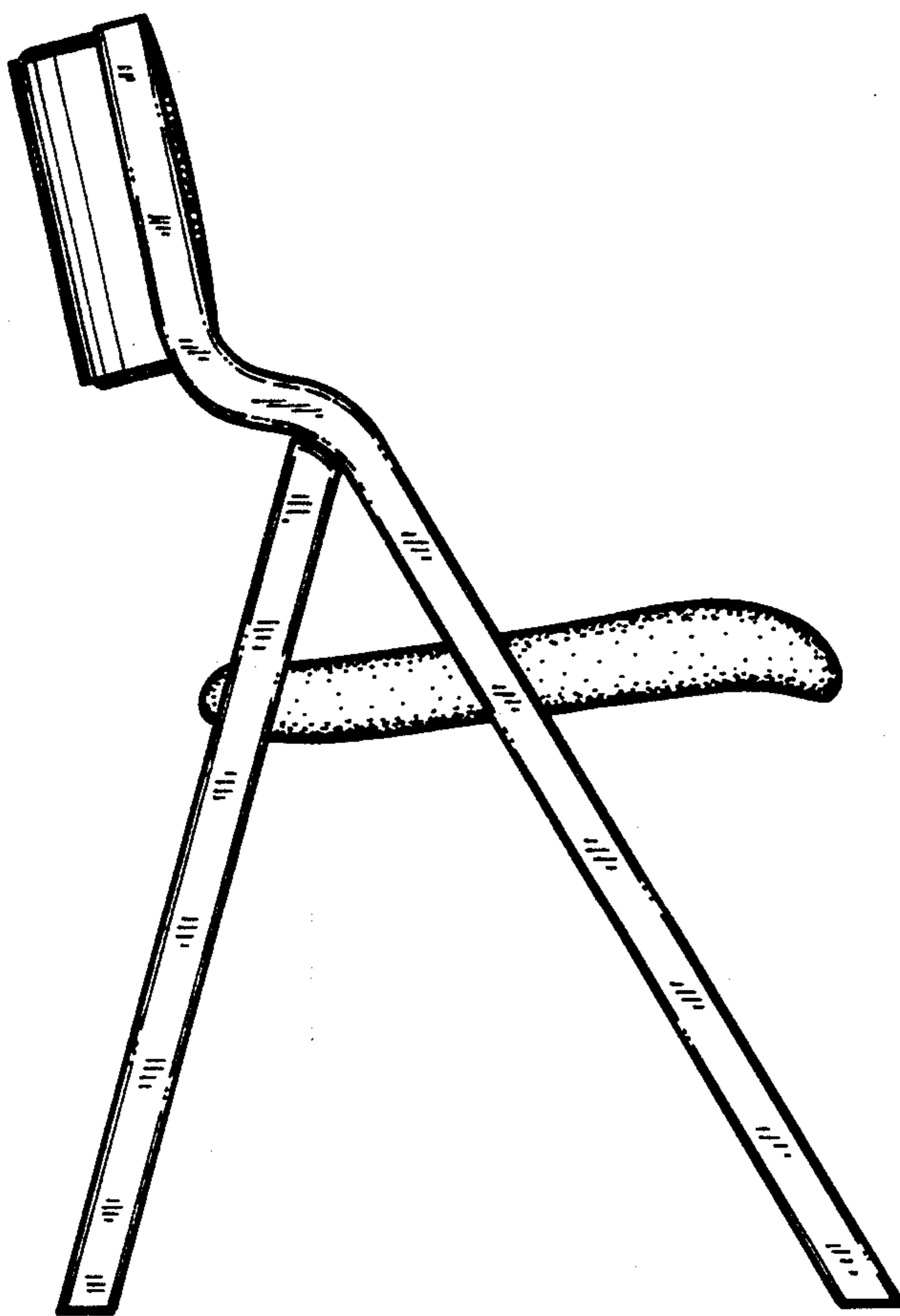
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a folding chair in accordance with the present invention;
 FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view of the folding chair of FIG. 1, with the left side elevational view being a mirror image thereof;

 FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view of the folding chair of FIG. 1.

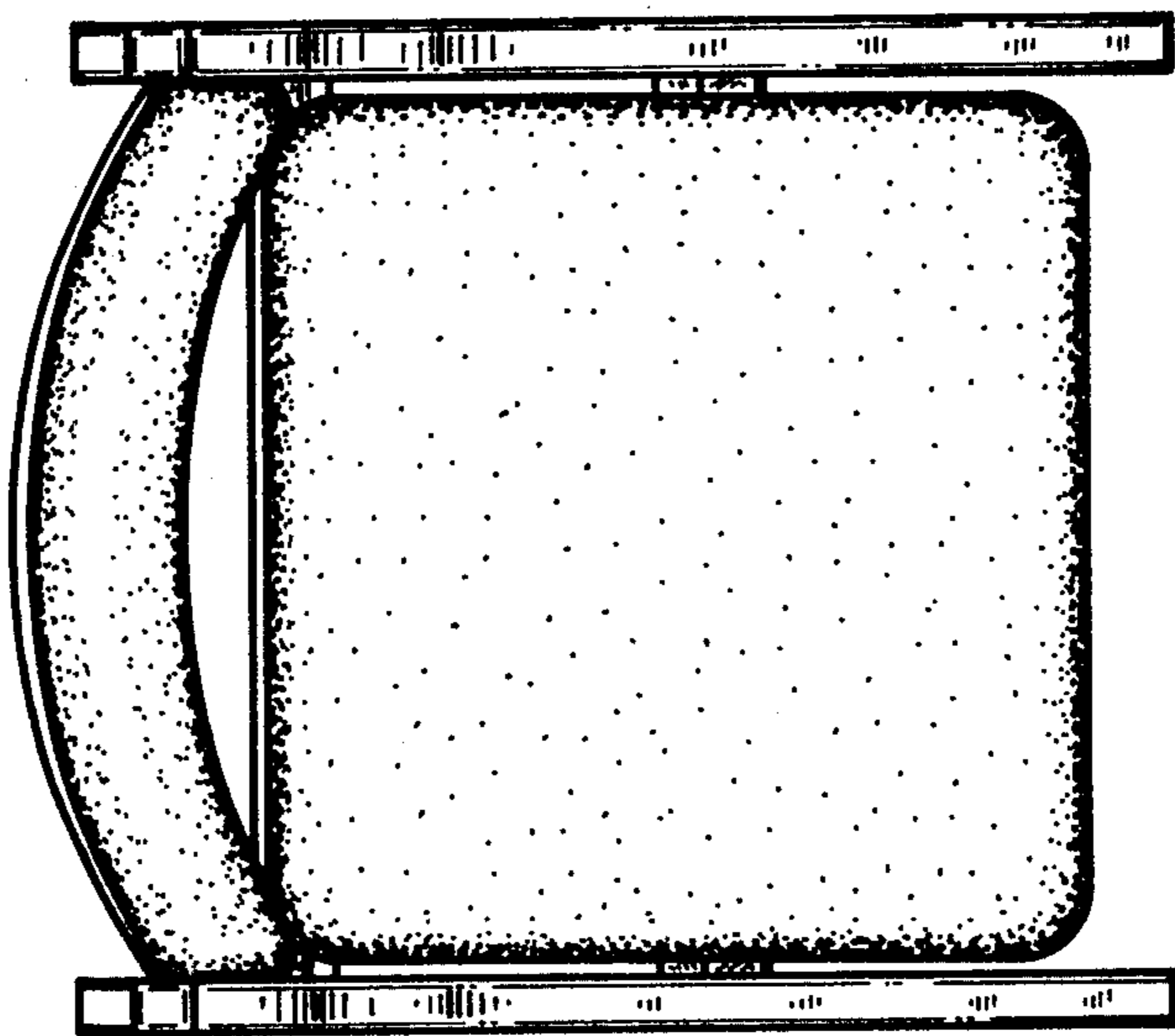




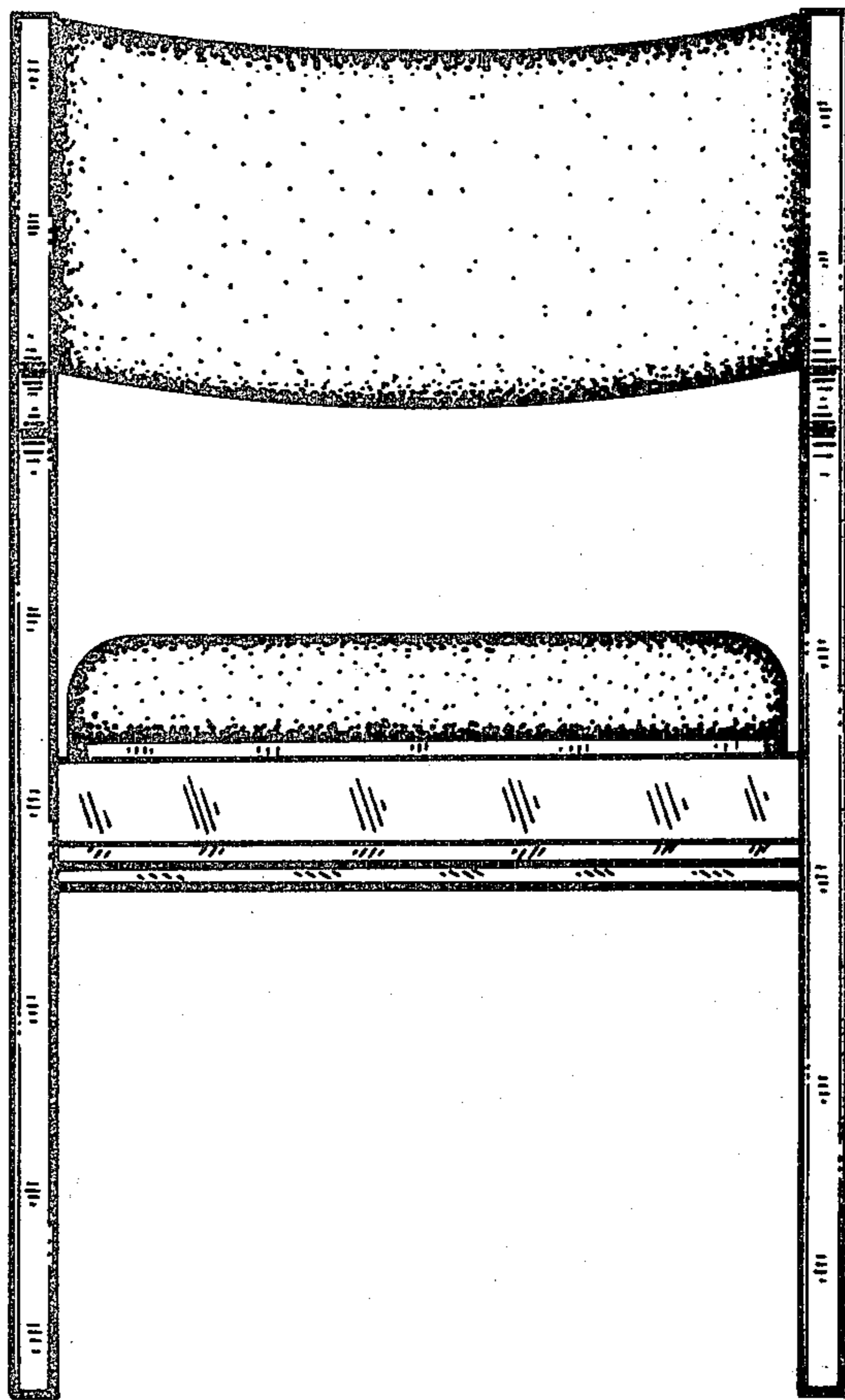

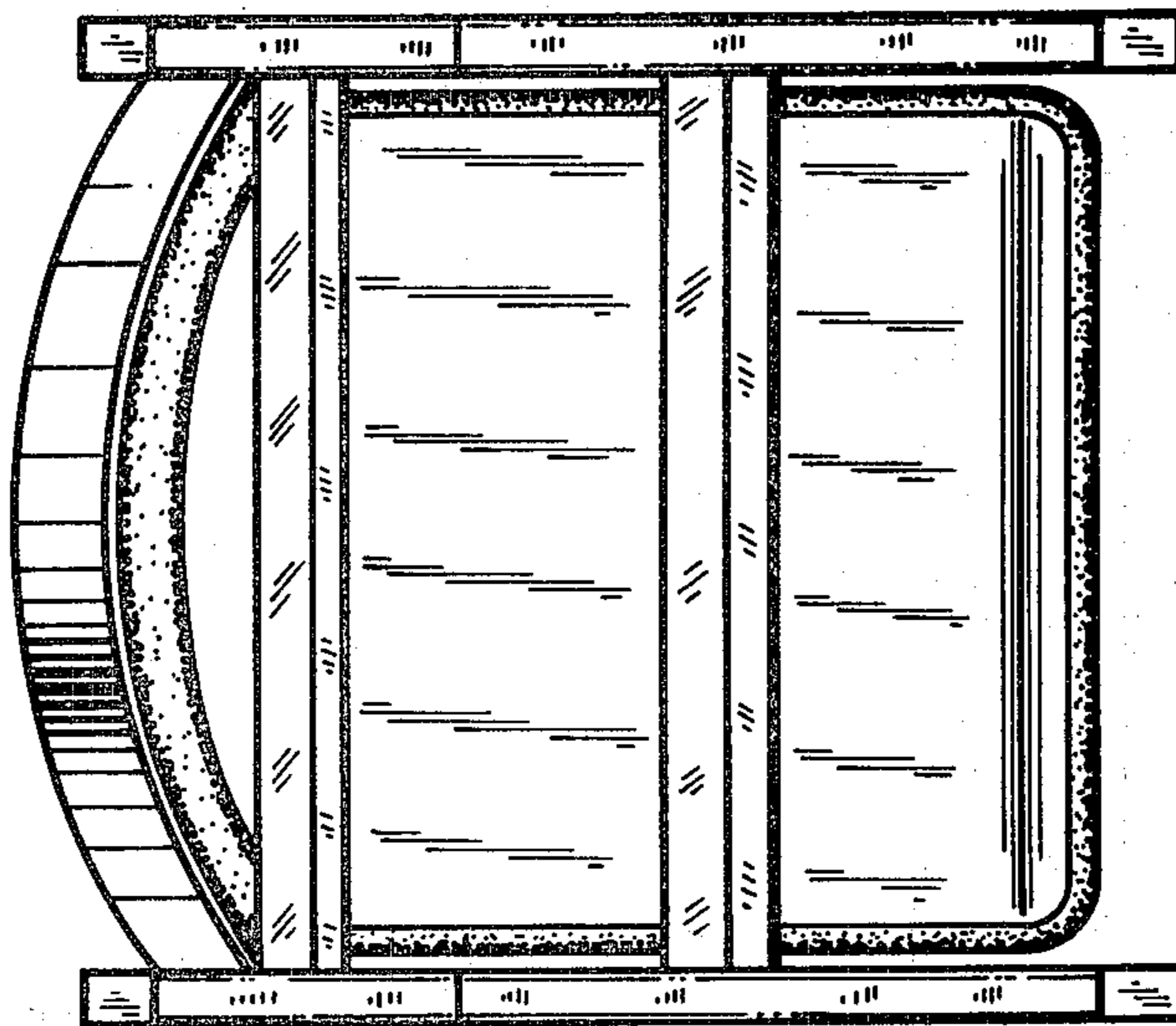

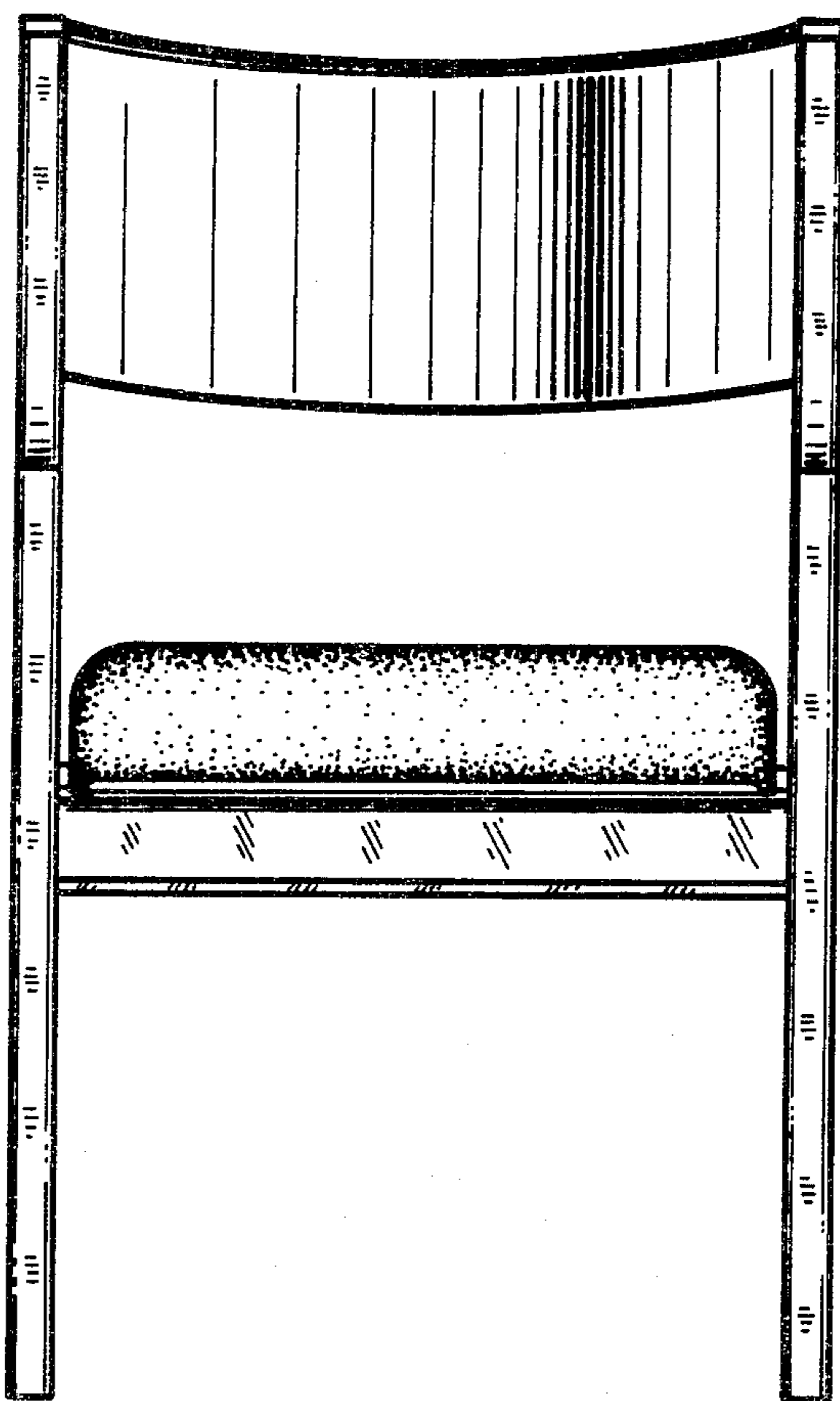
