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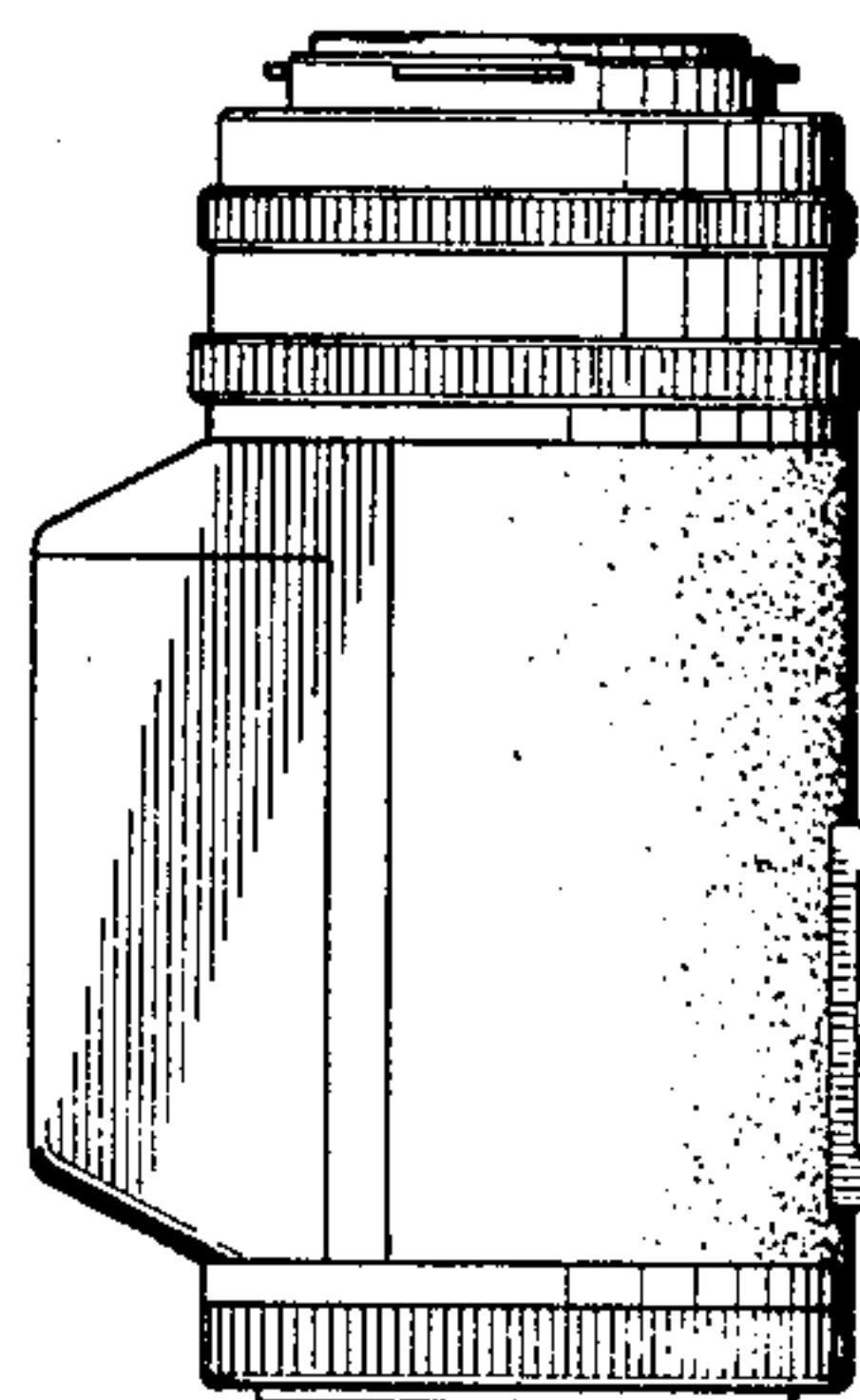
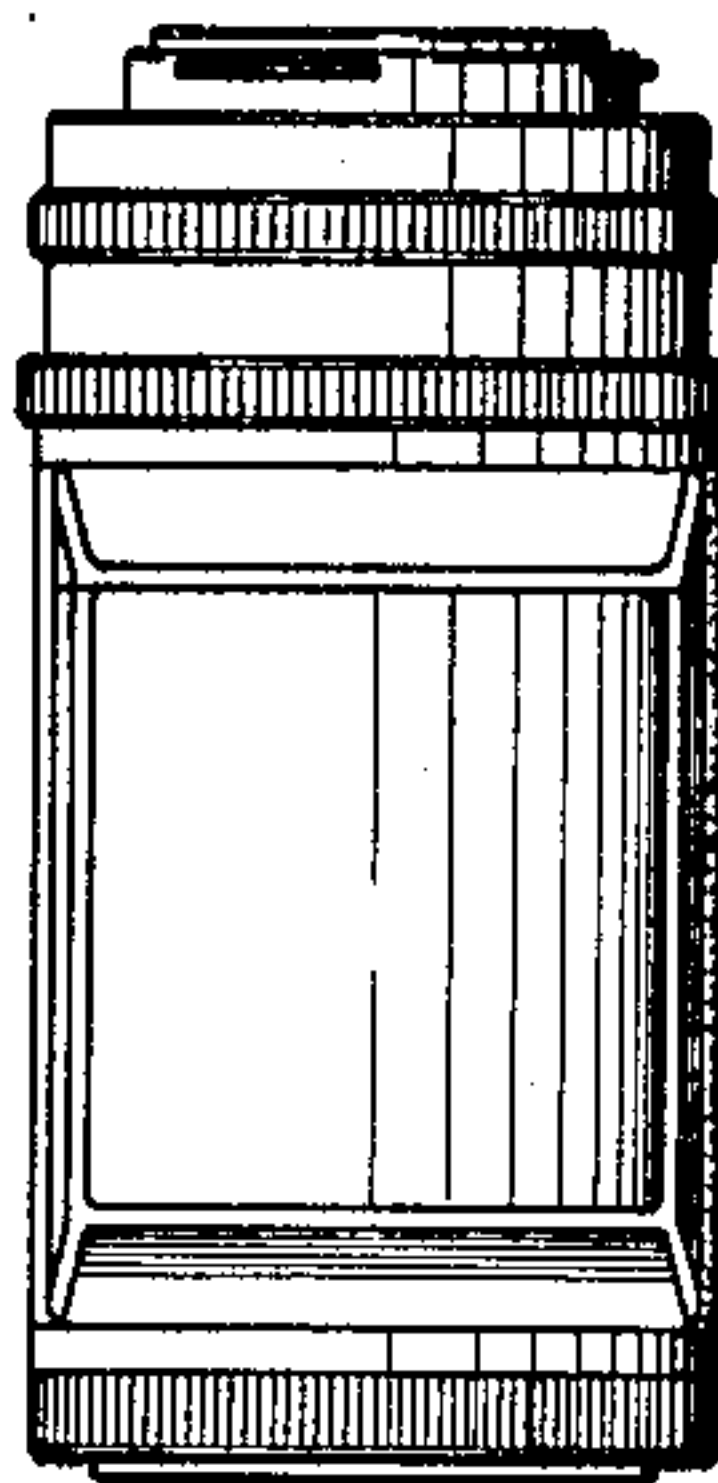

The ornamental design for an electromotive camera lens or similar article, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of an electromotive camera lens or similar article, showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof; FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof; and FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view thereof. The electromotive camera lens or similar article, substantially as shown, has a battery box at the bottom thereof and a push button at the top thereof.



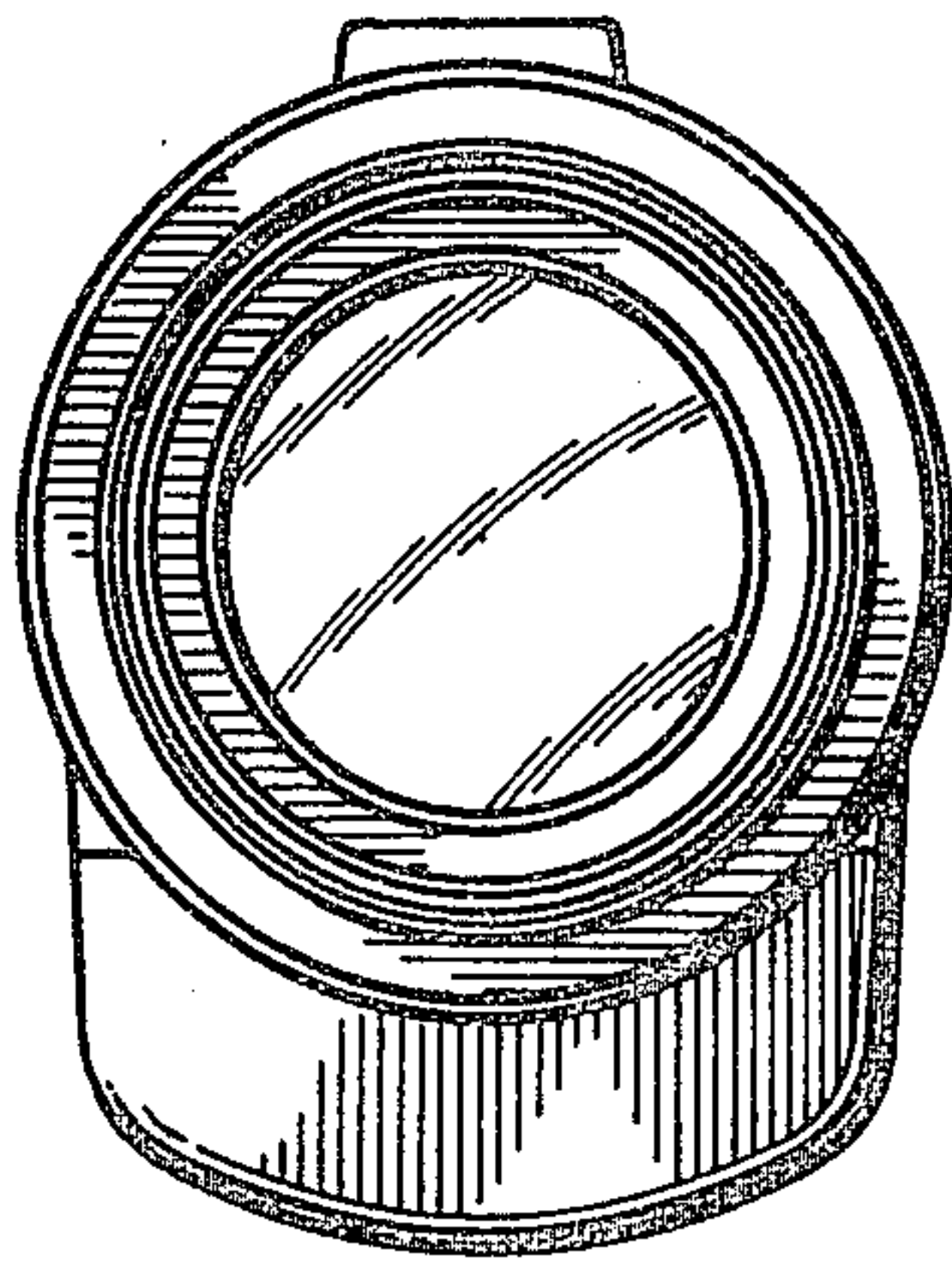

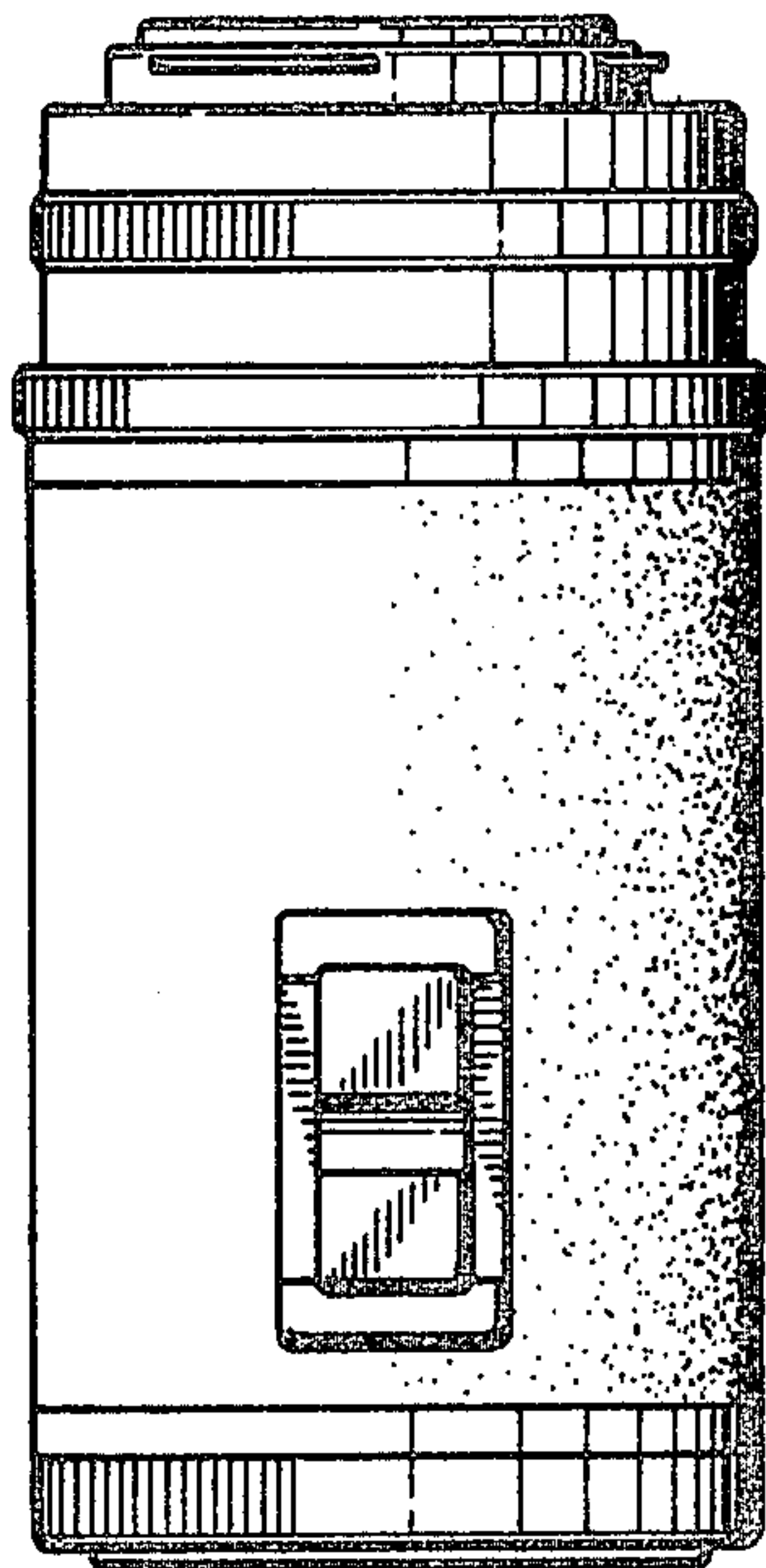

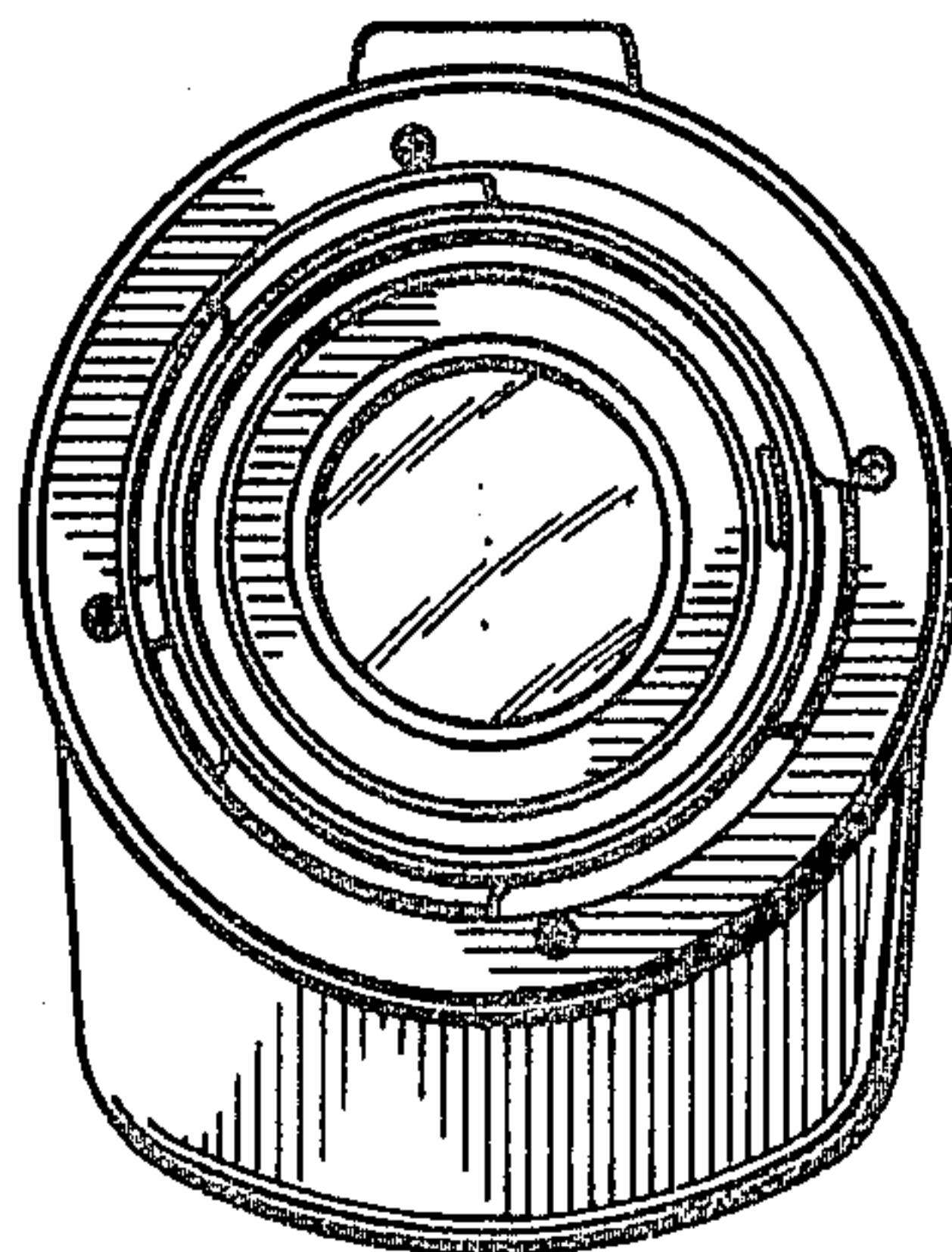

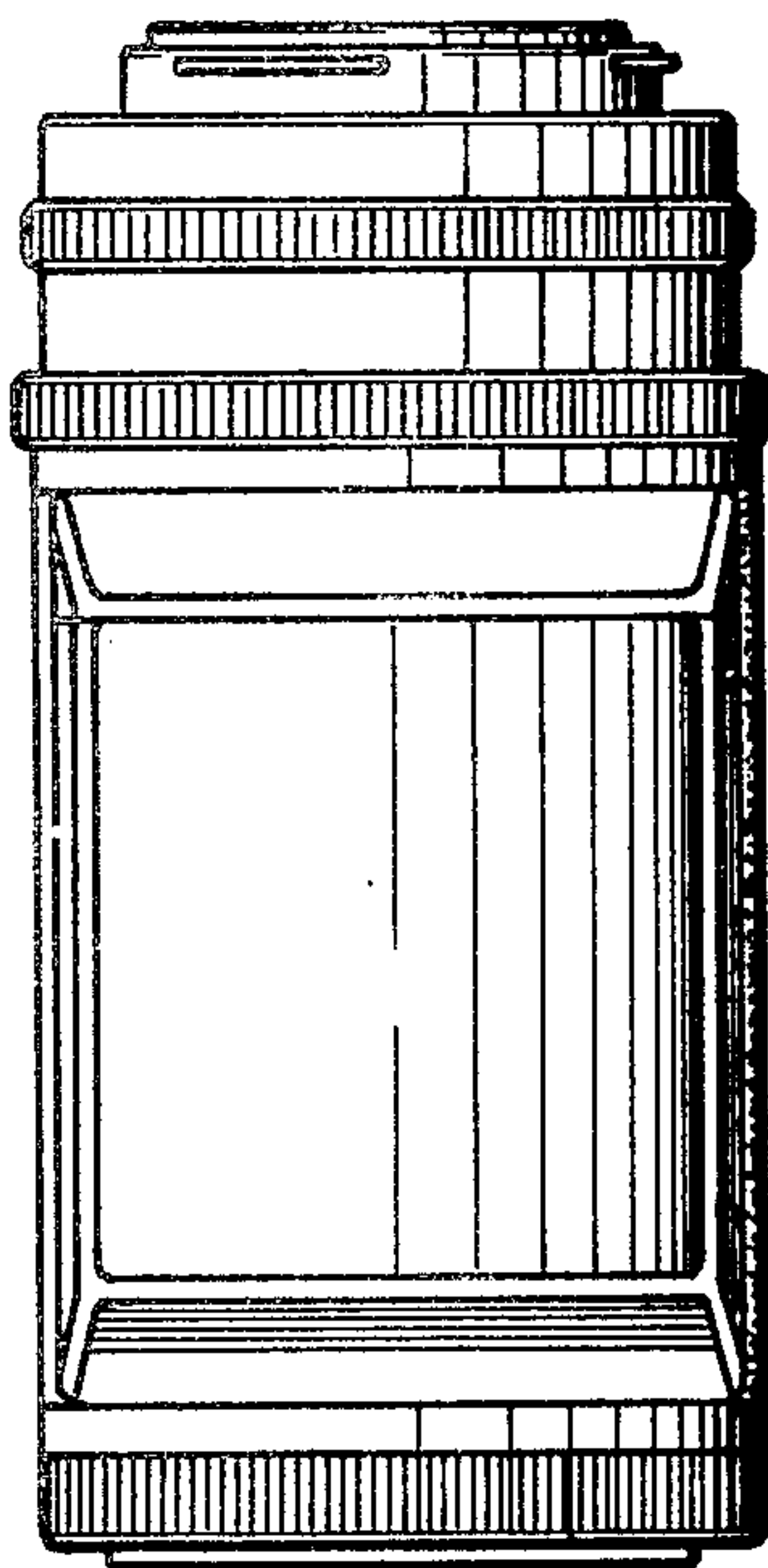

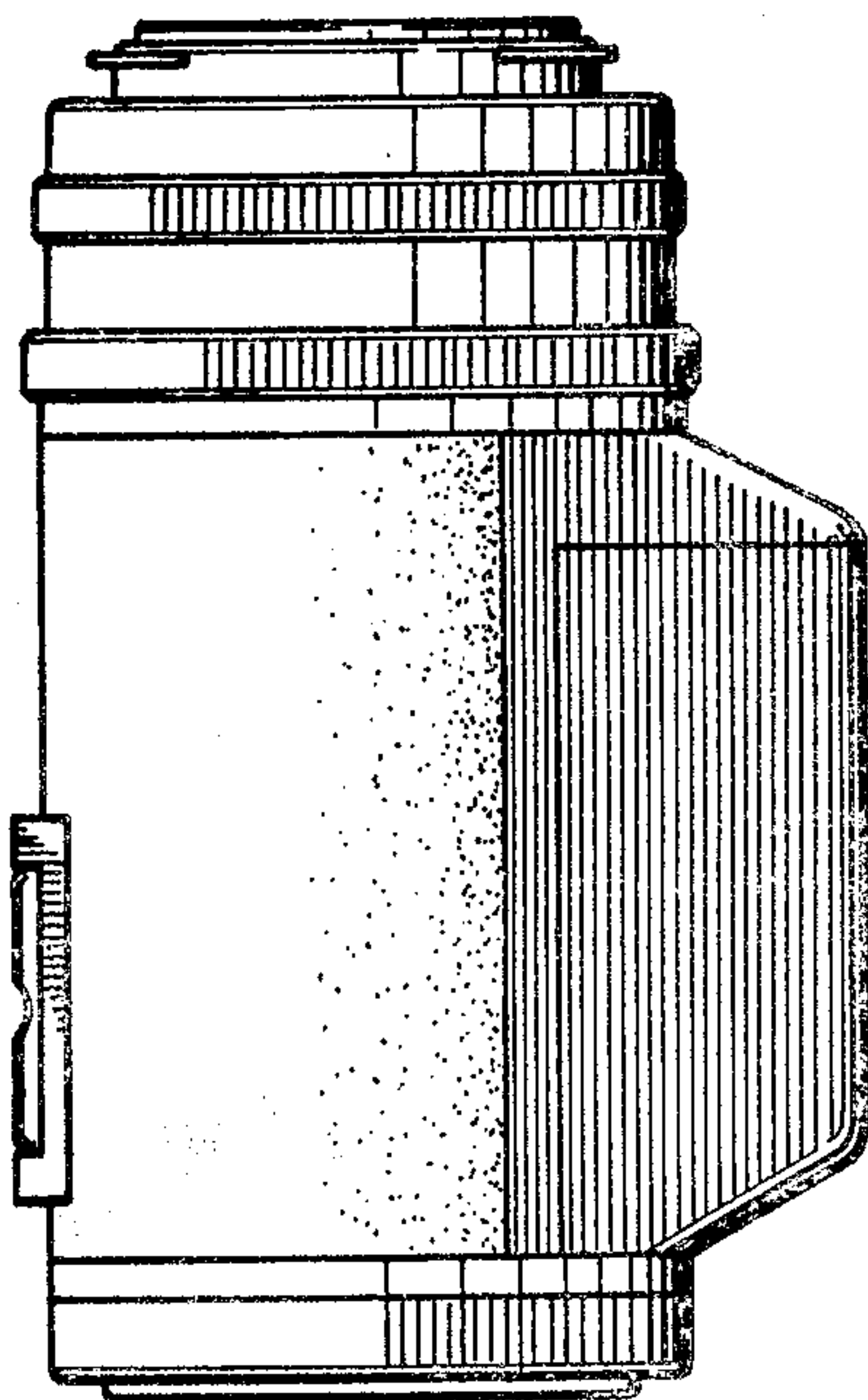

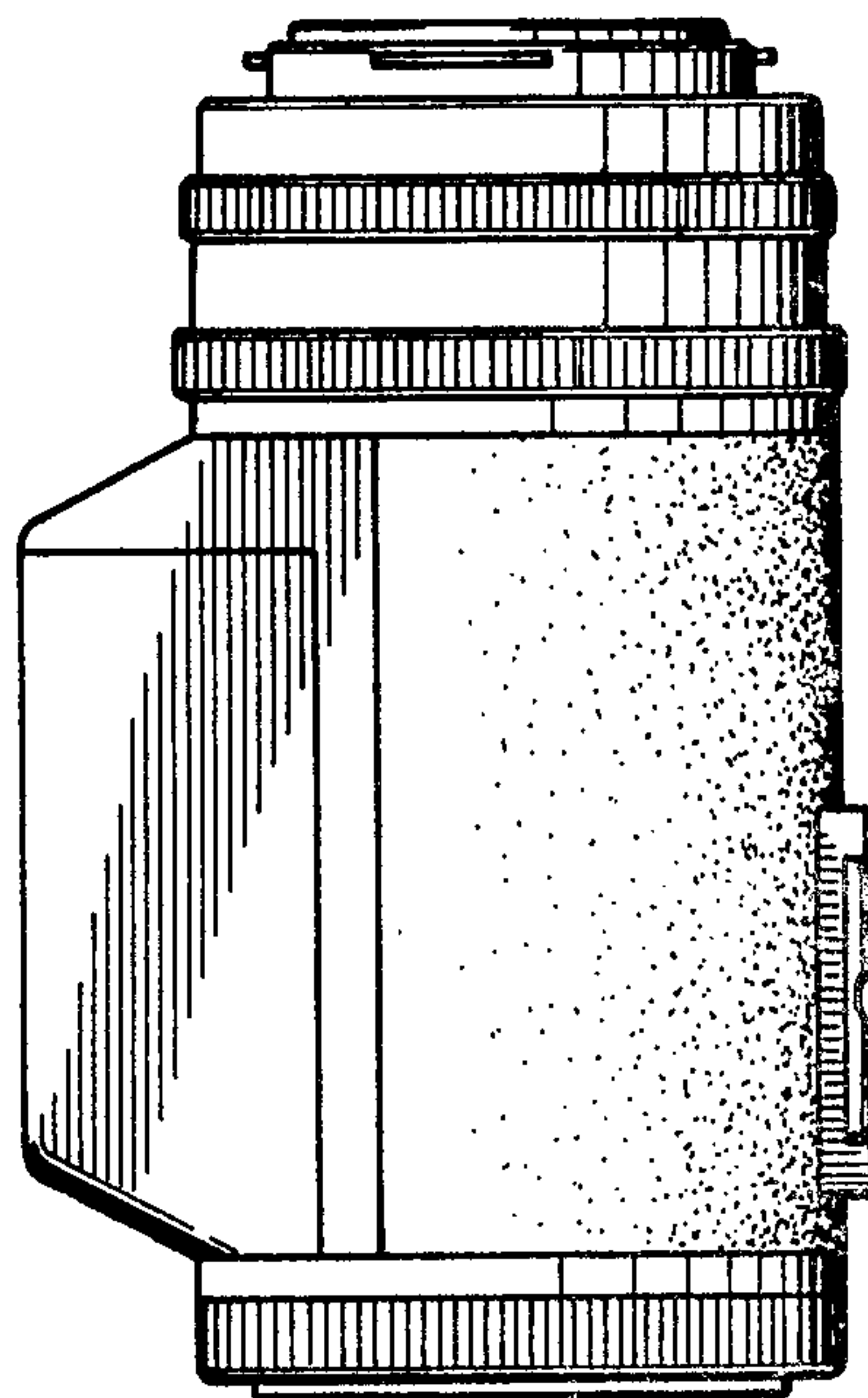
