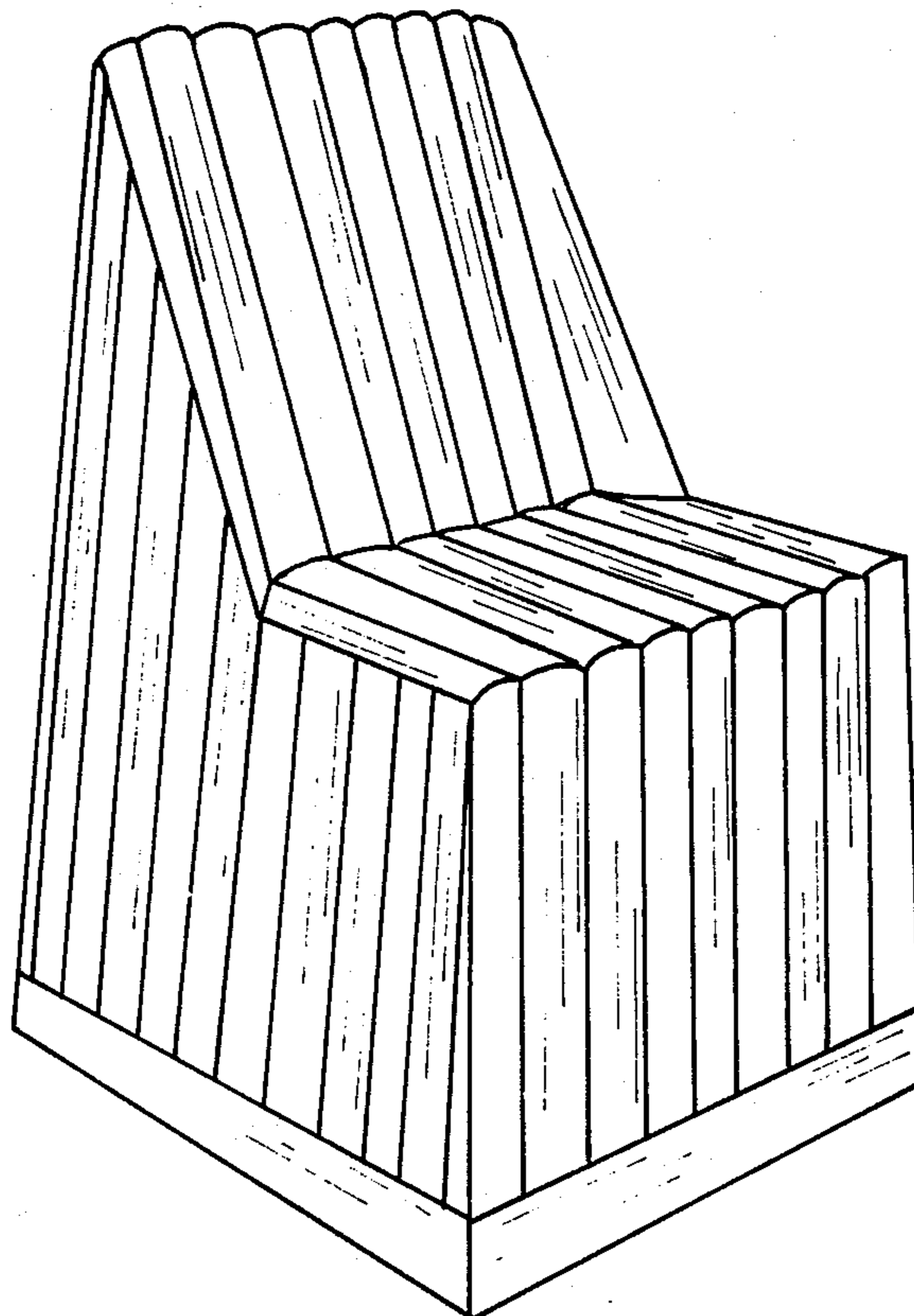

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a chair cover showing our design;
FIG. 2 is a side view;
FIG. 3 is a front view;
FIG. 4 is a rear view;
FIG. 5 is a cross sectional view taken along the lines 5—5 of FIG. 3; and
FIG. 6 is a front perspective view thereof.
The chair as shown by means of the broken lines in FIG. 5 is for illustrative purposes only.



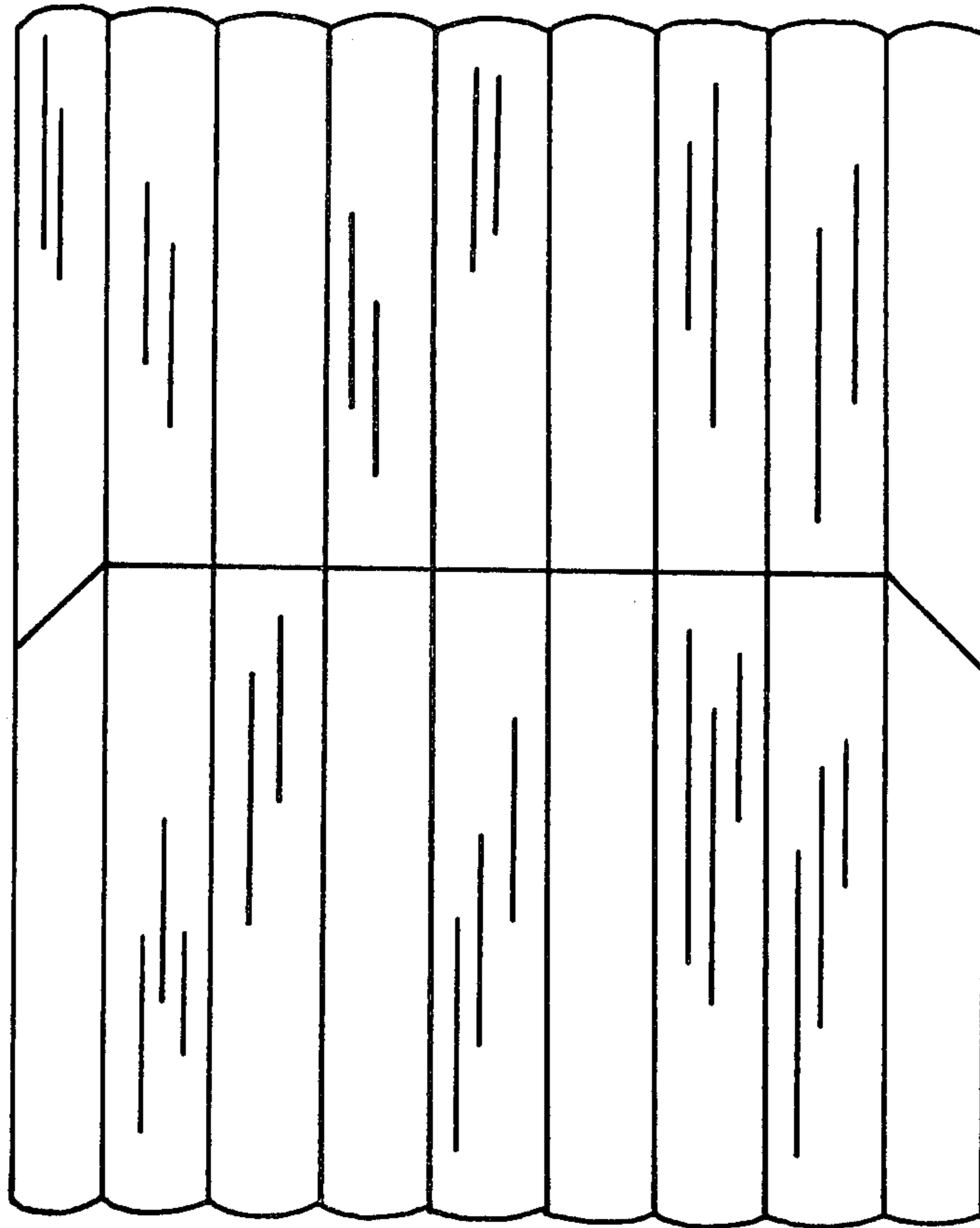

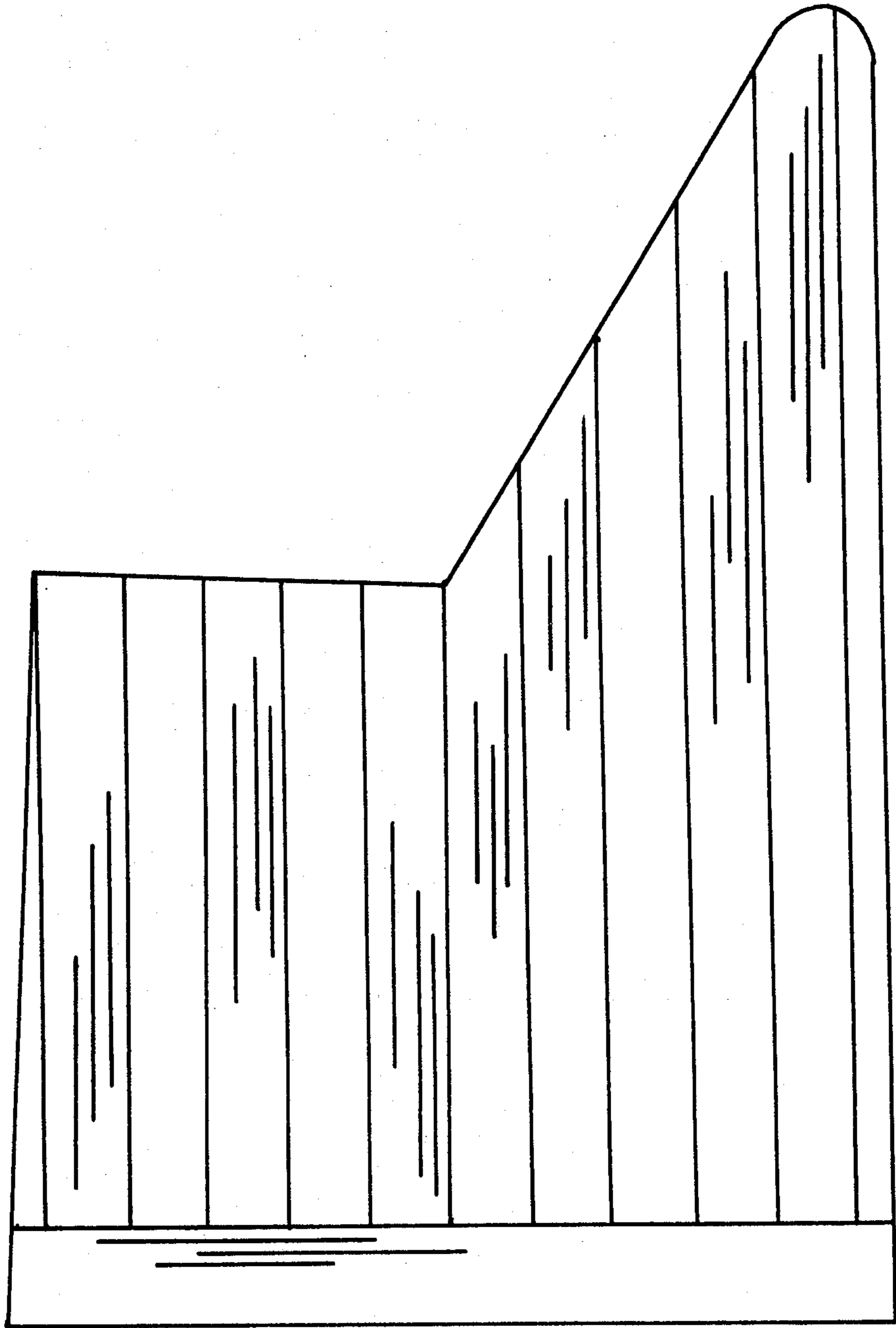

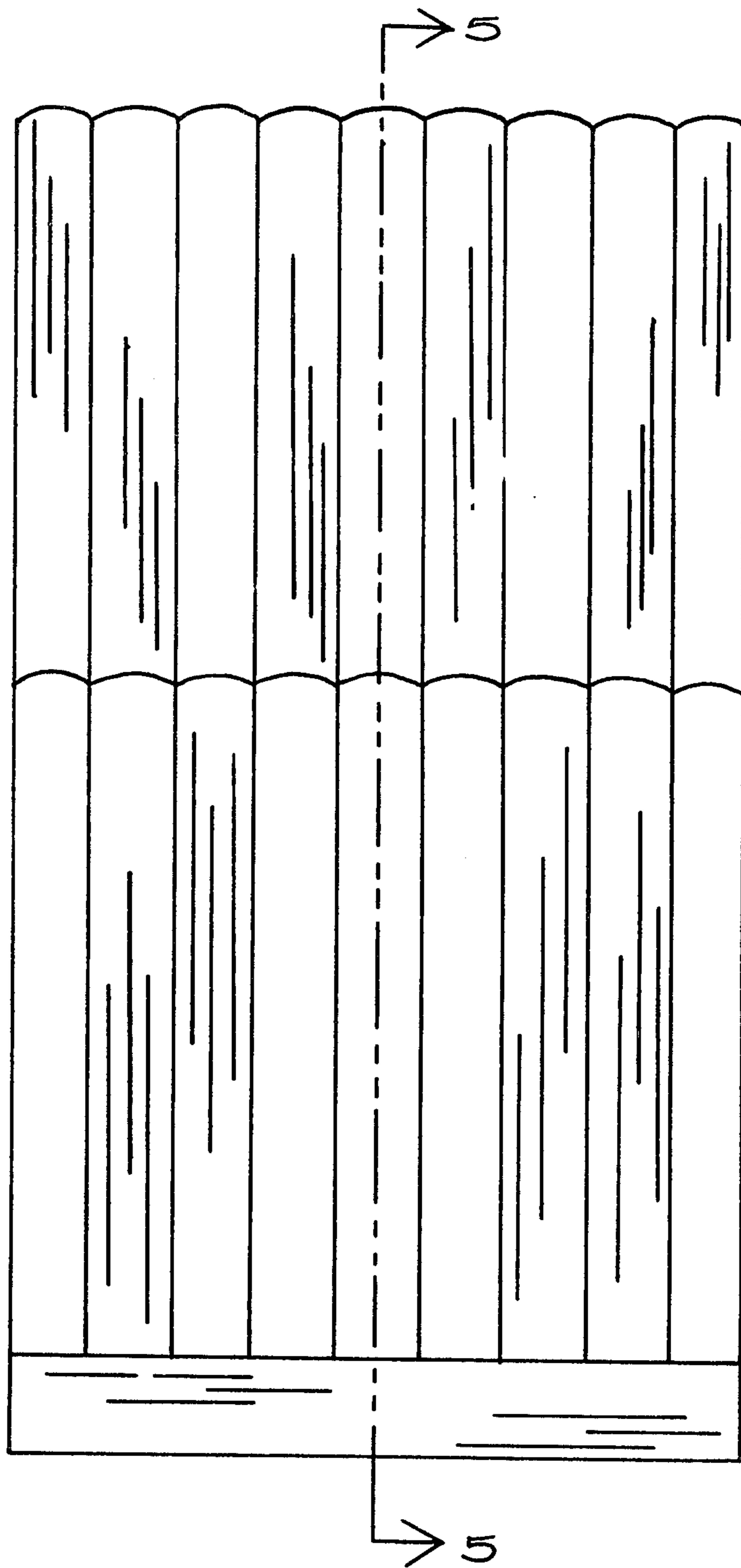

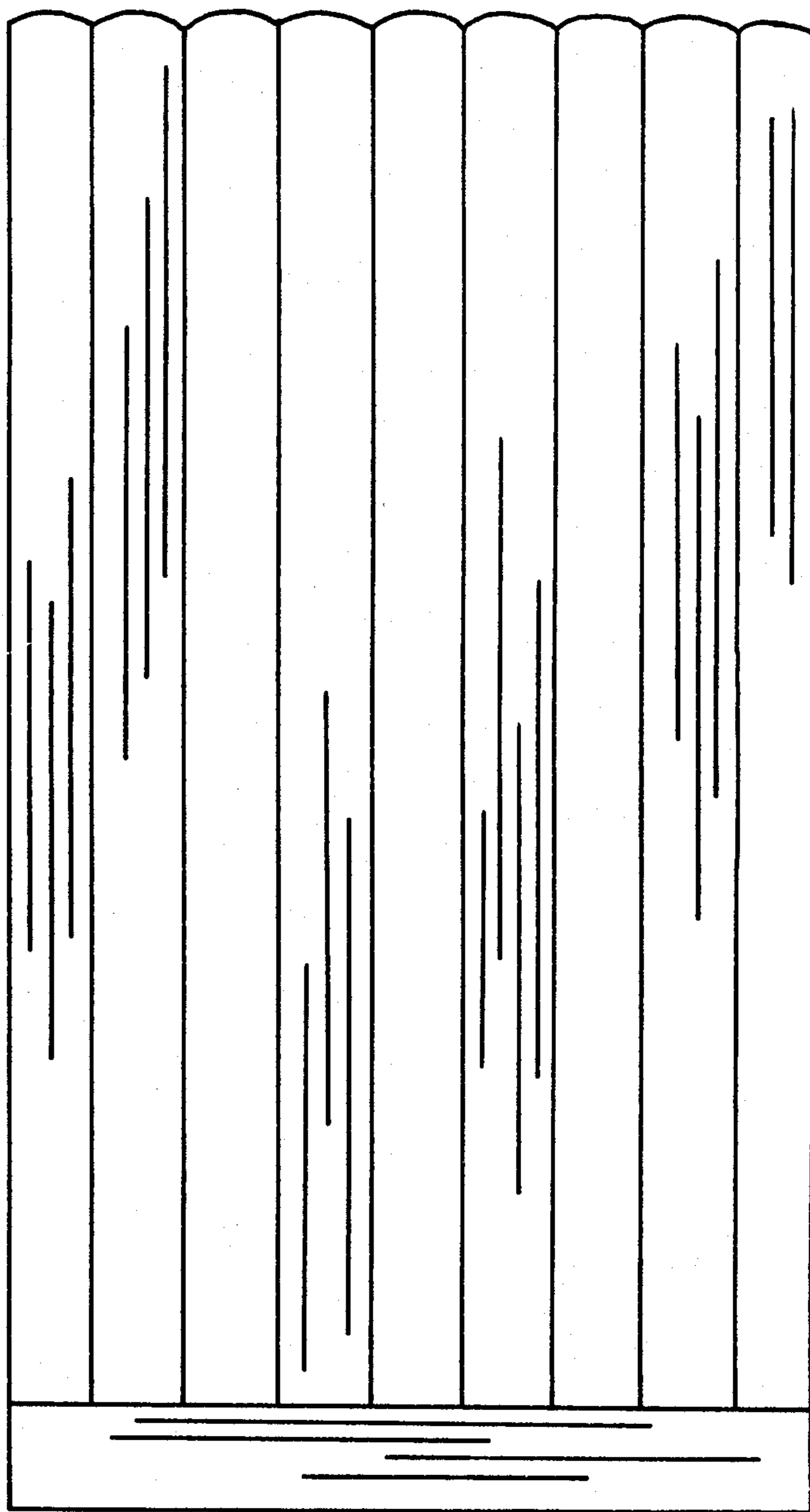

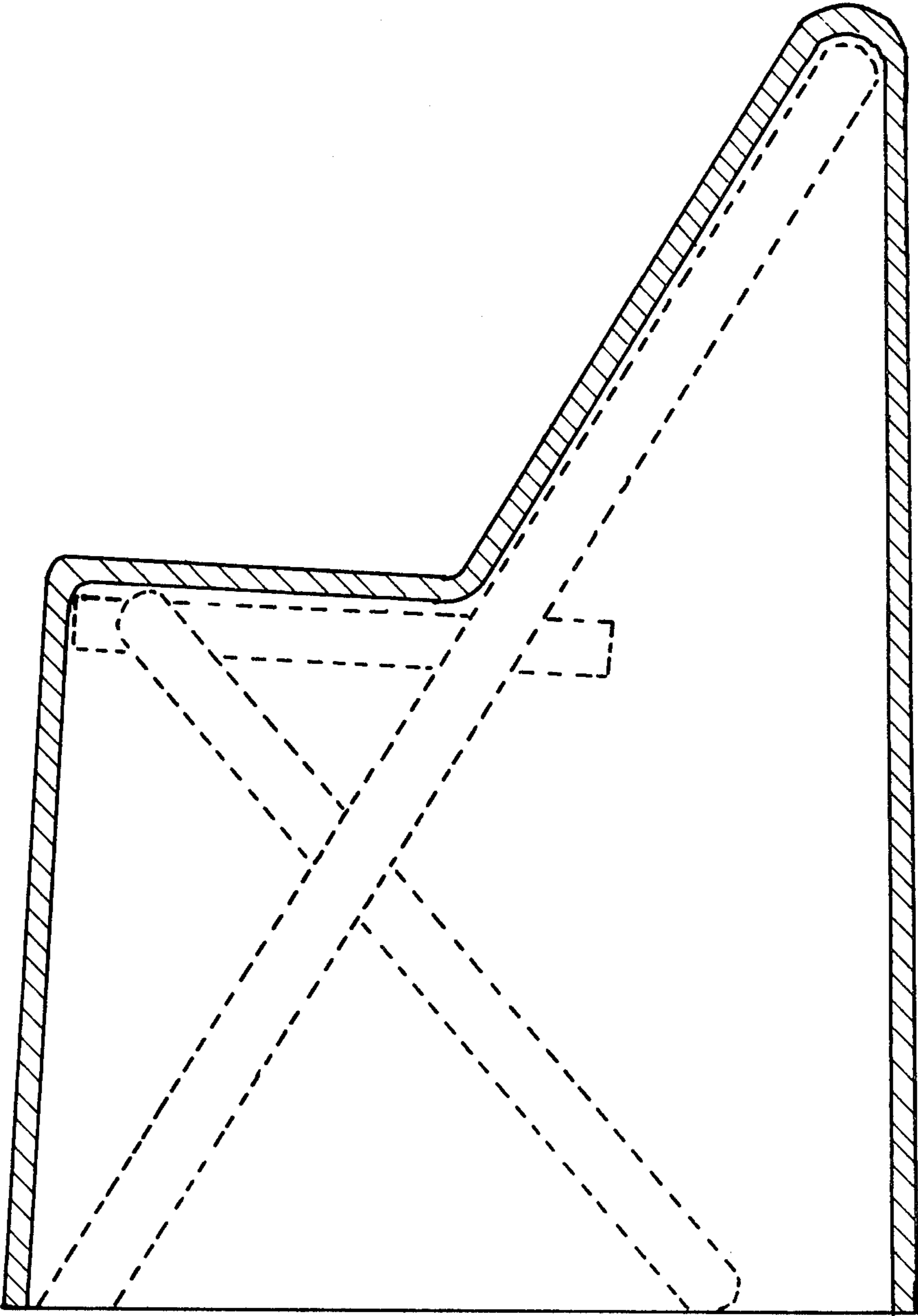

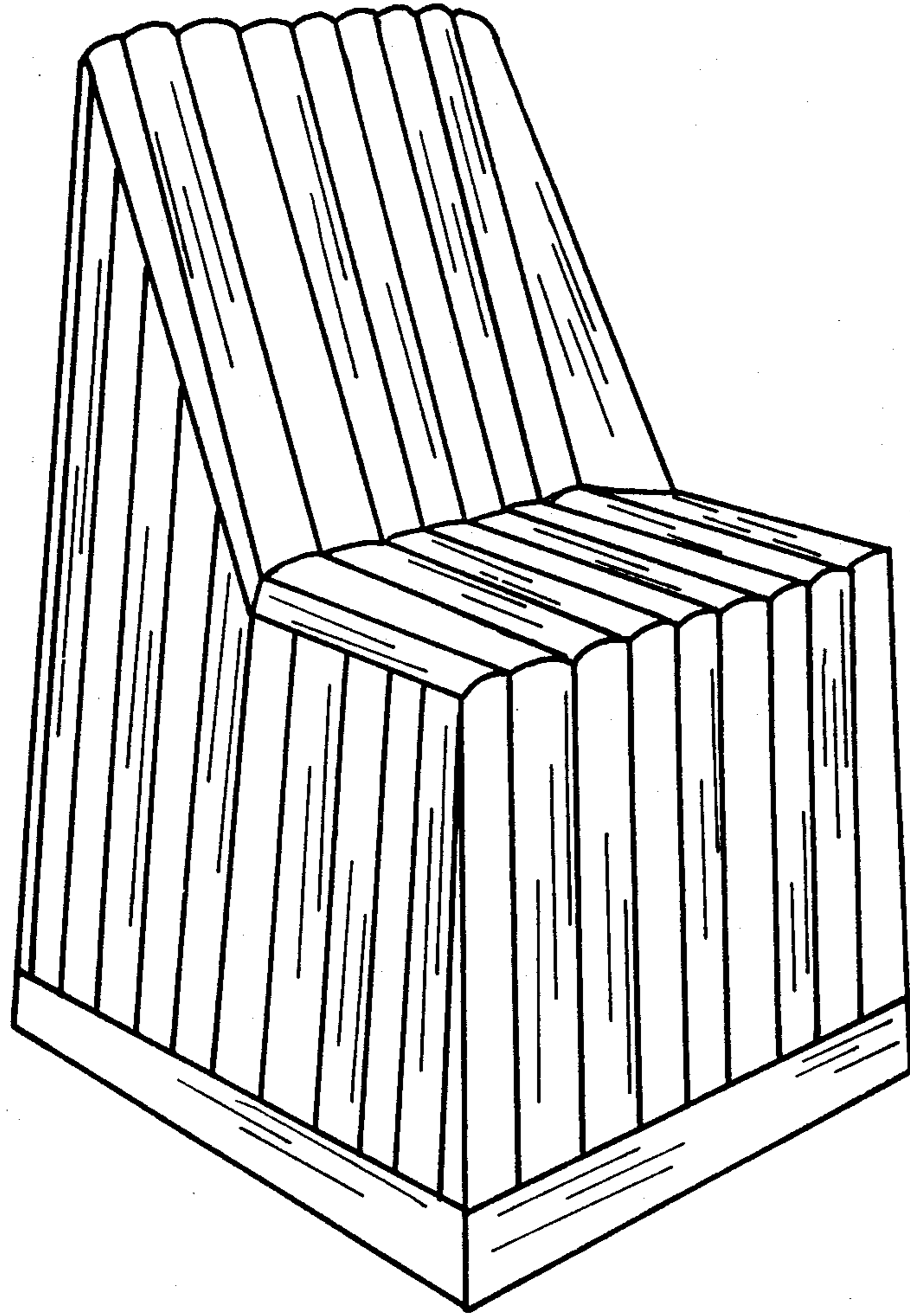
