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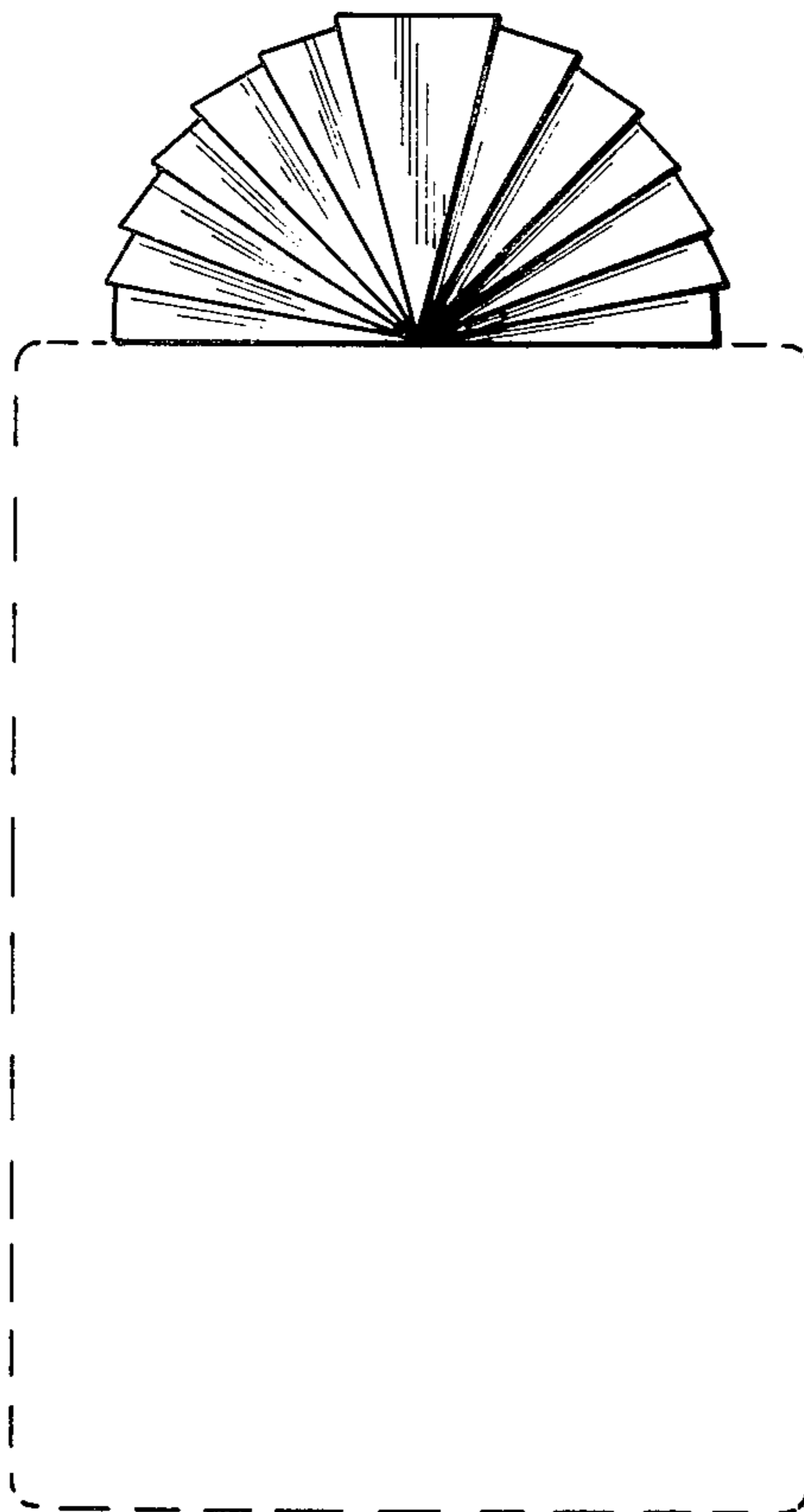
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[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a bottle cap, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a bottle cap embodying my new design;
FIG. 2 is an elevational view, the opposite side being the same in appearance; and
FIG. 3 is an elevational view looking from the right of FIG. 2, the opposite side being the same in appearance. The broken lines showing a bottle are for the purpose of illustrating environmental use only.



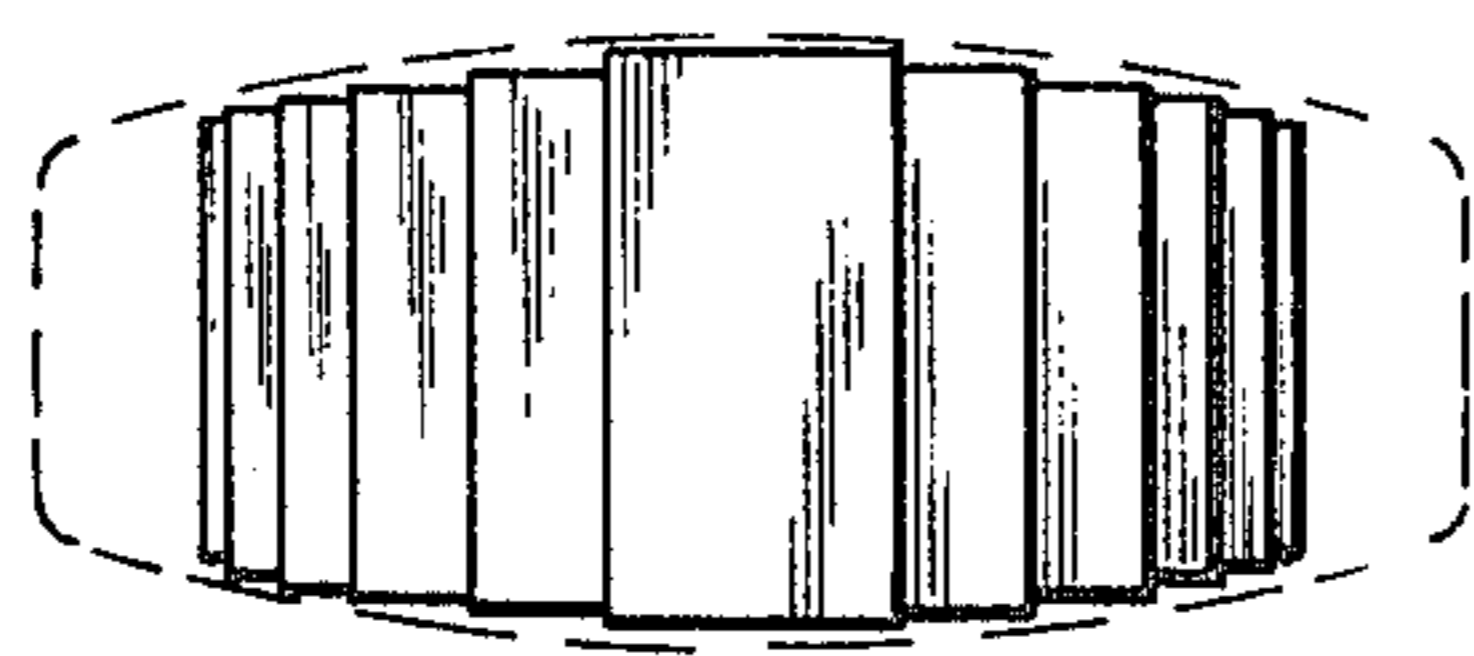

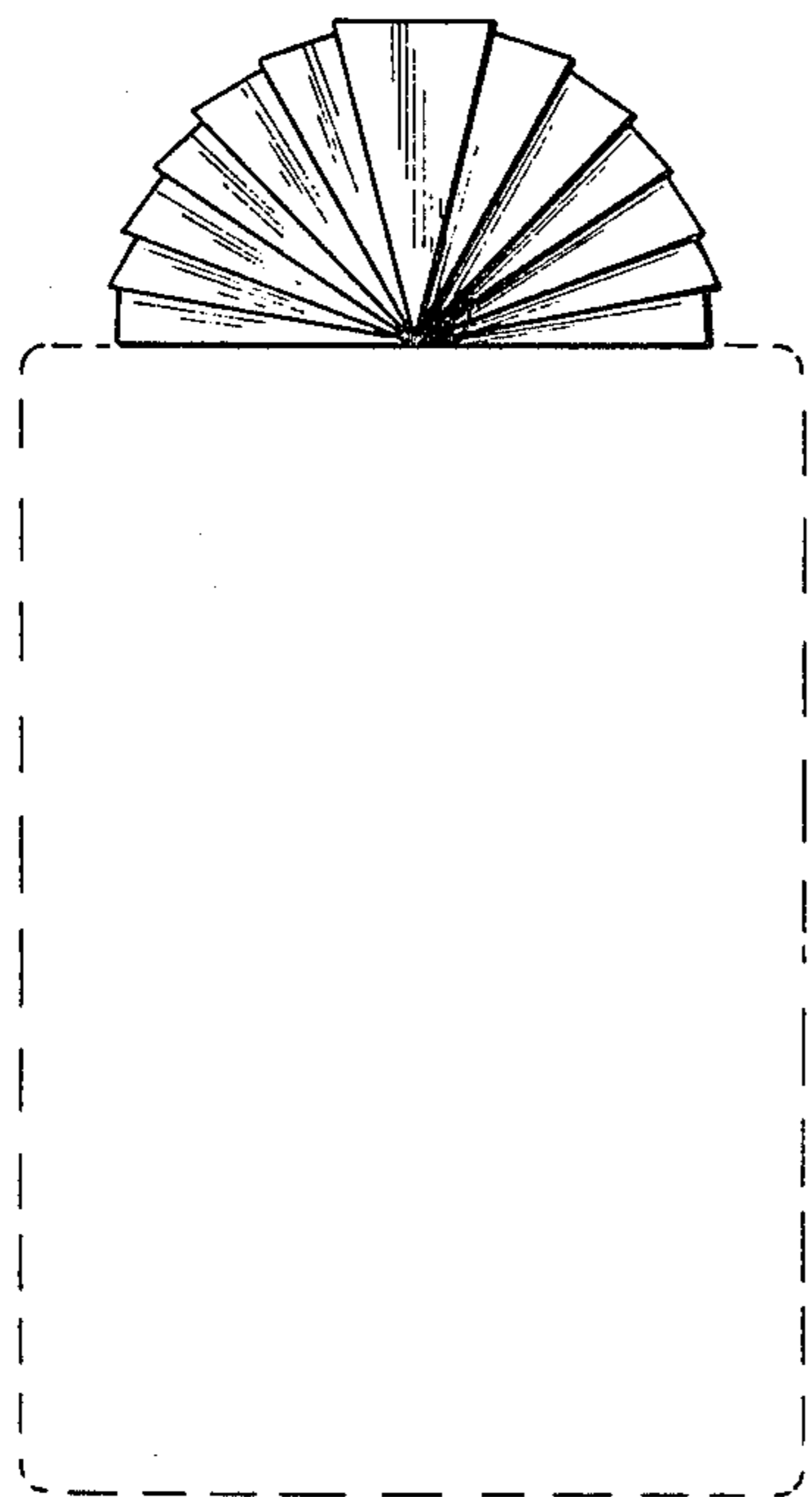
