[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a disc jockey's combined phonograph, mixer and console, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a disc jockey's combined phonograph, mixer and console showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view;

FIG. 6 is a right side elevational view;

FIG. 7 is a sectional view taken along line 7—7 in FIG. 4; and

FIG. 8 is a left side elevational view.

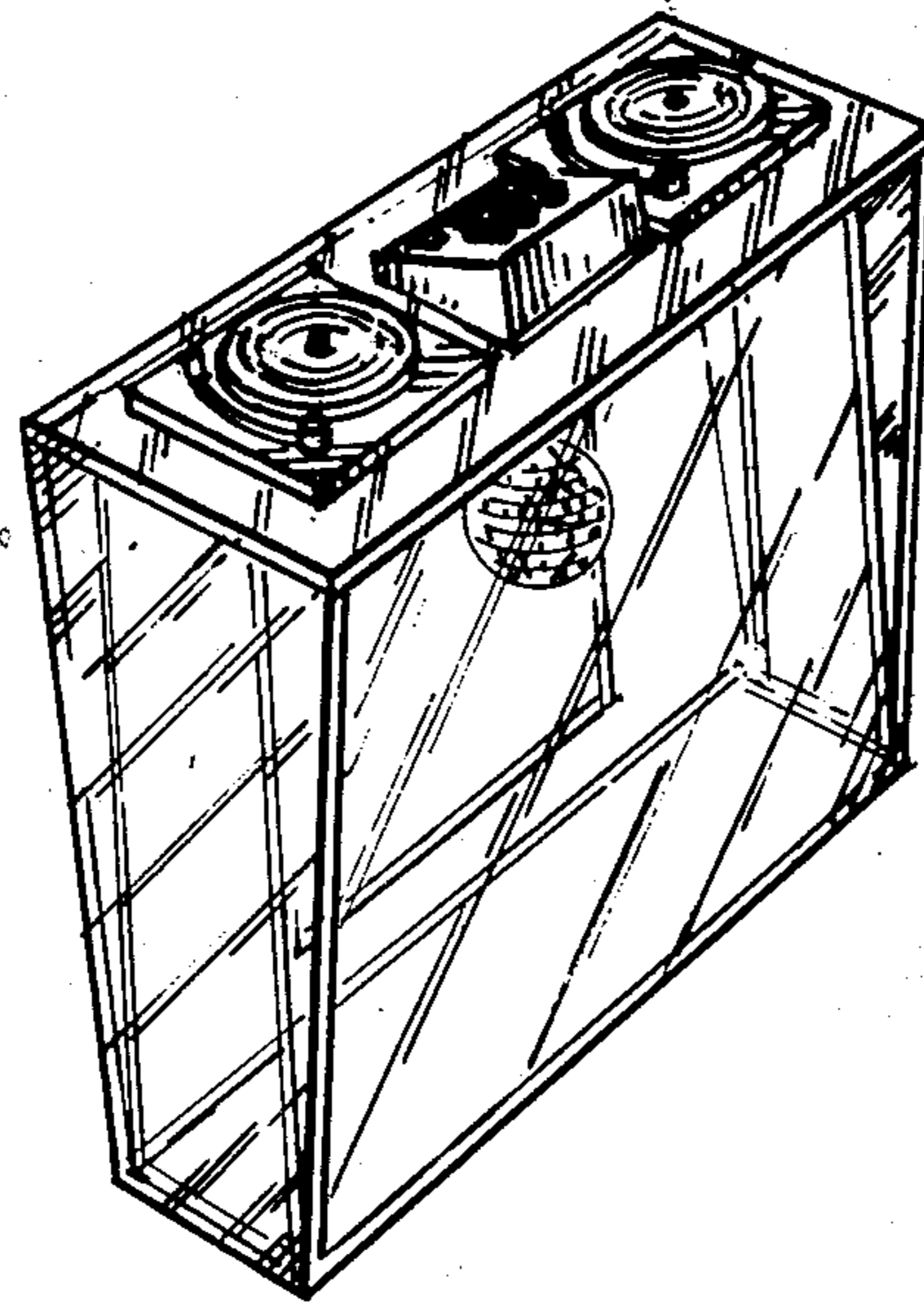

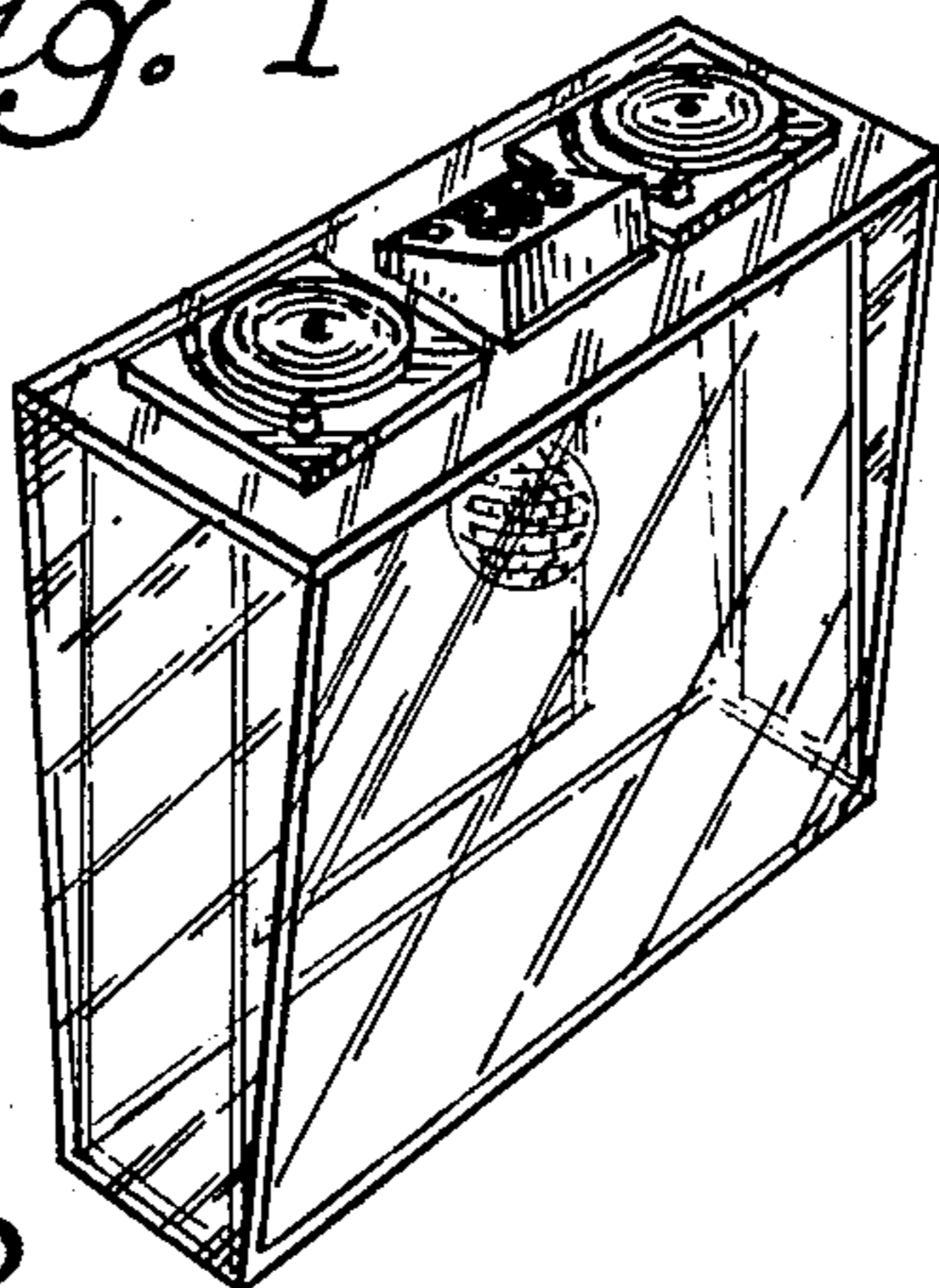

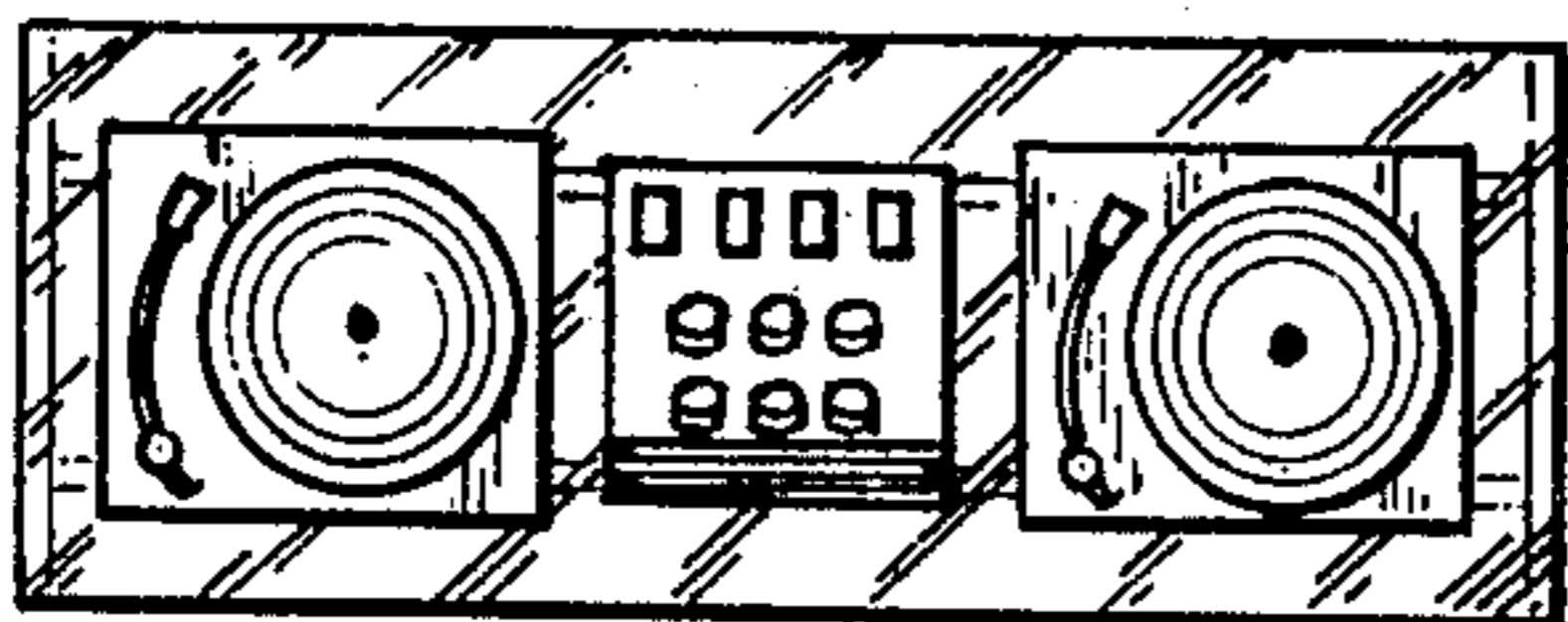

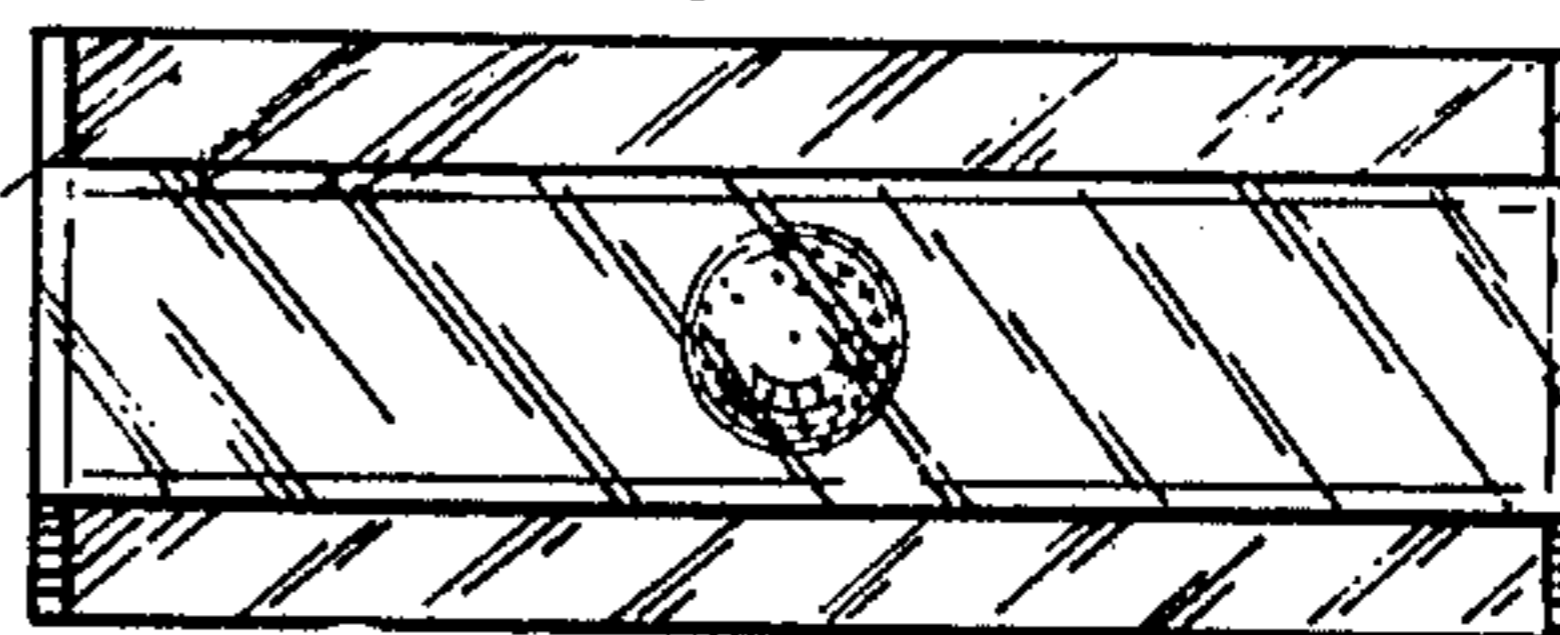

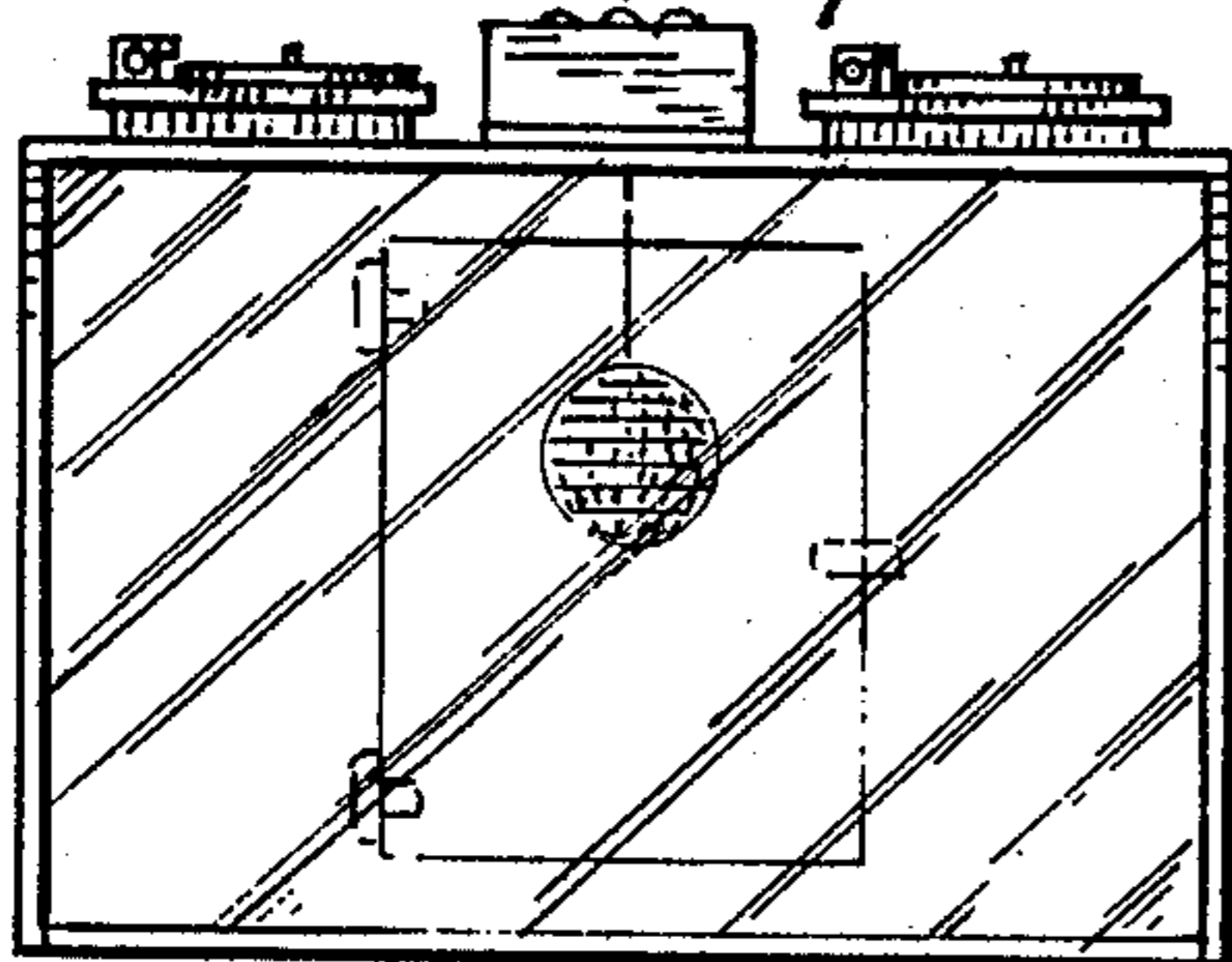

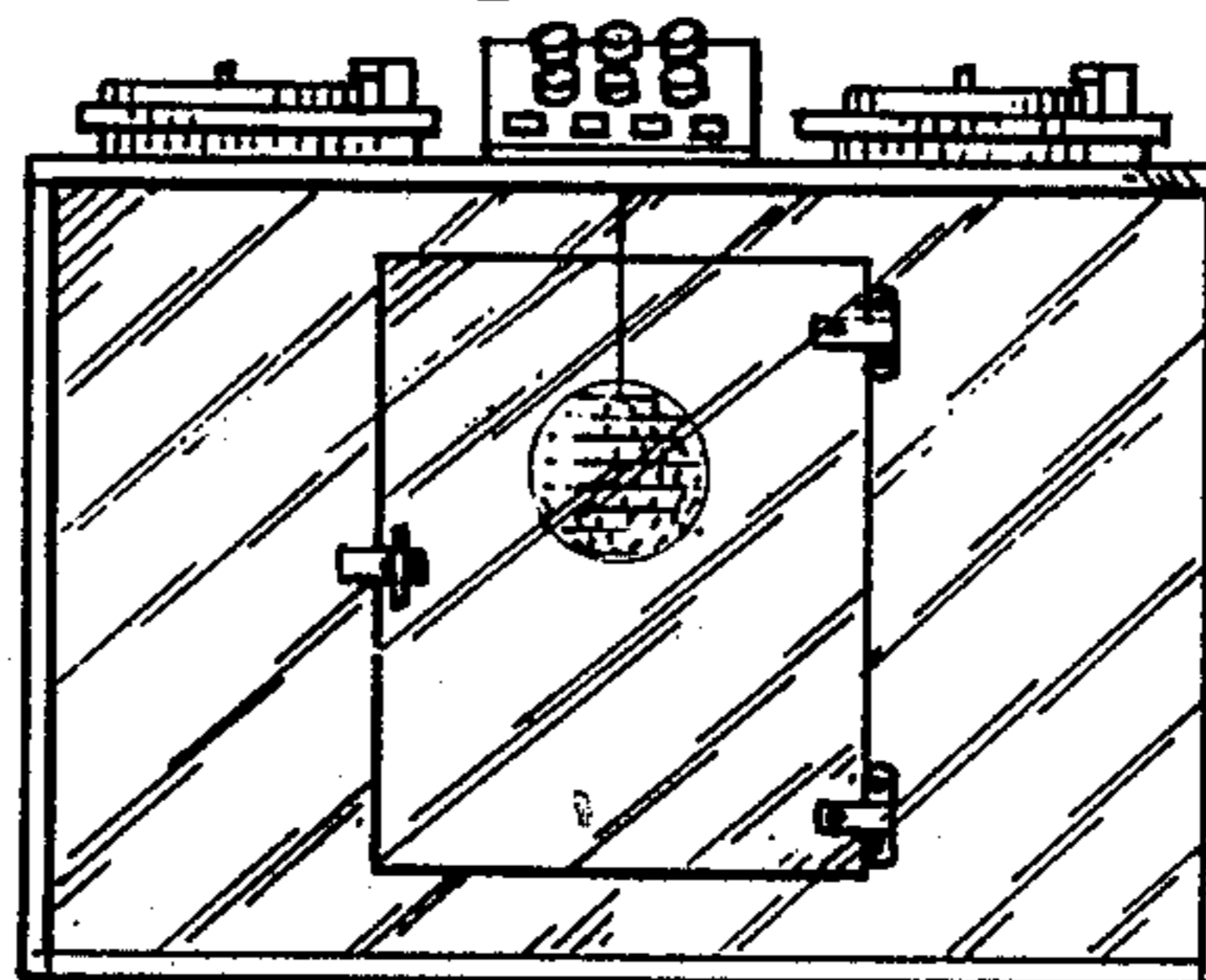

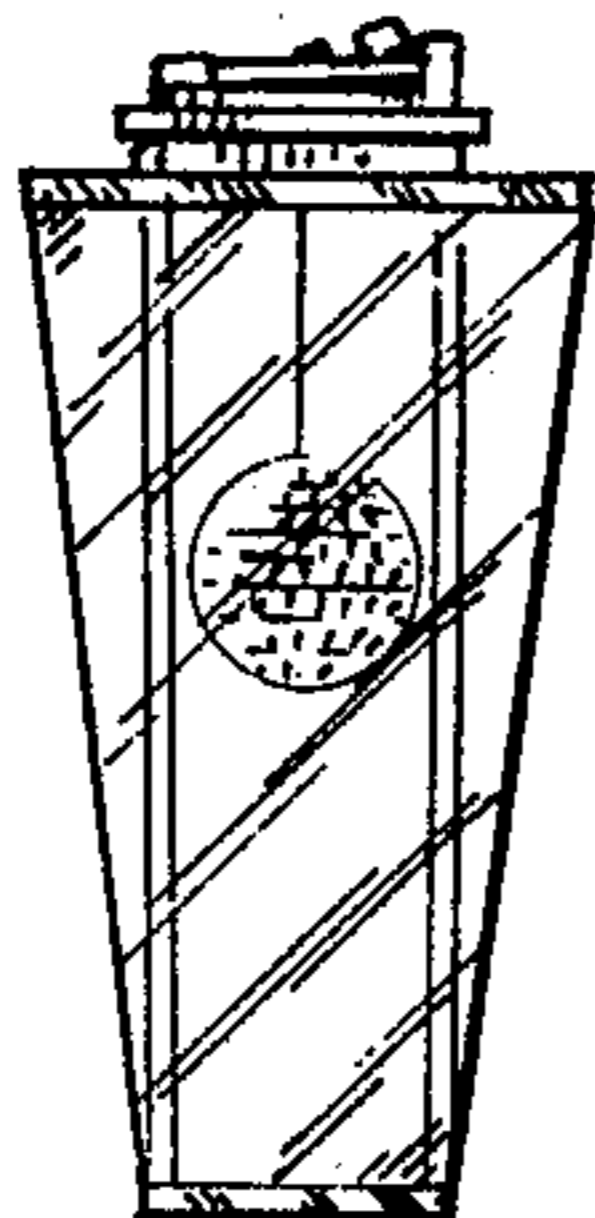

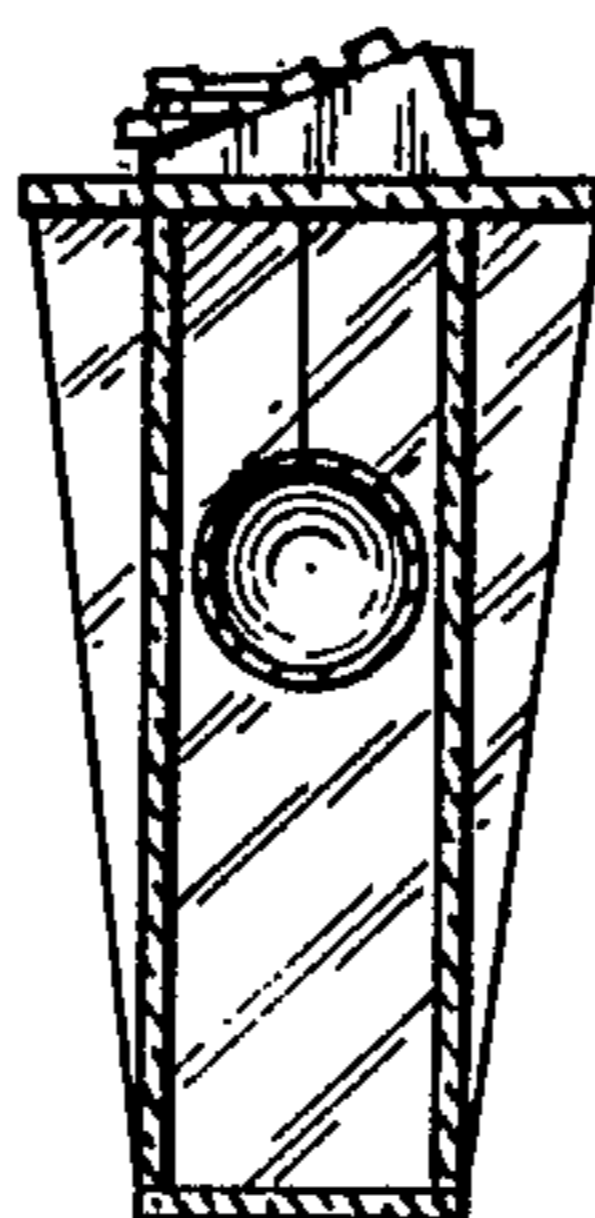
