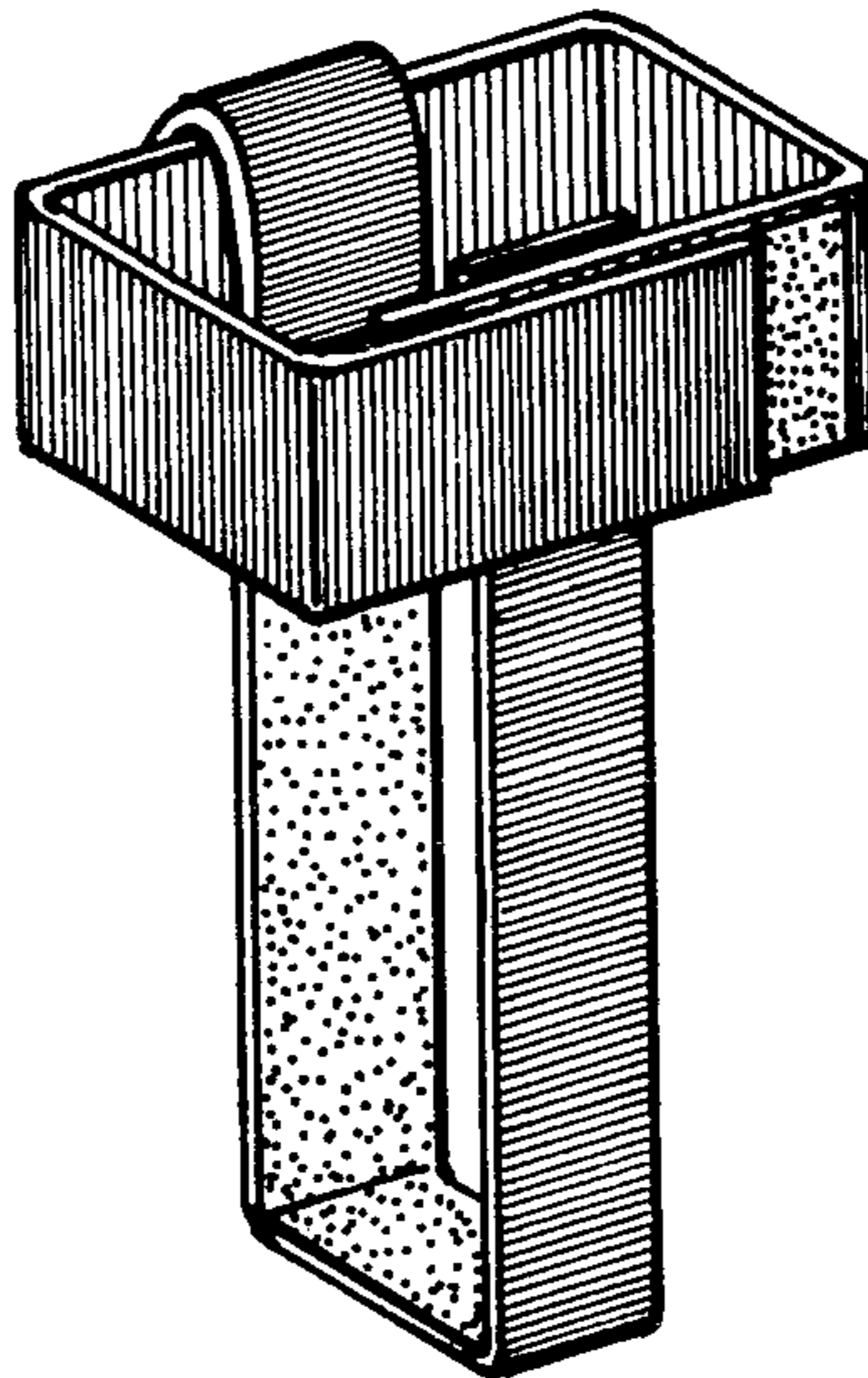

The ornamental design for a belt mountable holder, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a belt mountable holder showing my new design;  
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;  
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof;  
FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 7 is a right side elevational view thereof.  
It is understood that the continuous shade lines on the exterior surface of the holder indicate a textured surface.



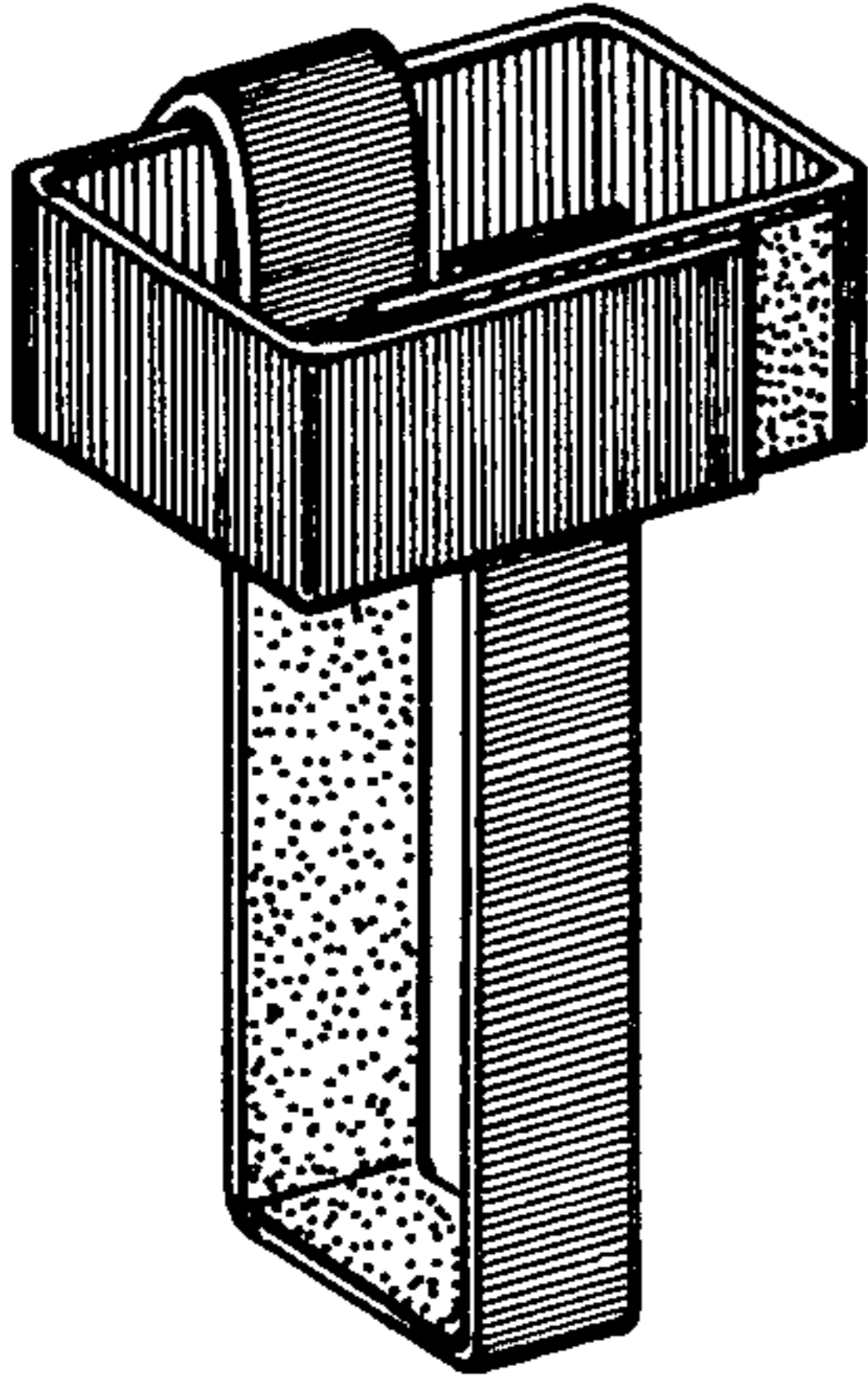

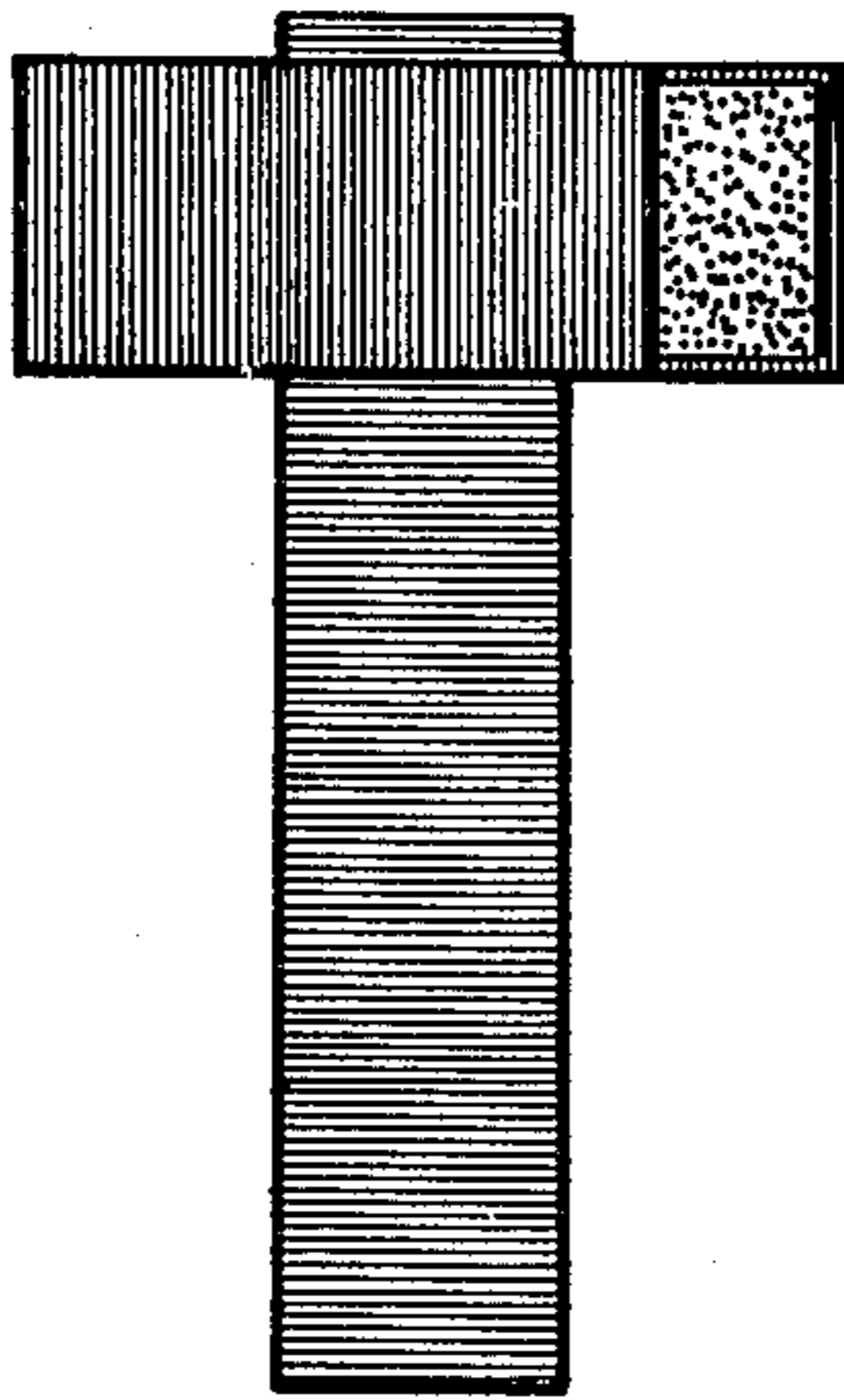

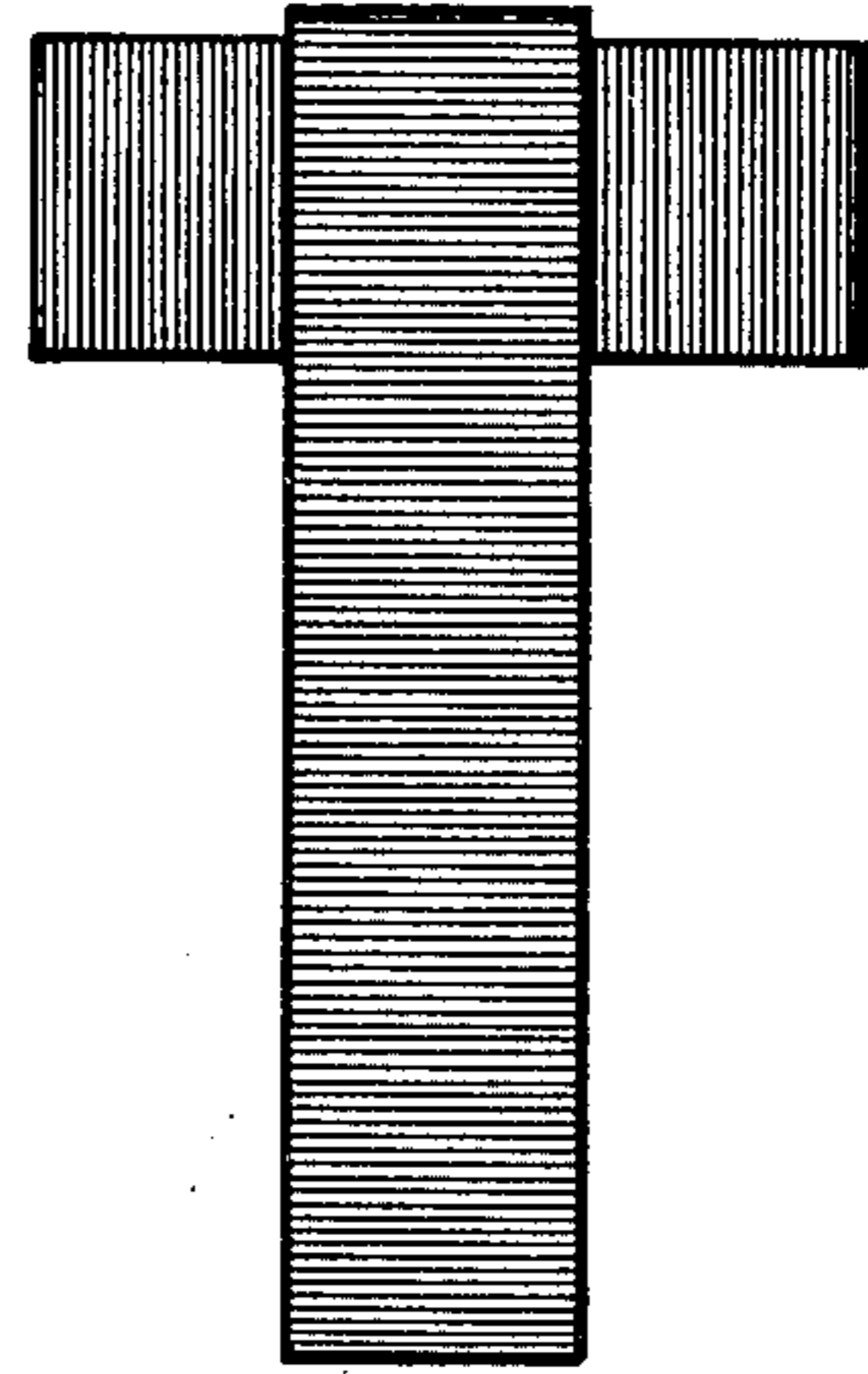

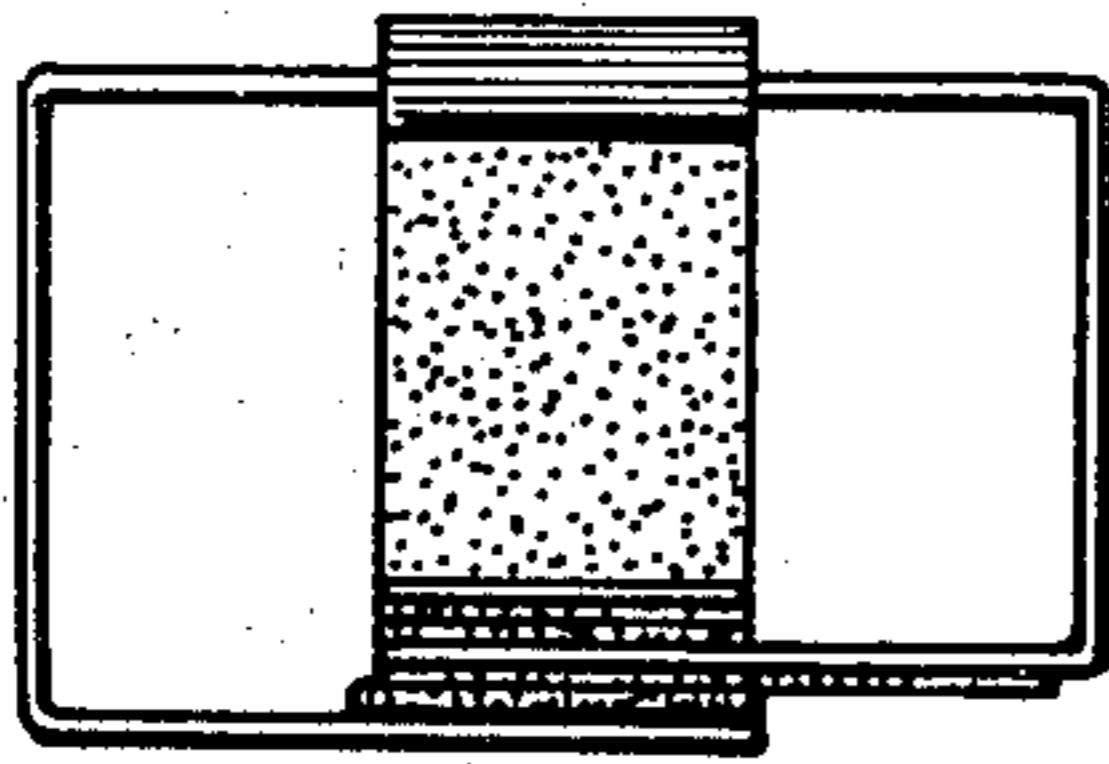

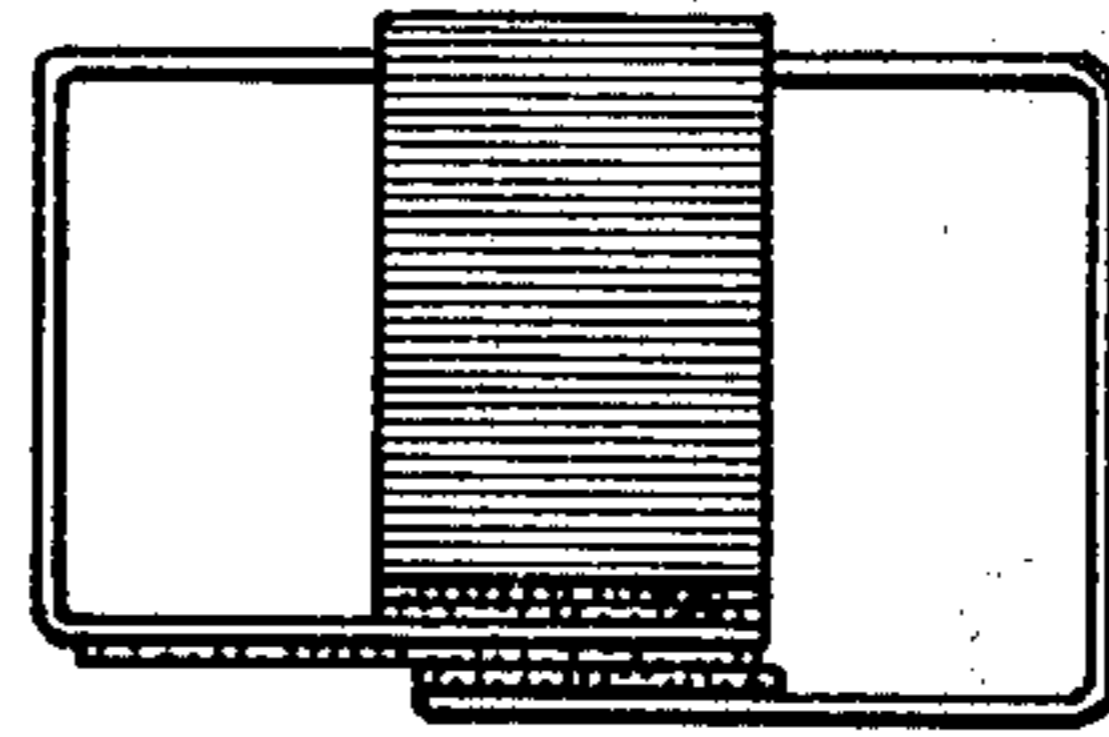

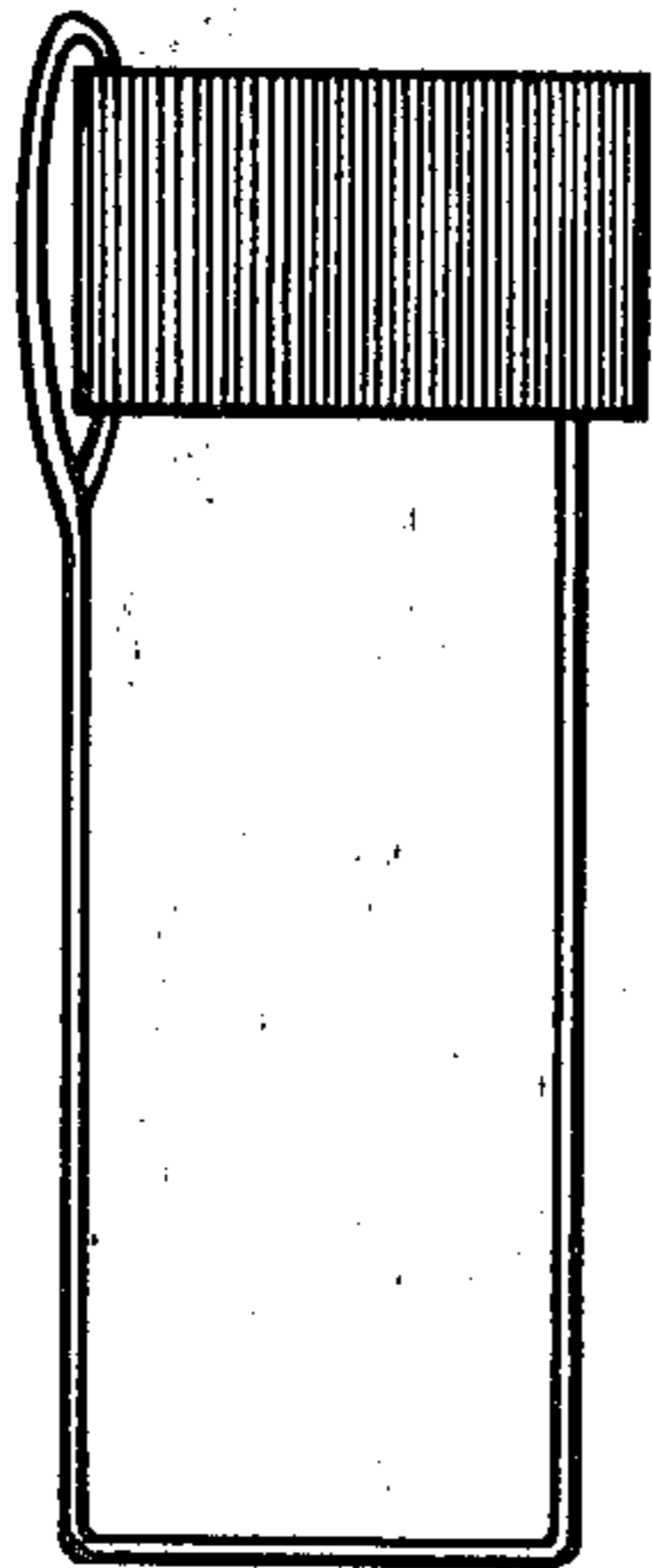

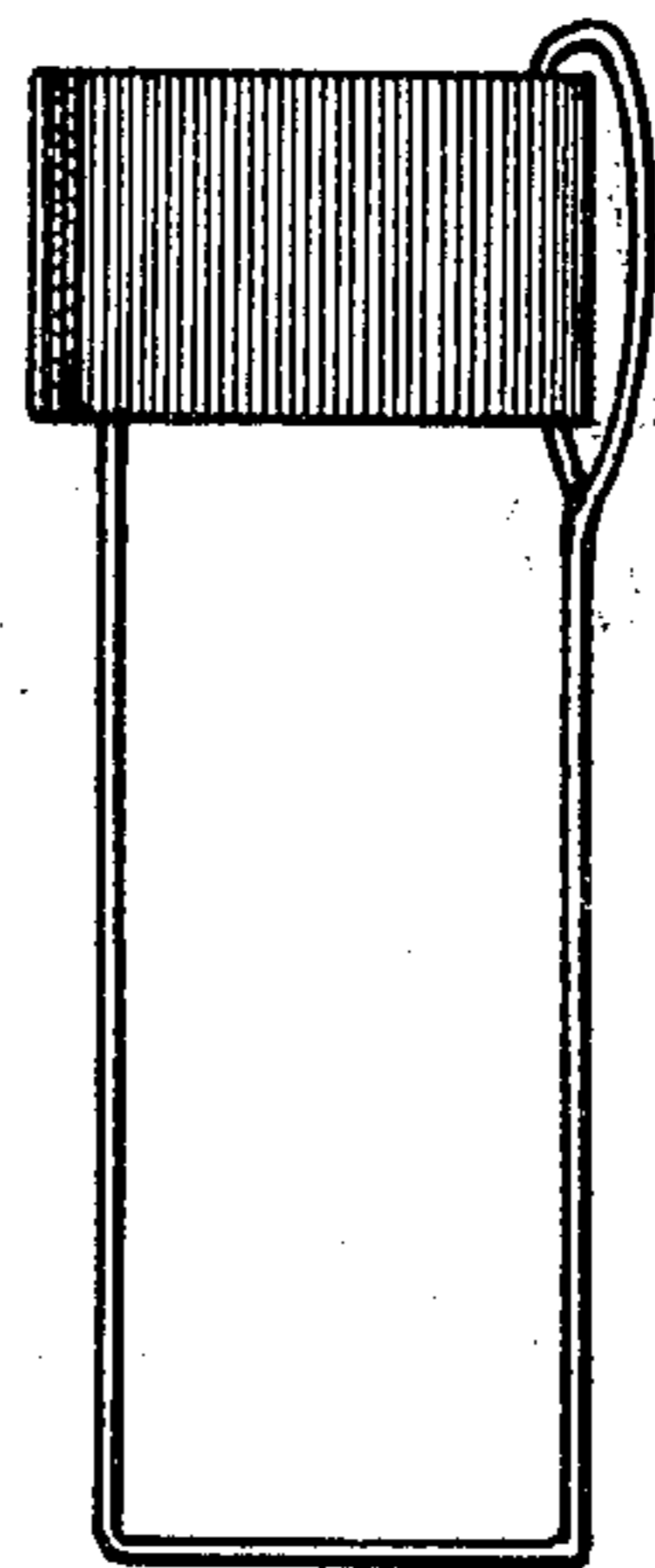
