**DESCRIPTION**

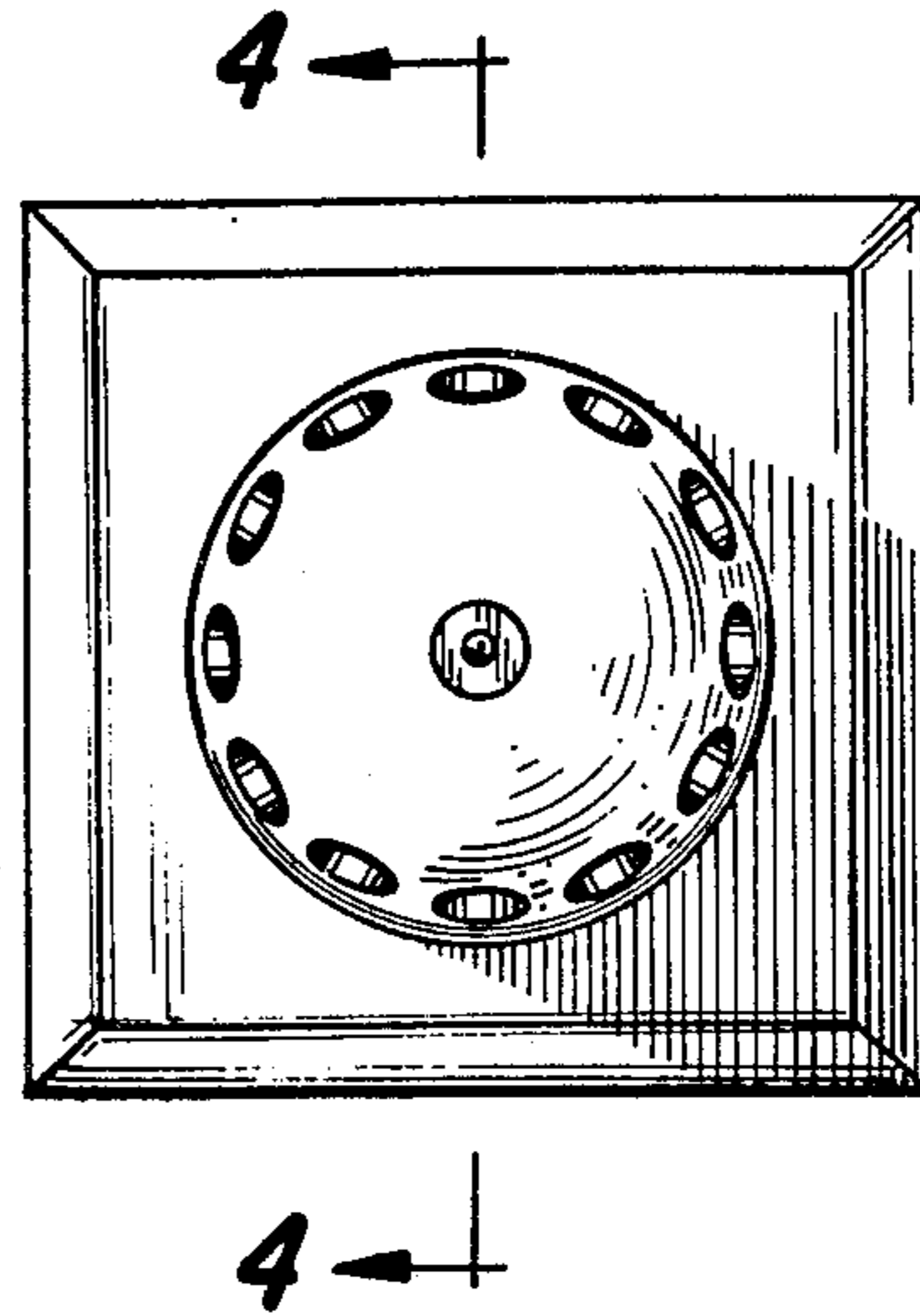
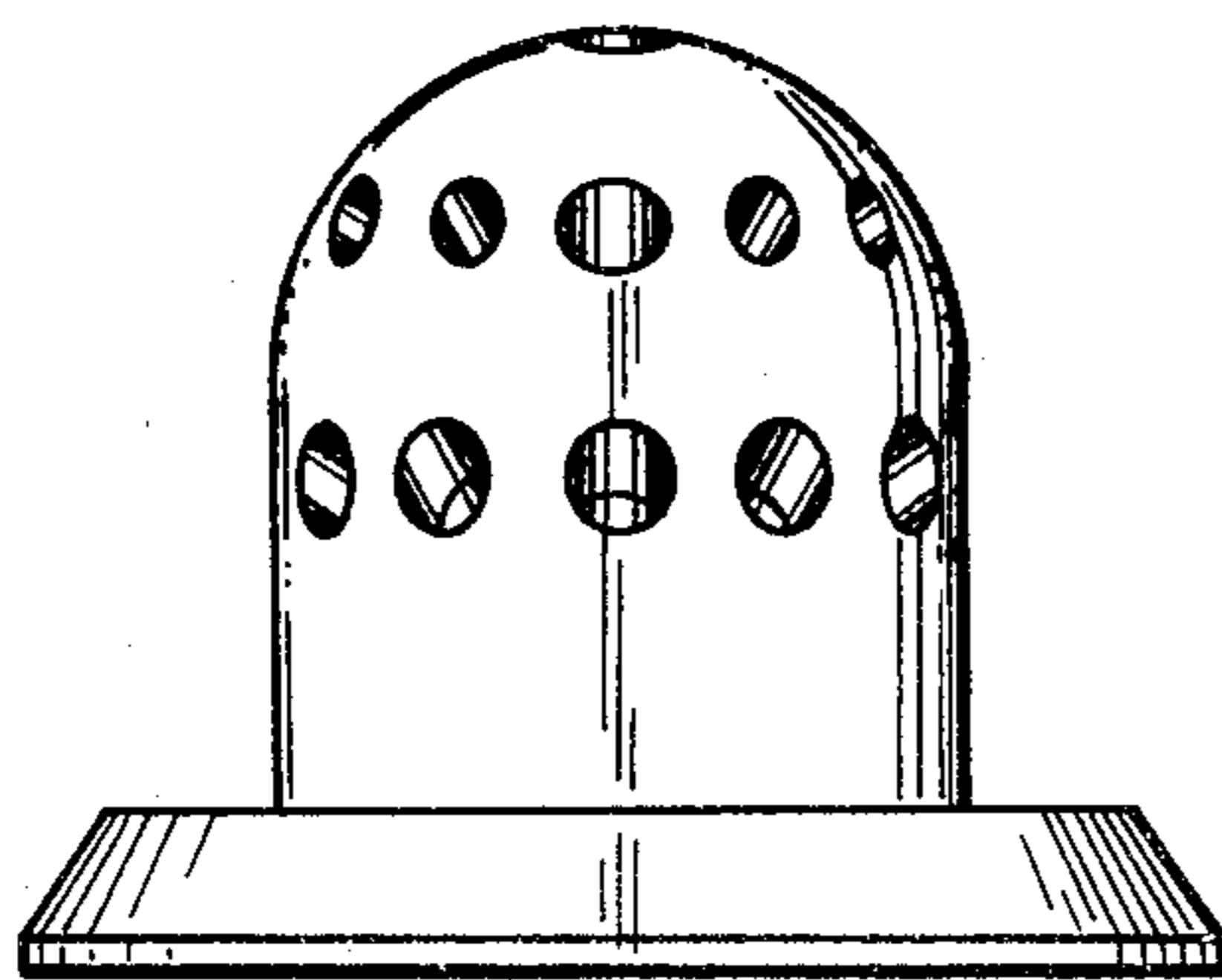
FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a toothpick holder showing my new design; the broken line showing of the toothpicks being for illustrative purposes only.

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof; and

FIG. 4 is a sectional view thereof taken along the line 4—4 of FIG. 2 with toothpicks being shown in broken lines for illustrative purposes only.

The bottom of the design is flat and unornamented.



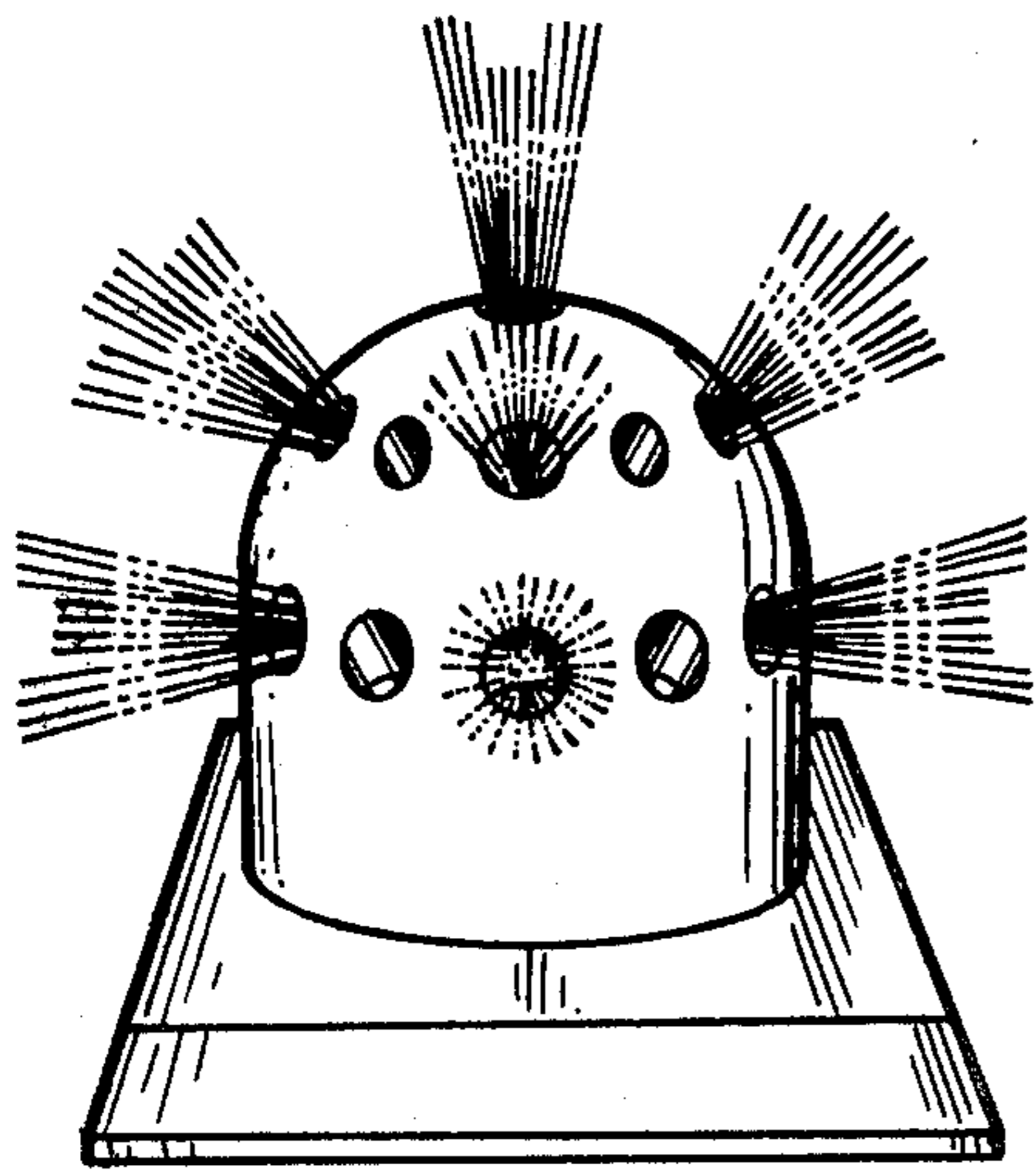

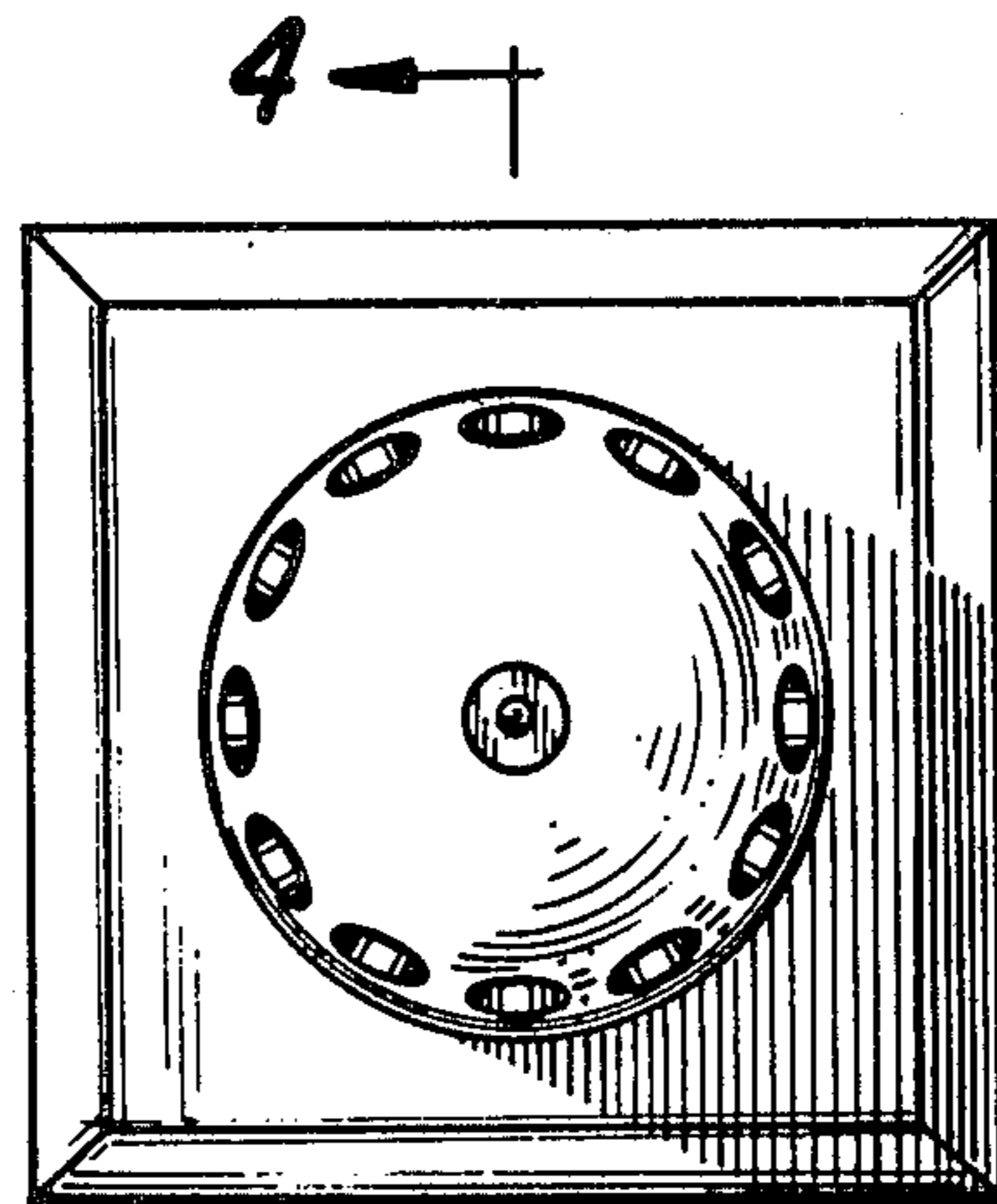

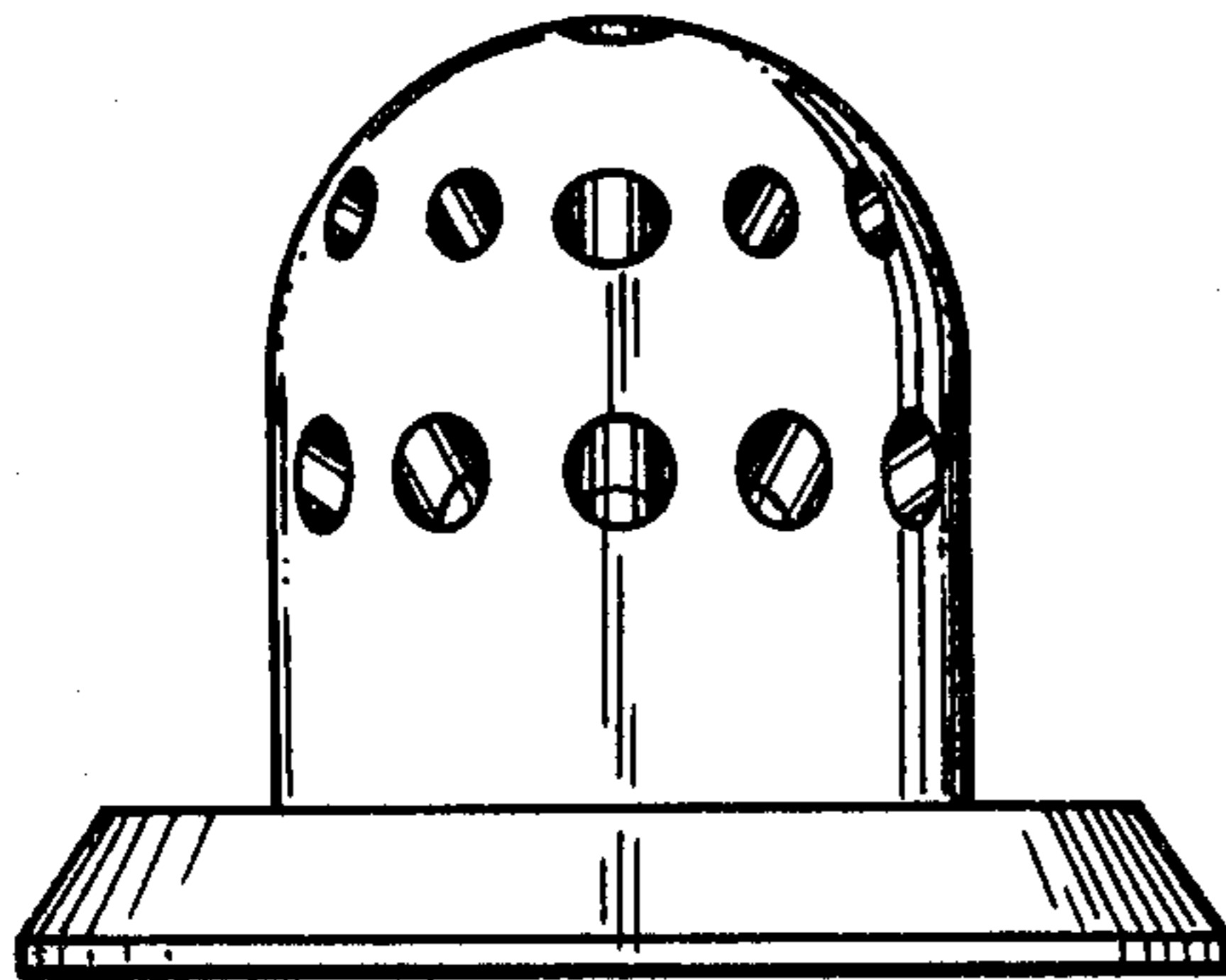

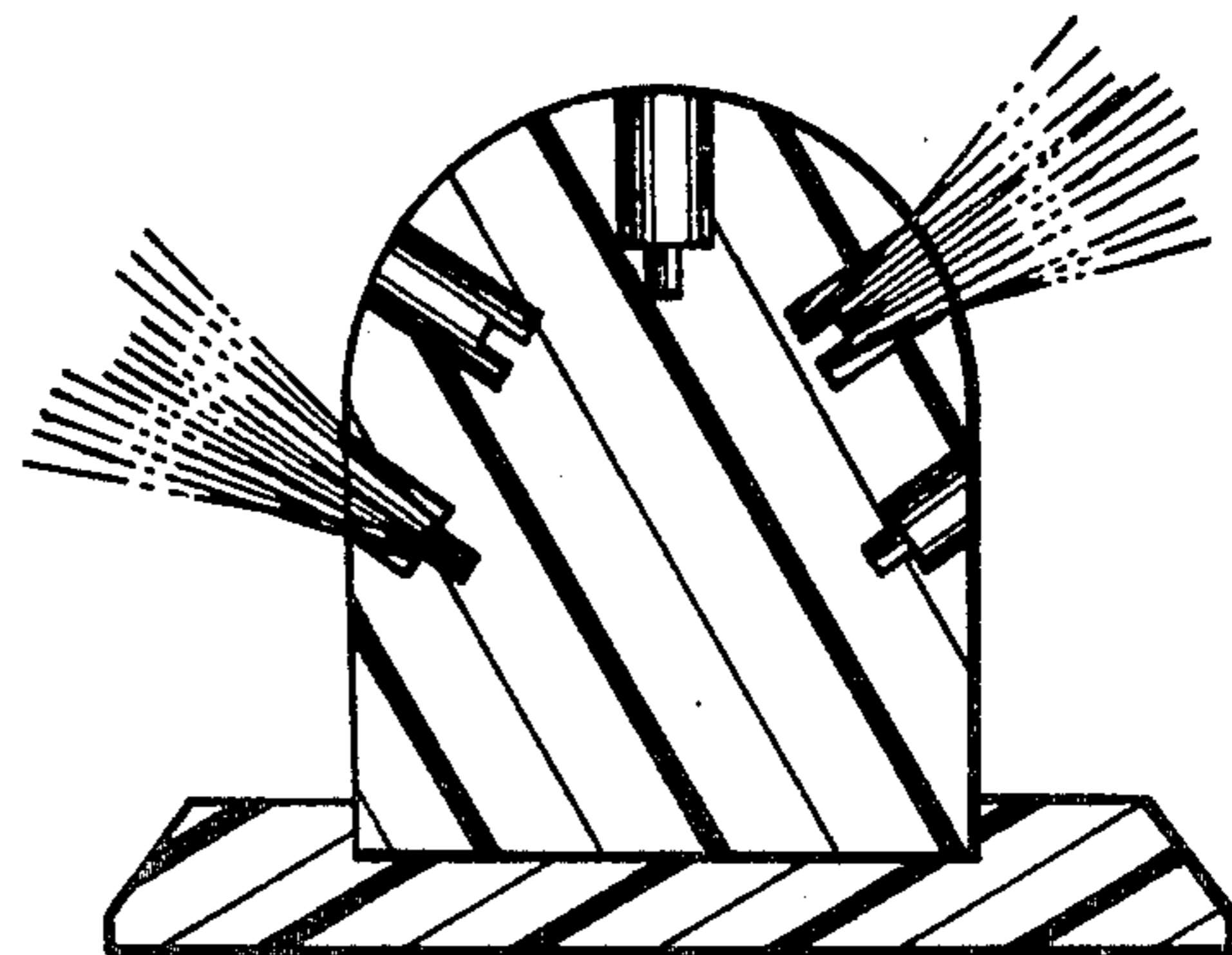
