FIG. 3 is a front view;

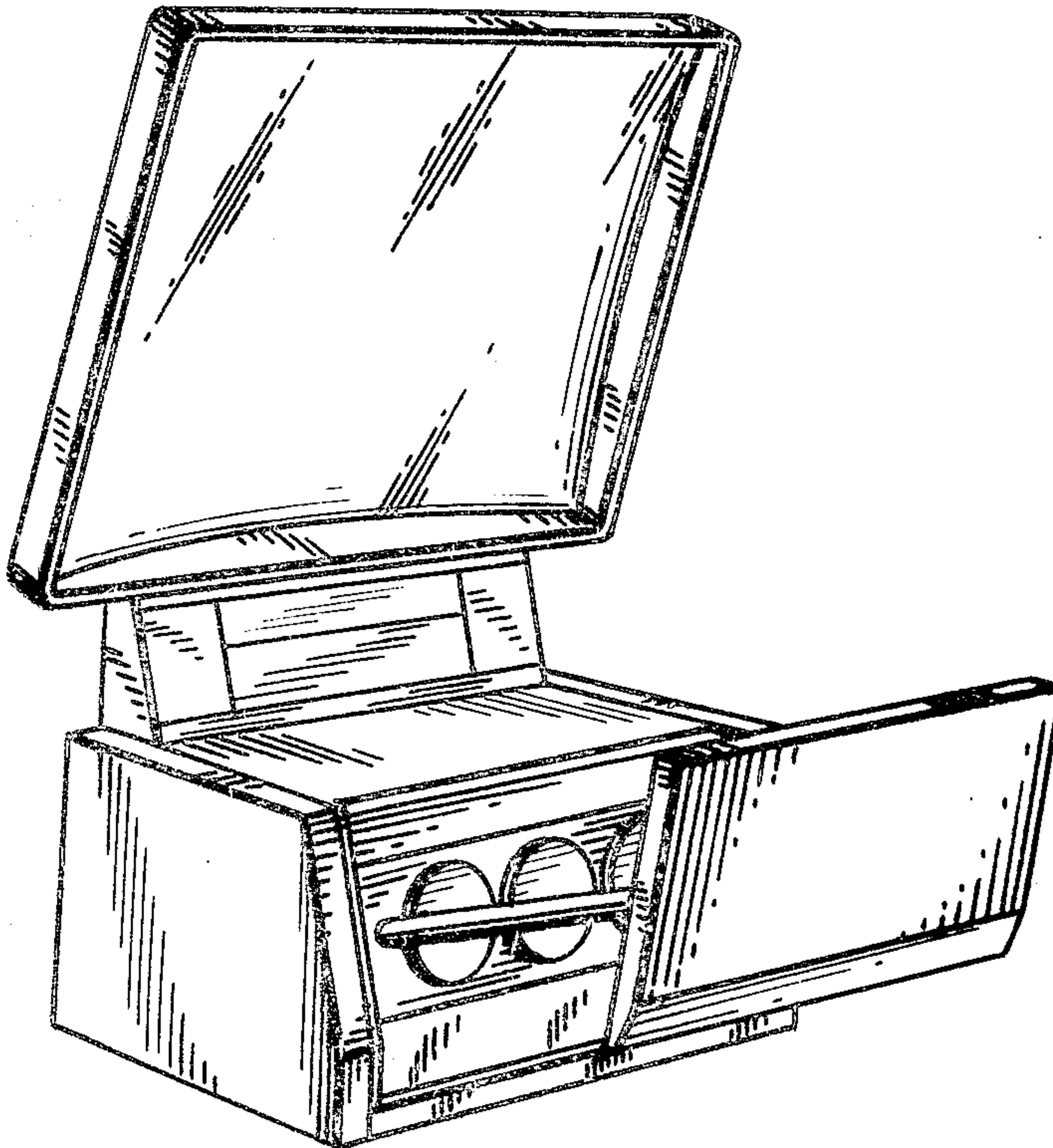
FIG. 4 is a left side view;

FIG. 8 is a perspective view in the shut position.



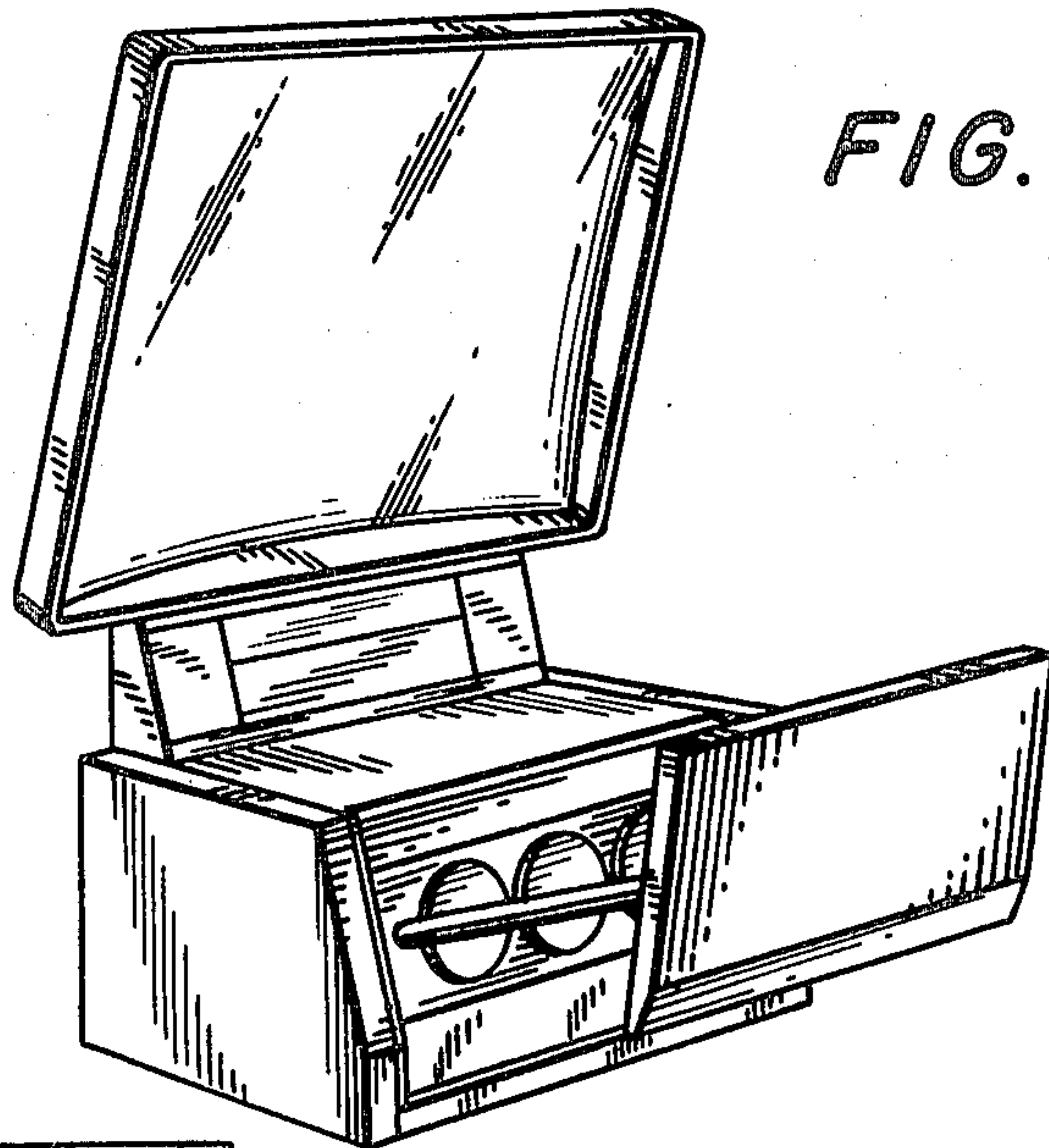

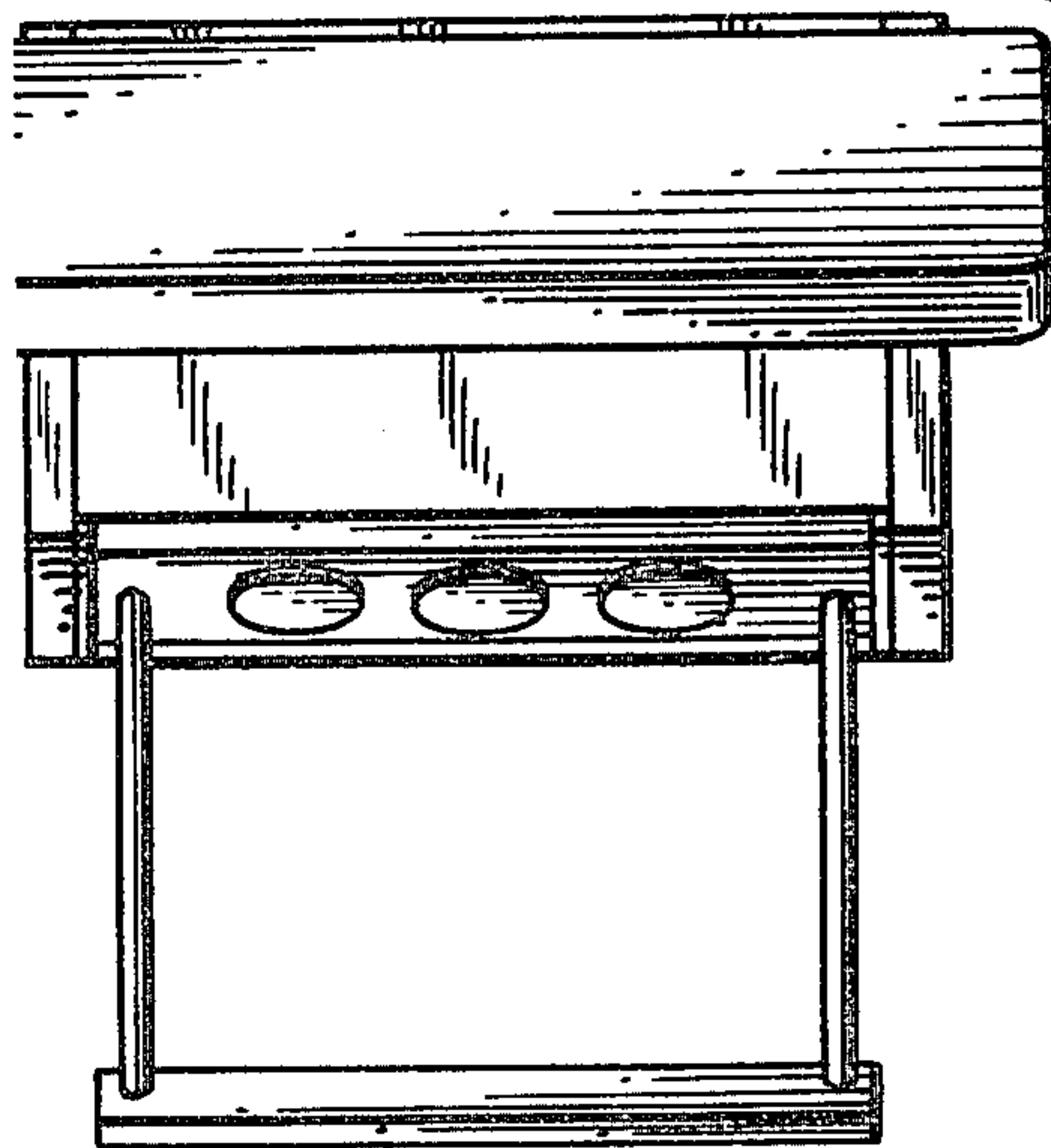

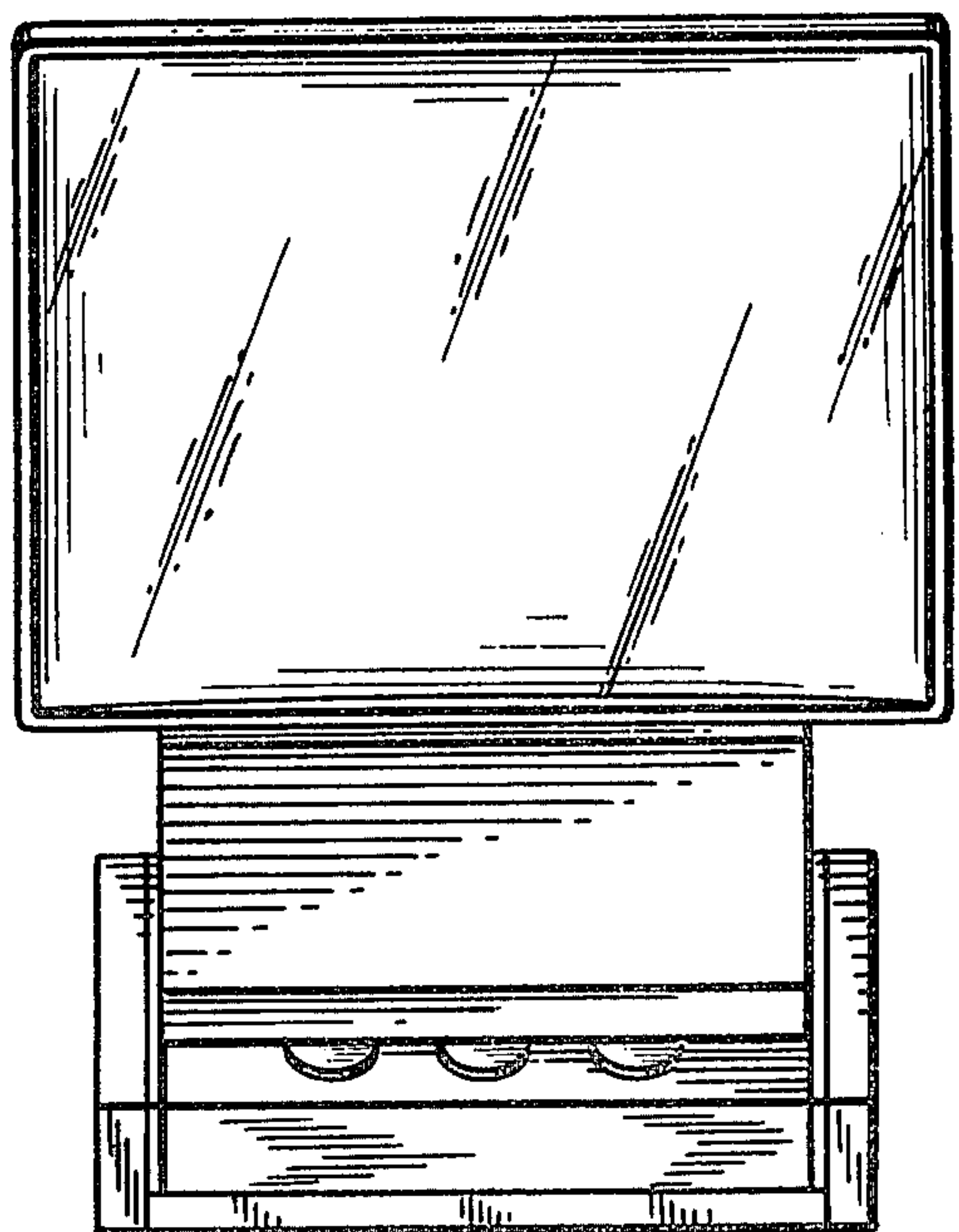
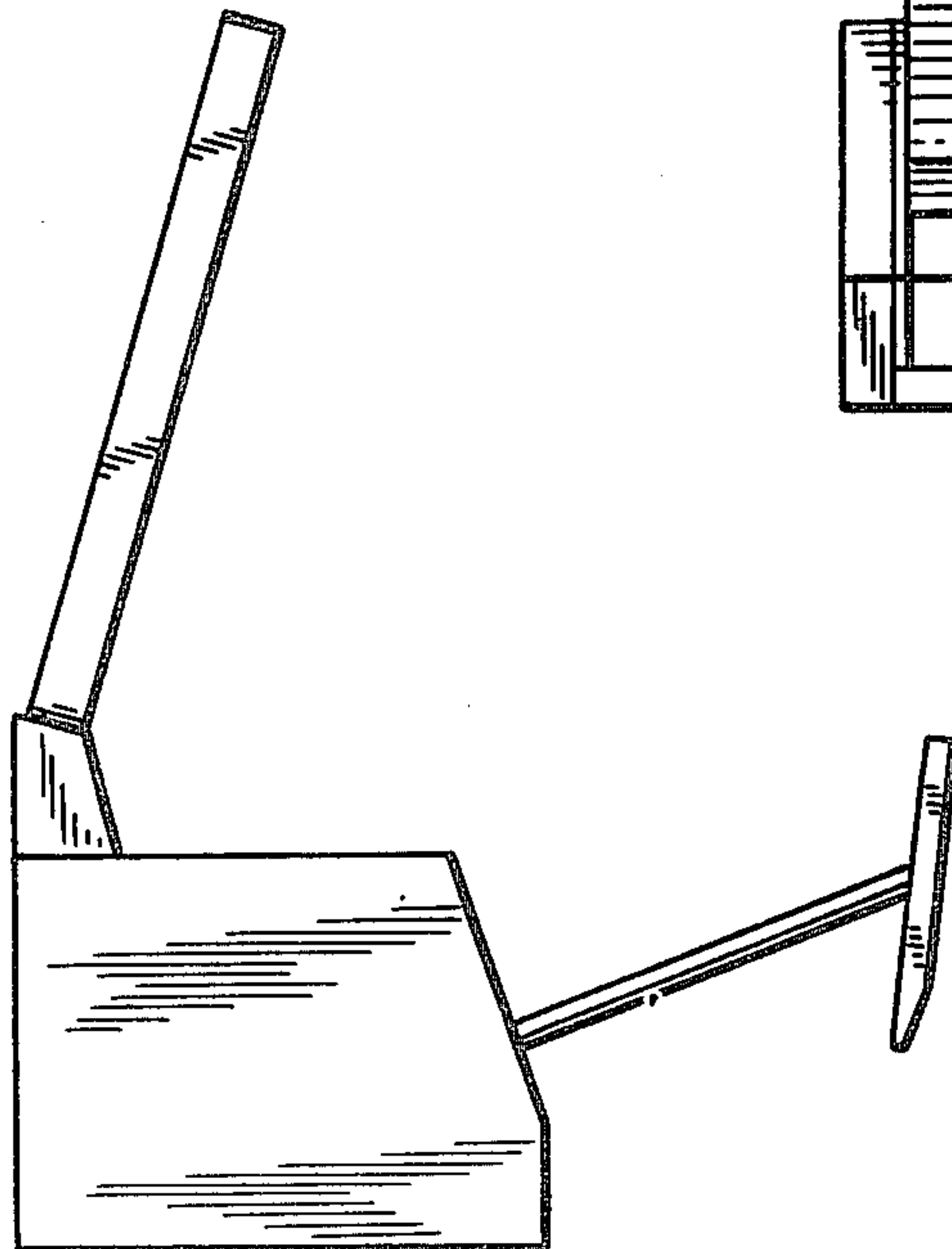

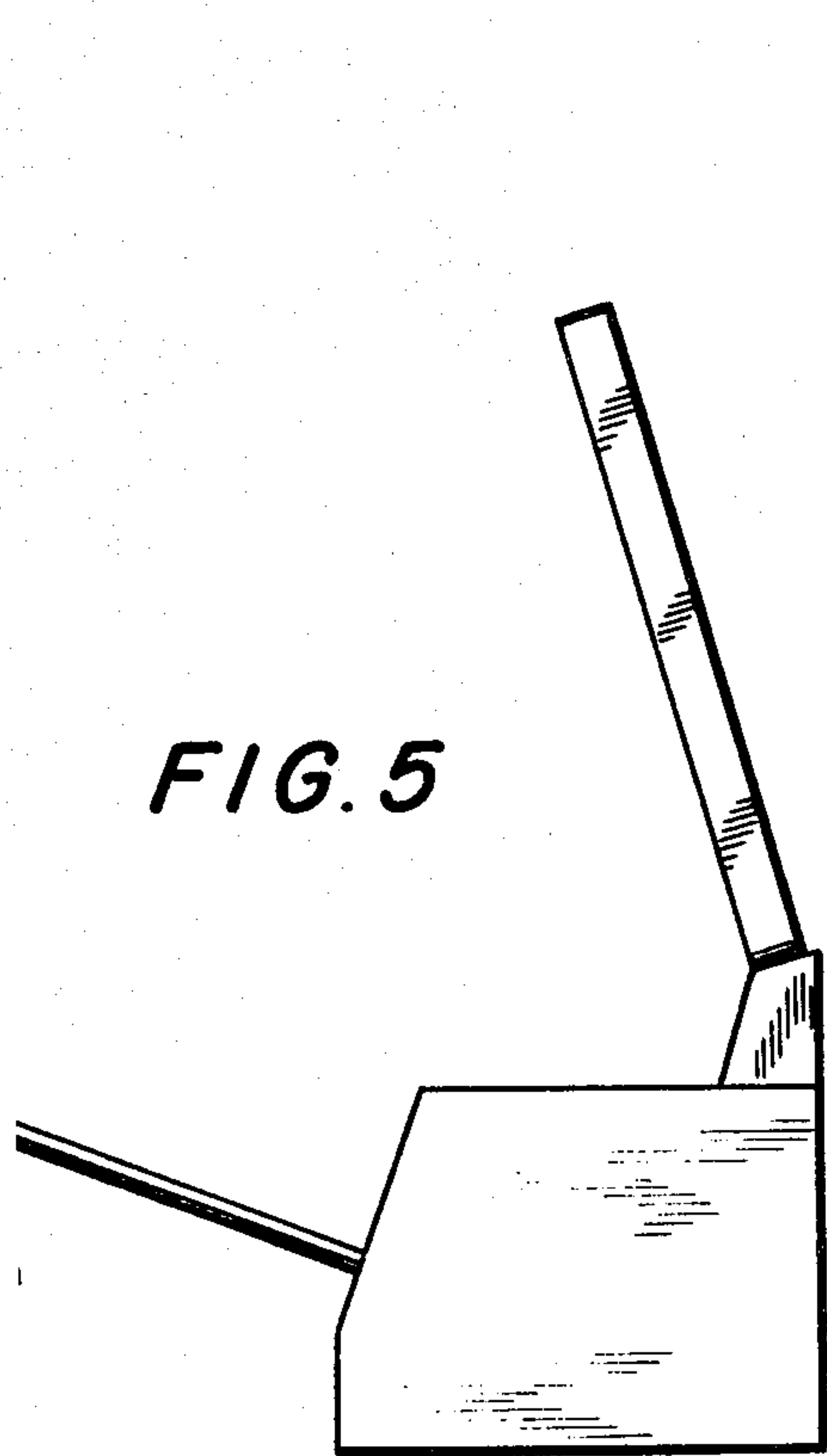

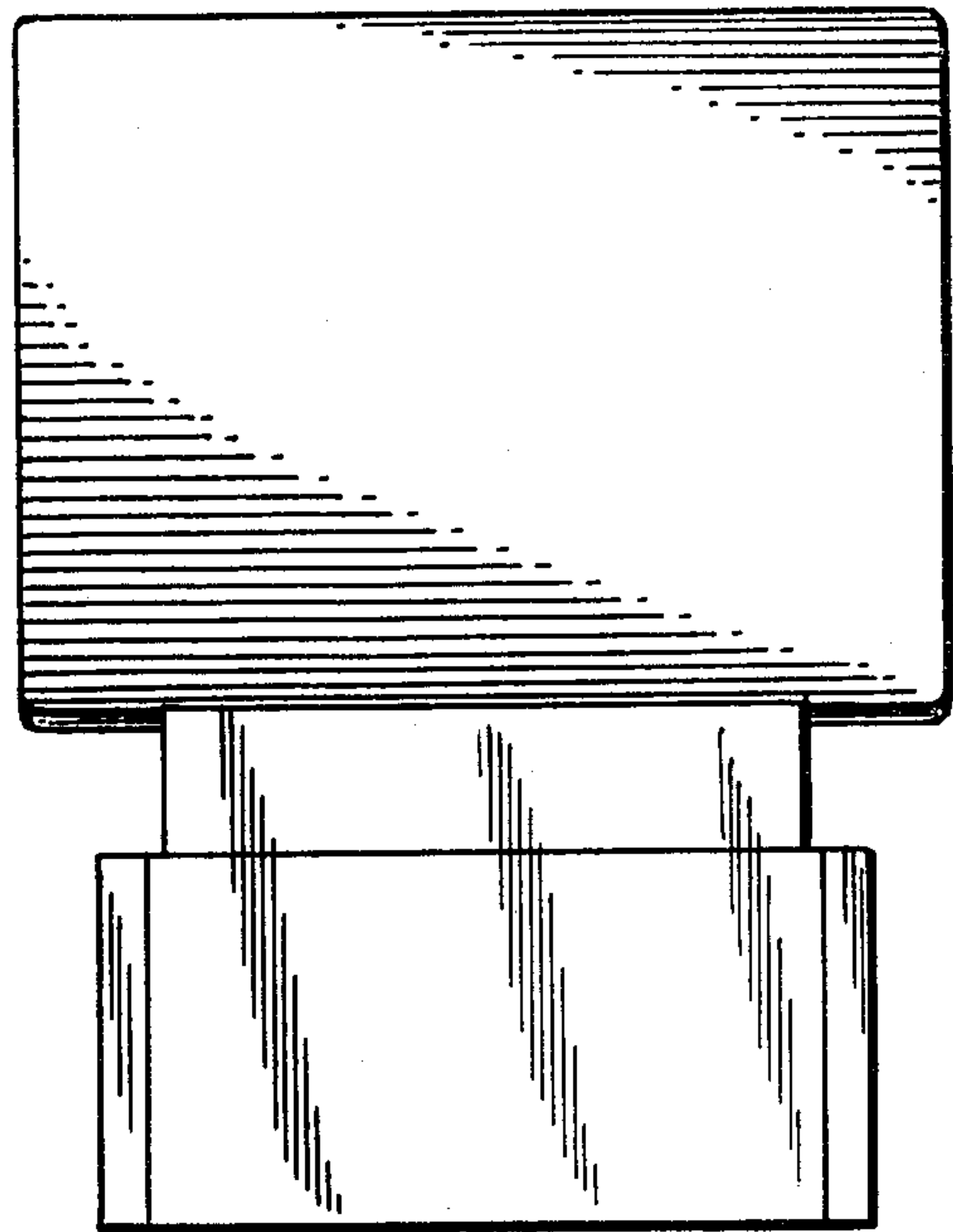

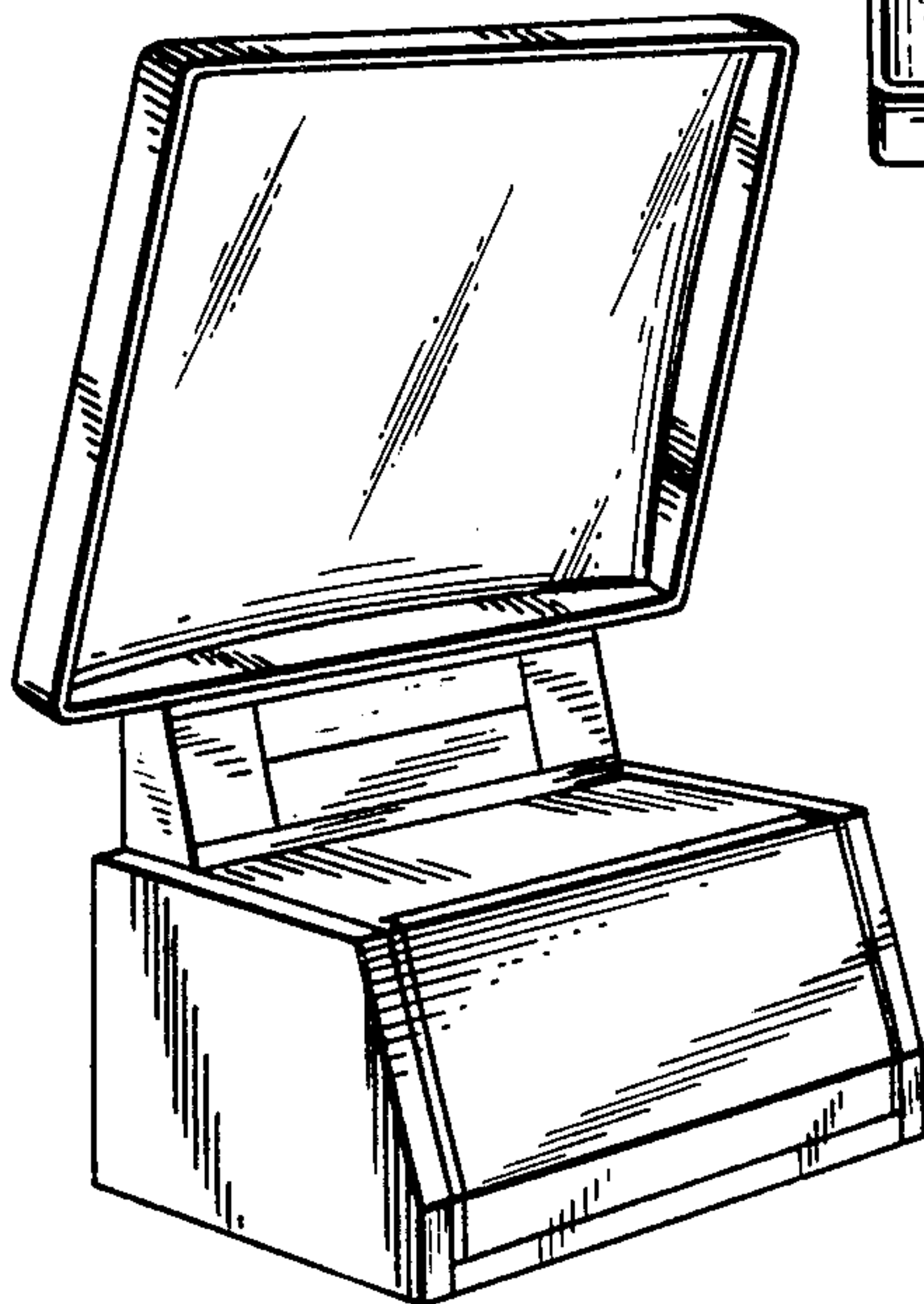
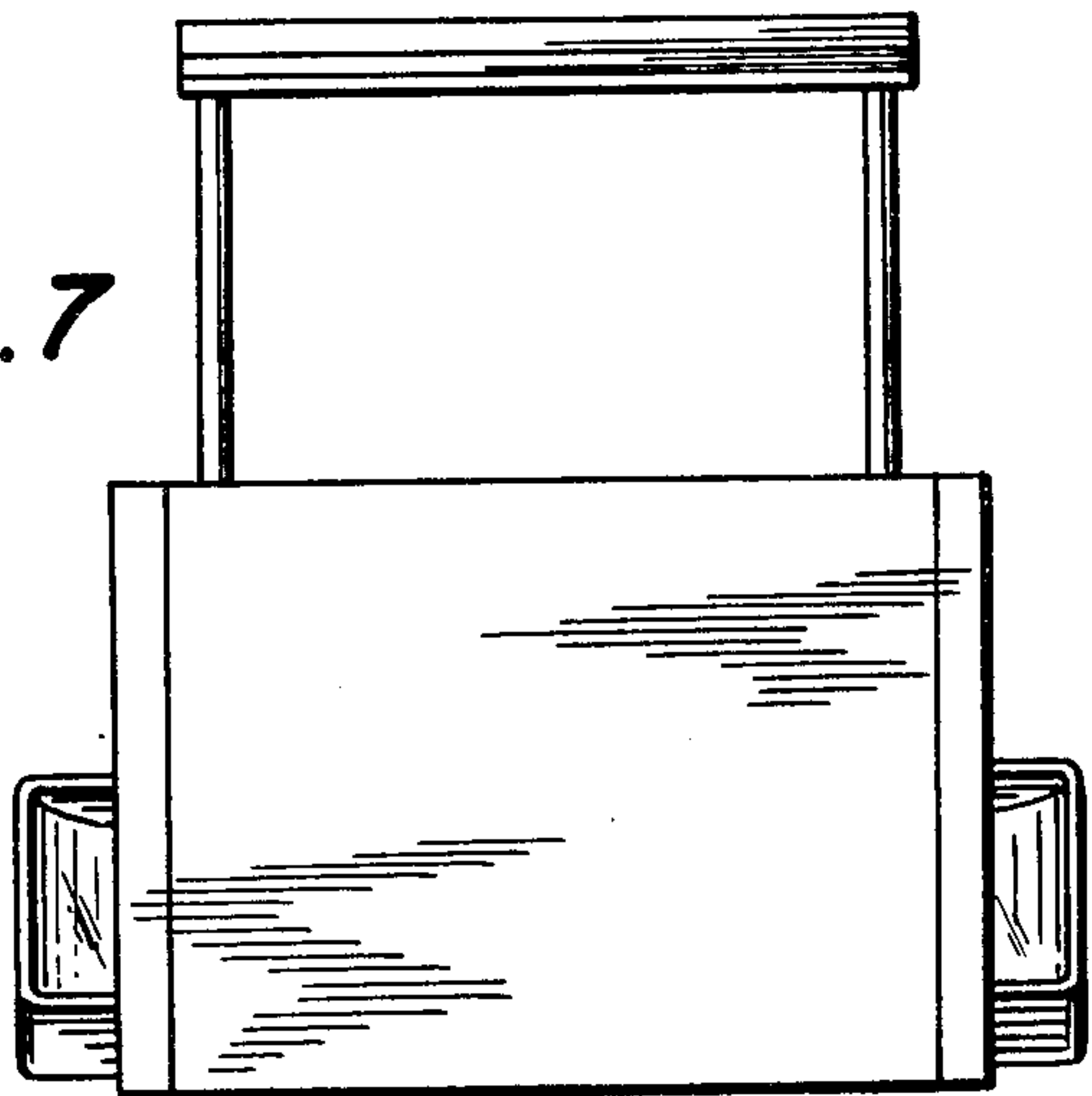
