The back is plain and unornamented.

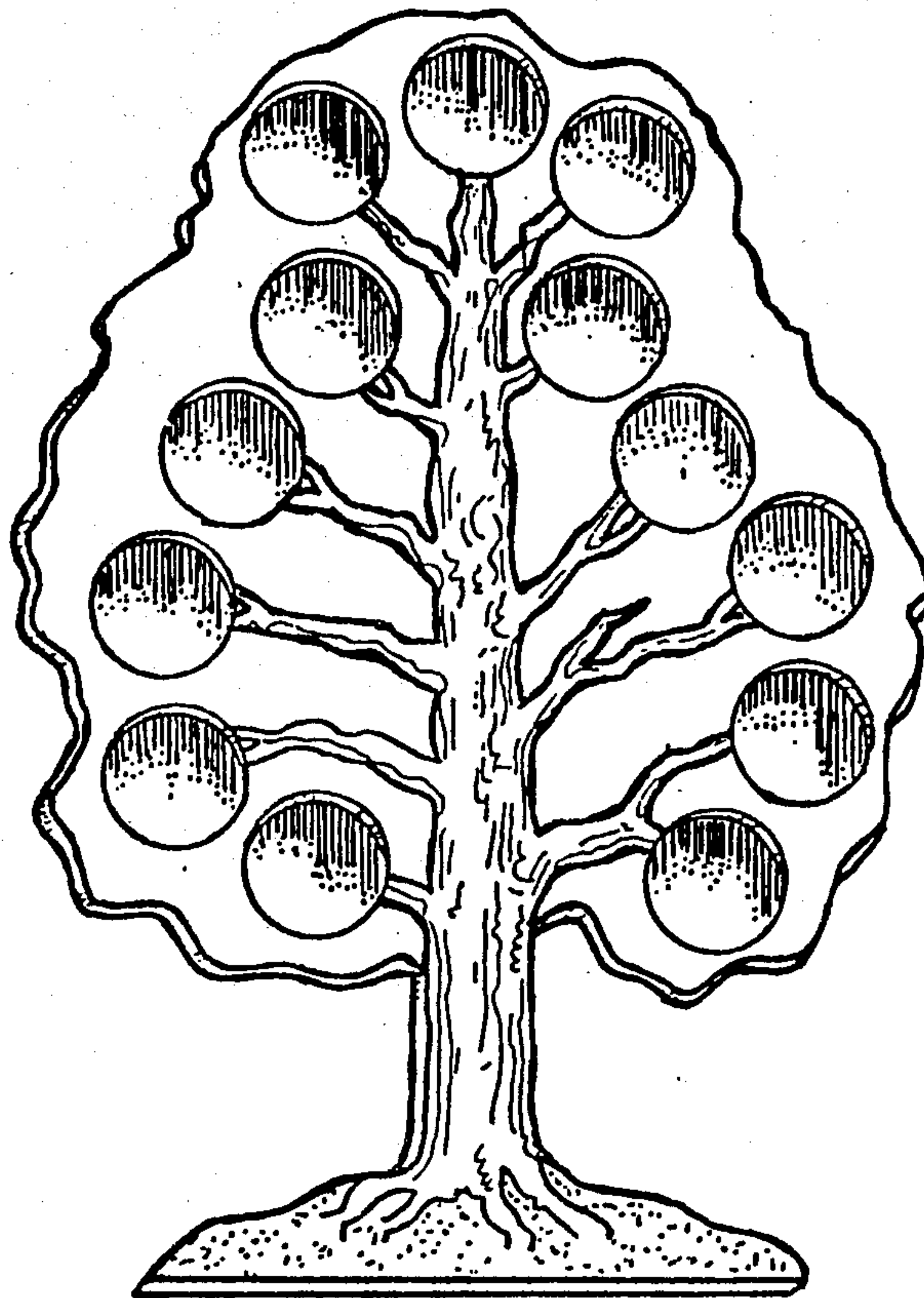
