FIG. 5 is a front elevational view of the seat shown in FIG. 1, the rear elevational view being the same.

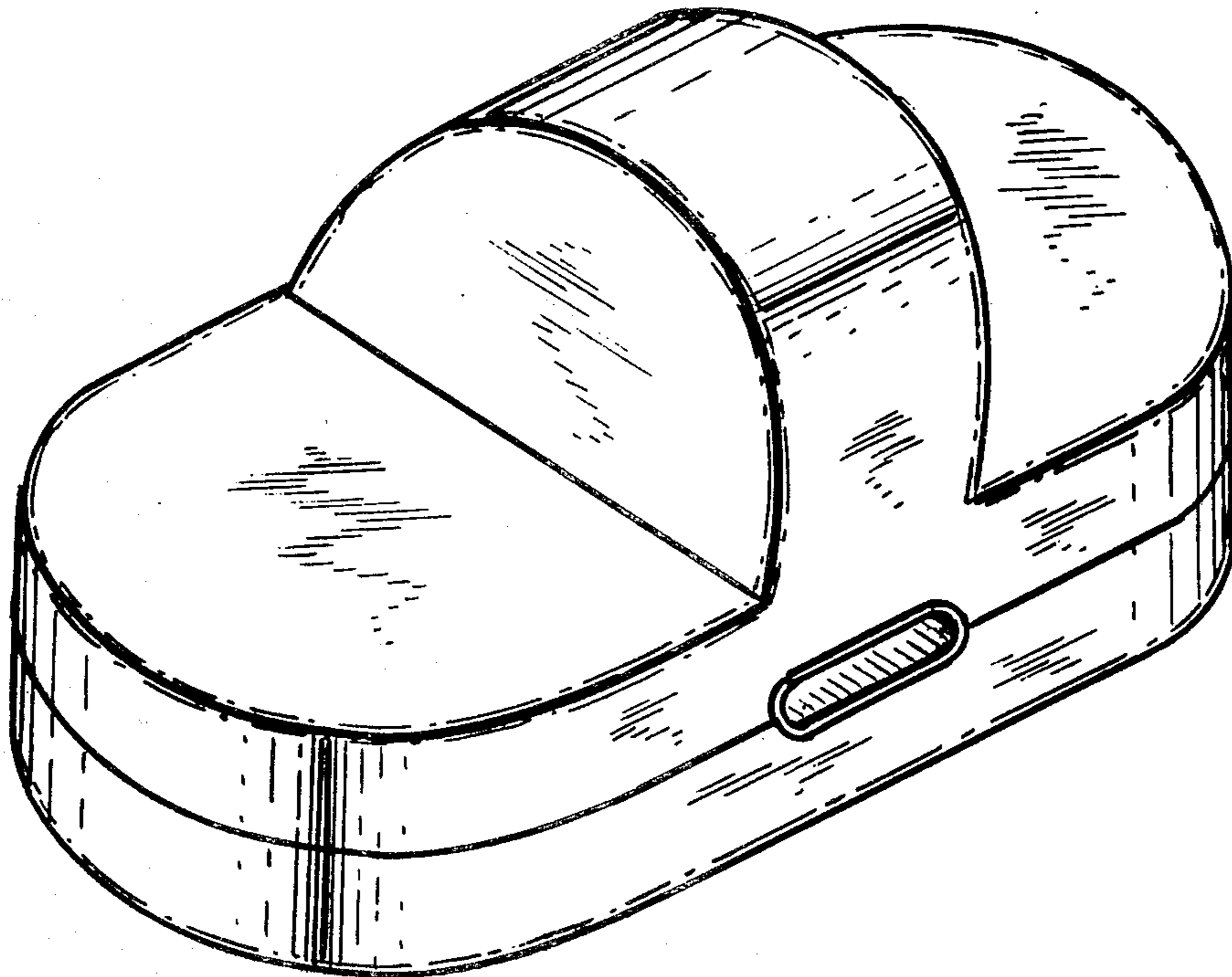

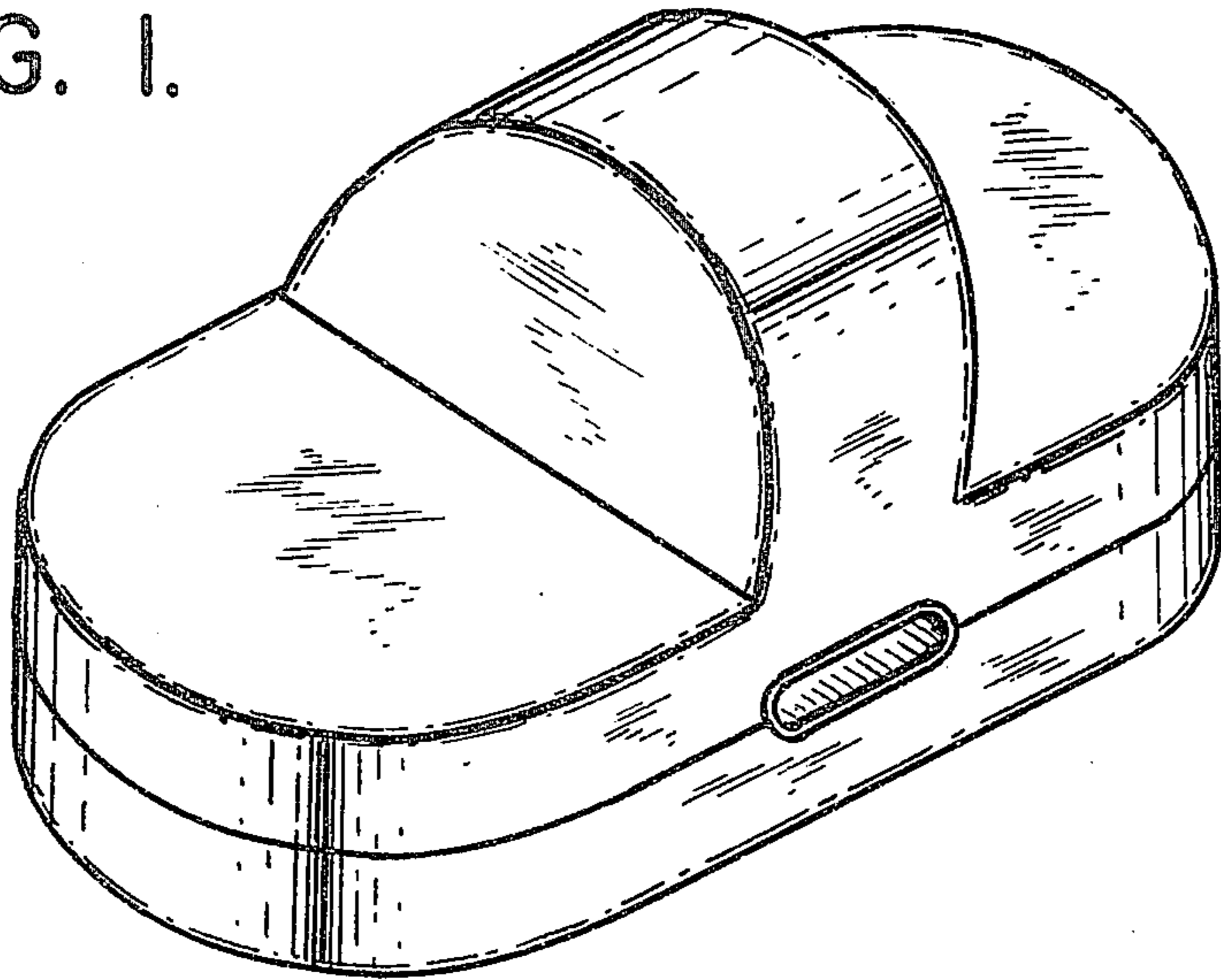

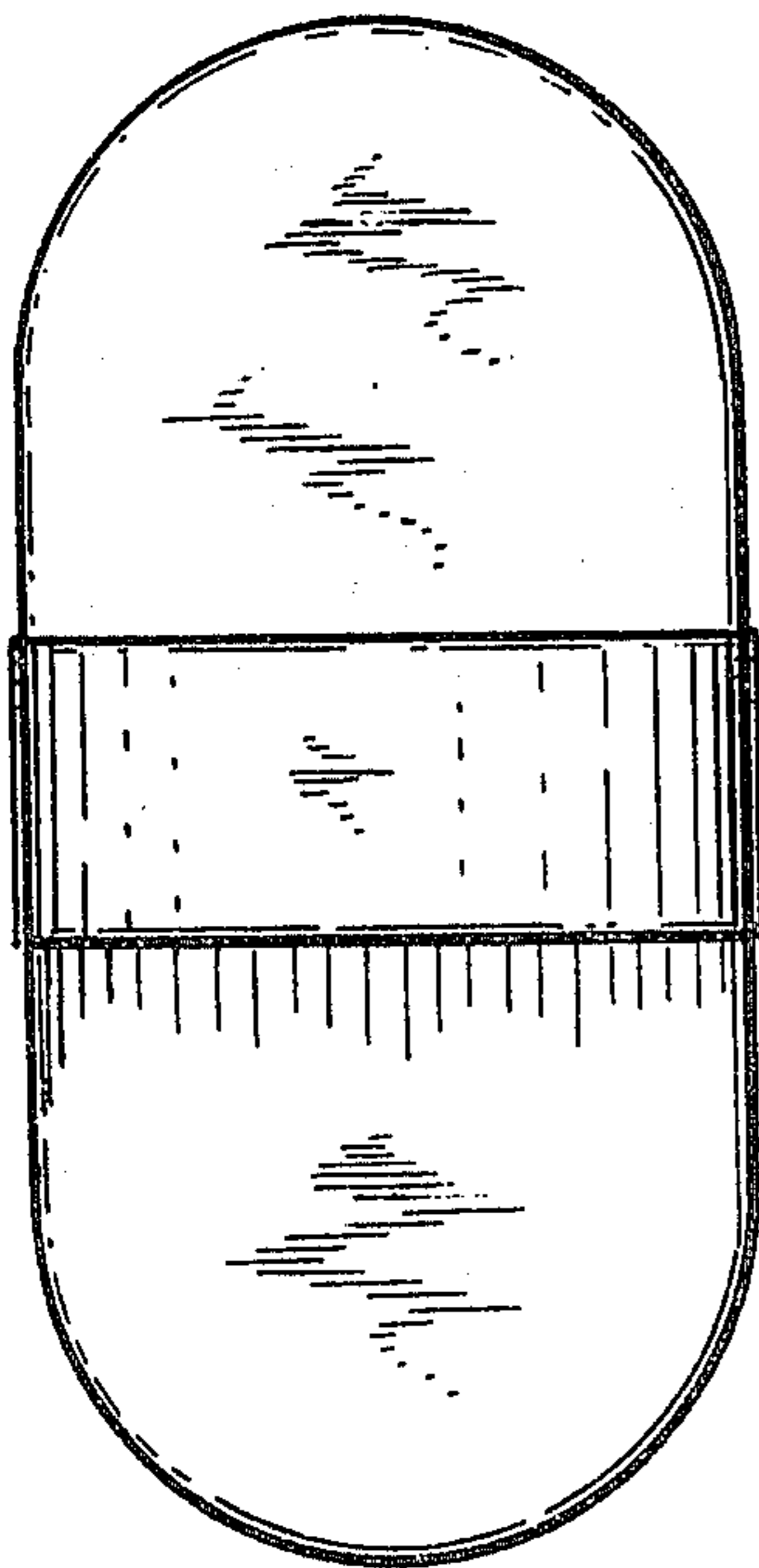

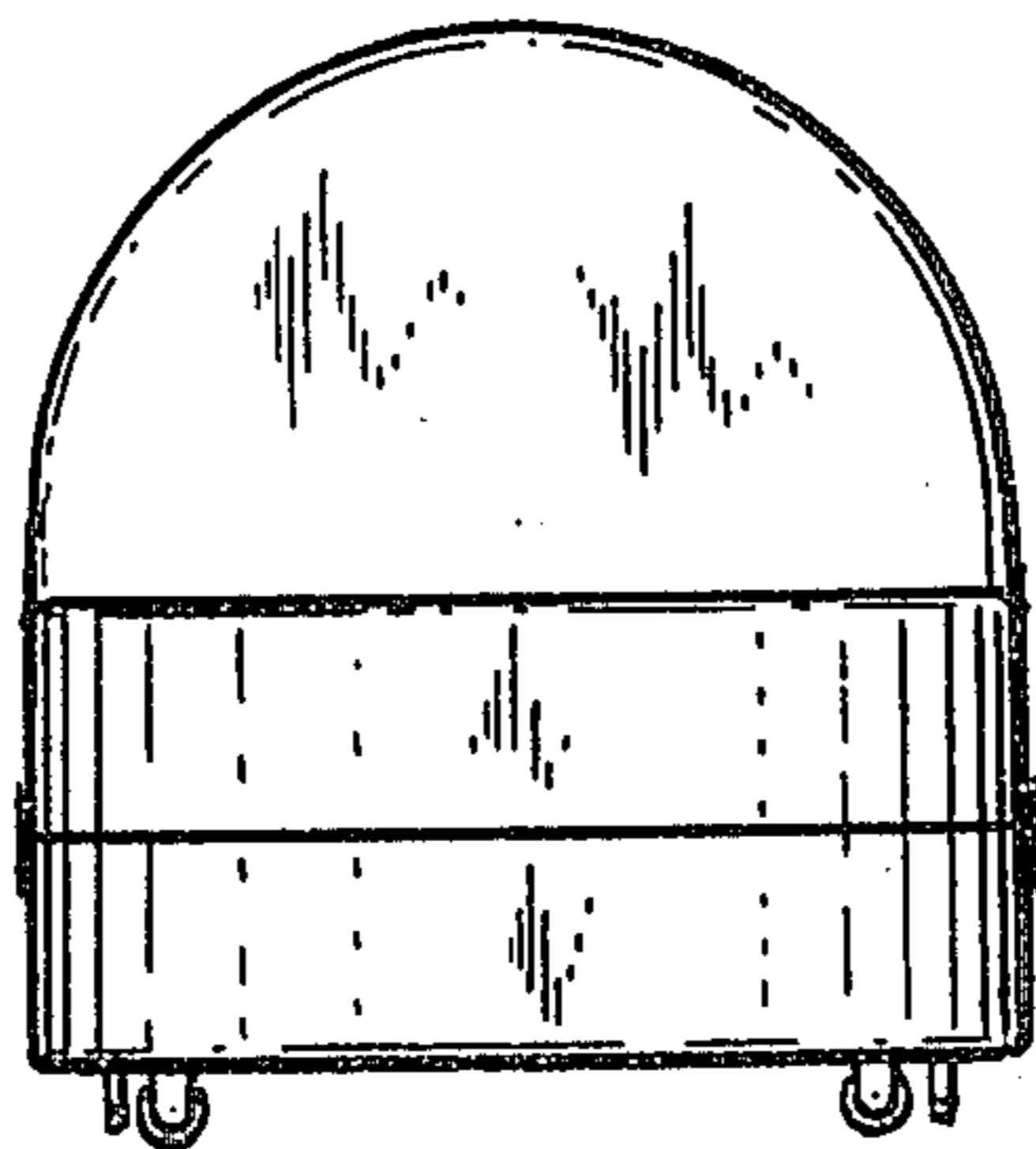

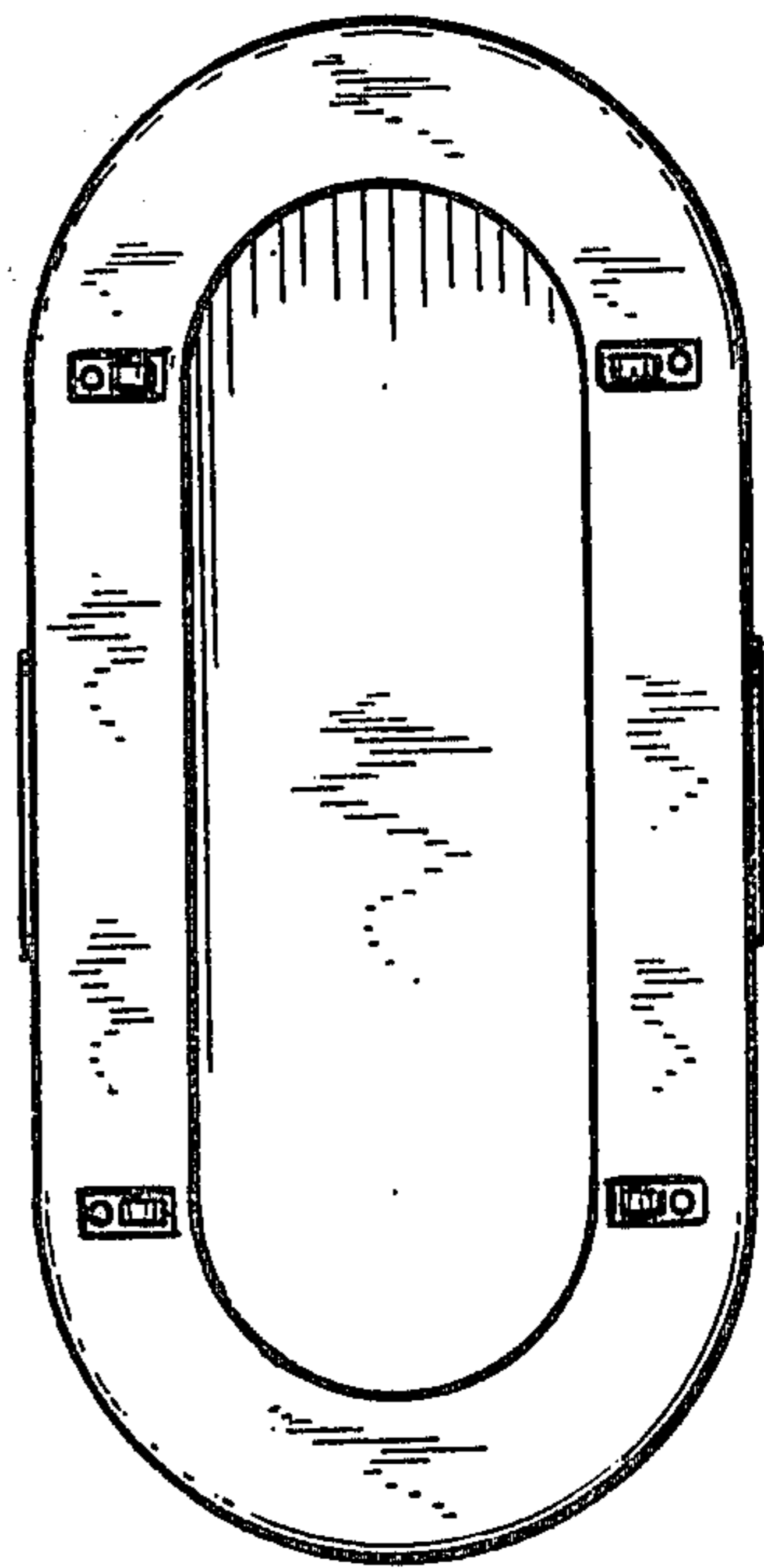
