The ornamental design for a wire puzzle, substantially as shown.

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.

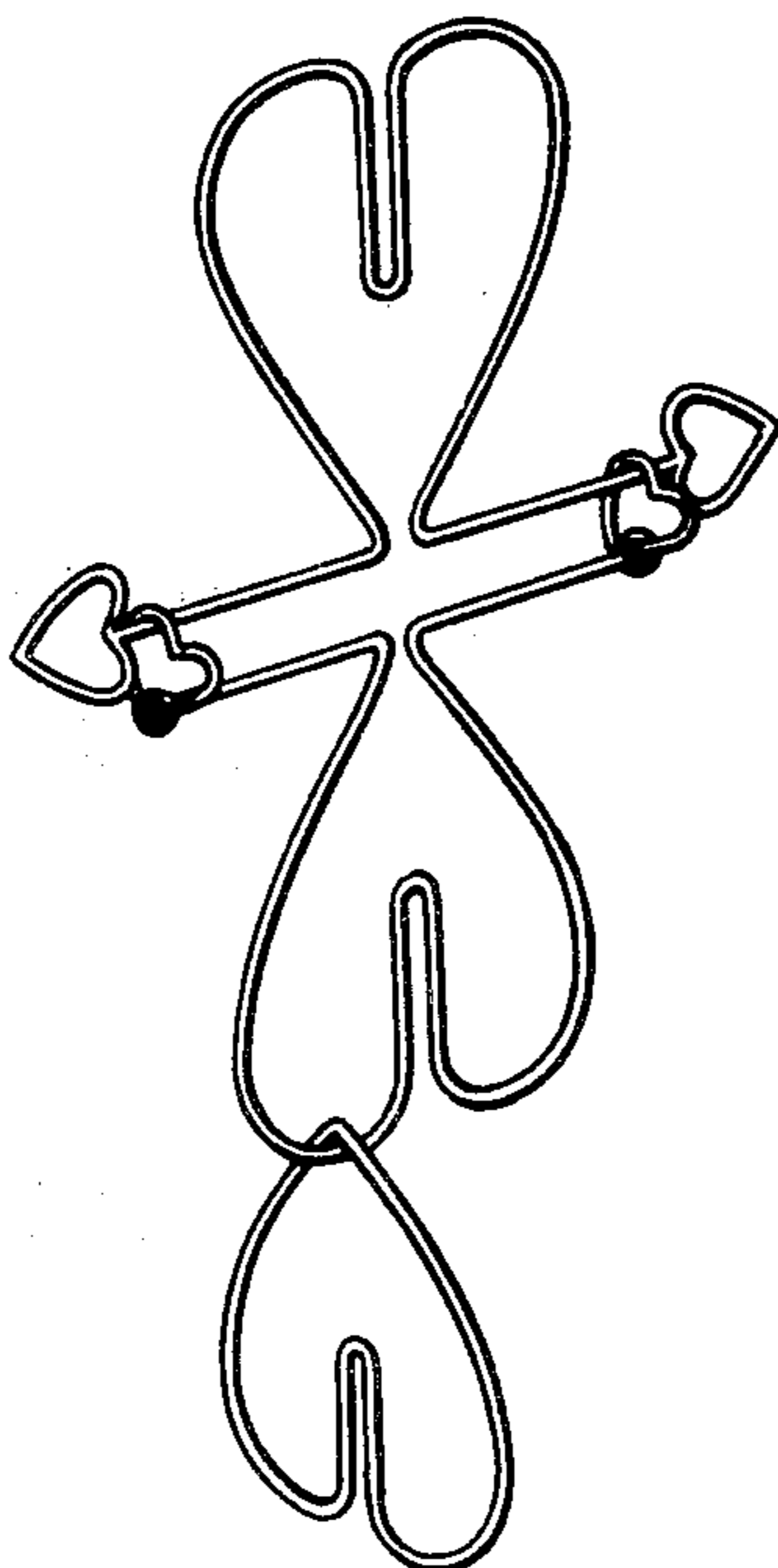

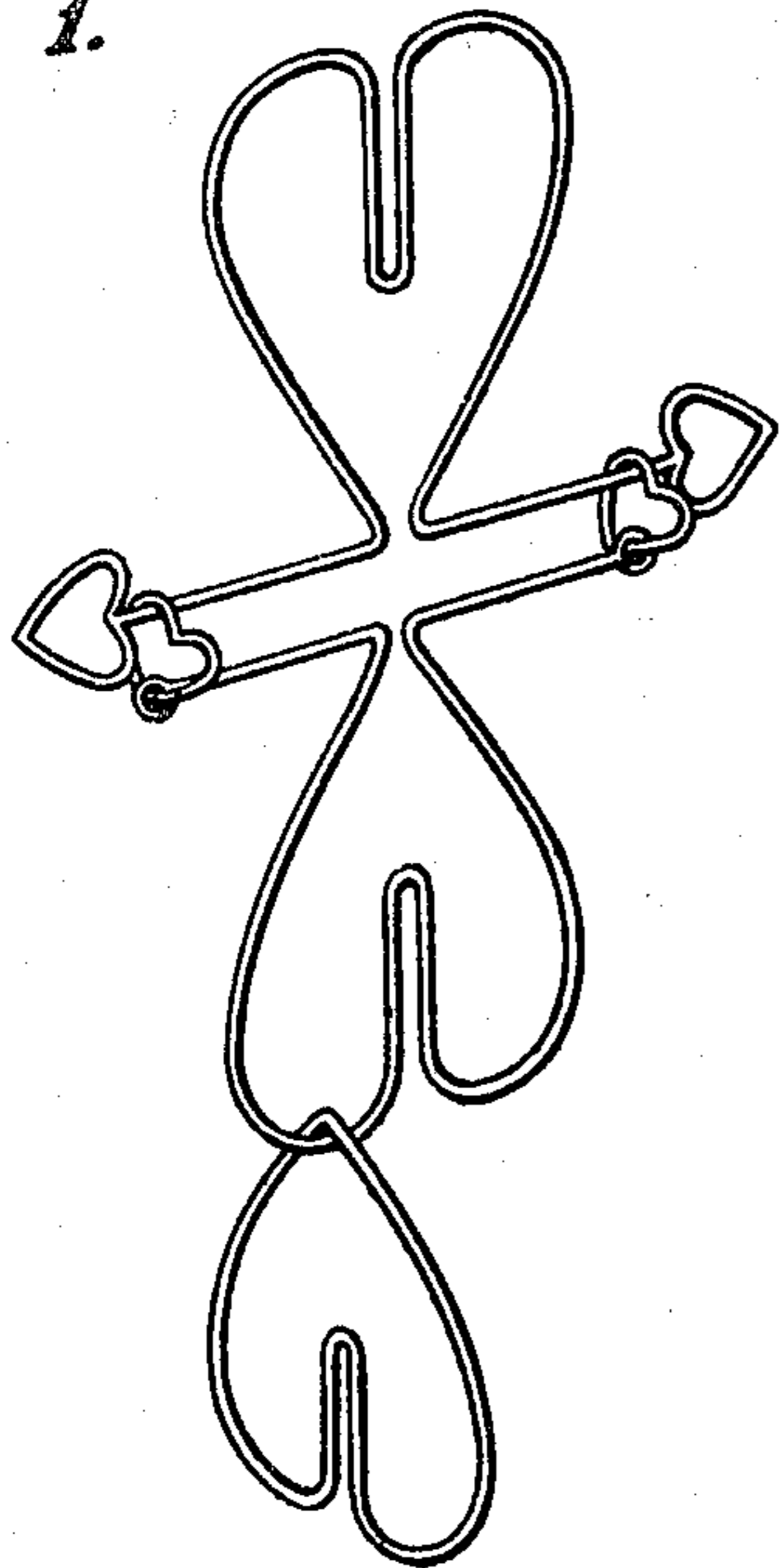

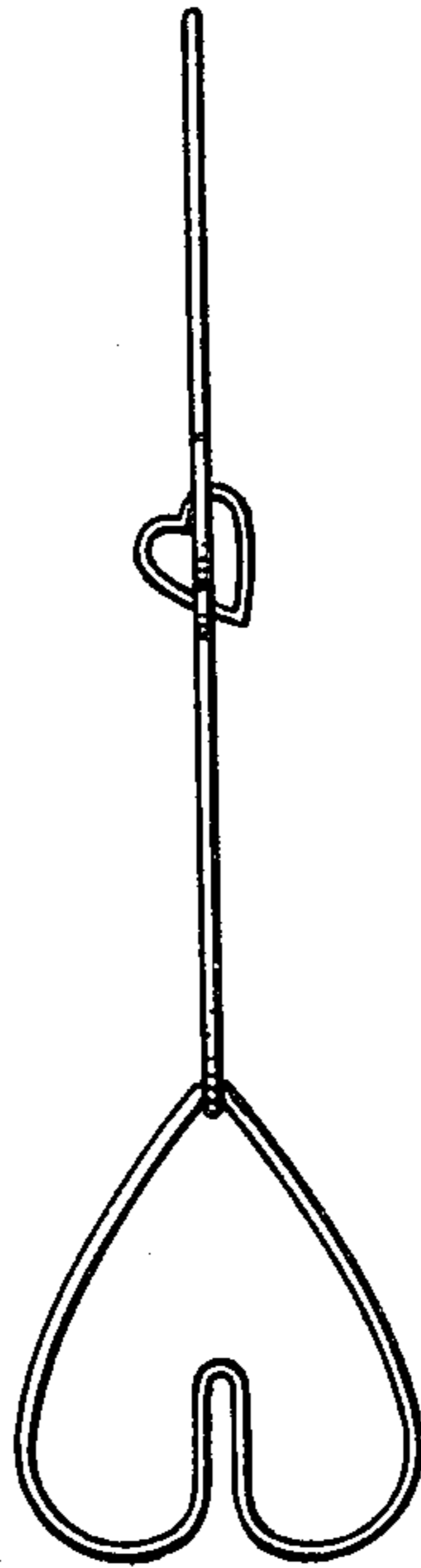

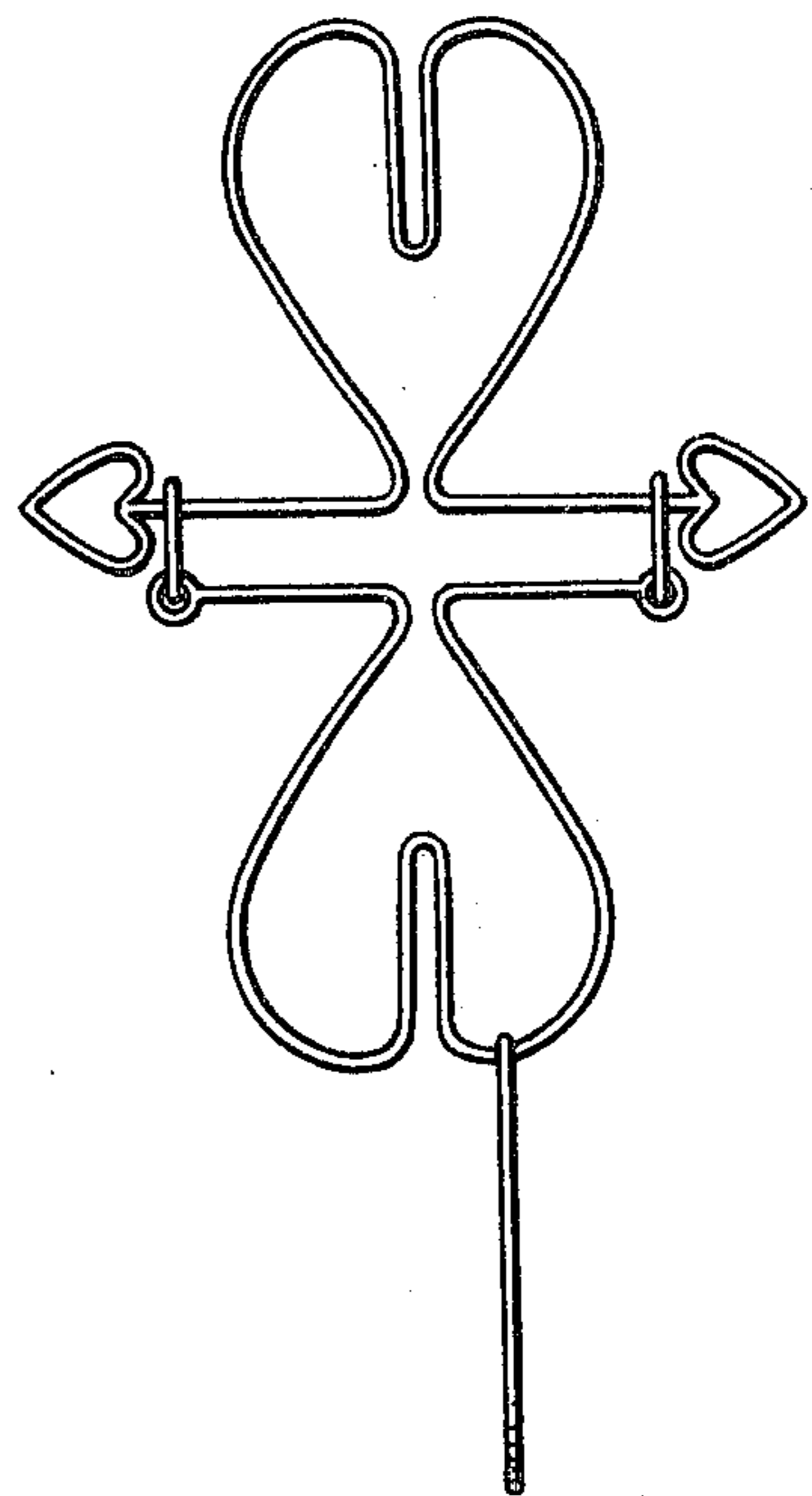

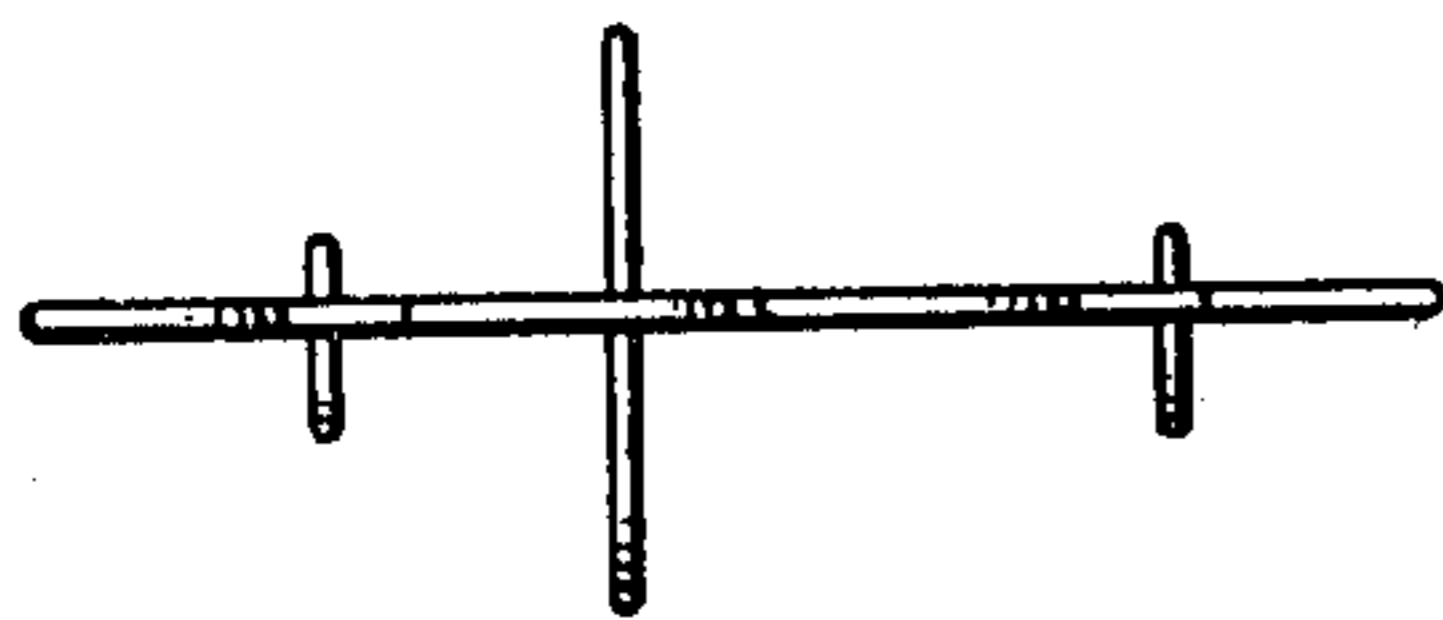
