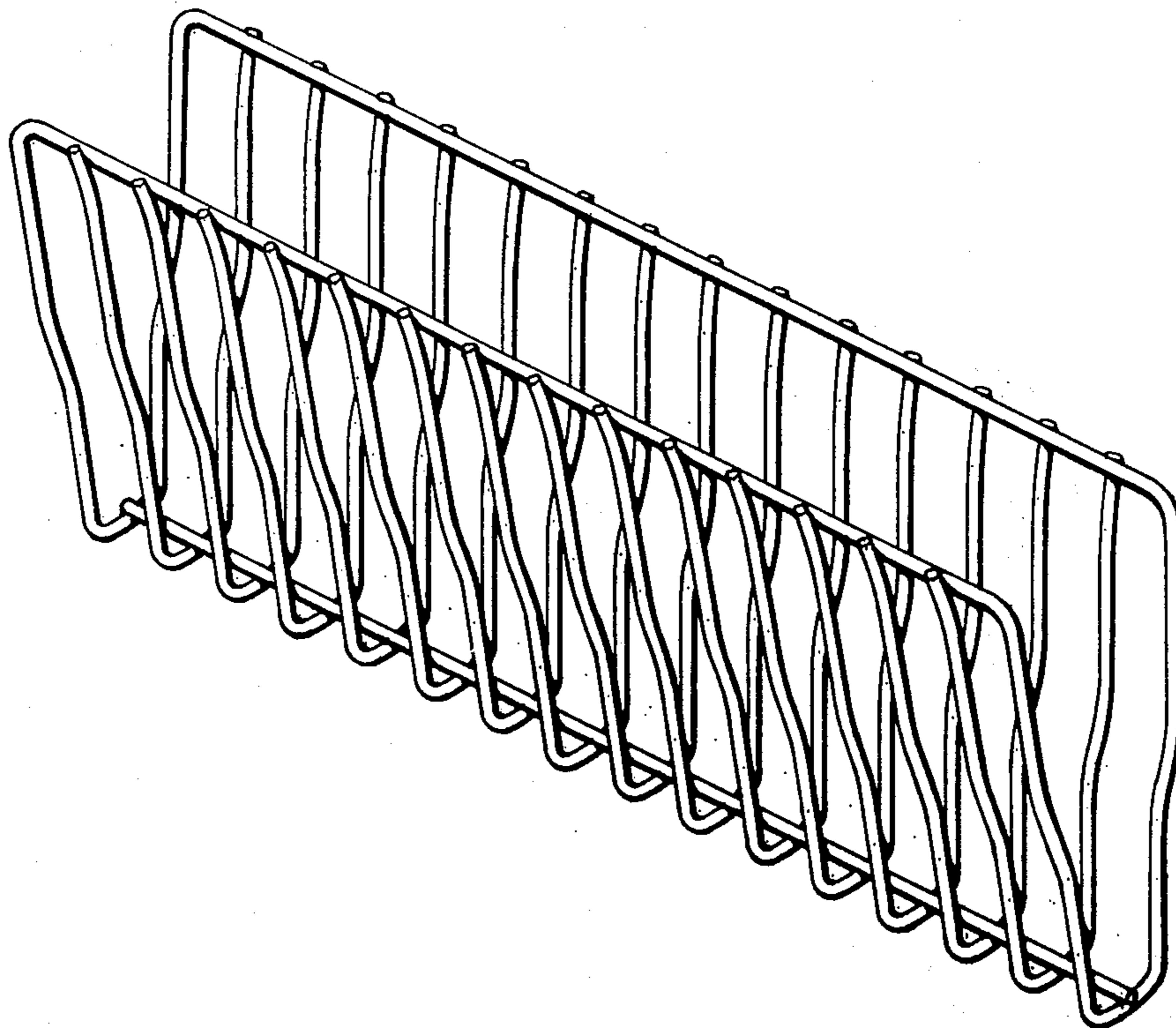

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for an elongated taco shell mold, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a left front perspective view of an elongated taco shell mold, showing my new design;  
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view, the rear elevational view being substantially a mirror image, thereof;  
FIG. 3 is an elevational view of one end, the opposite end elevational view being substantially a mirror image, thereof;  
FIG. 4 is a top plan view; and,  
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view.



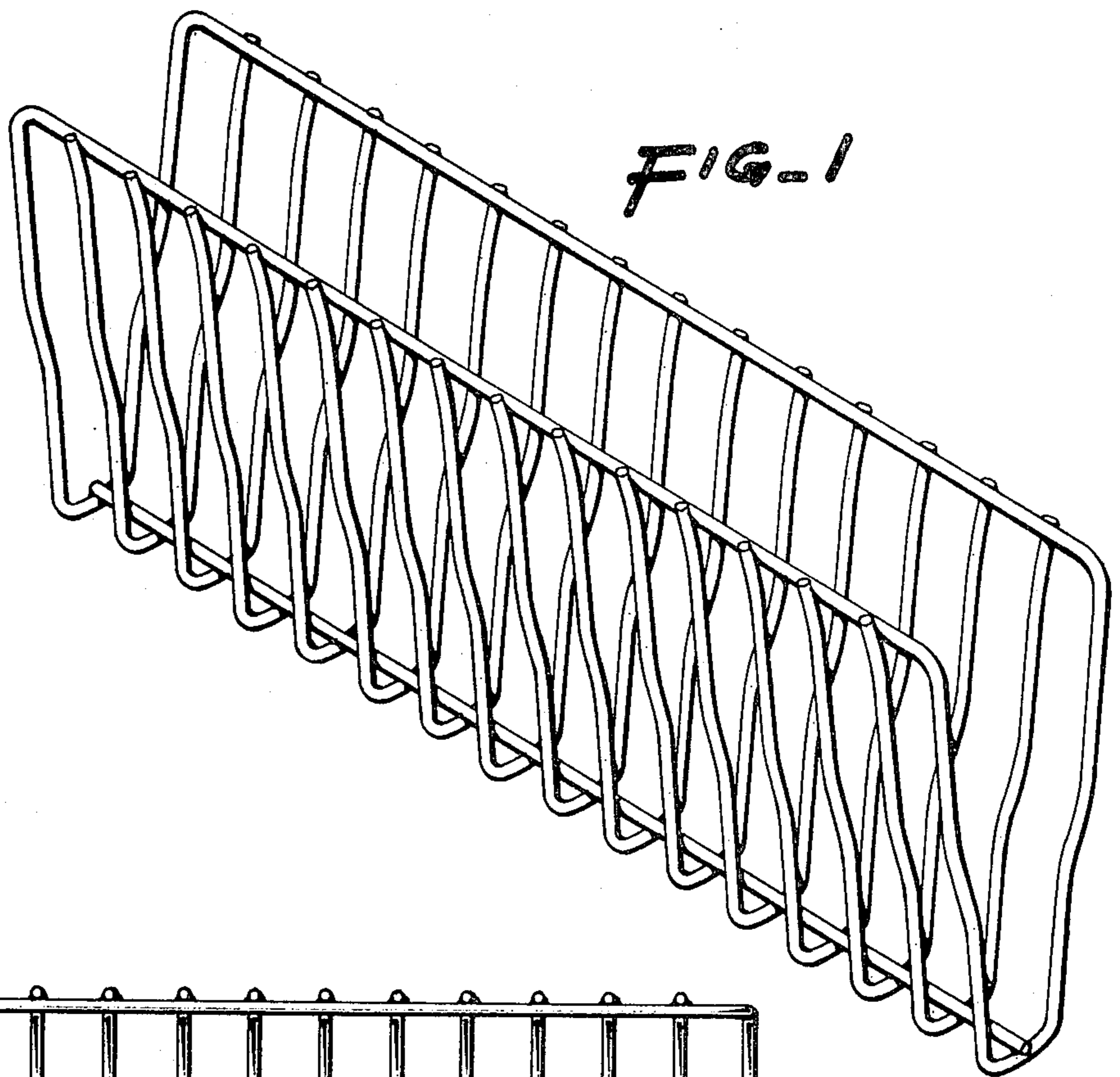

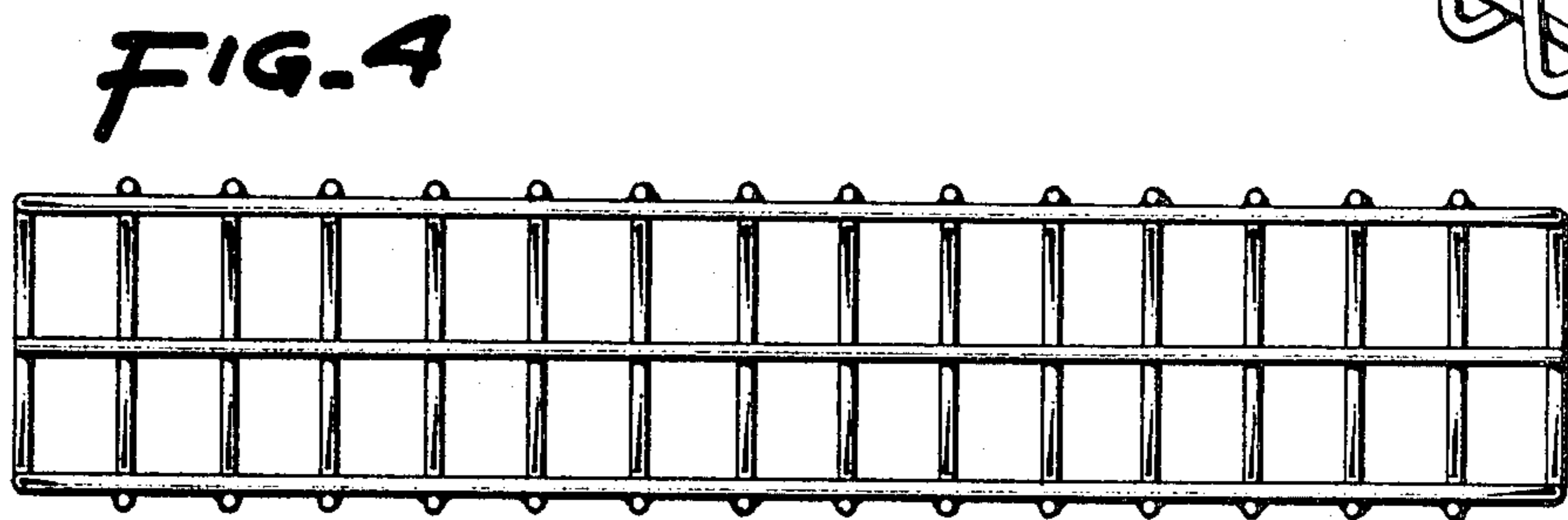

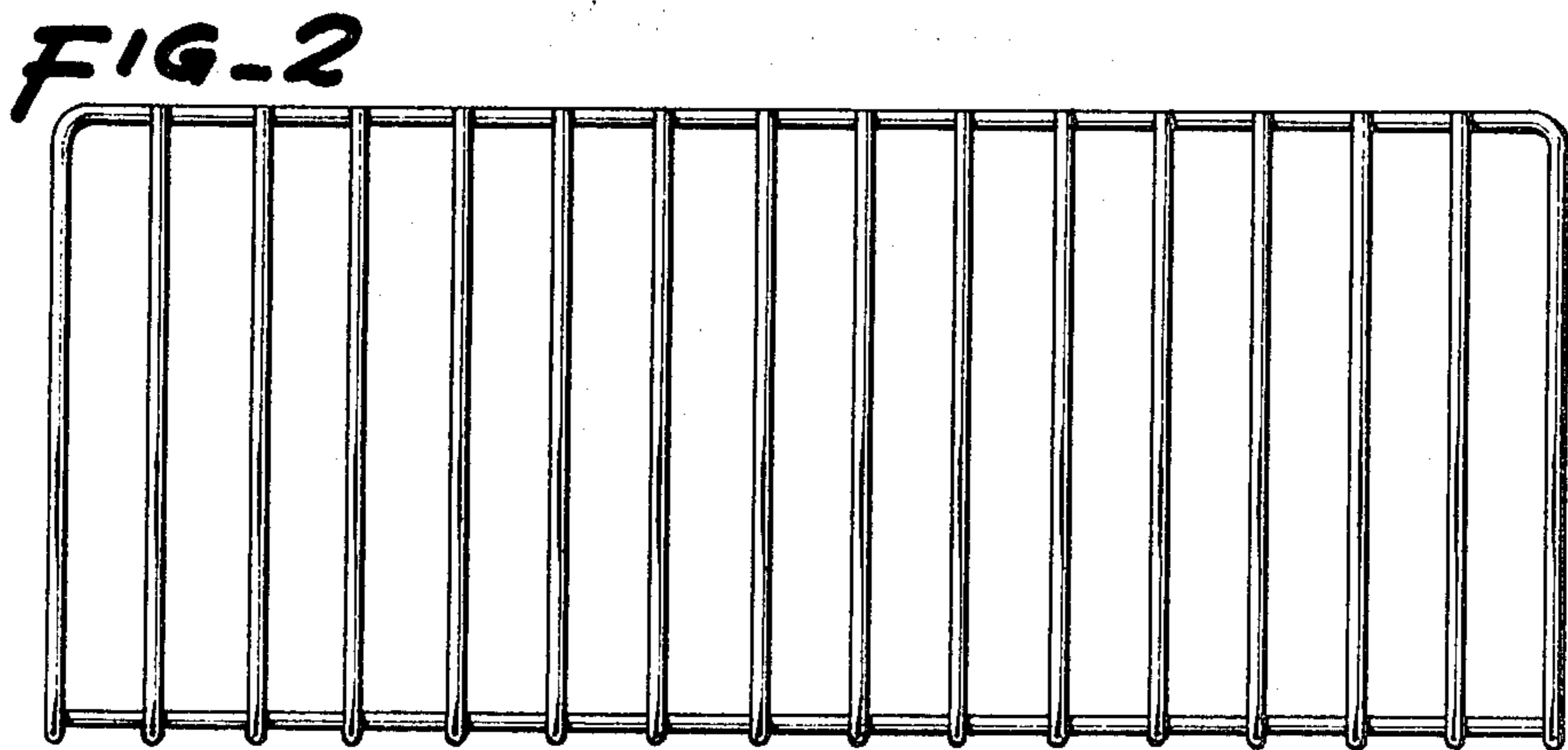

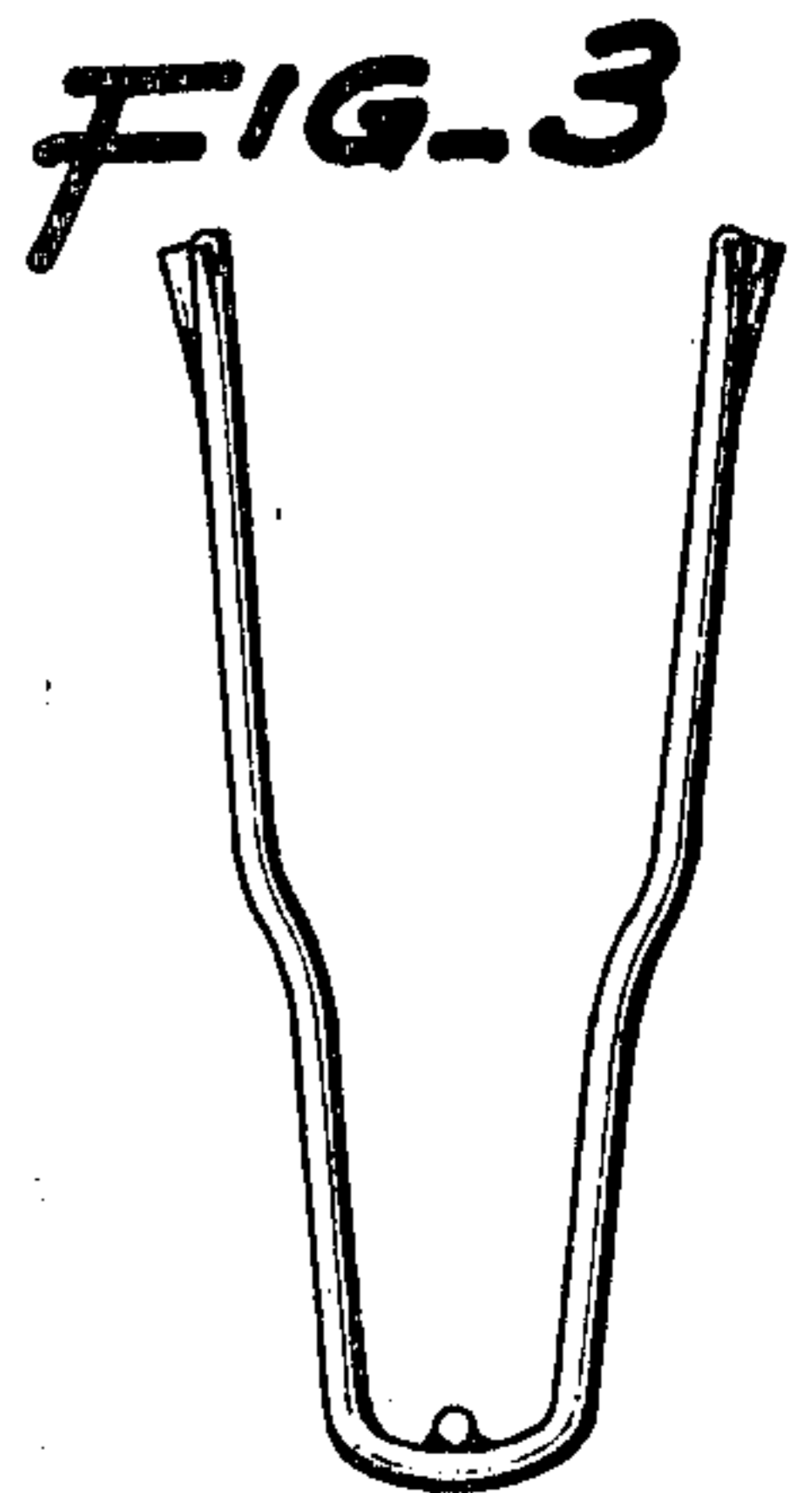

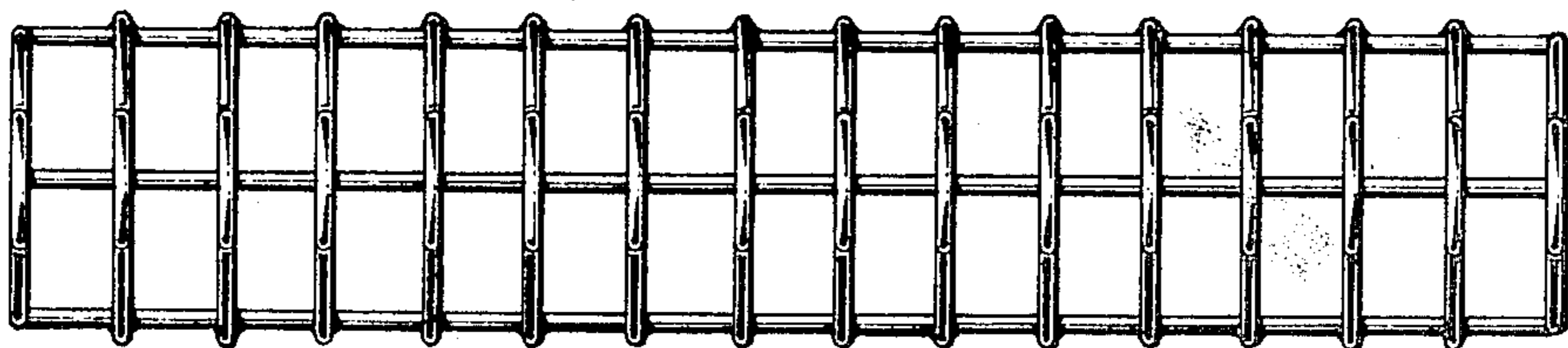
