The ornamental design for a display stand, as shown and described.

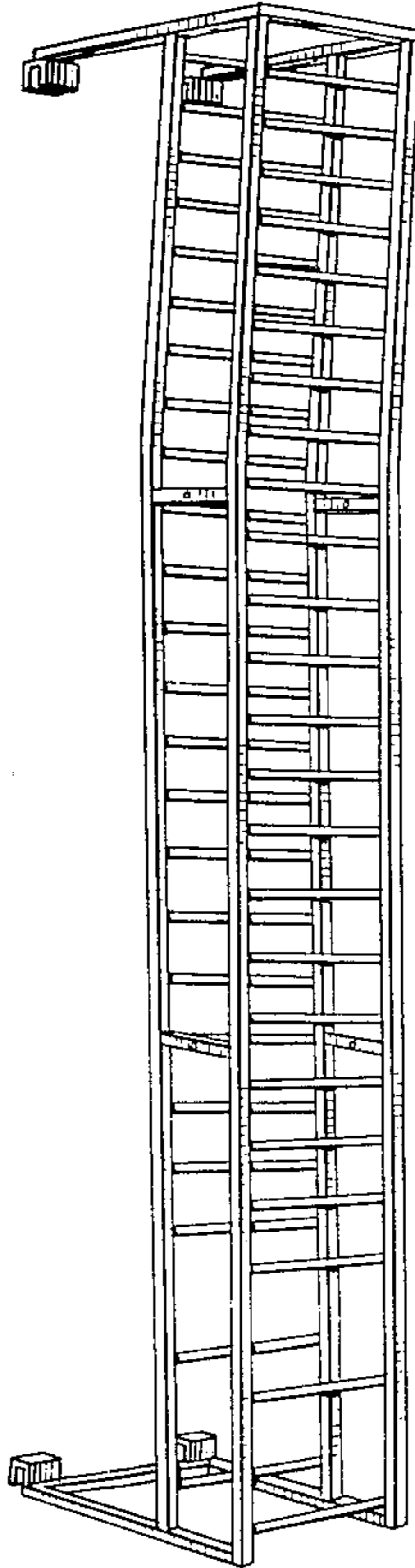
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 4 is a horizontal section along the line 4—4 of FIG. 2.



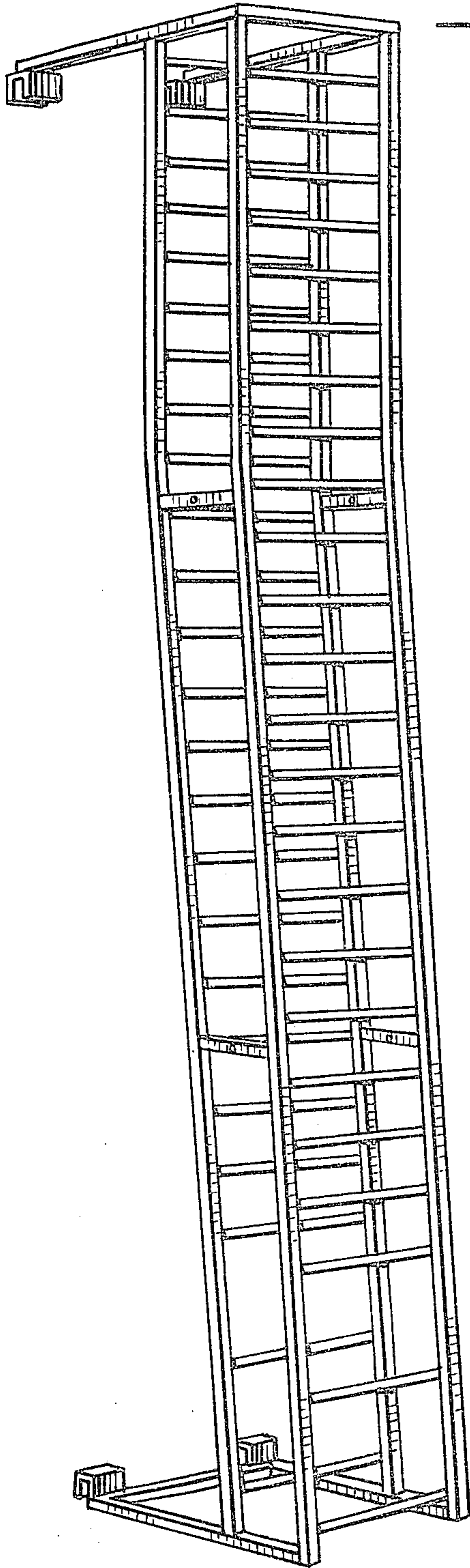

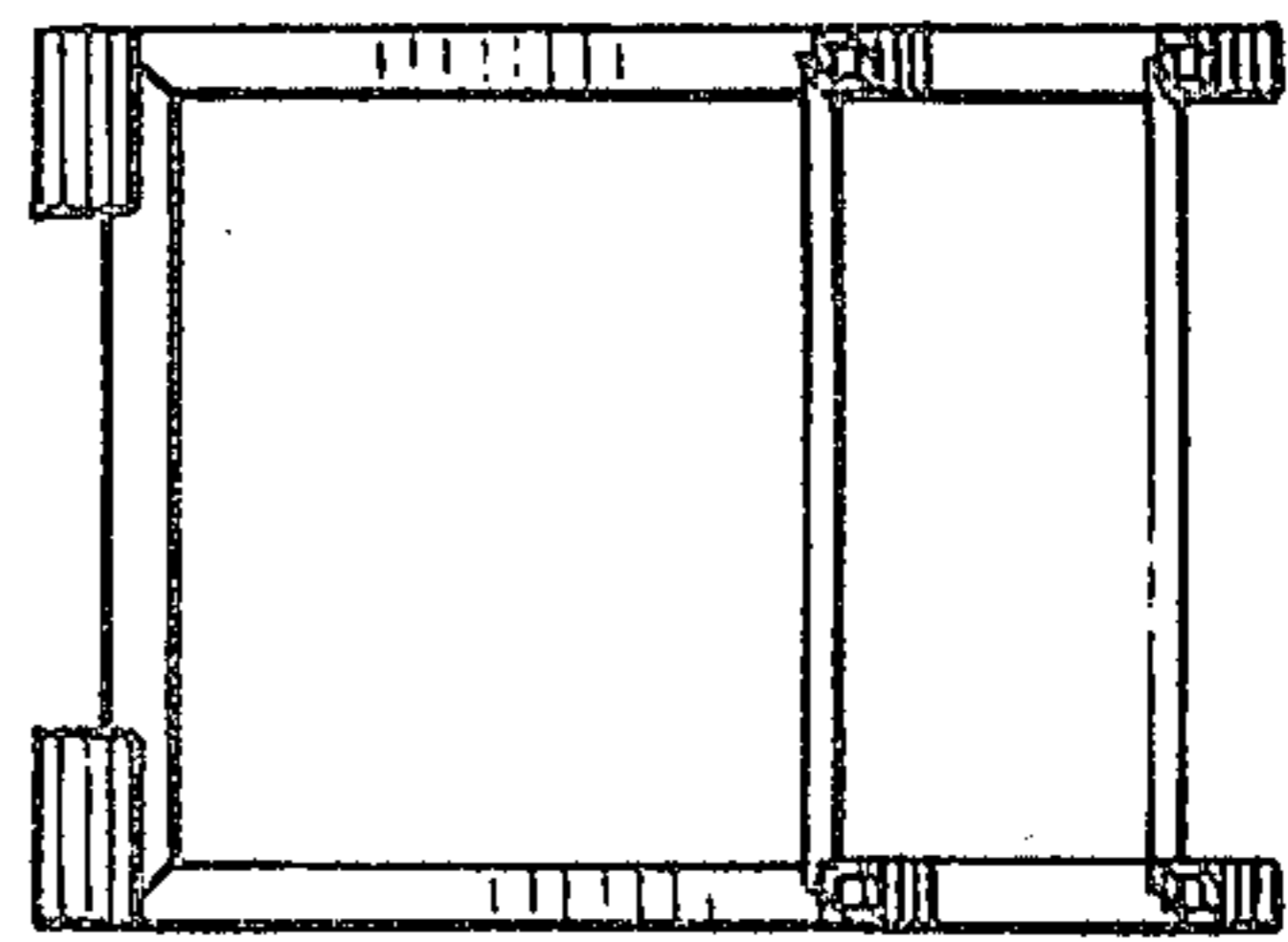

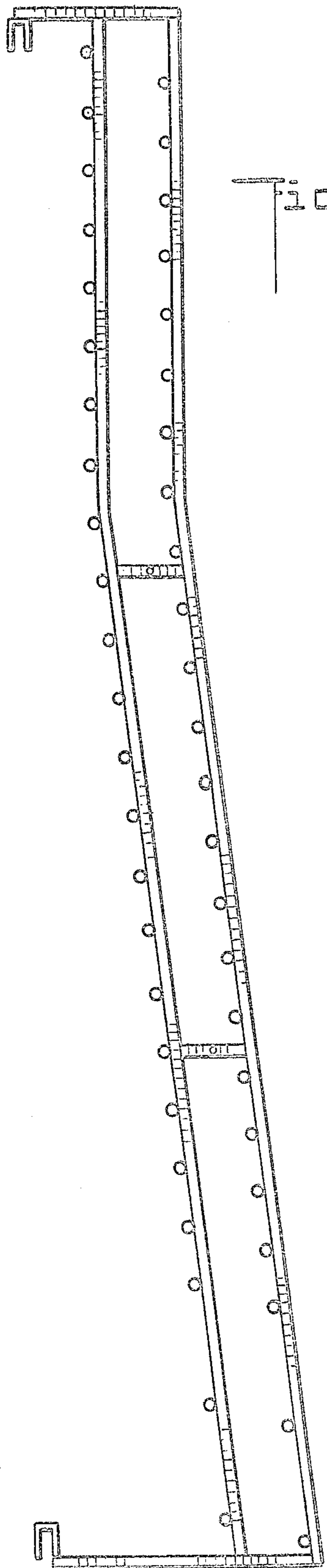
