FIG. 1 is a top plan view of an air handling unit, showing my new design.

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof.

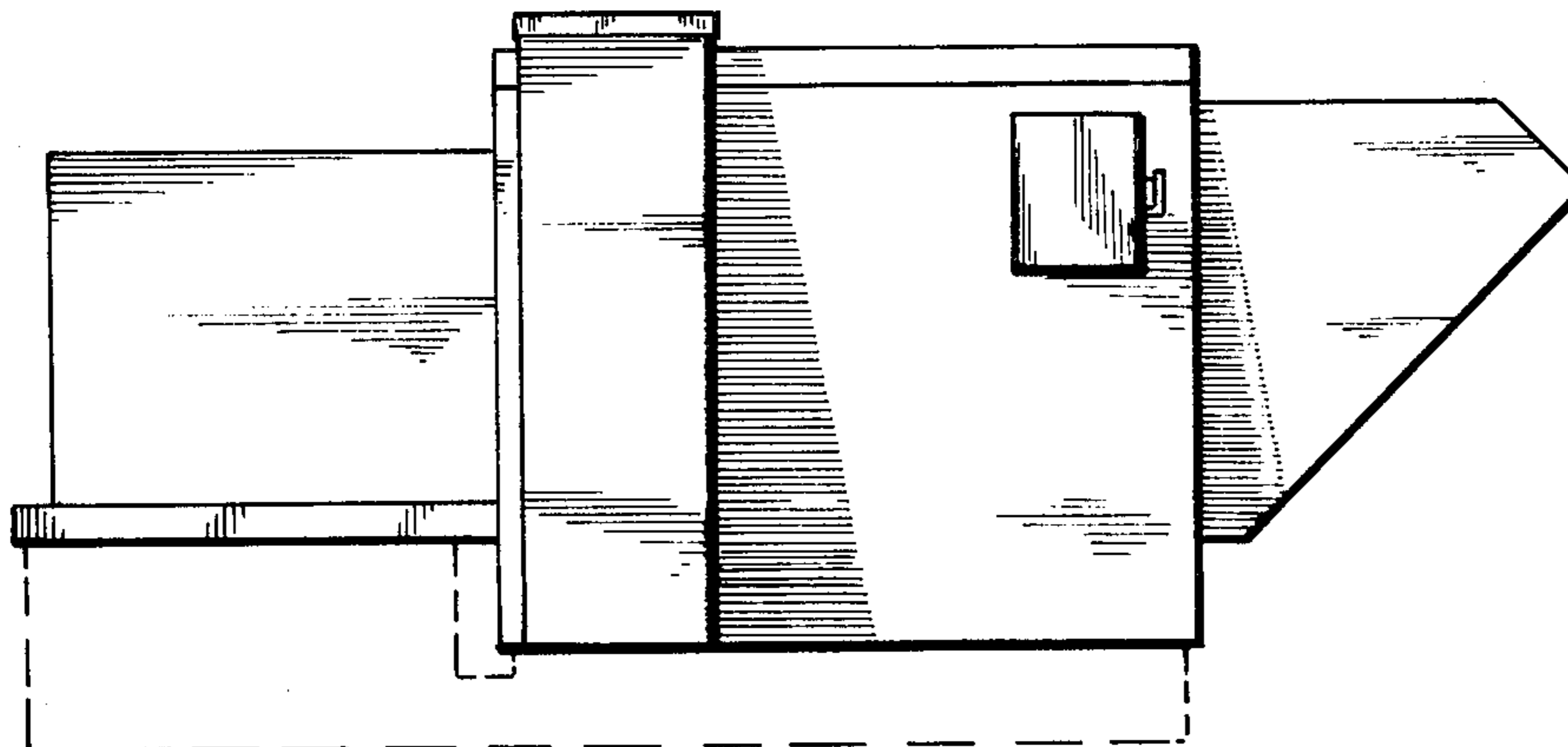
FIG. 3 is an end elevational view thereof.

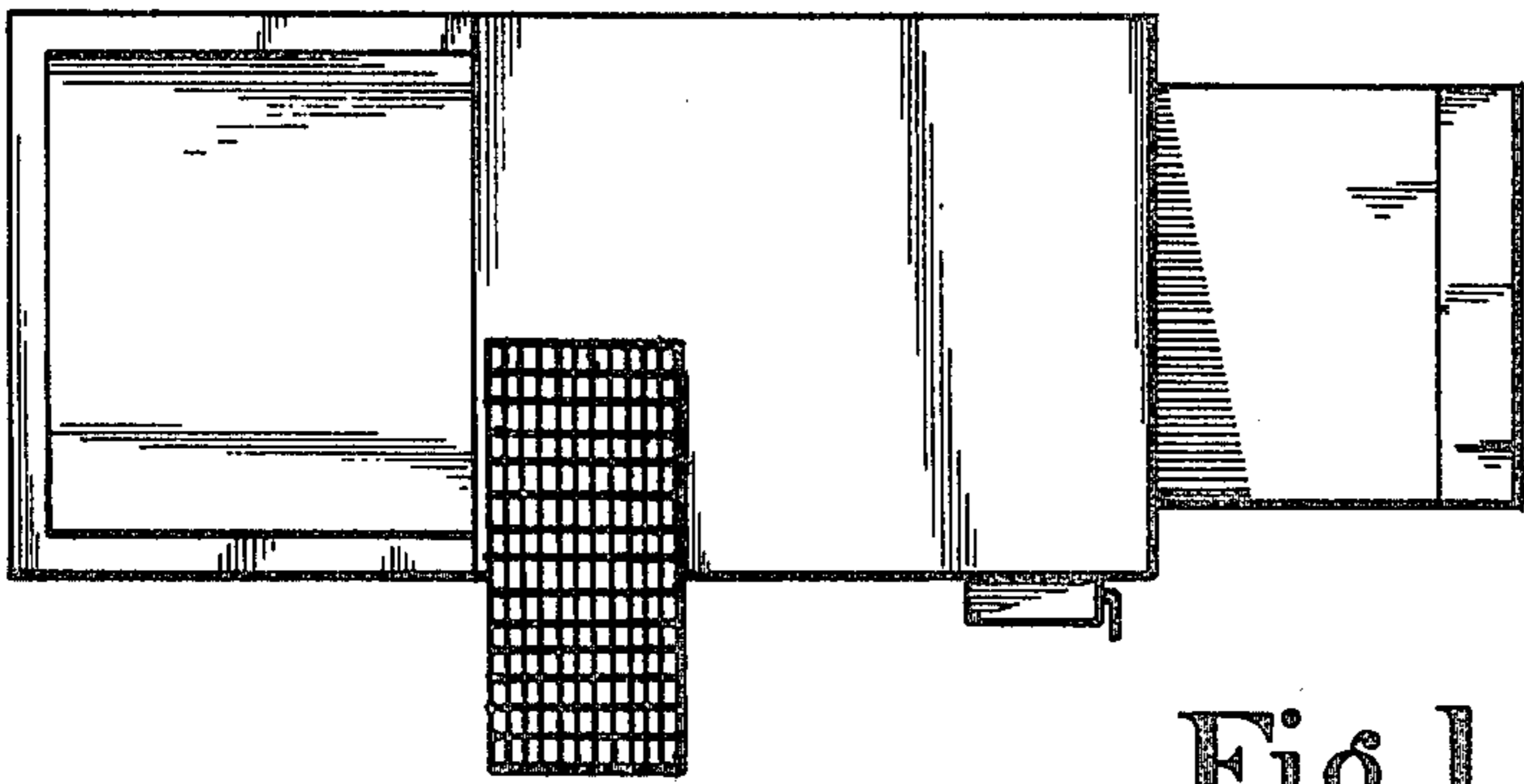

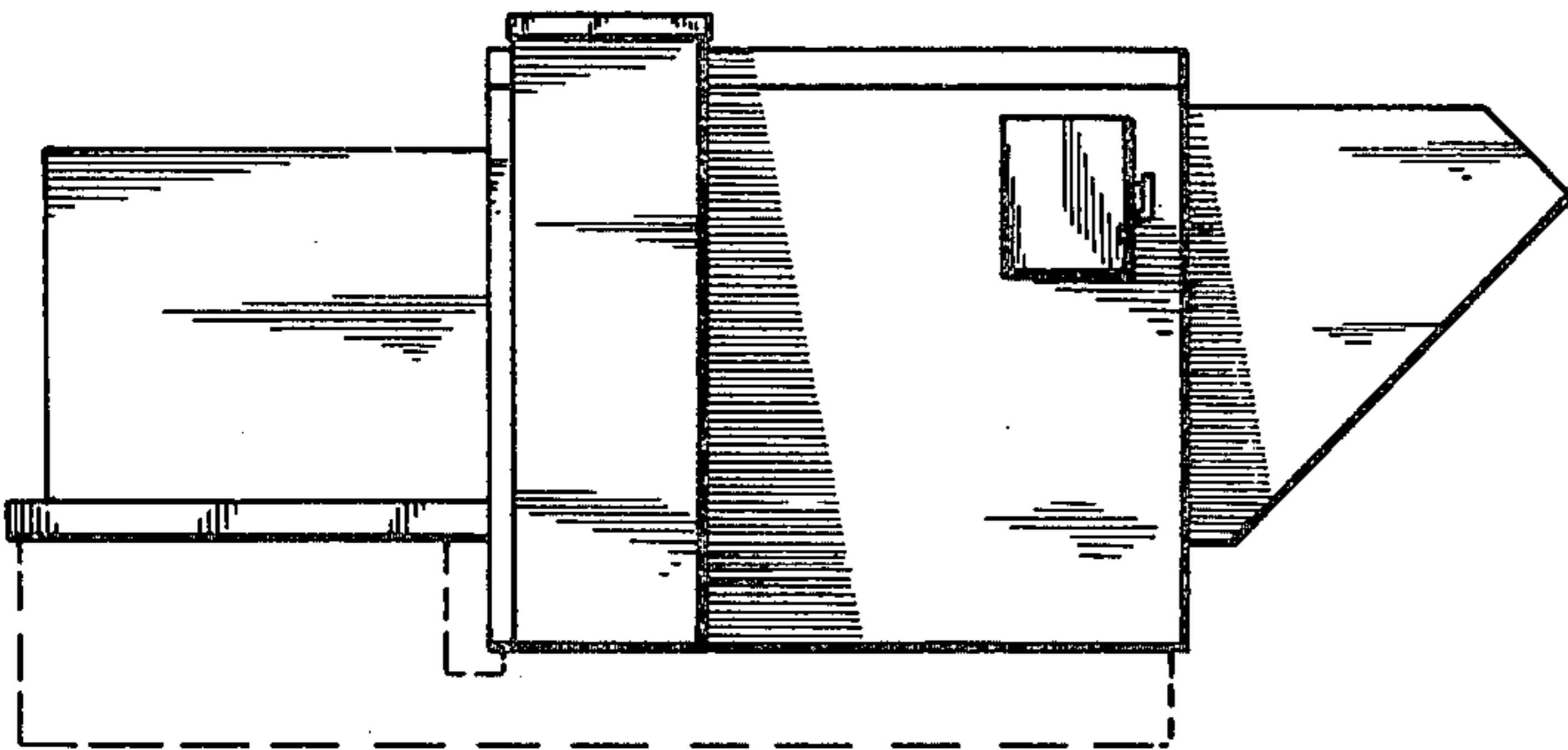

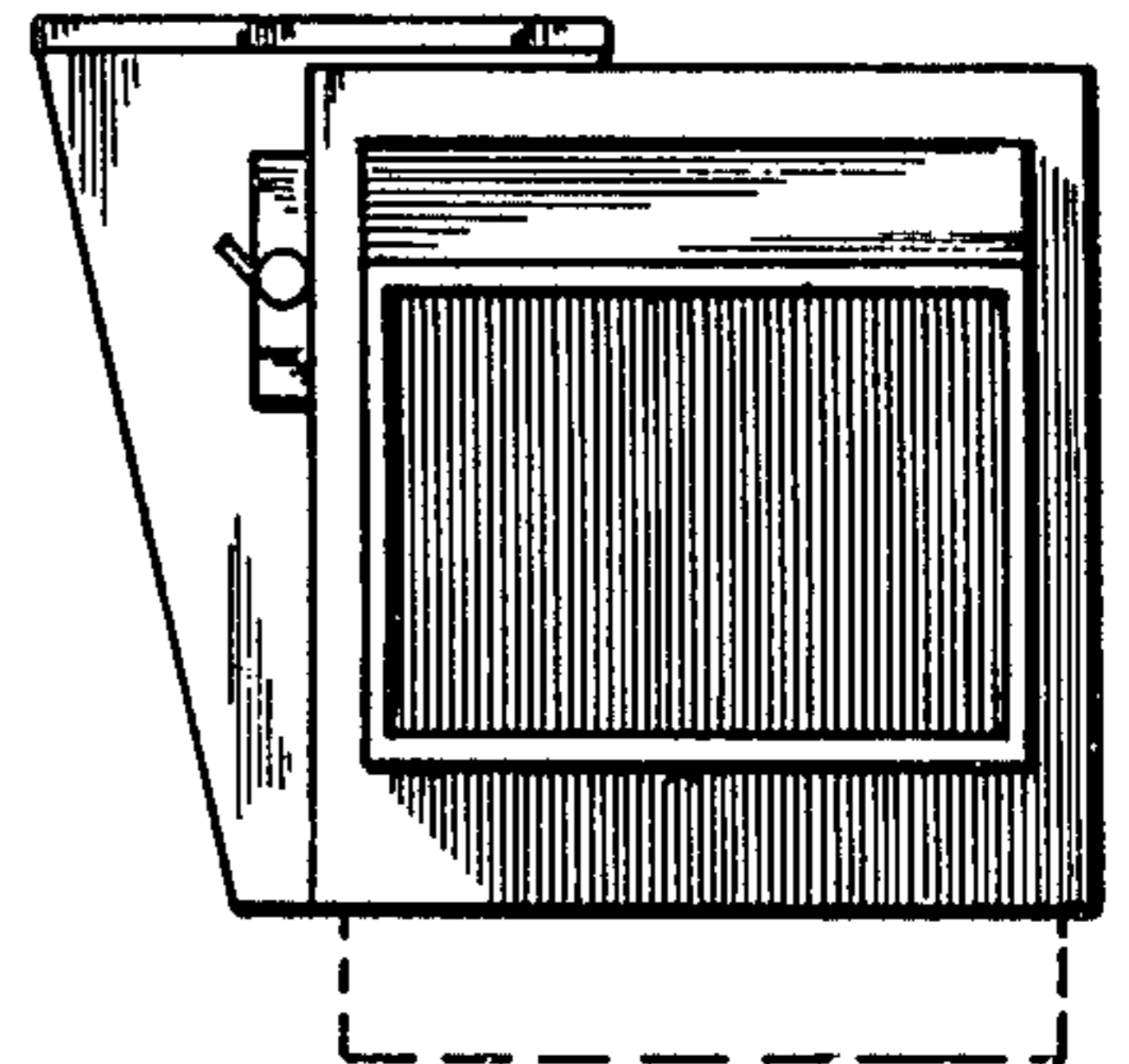

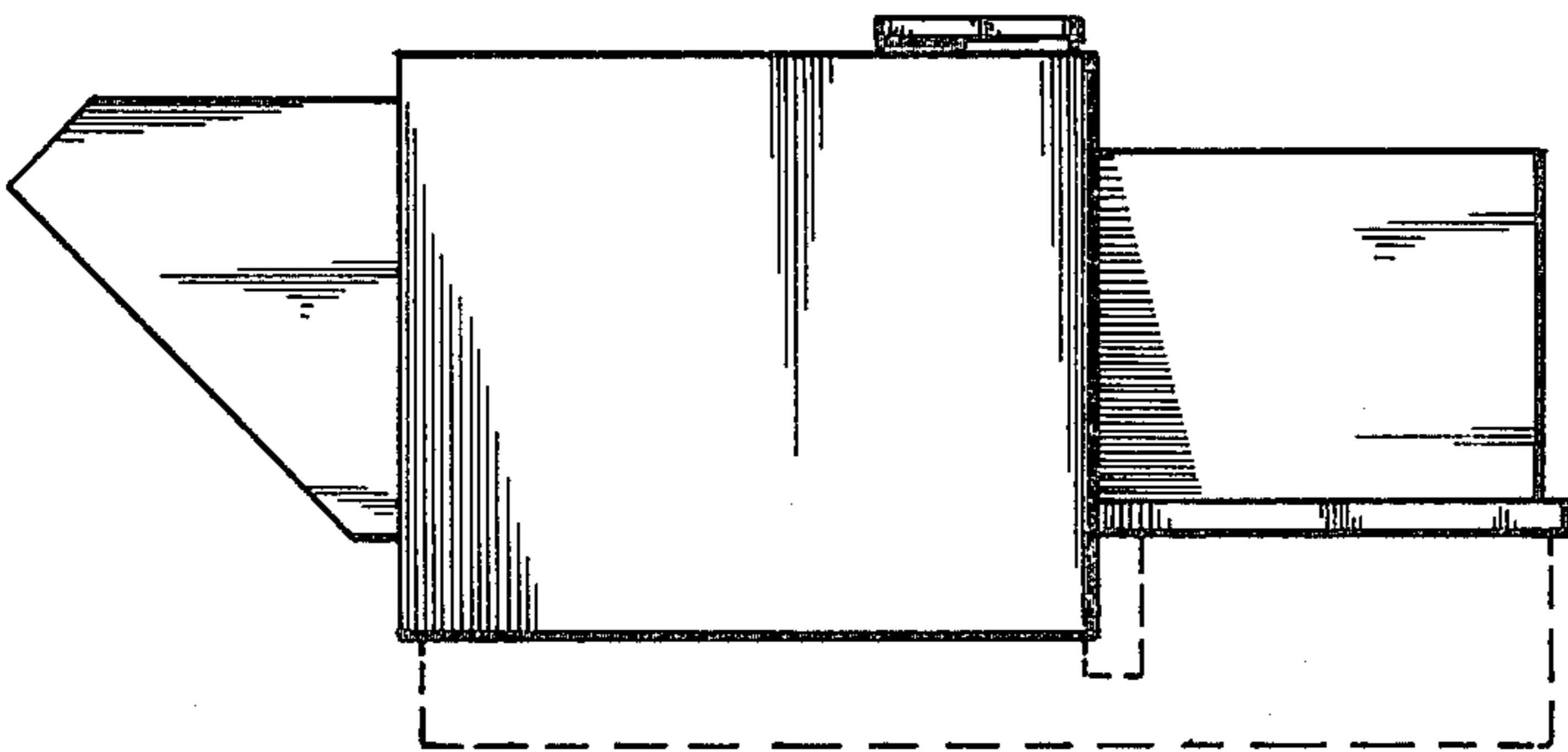

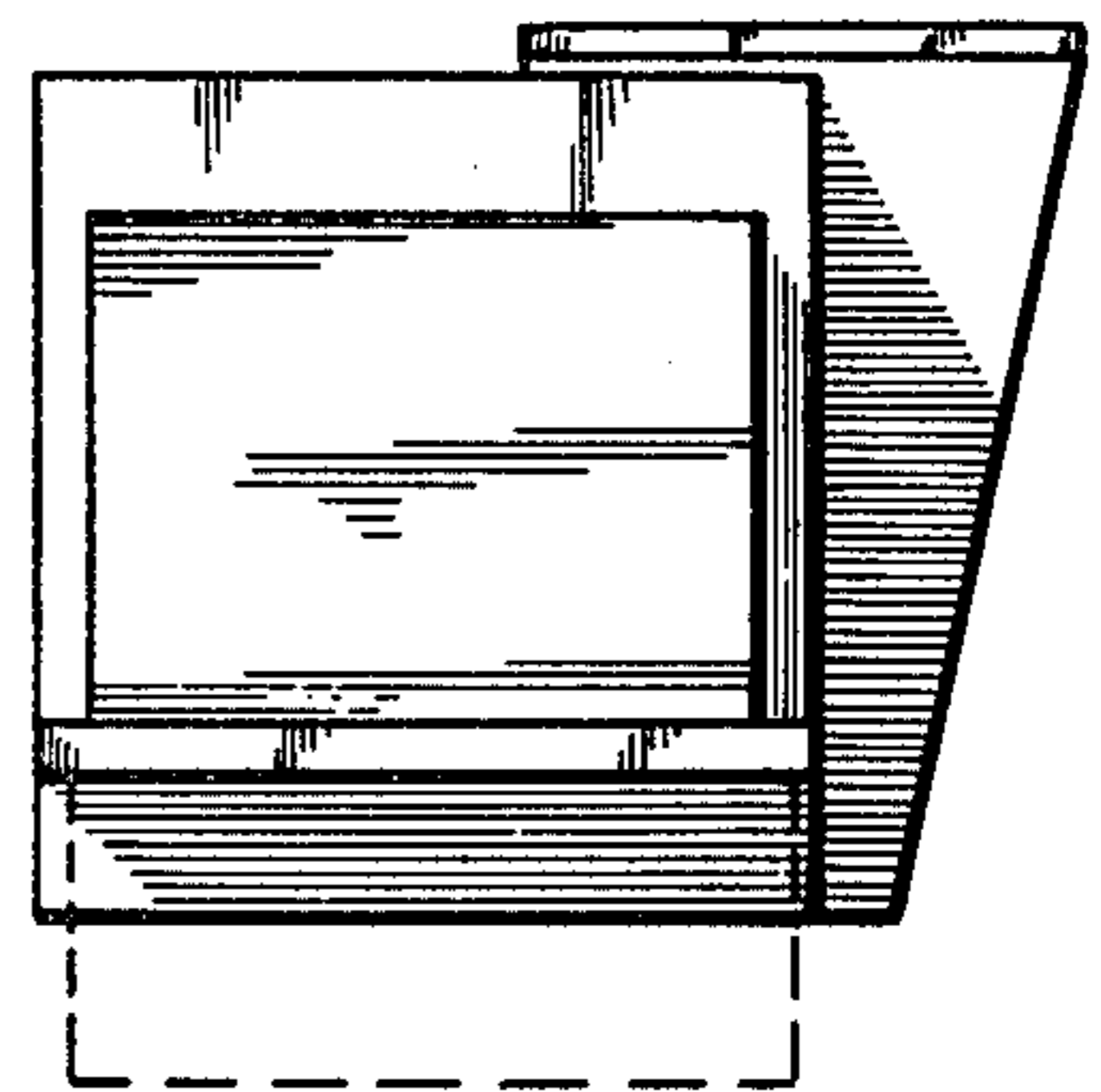

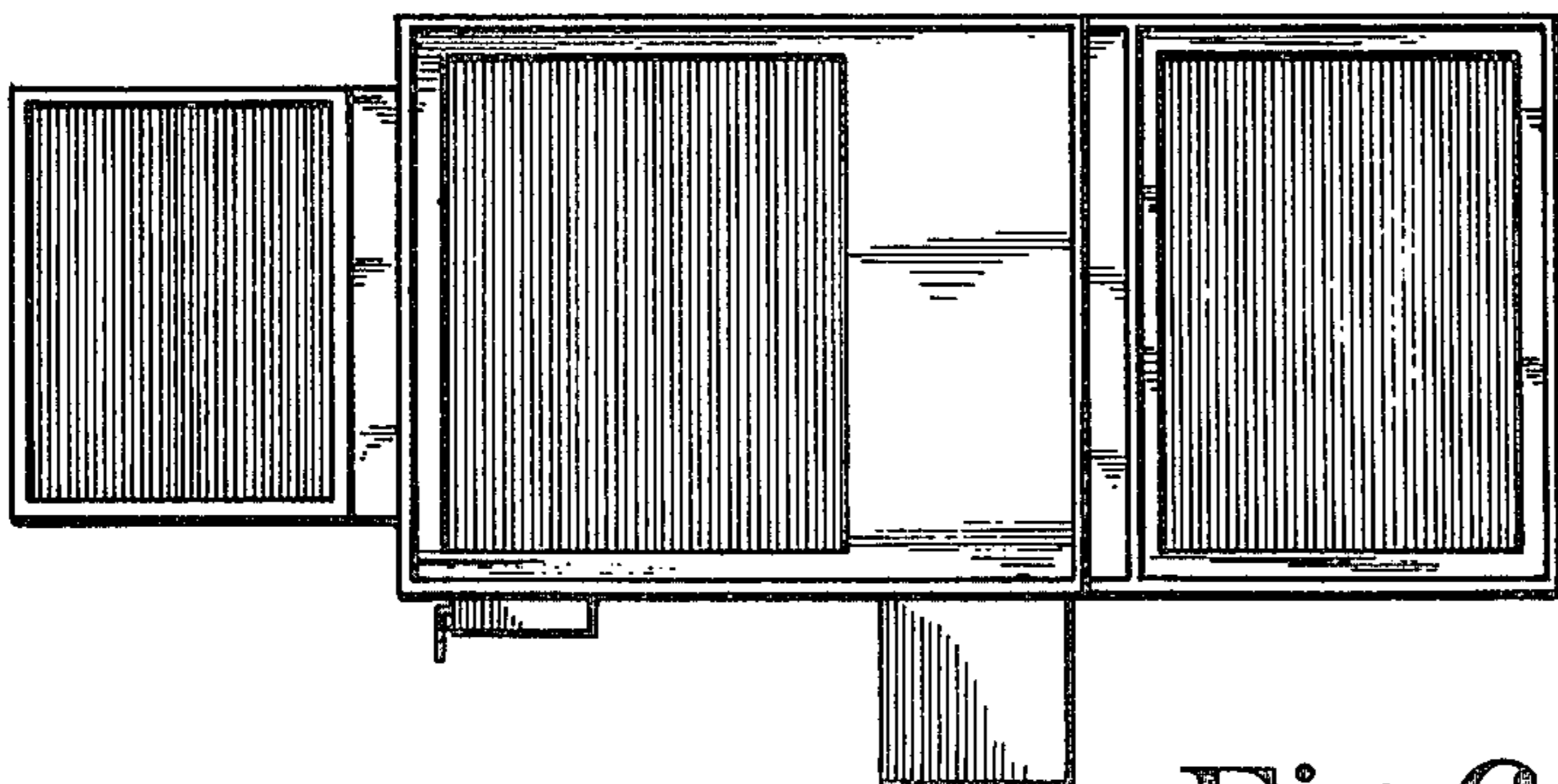
