DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a nit comb handle showing
our new design, the broken line showing of teeth being
illustrative of environment only;
FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a sectional view taken on line III—III in FIG.
1; and
FIG. 4 is an edge elevational view taken on line IV—IV
in FIG. 1.

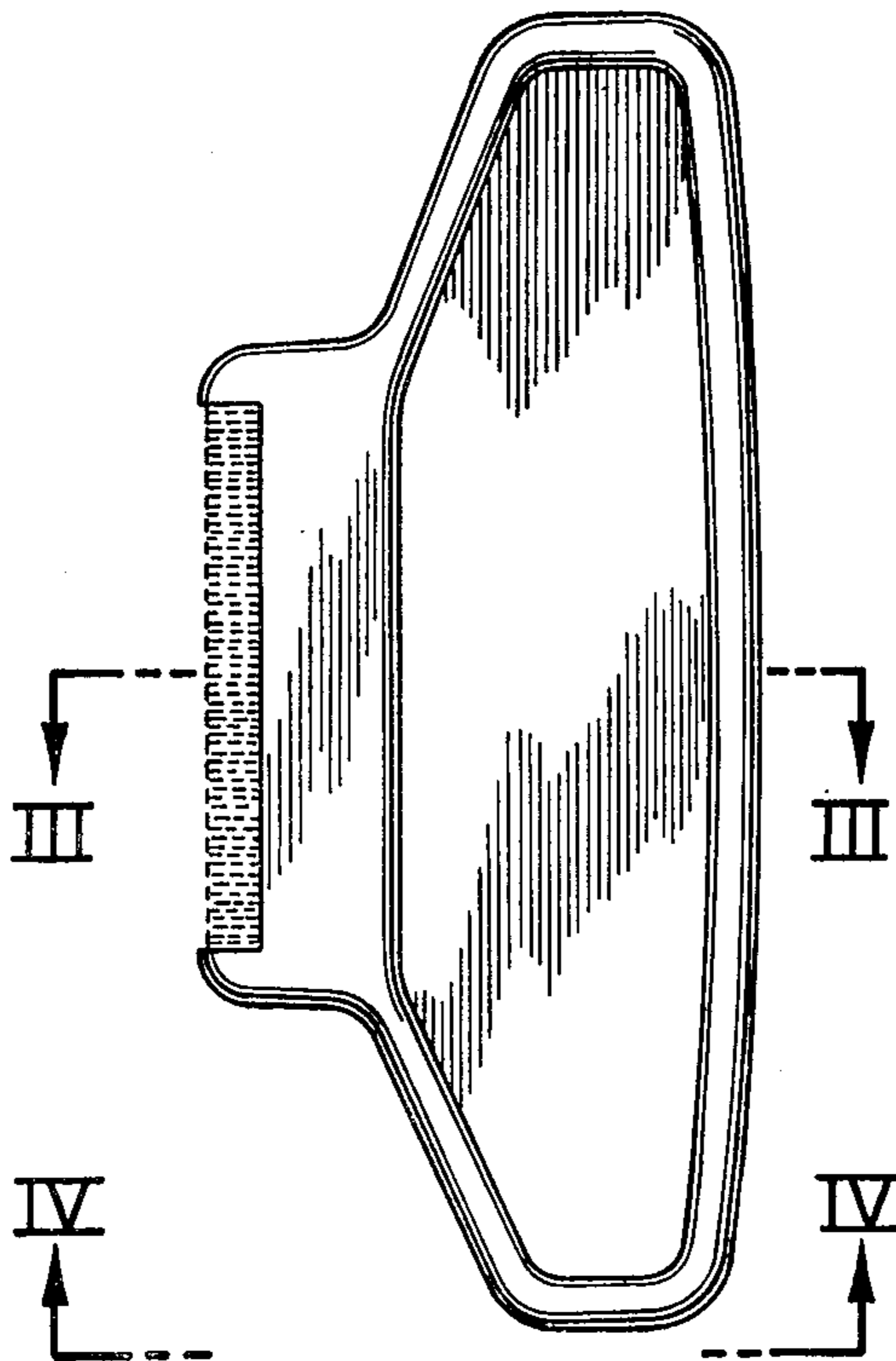

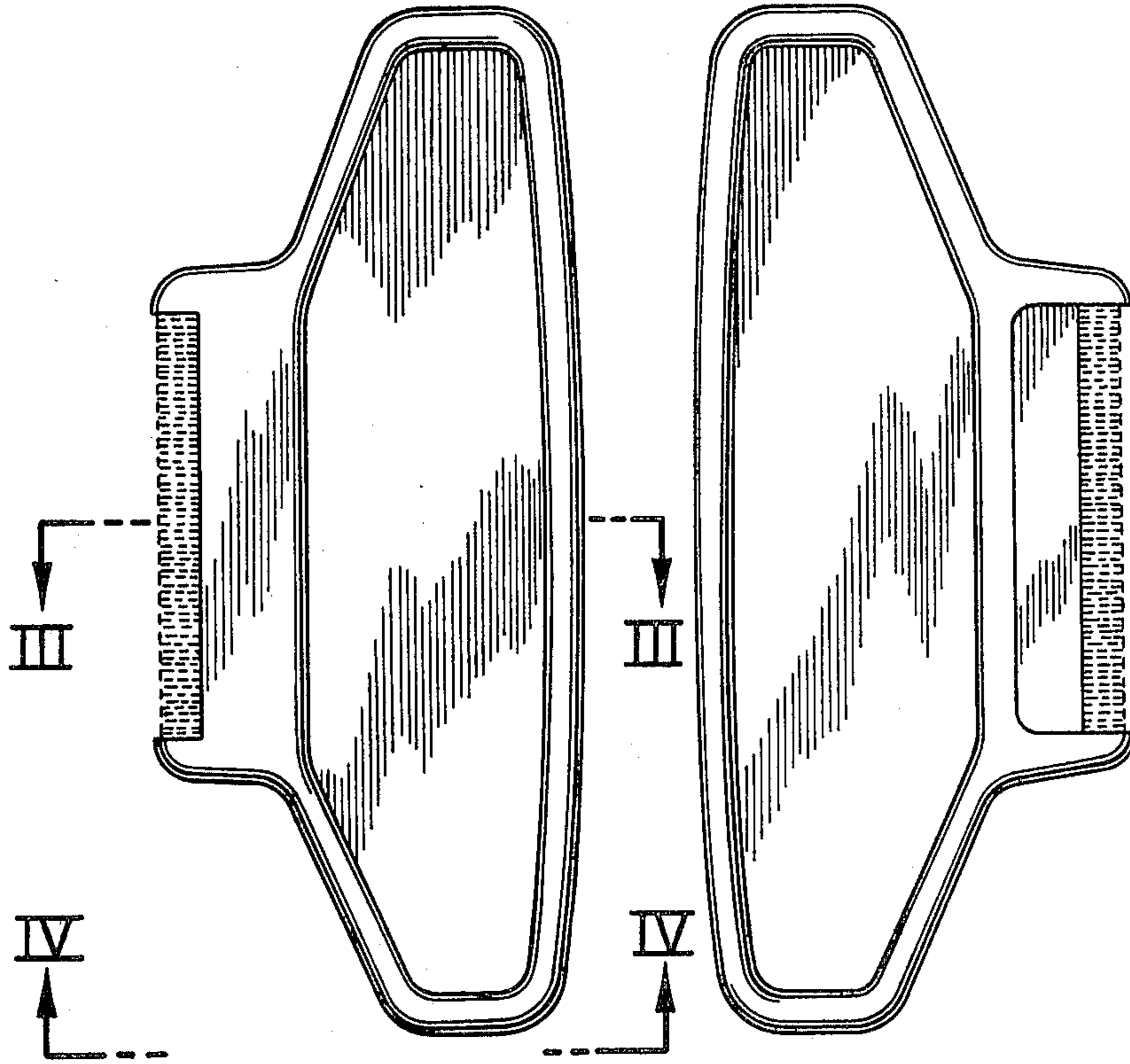

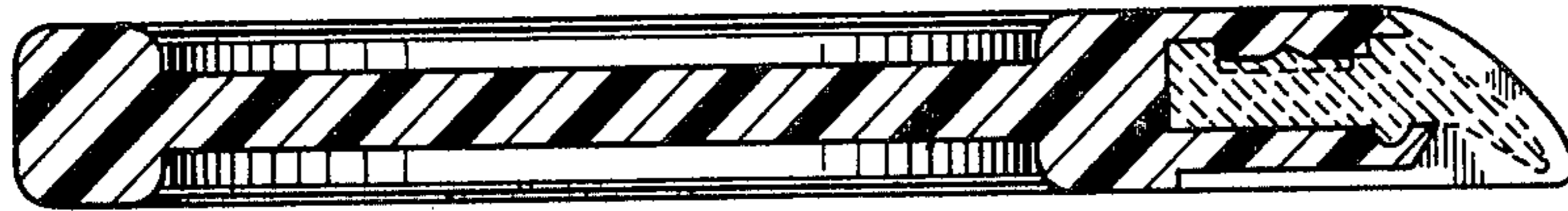
