[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a dispenser for instant coffee, tea, or the like, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a dispenser for instant coffee, tea, or the like, showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a top view thereof; FIG. 4 is a bottom view thereof; FIG. 5 is a side view thereof, showing it in a different operative position than that shown in FIG. 2; FIG. 6 is a cross-sectional, elevational view thereof along the lines 6—6 of FIG. 3; and FIG. 7 is a fragmentary perspective view thereof in a different condition.

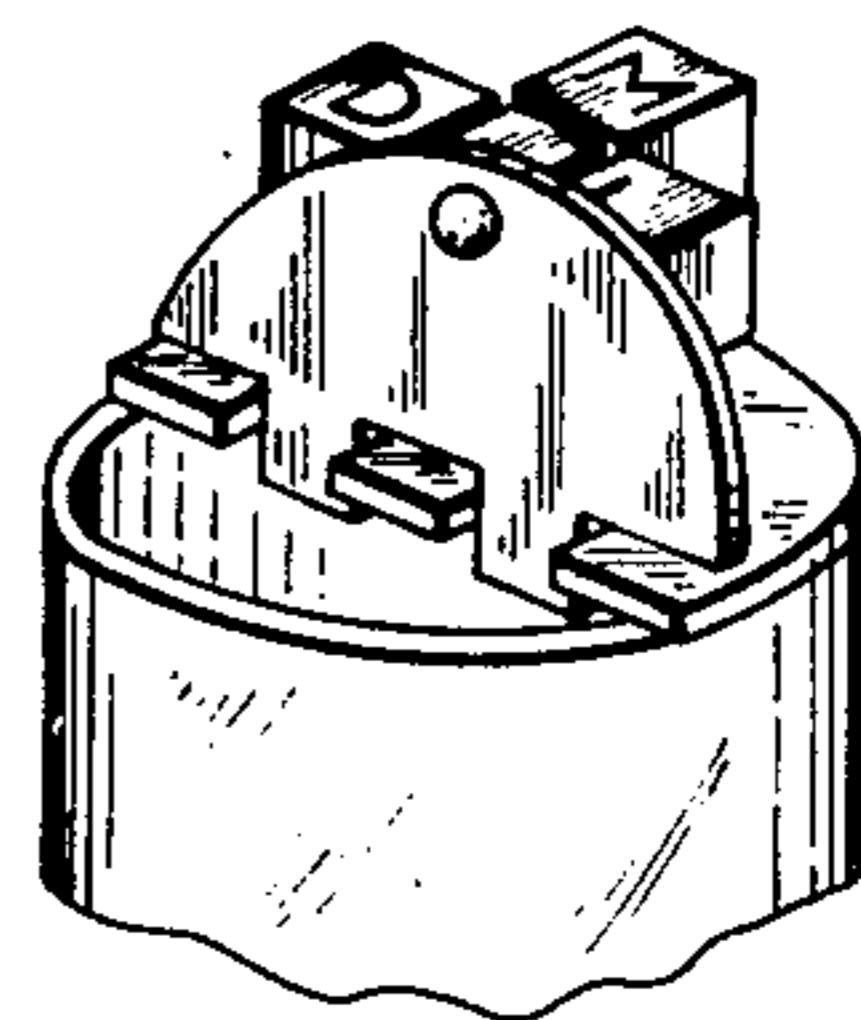
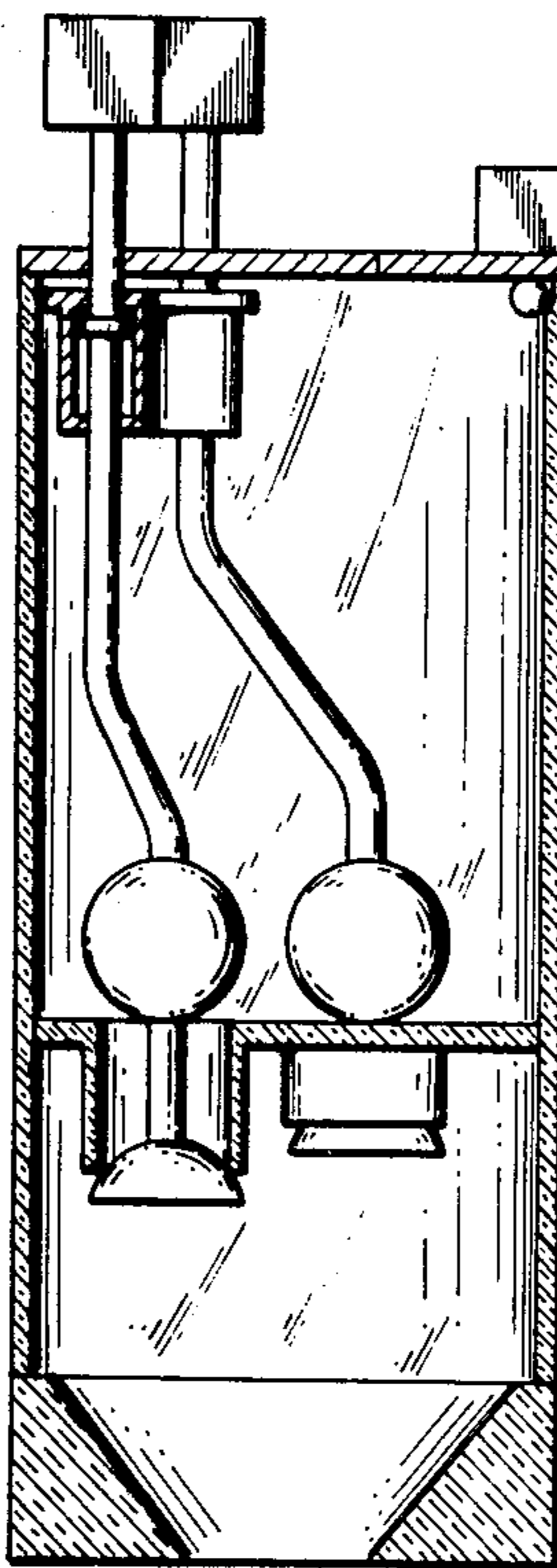
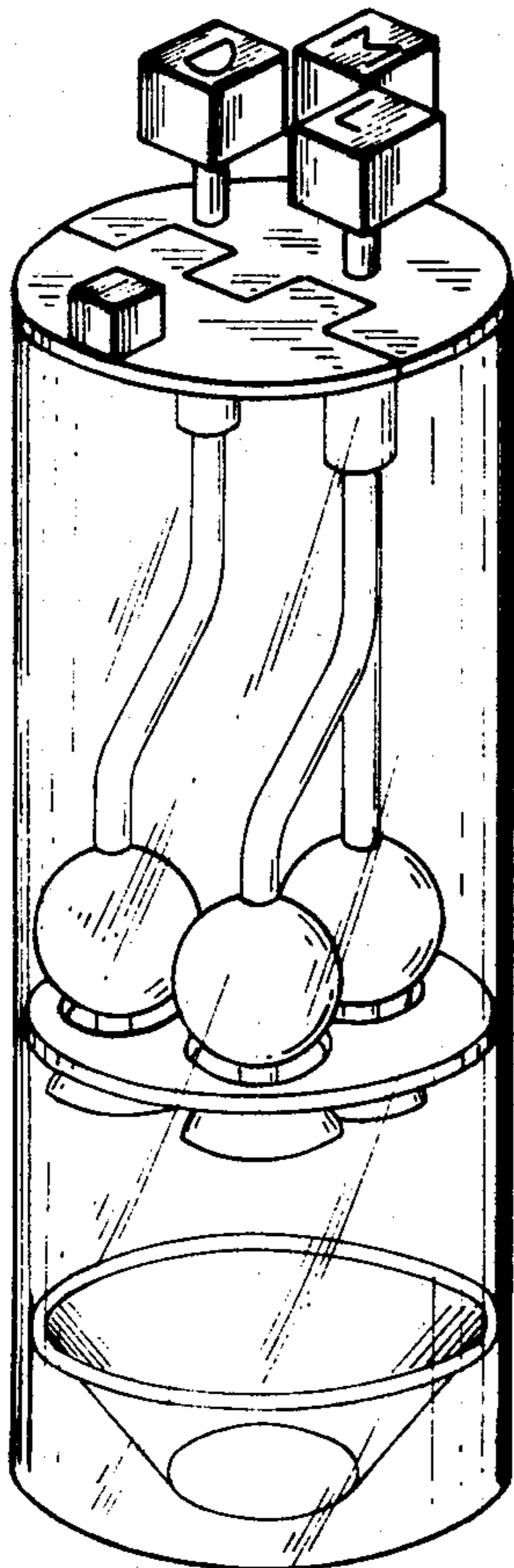

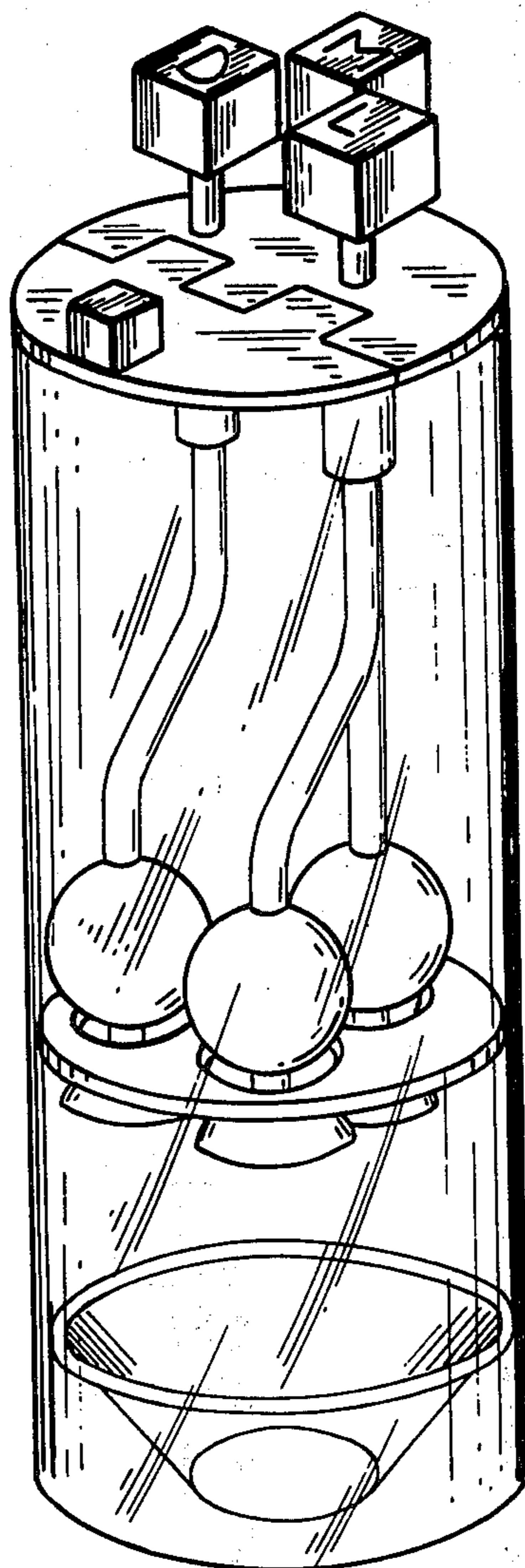

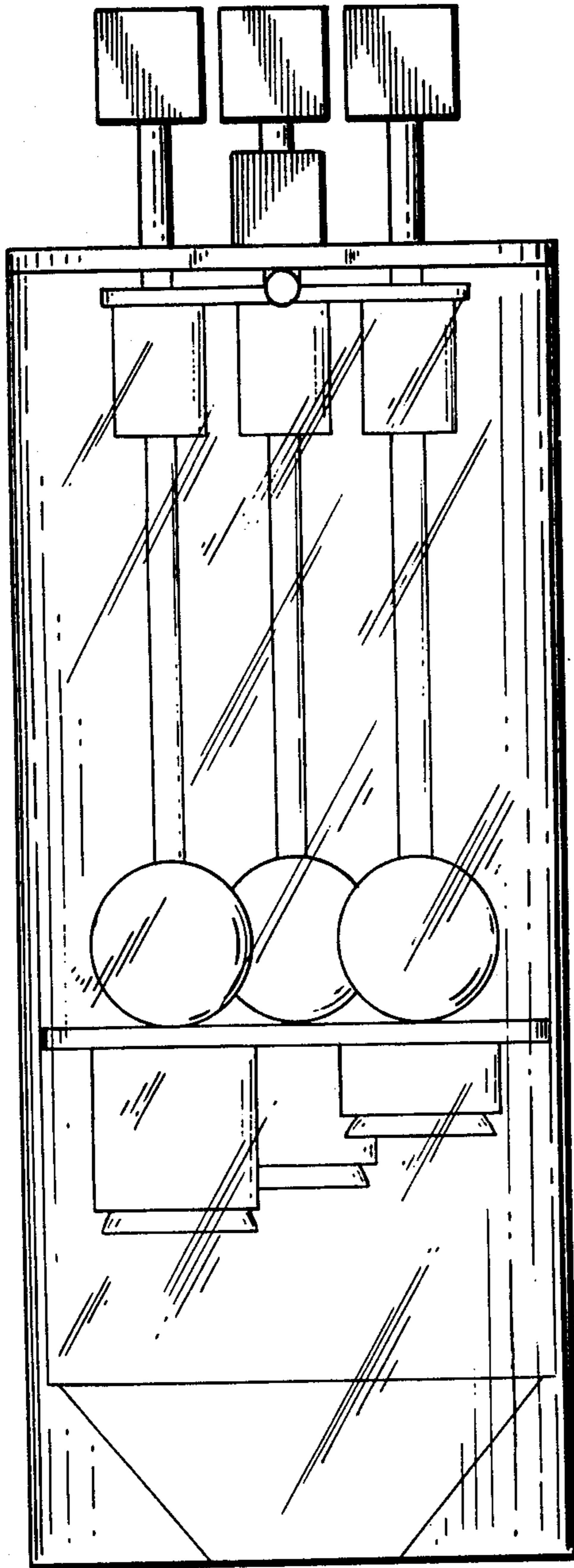

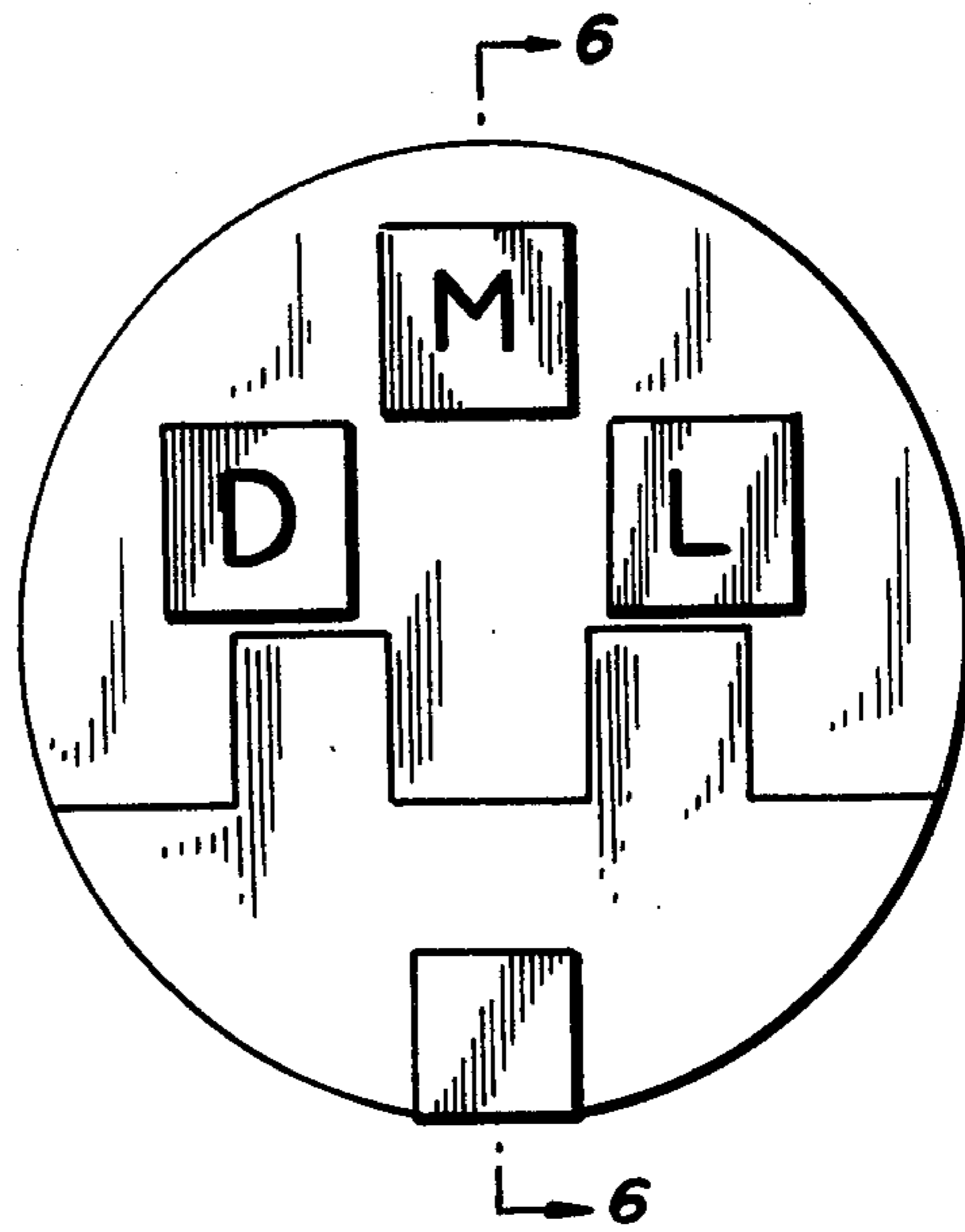

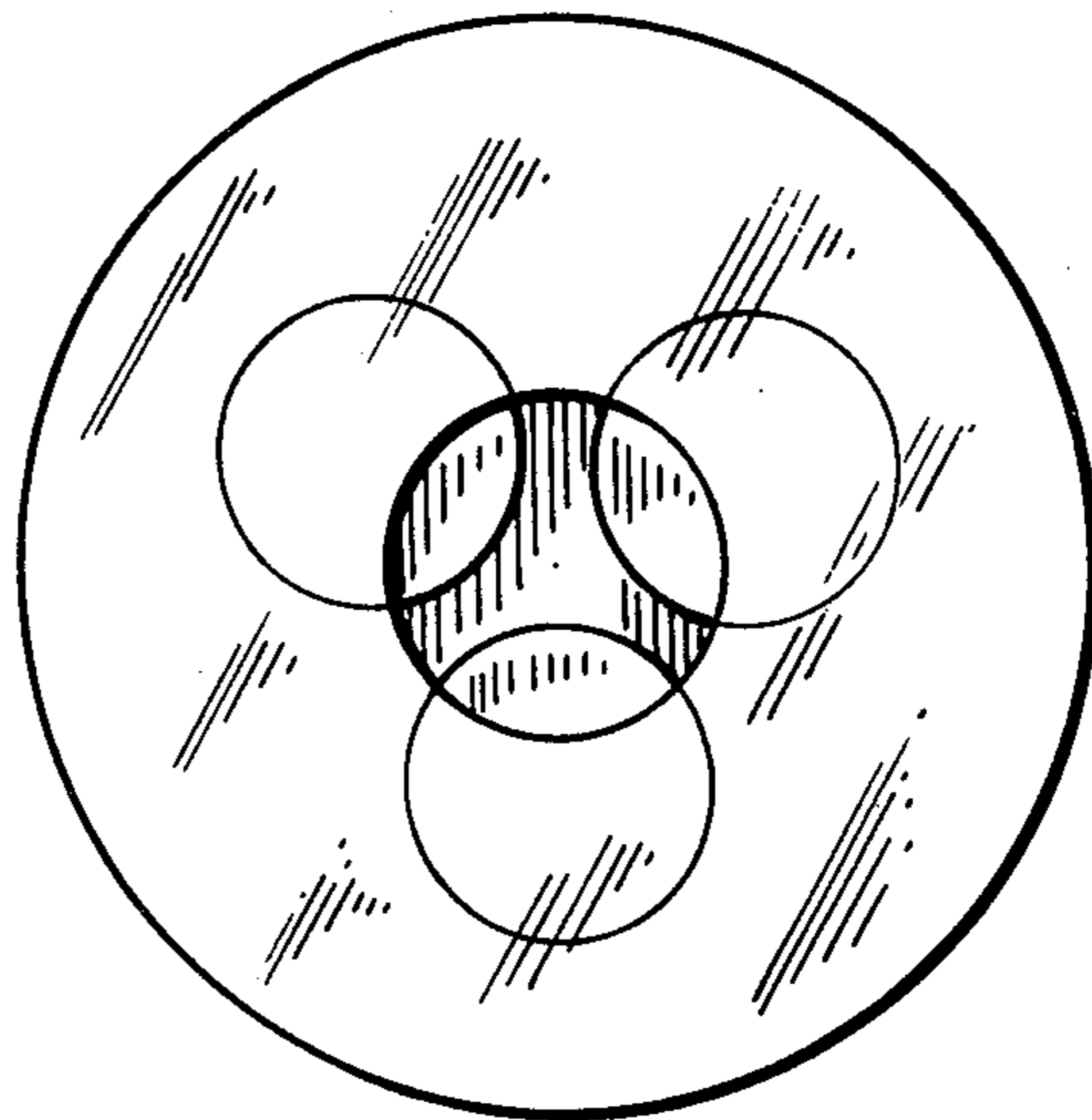

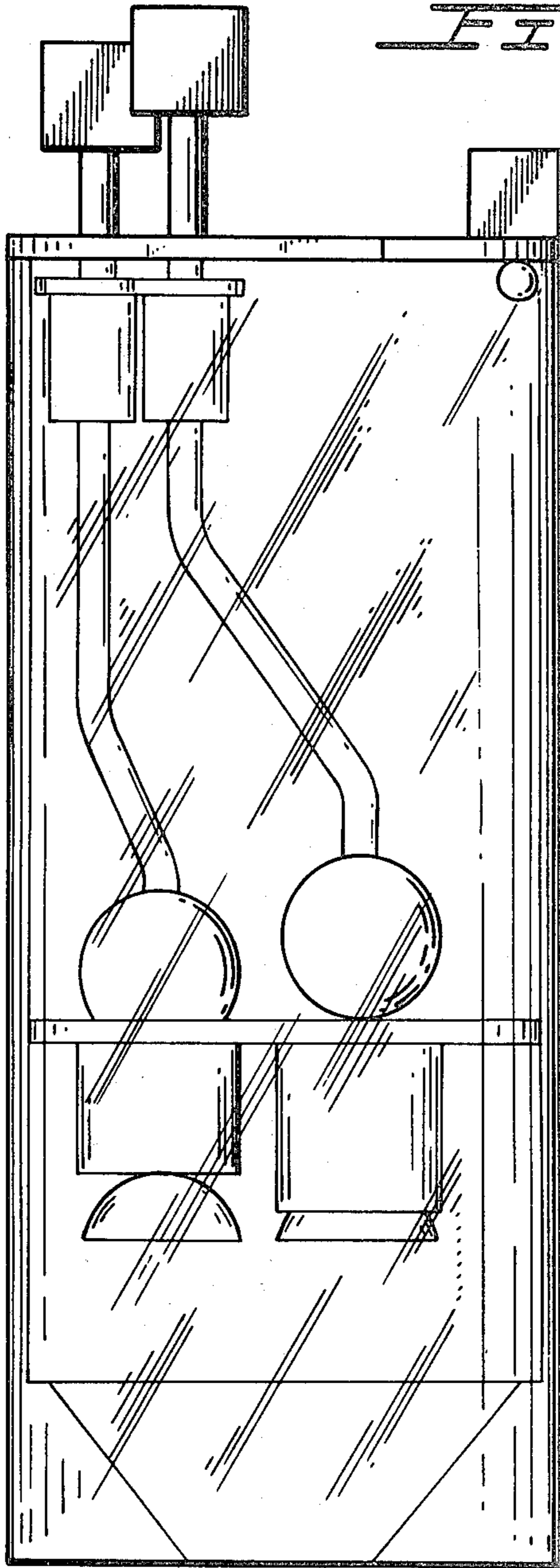

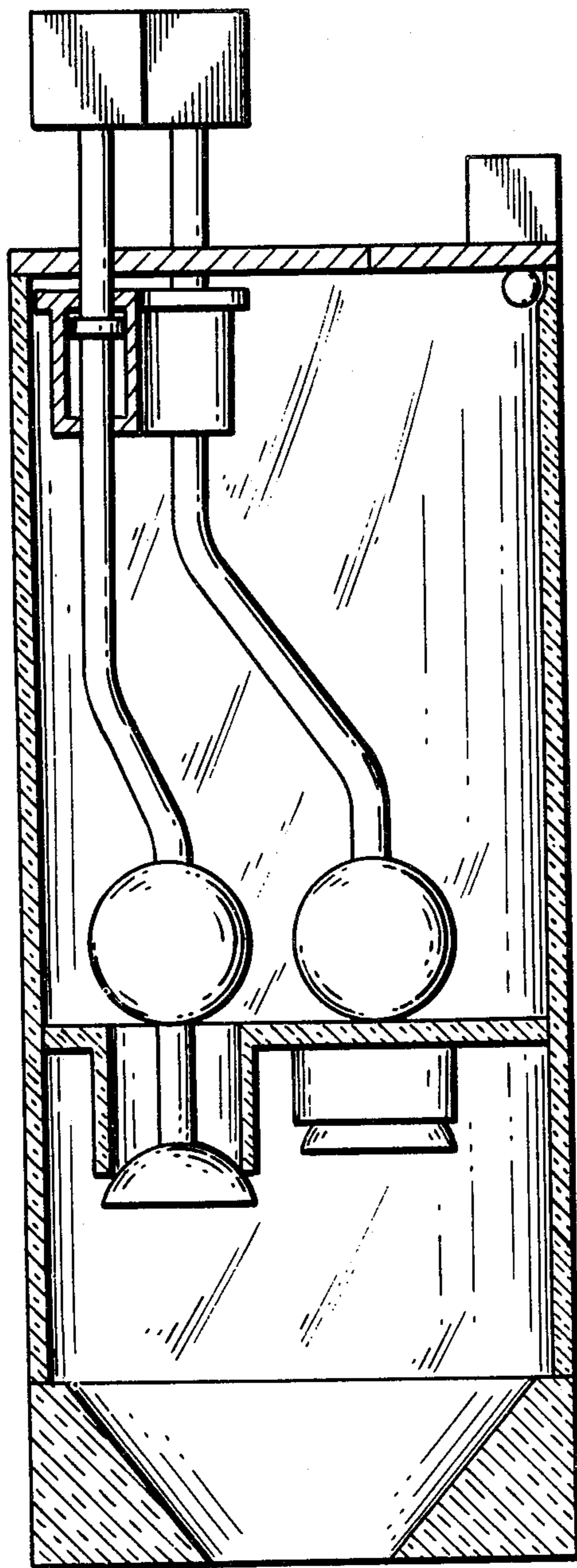
