[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a plate or similar article, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a plate or similar article showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof, the surface decoration as seen through the plate having been partially left out for ease of illustration;

FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof, the reverse side being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof, the surface decoration having been partially left out for ease of illustration; and

FIG. 5 is a sectional view thereof taken along the lines 5—5 of FIG. 3, showing the inner surface, the surface decoration, as seen through the plate having been left out for clarity of illustration.

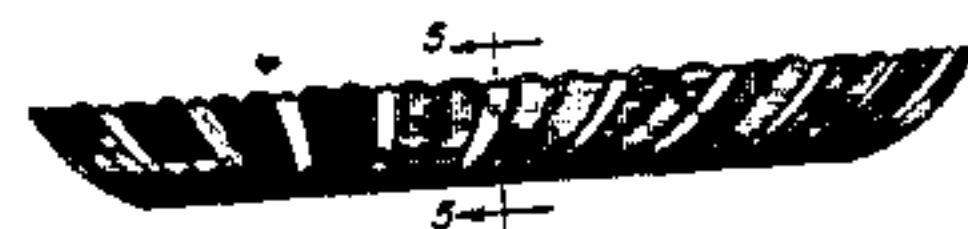
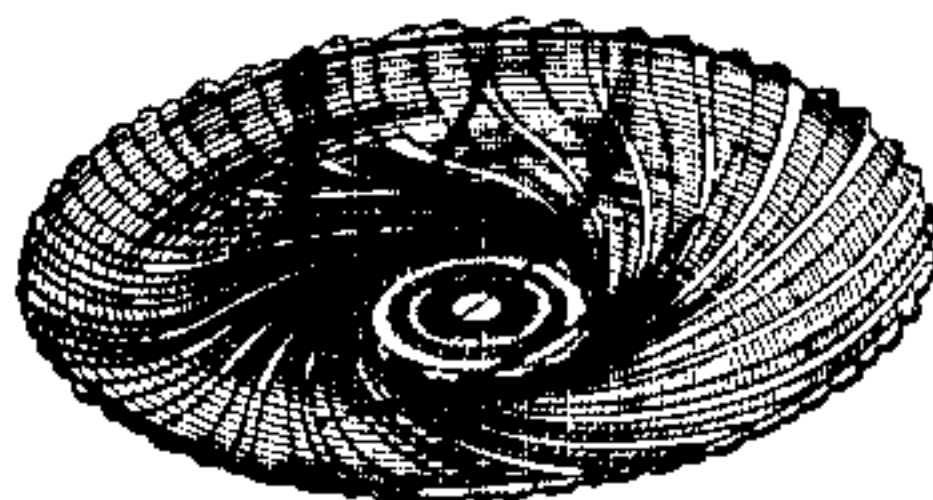
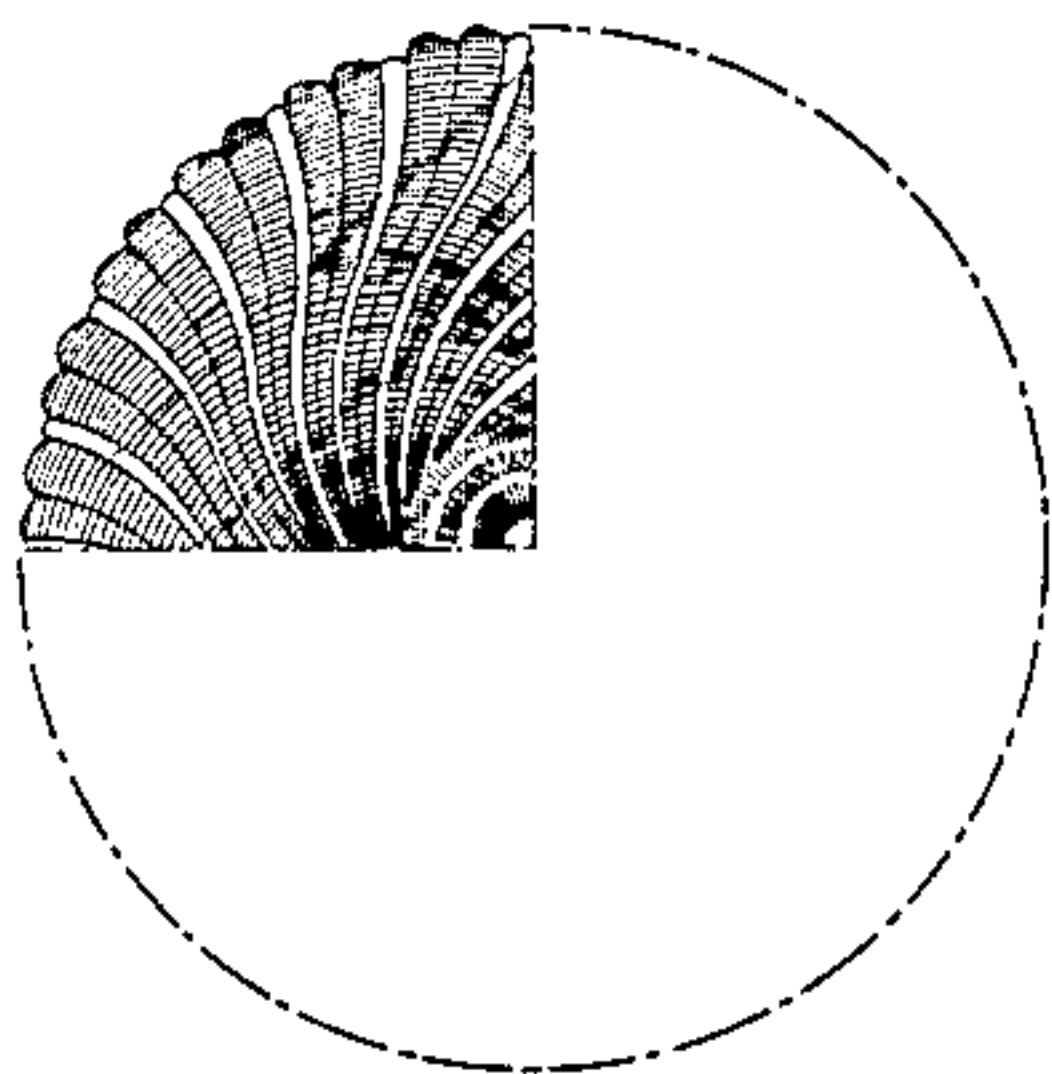

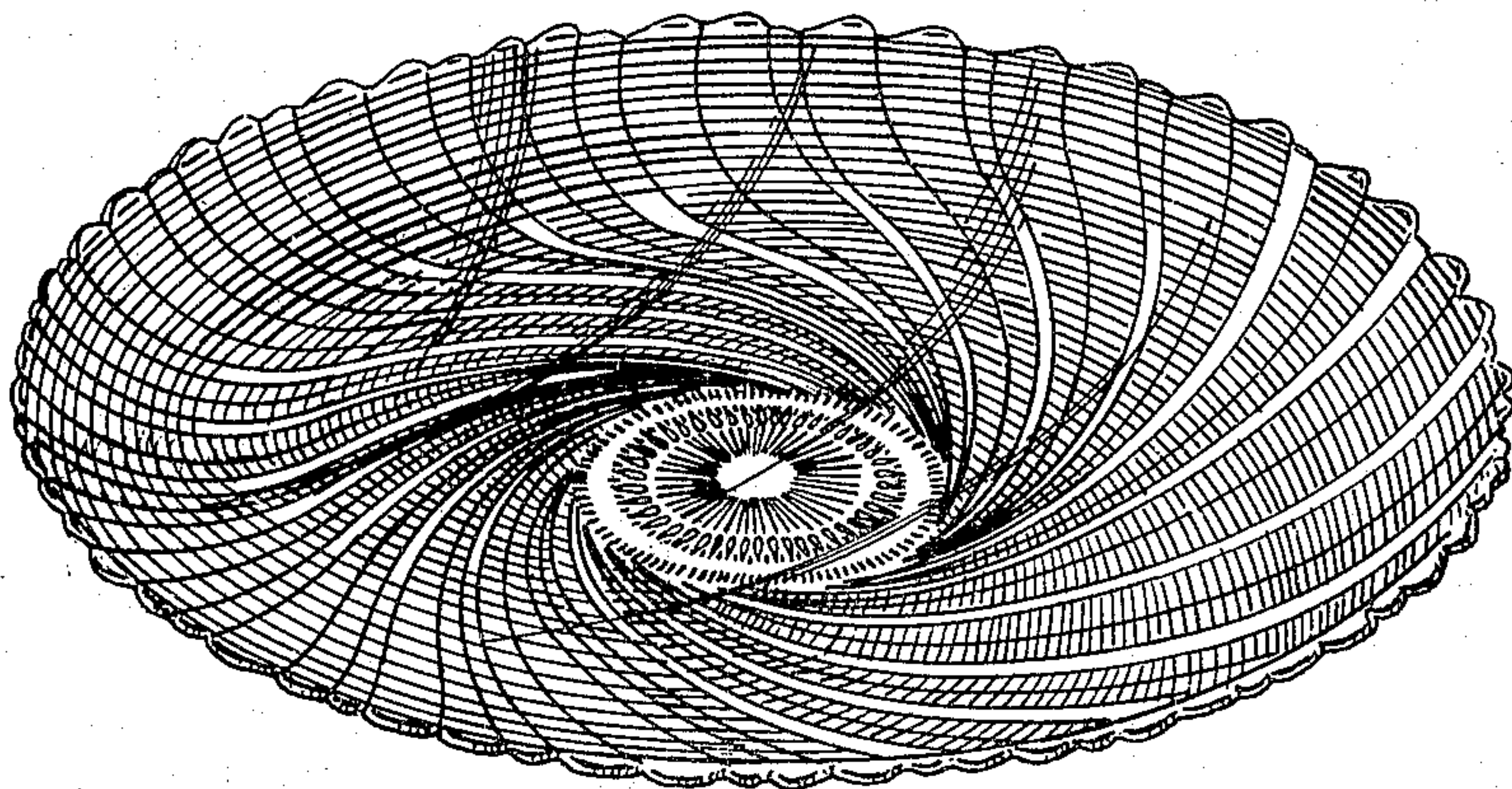

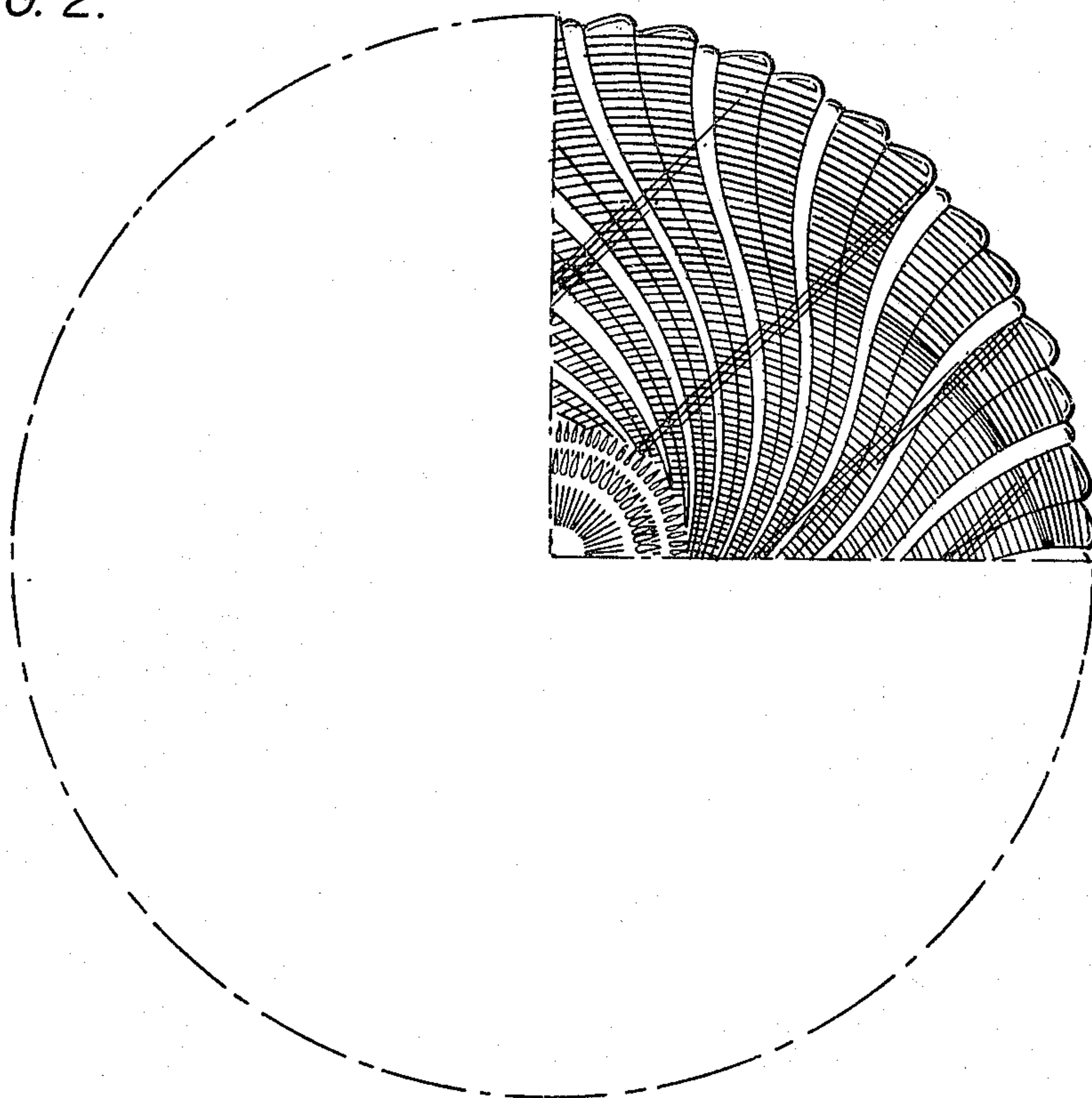

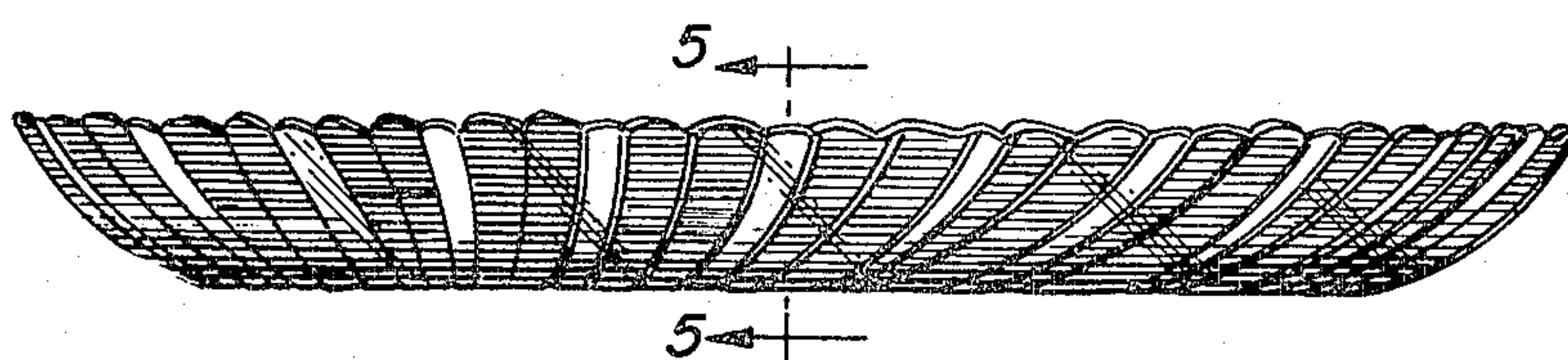

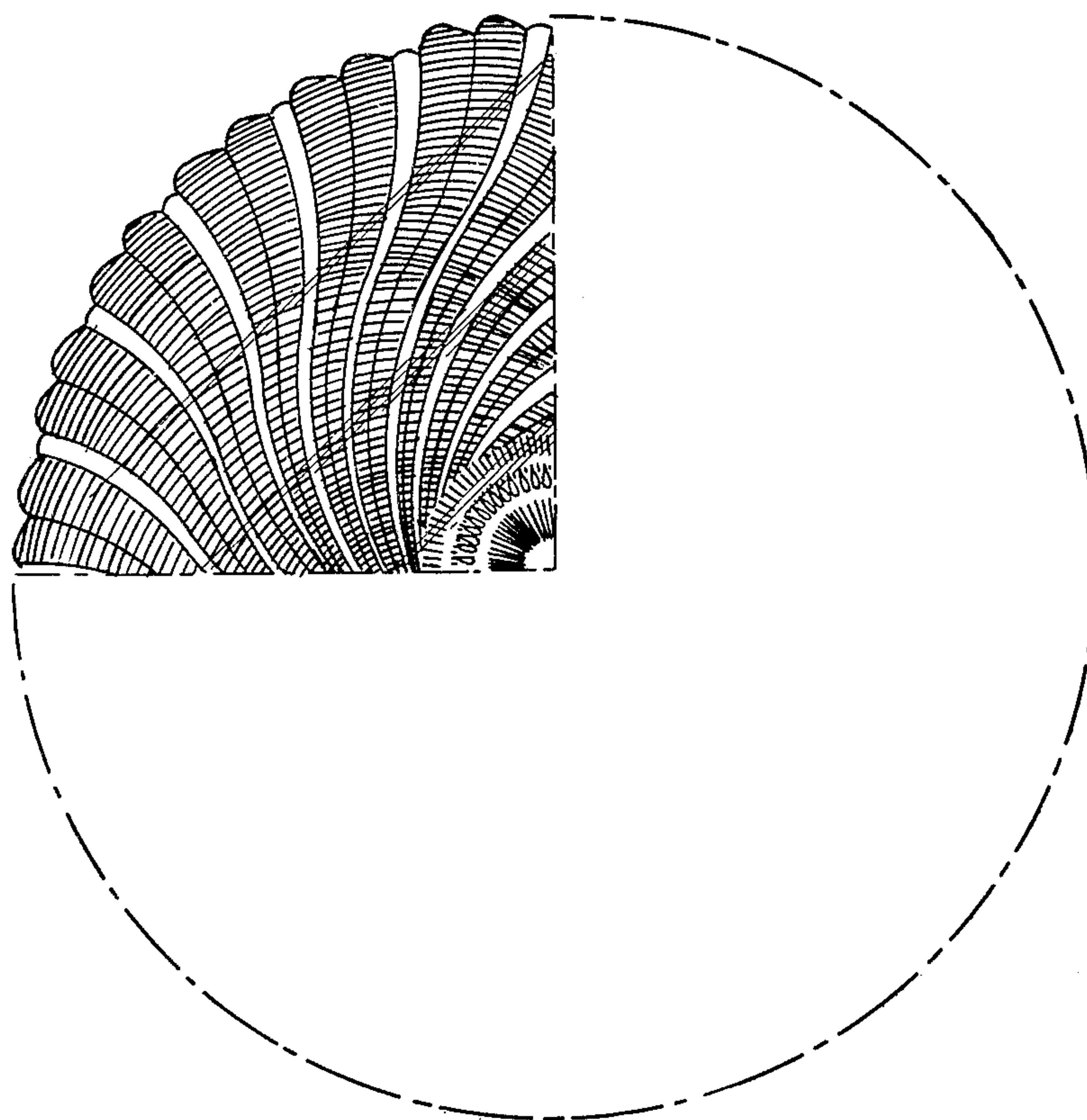
