The ornamental design for a casserole dish or the like, substantially as shown.

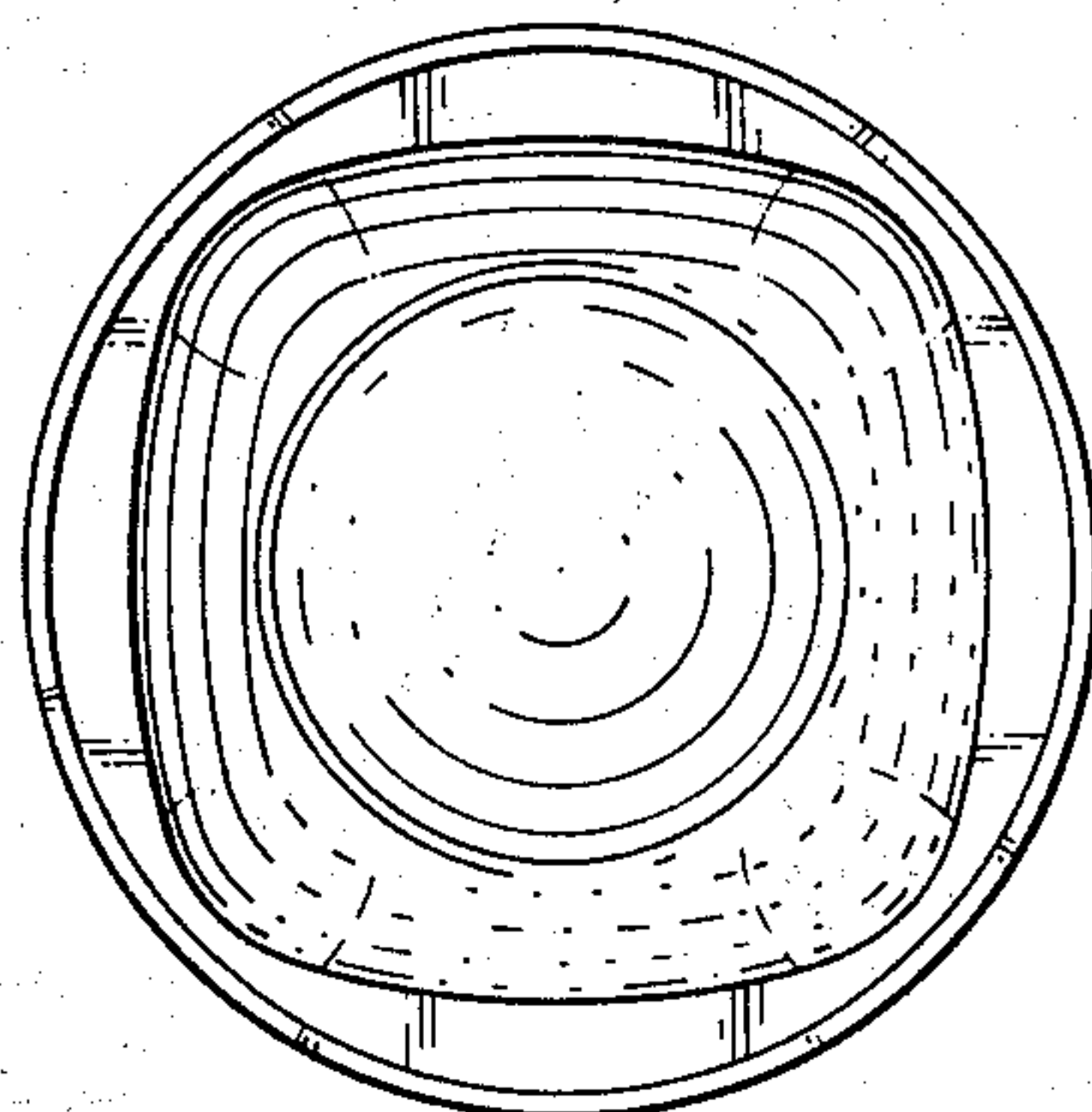
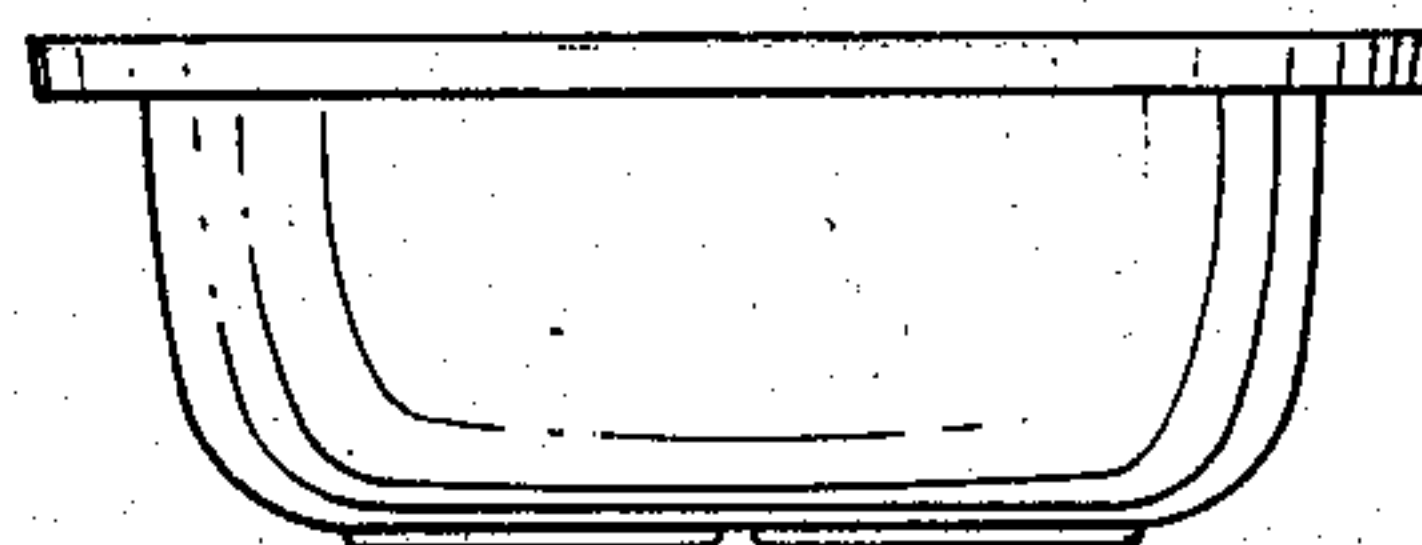
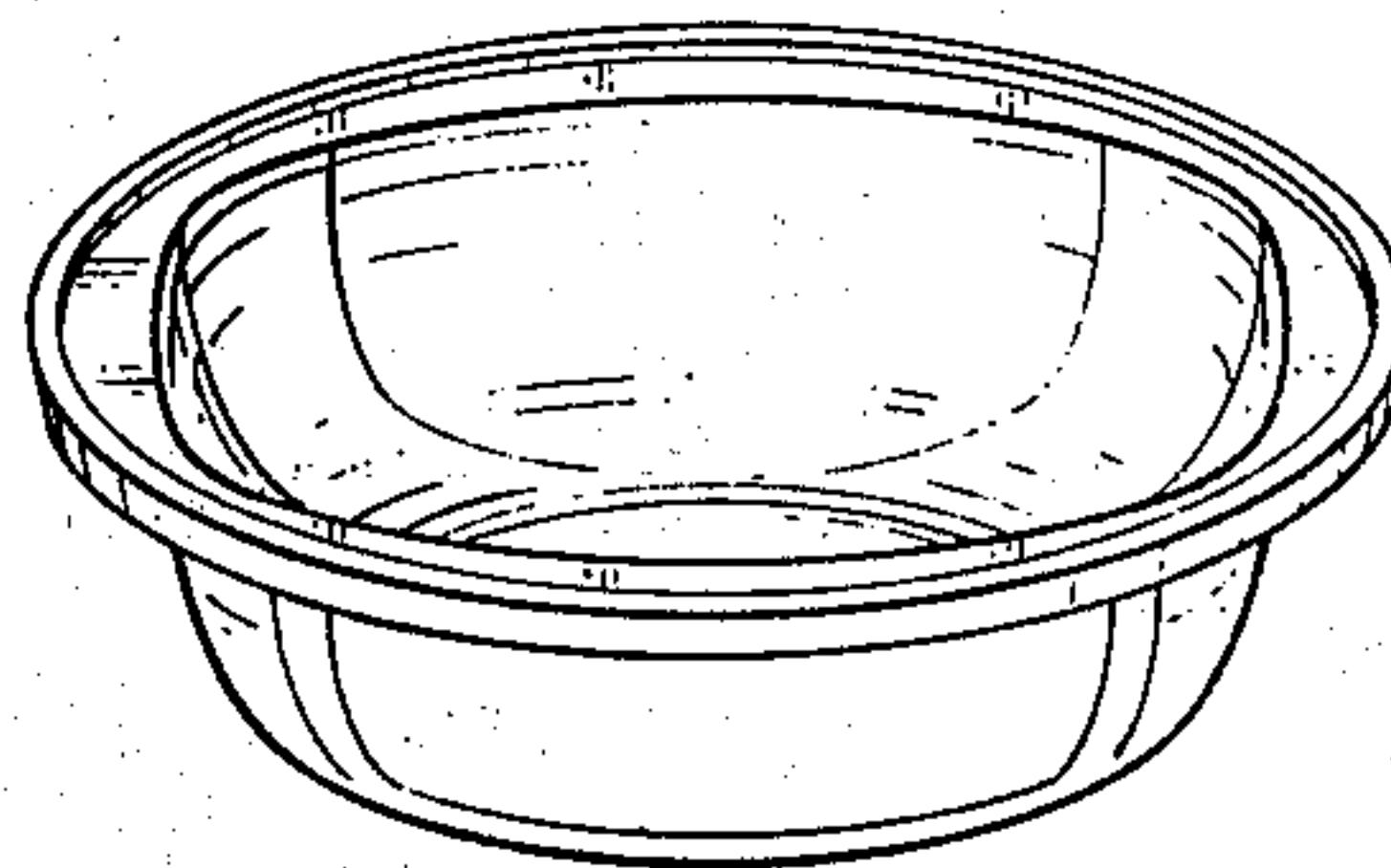
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof.



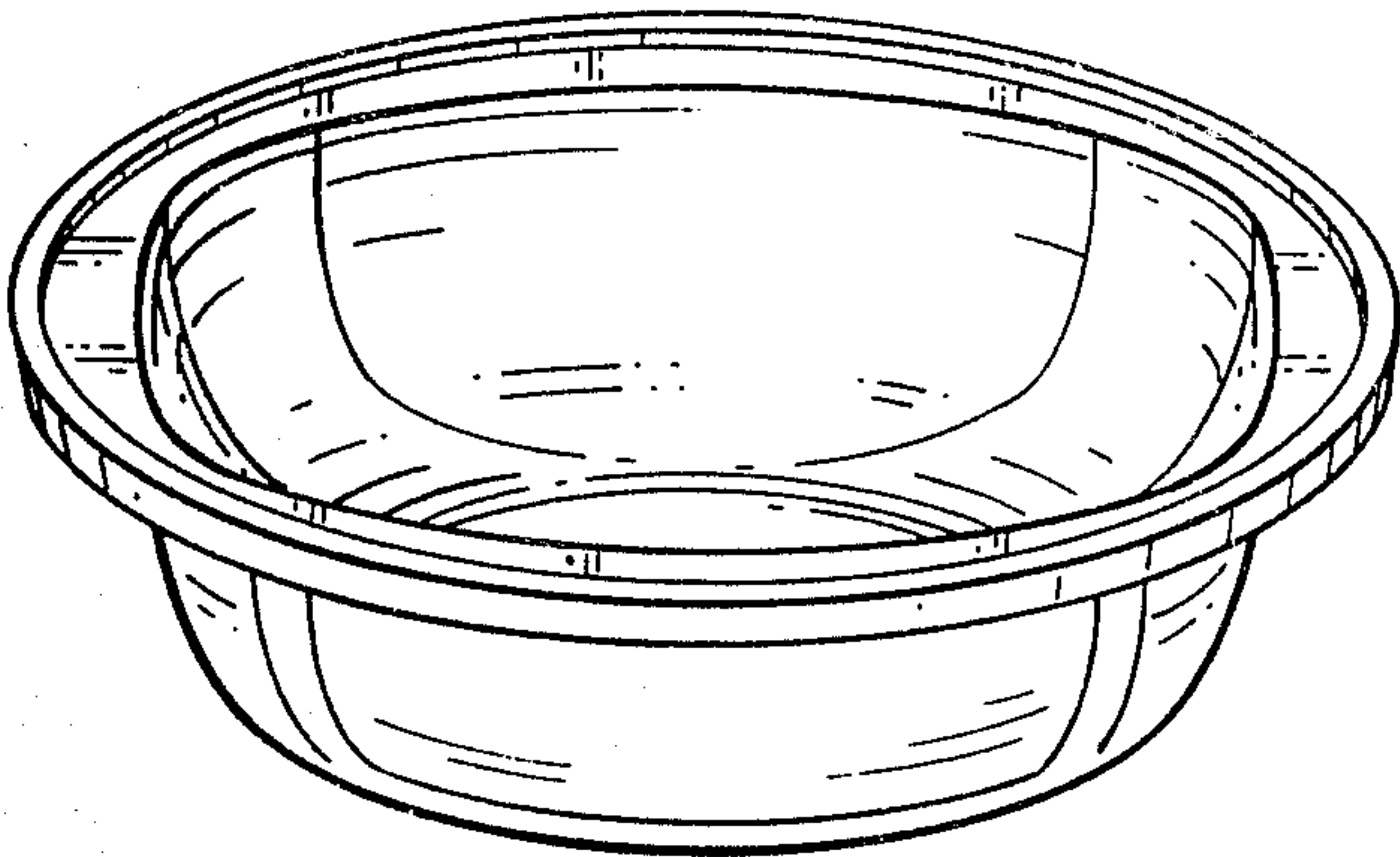

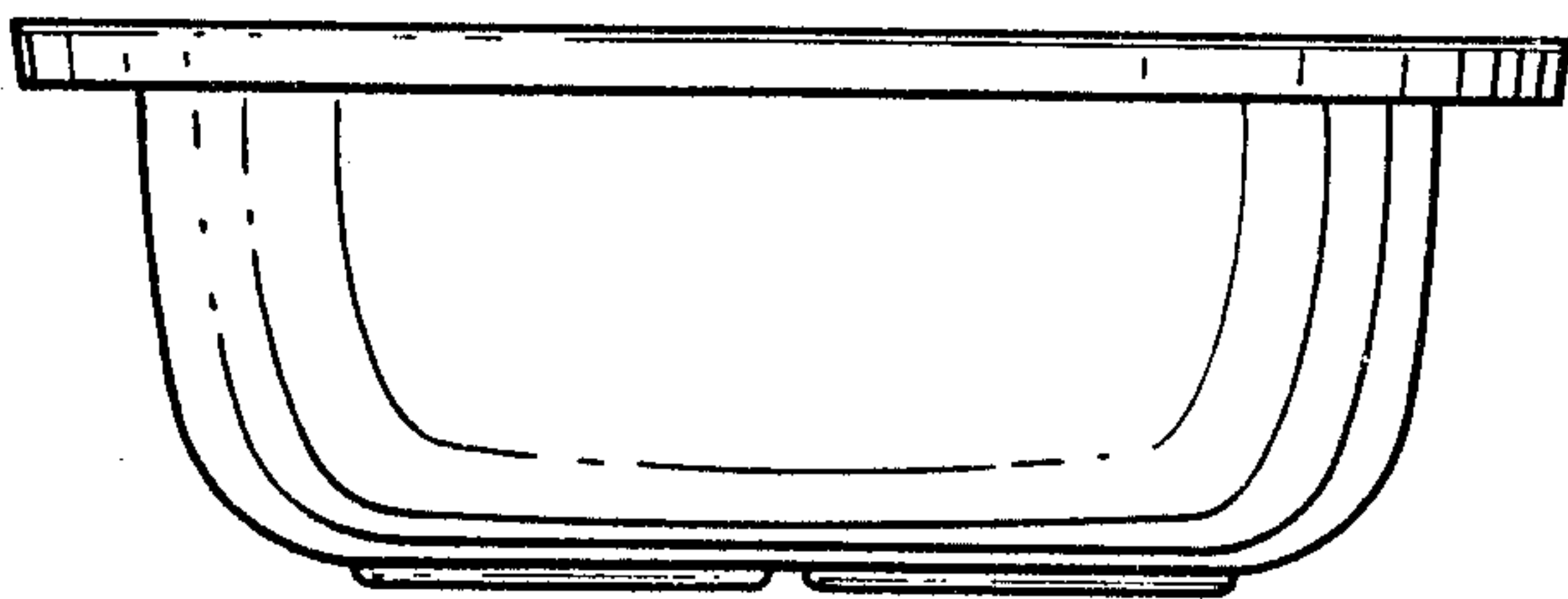

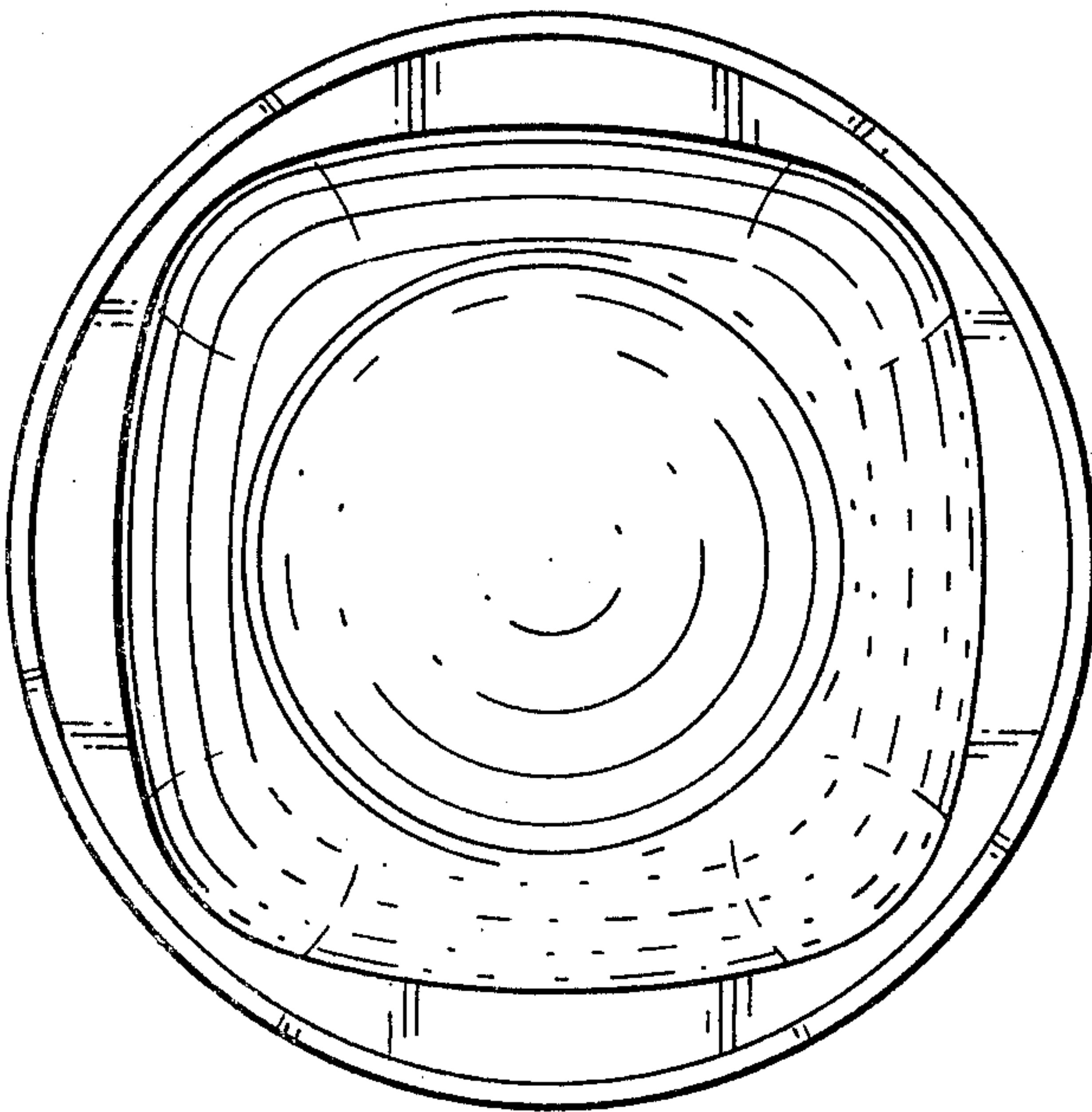

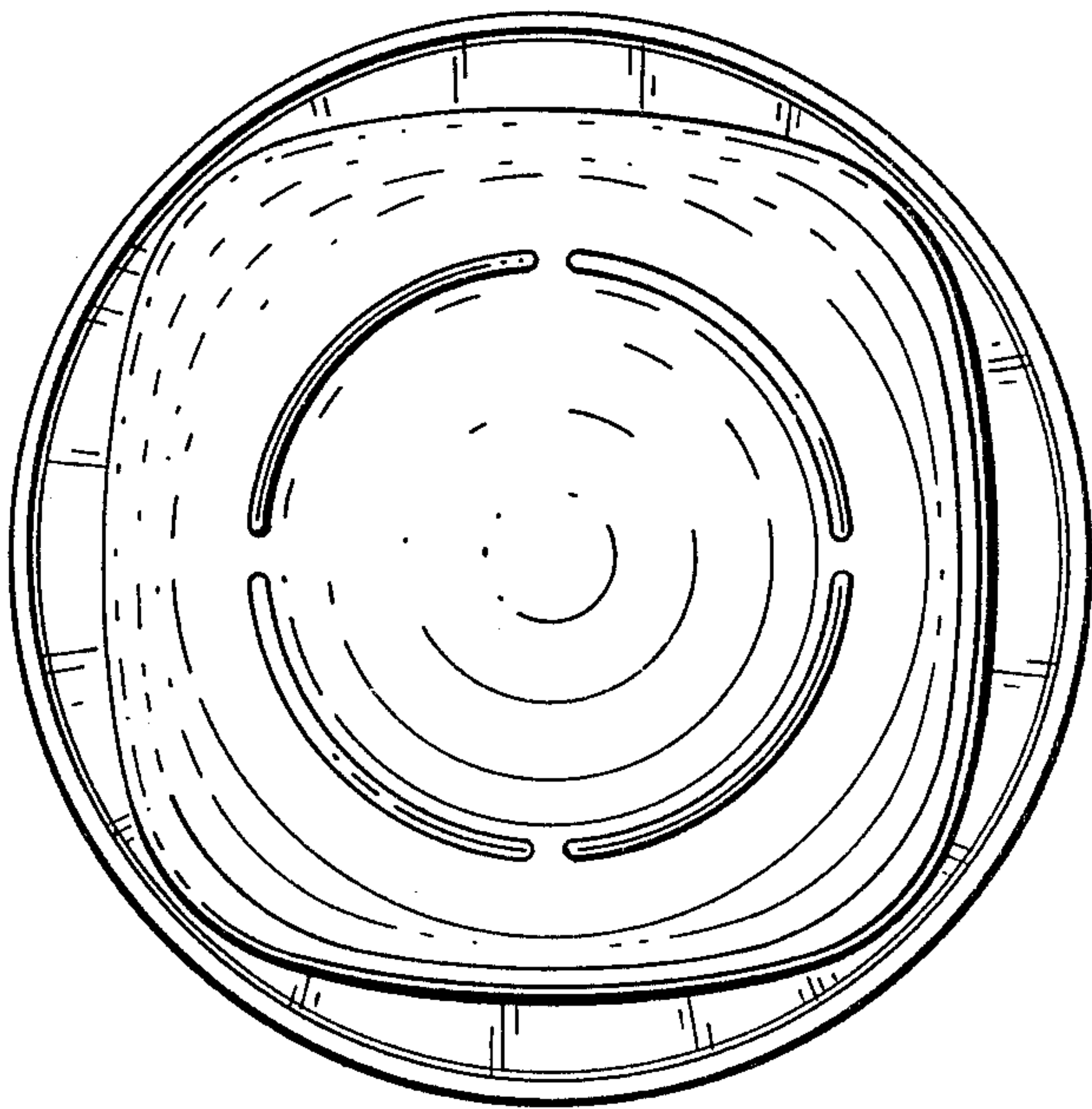
