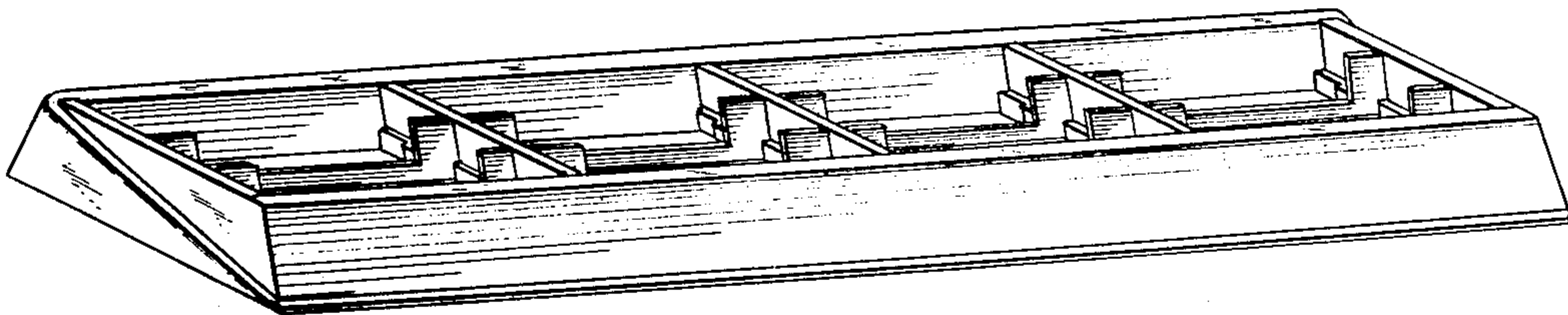

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a cassette tray, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, top and left-side perspective view of a cassette tray showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a right-side elevational view thereof, the left-side elevational view being a mirror image;
FIG. 7 is a cross-sectional view on an enlarged scale taken along the line 7—7 of FIG. 2; and
FIG. 8 is a cross-sectional view on an enlarged scale taken along the line 8—8 of FIG. 2.



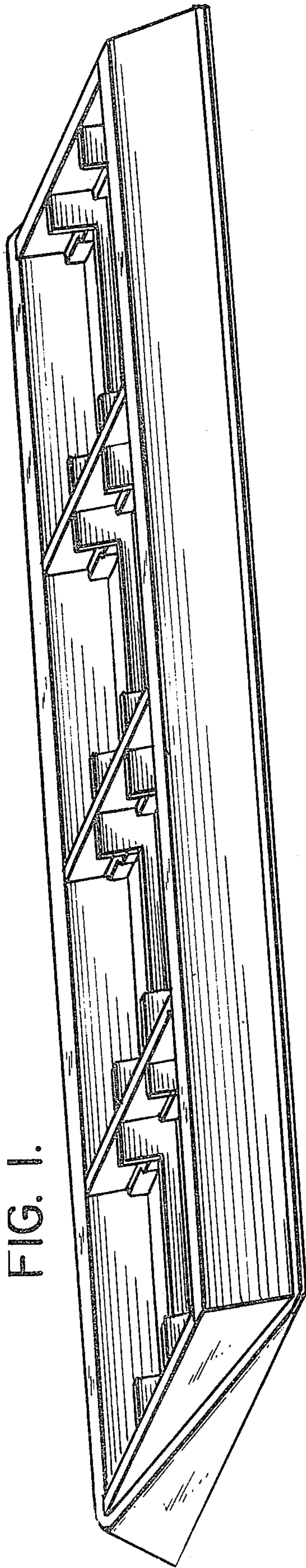

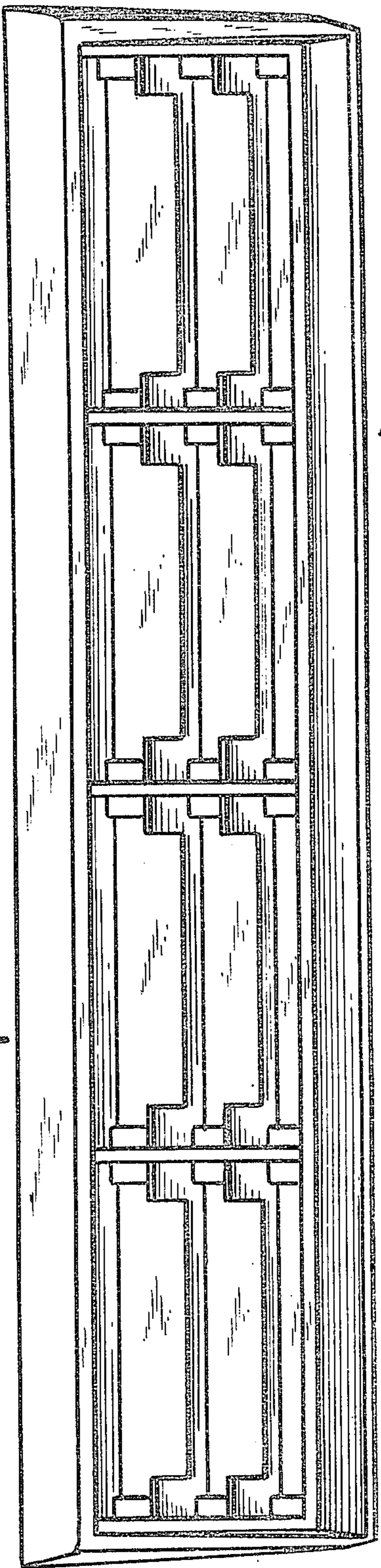

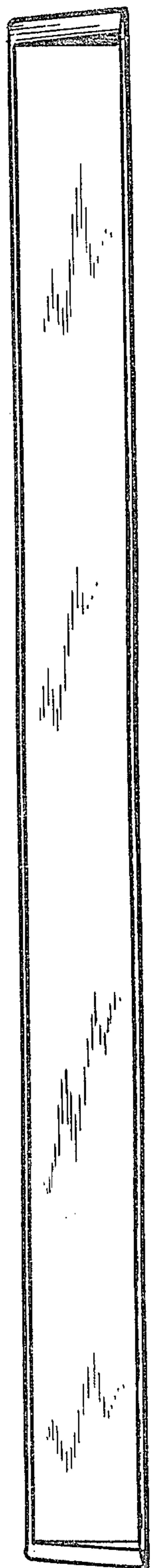

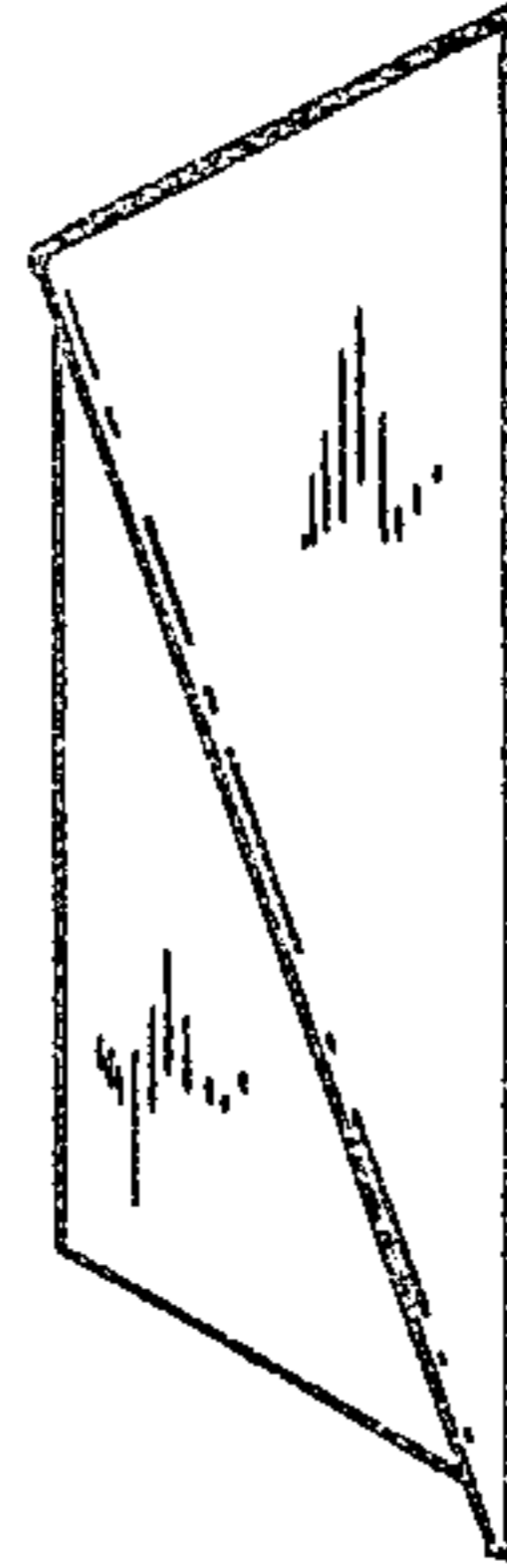

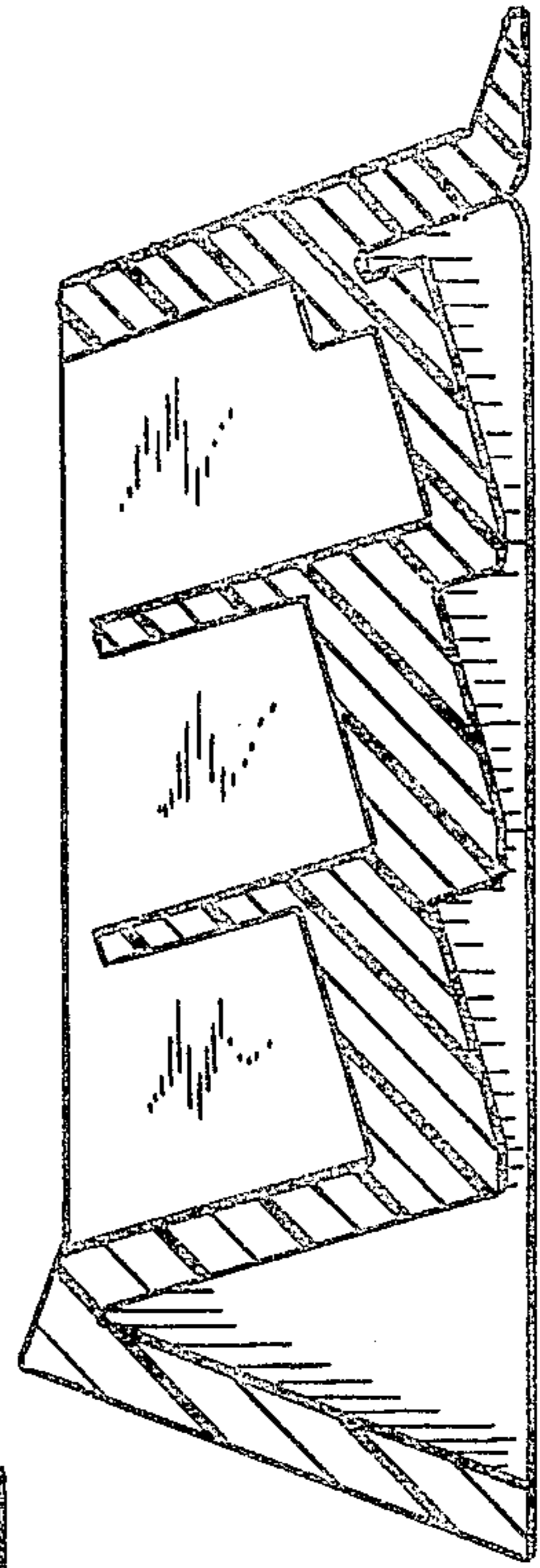
