DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a combined portable power source, light and fan, showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof on an enlarged scale;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof on an enlarged scale;

FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof on an enlarged scale; and

FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view thereof on an enlarged scale.

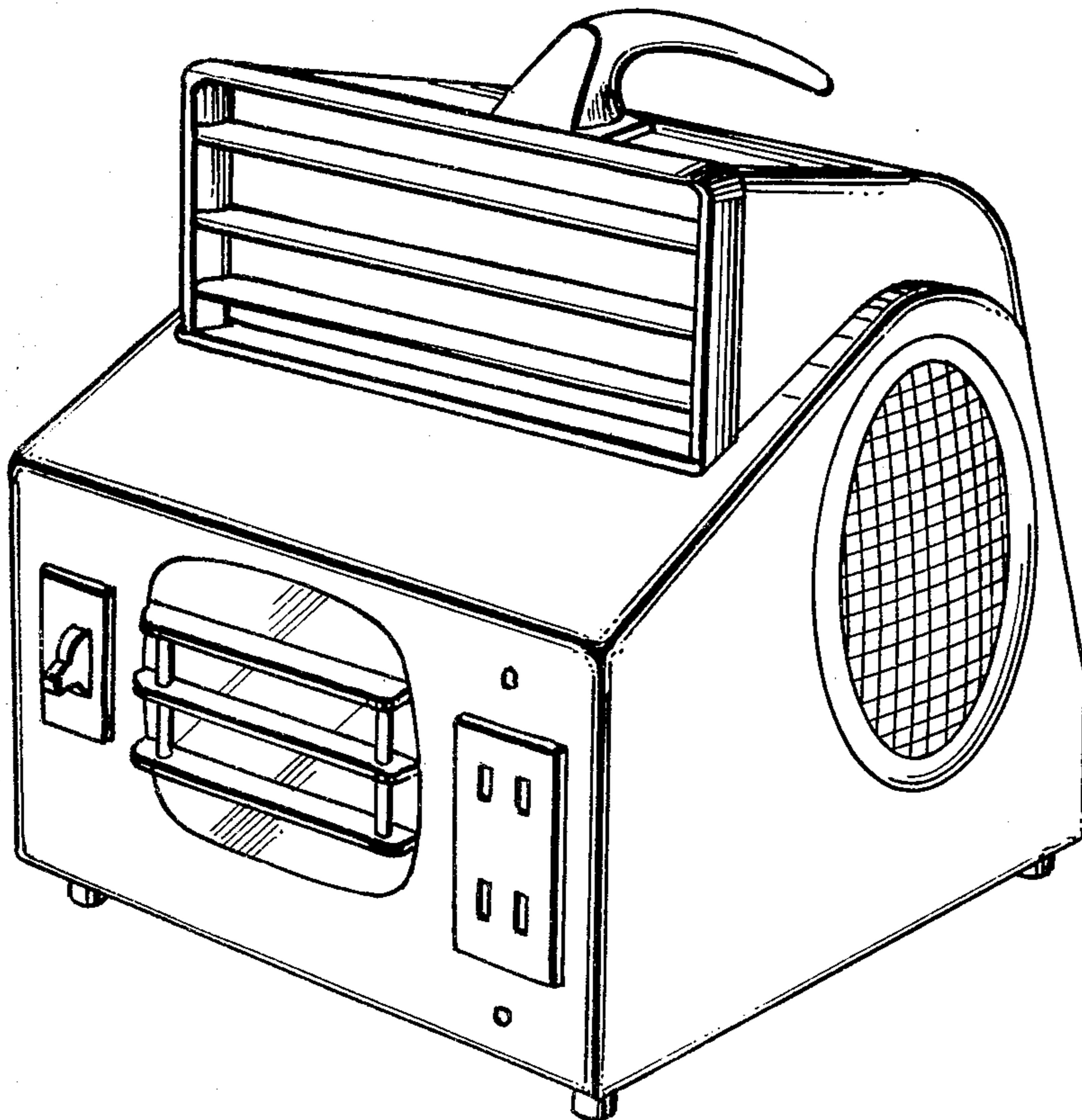

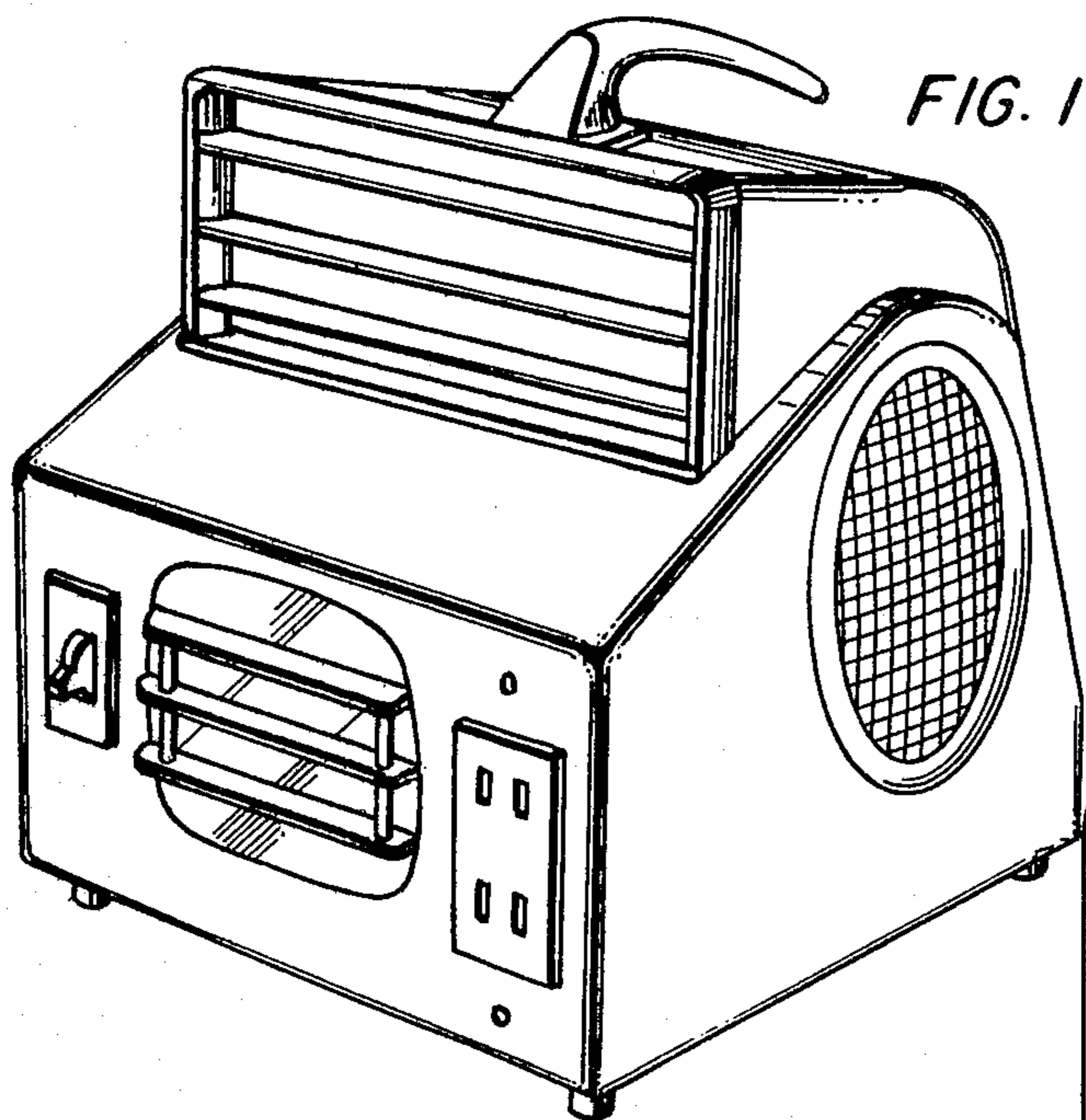
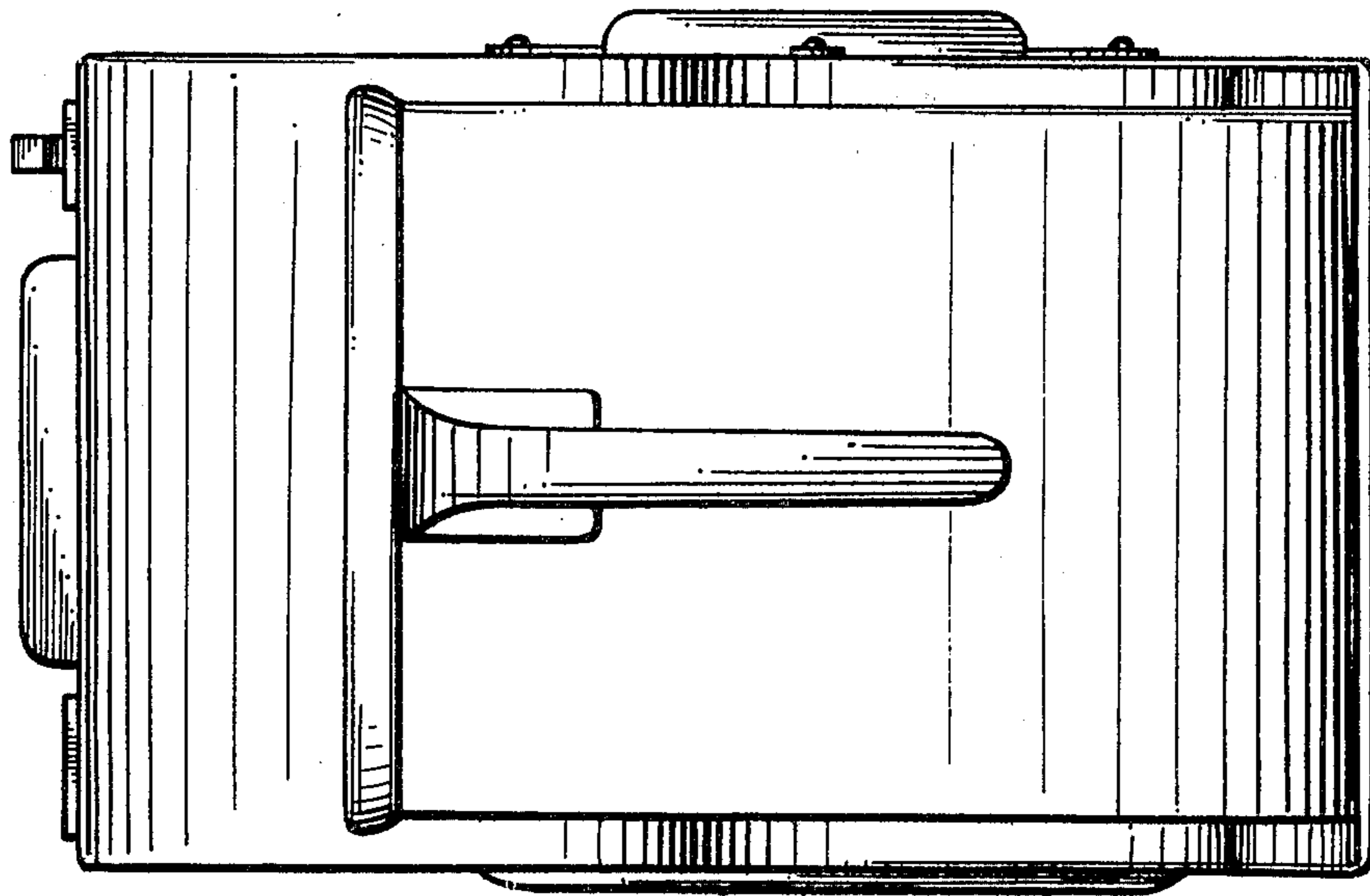

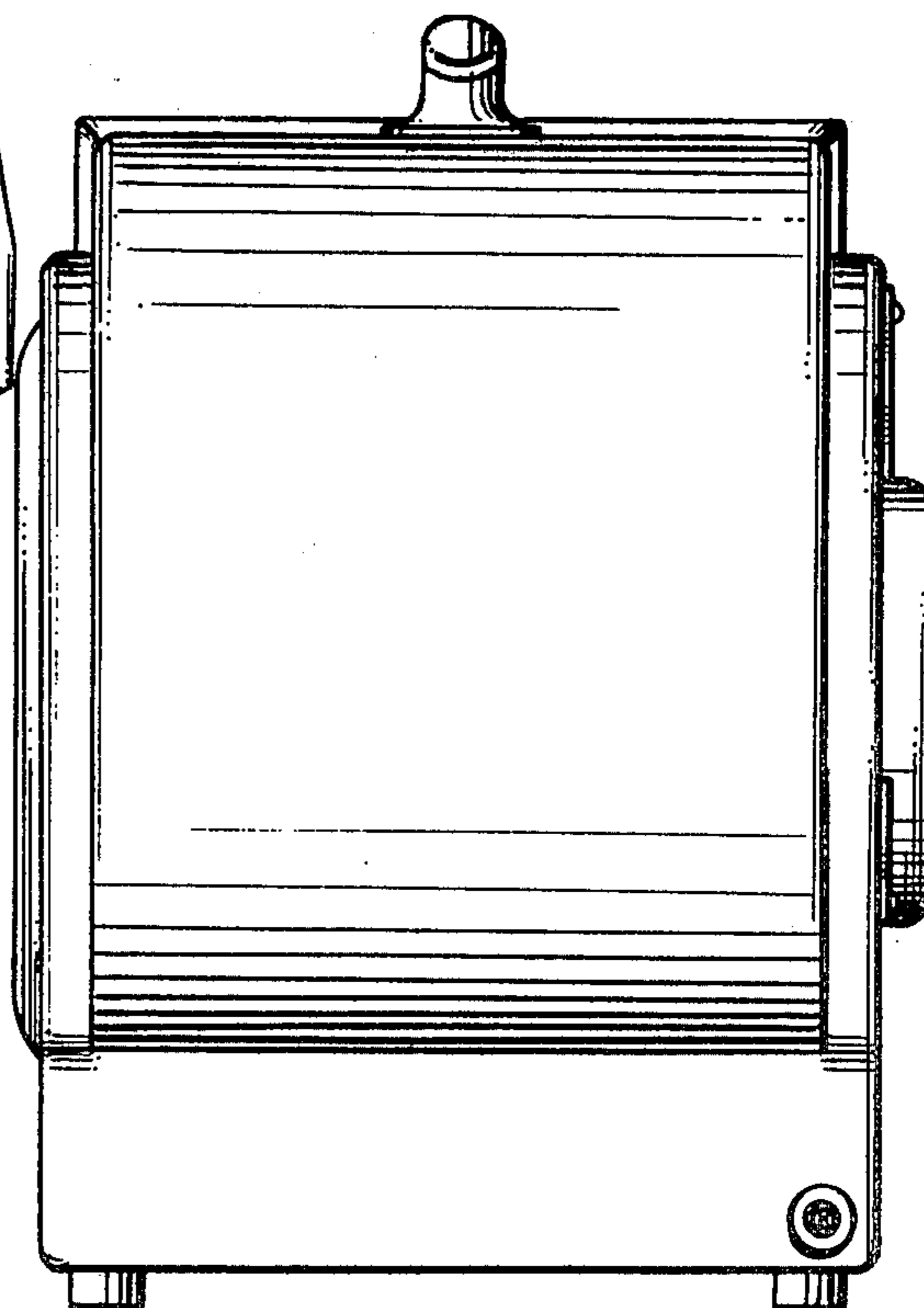

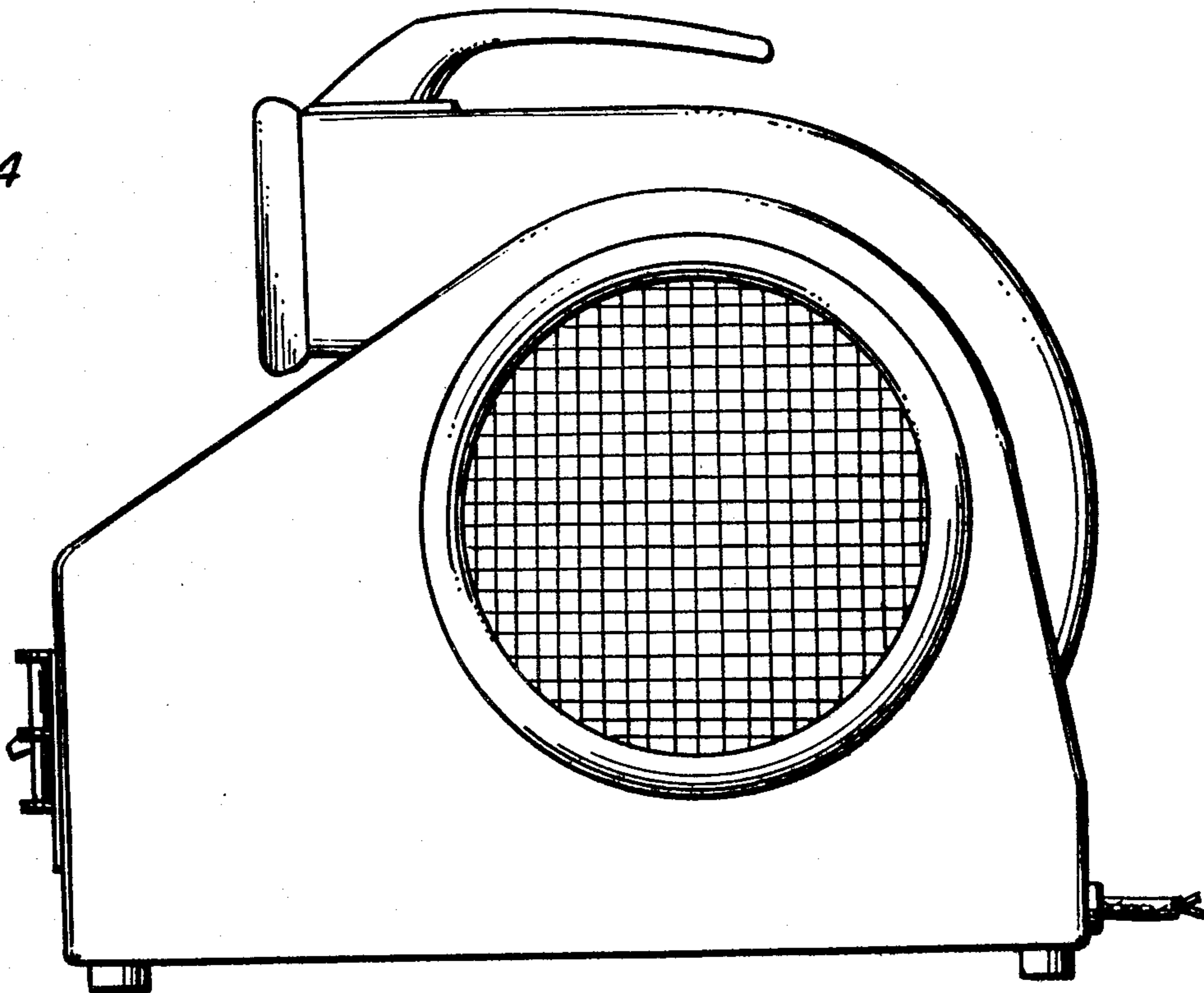
